FIG. 4 is a left elevational view thereof.

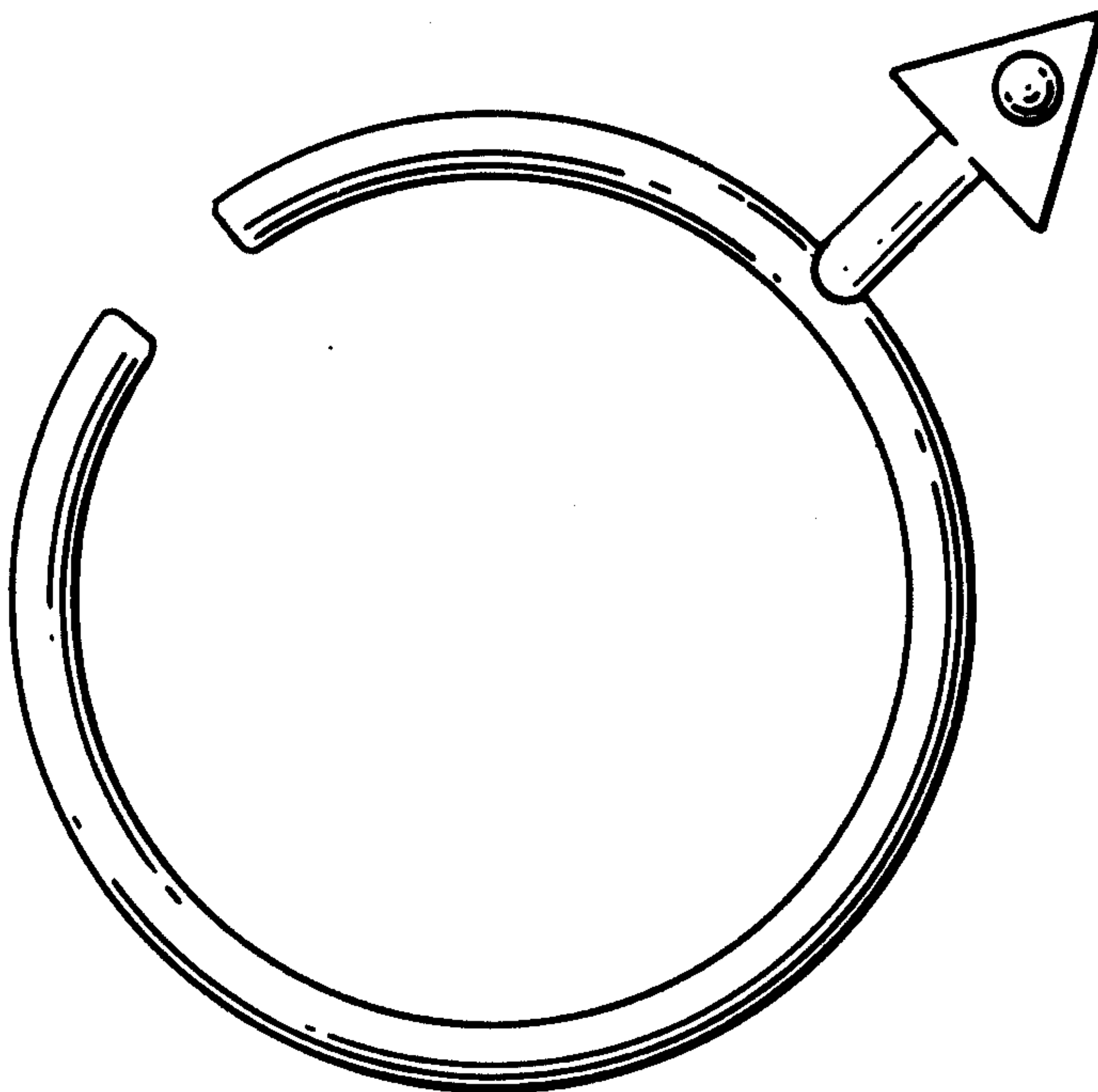

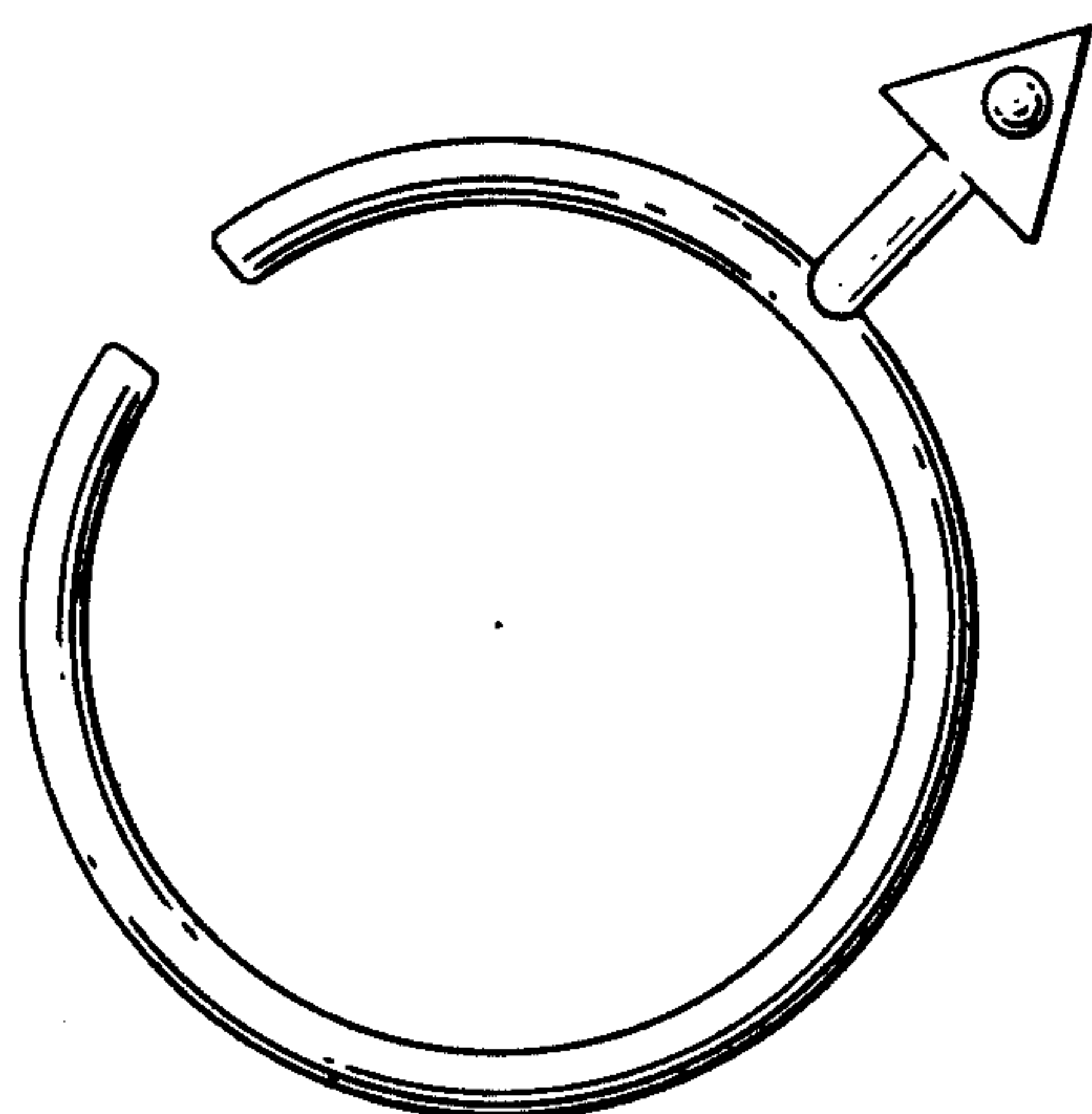

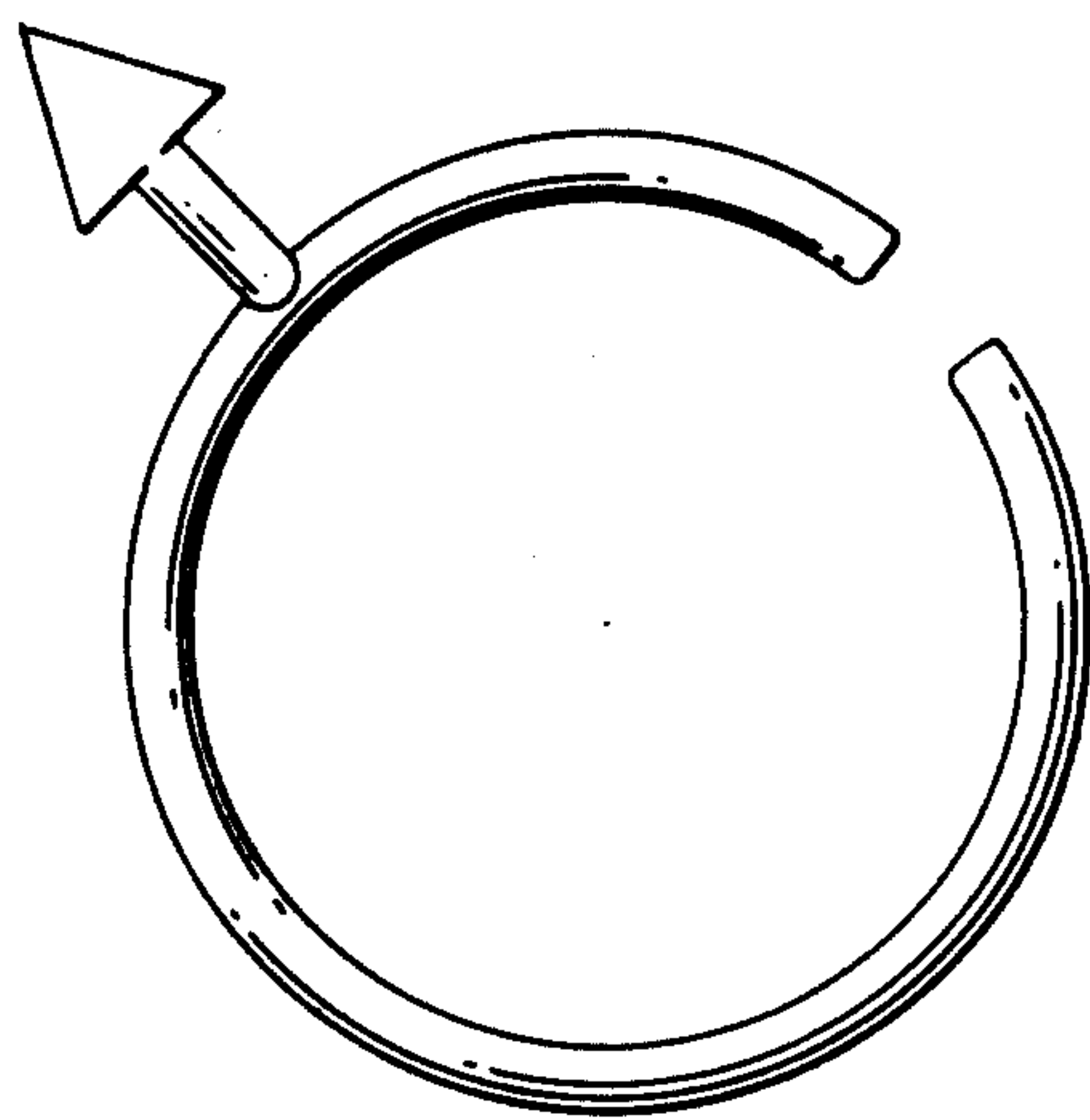

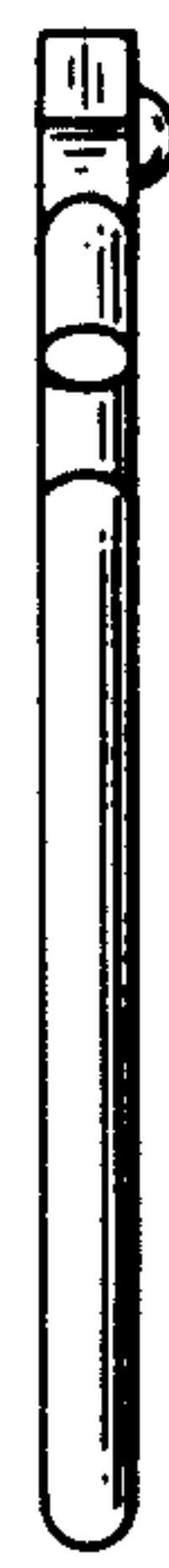
