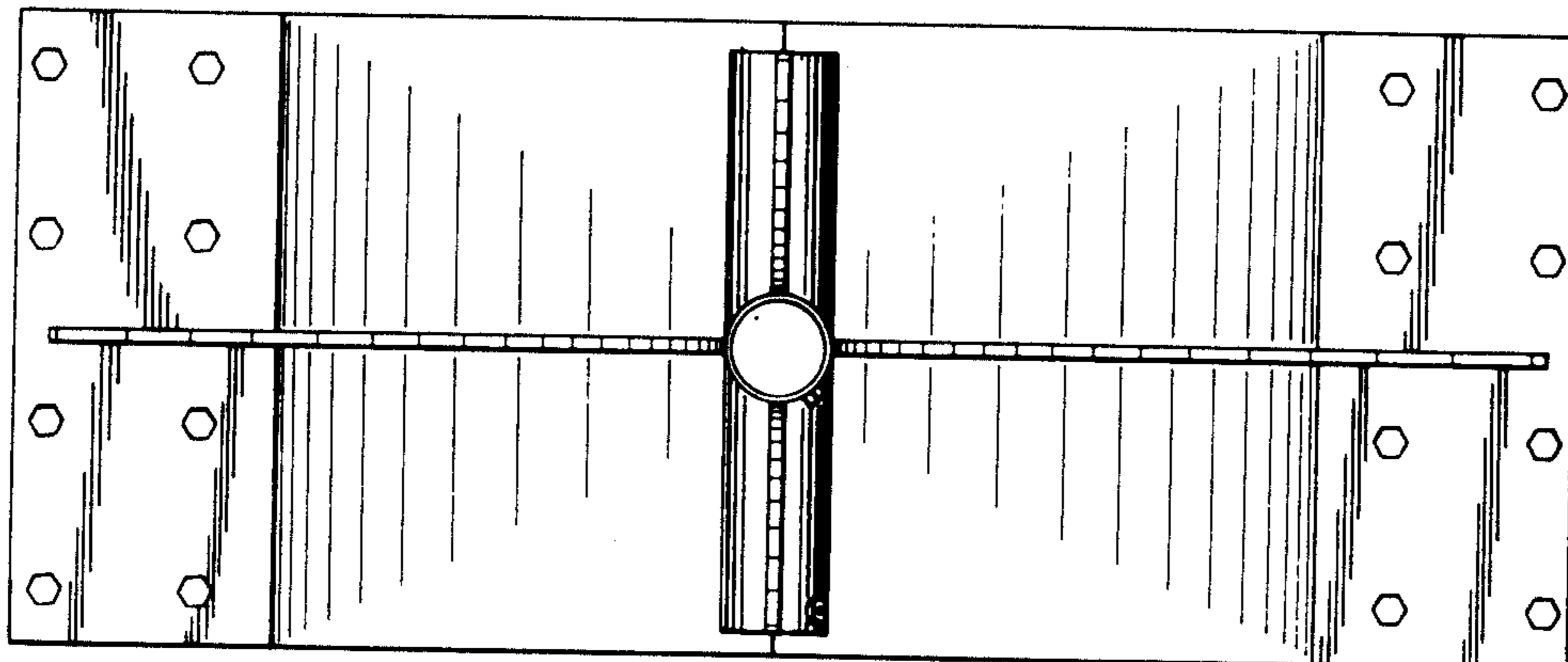
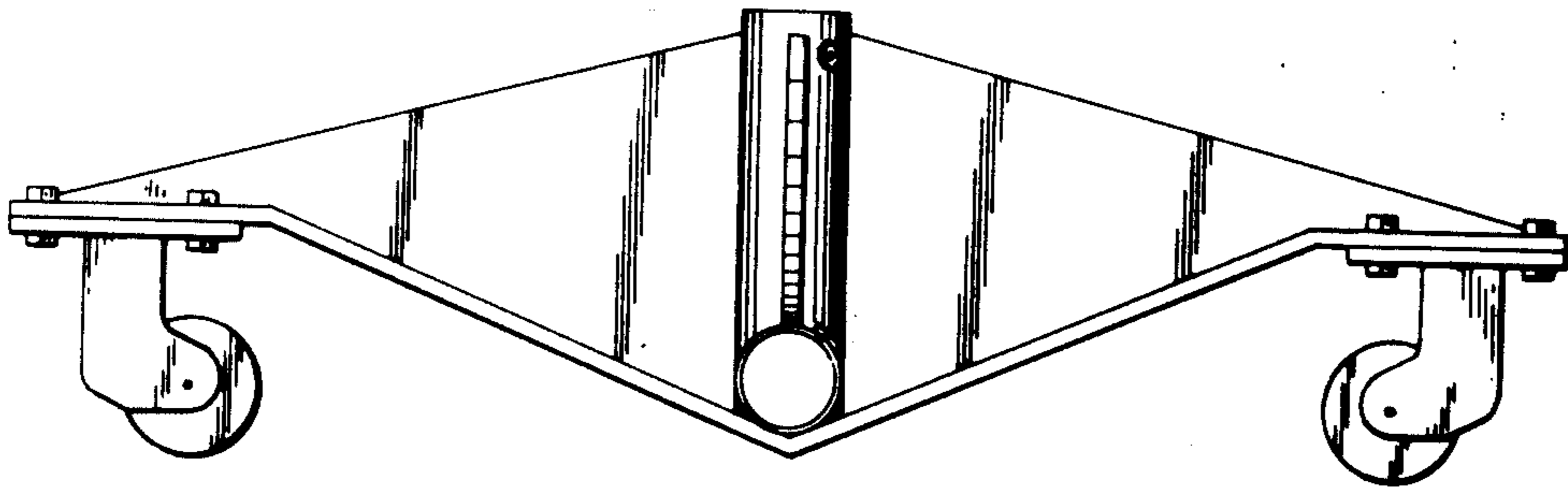

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a mobile support platform for vehicles, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the mobile support platform for vehicles showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof opposite to that shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof opposite to that shown in FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



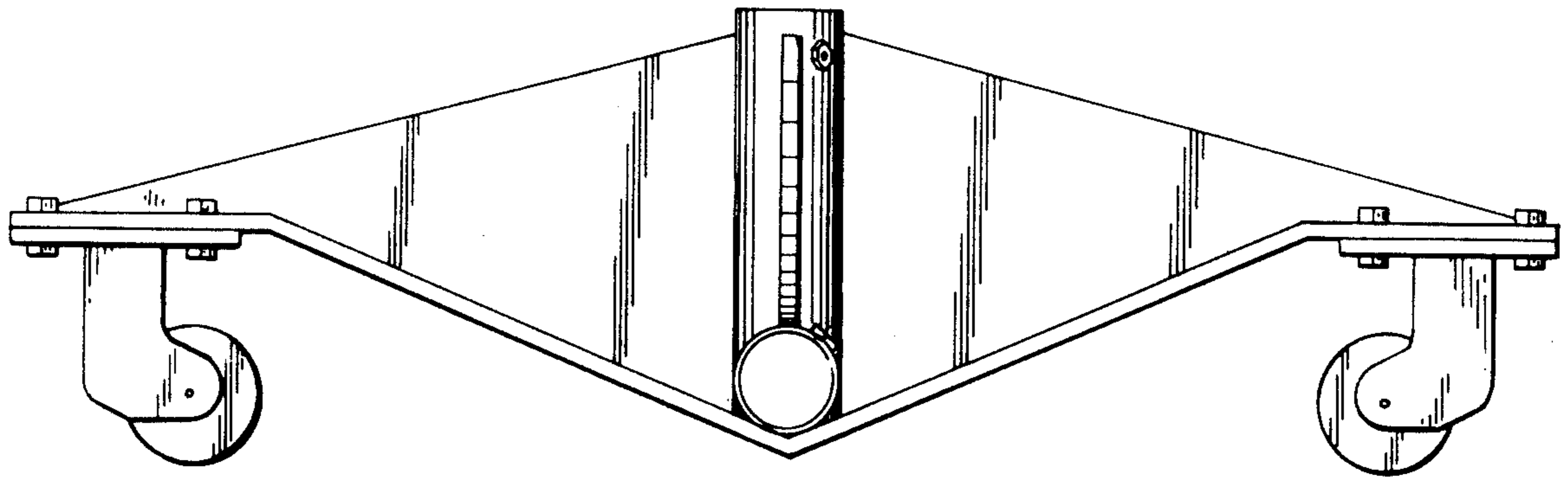

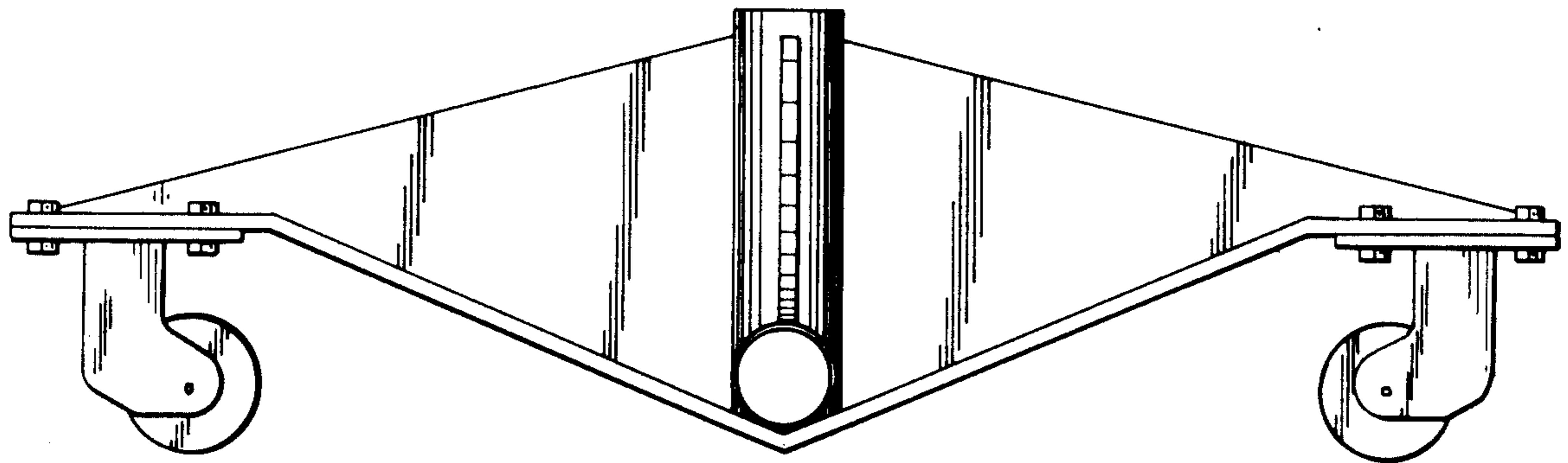

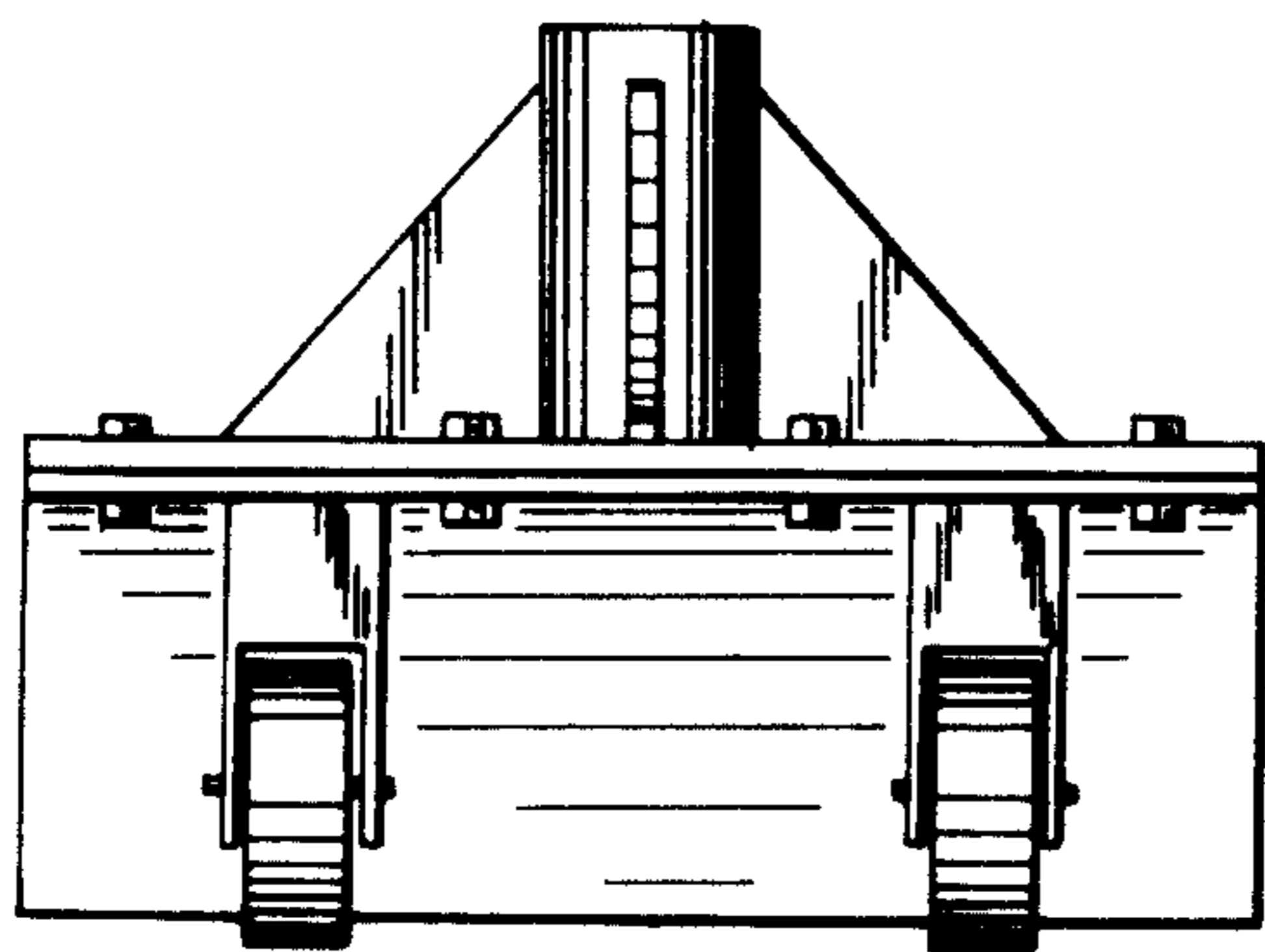

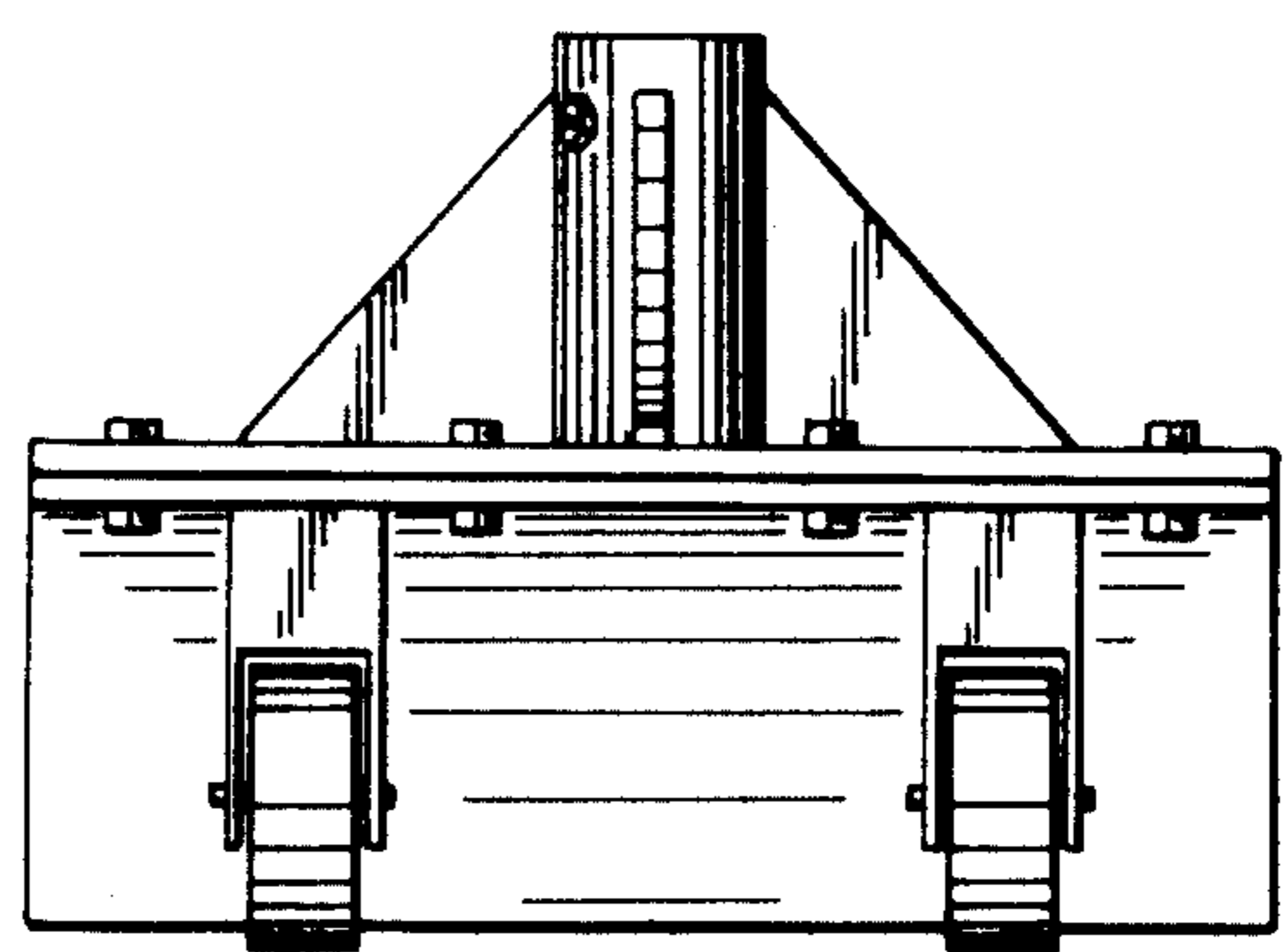

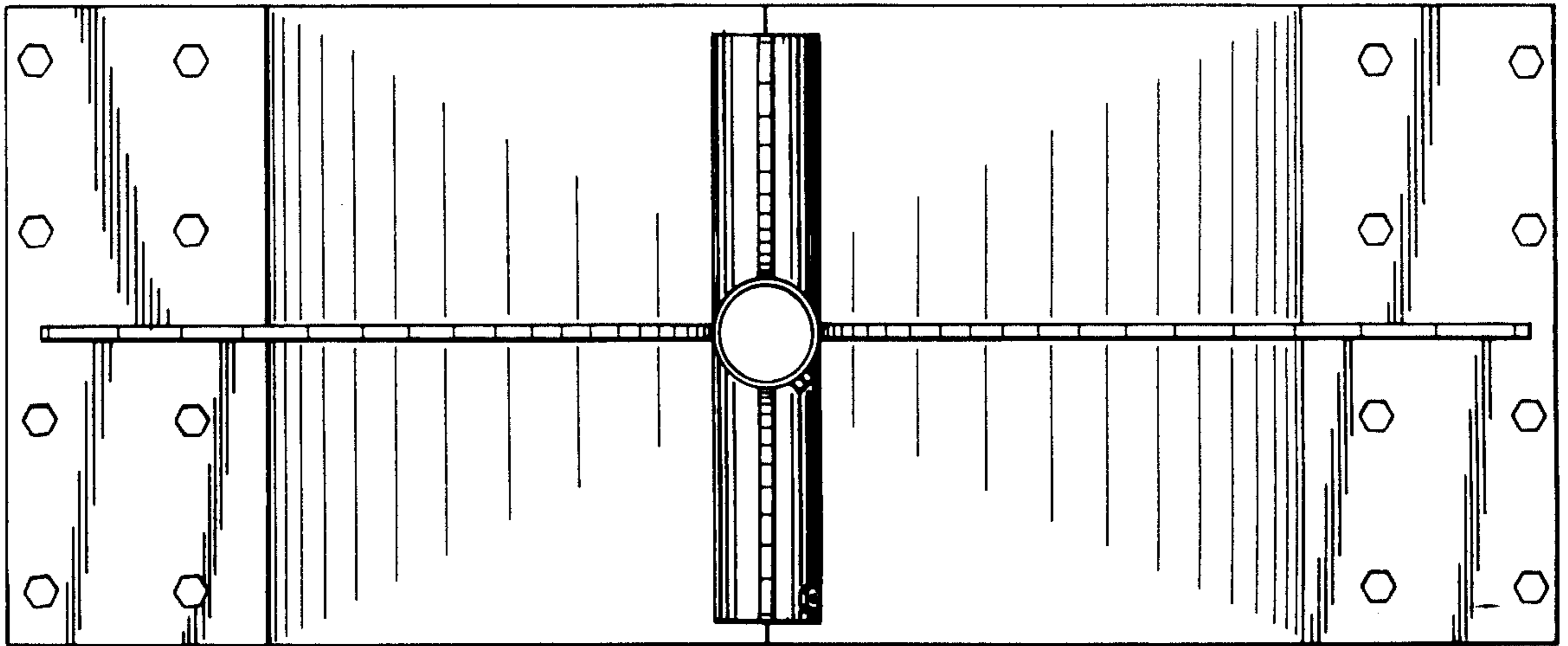

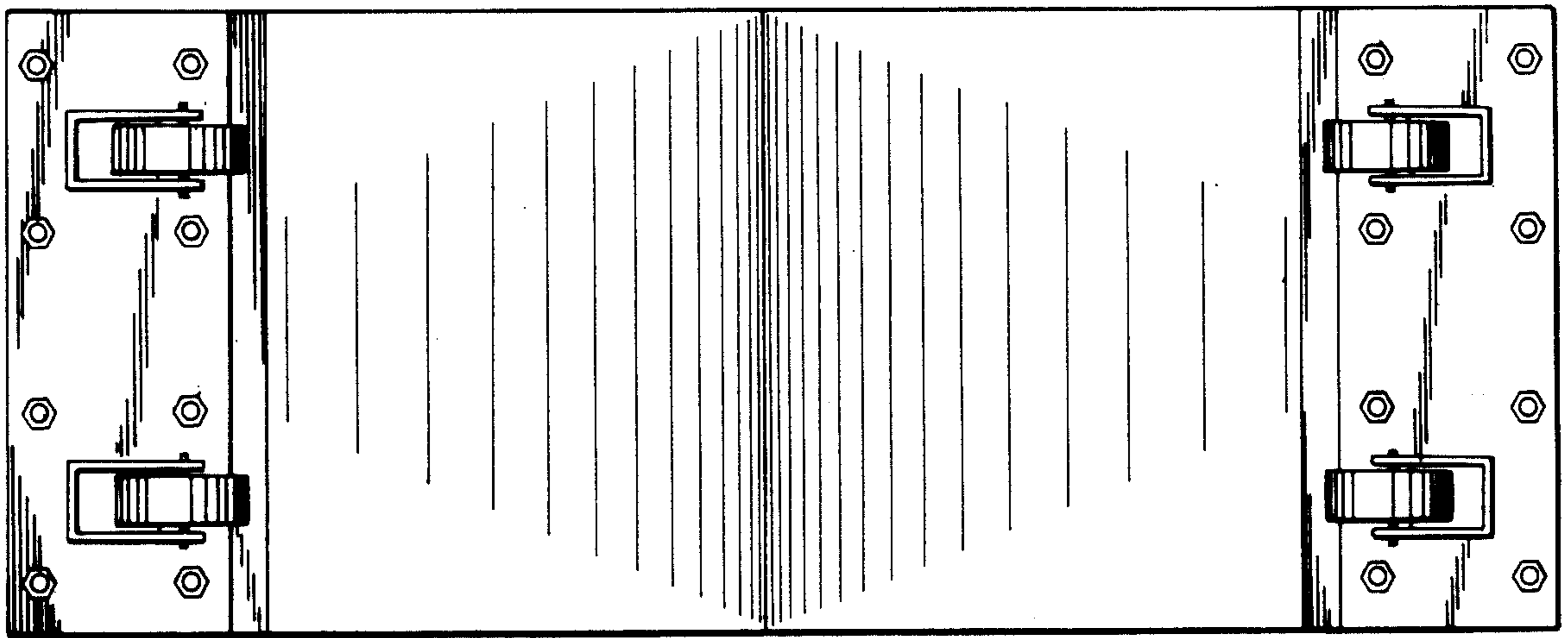
