The ornamental design for a stationery folder, as shown and described.

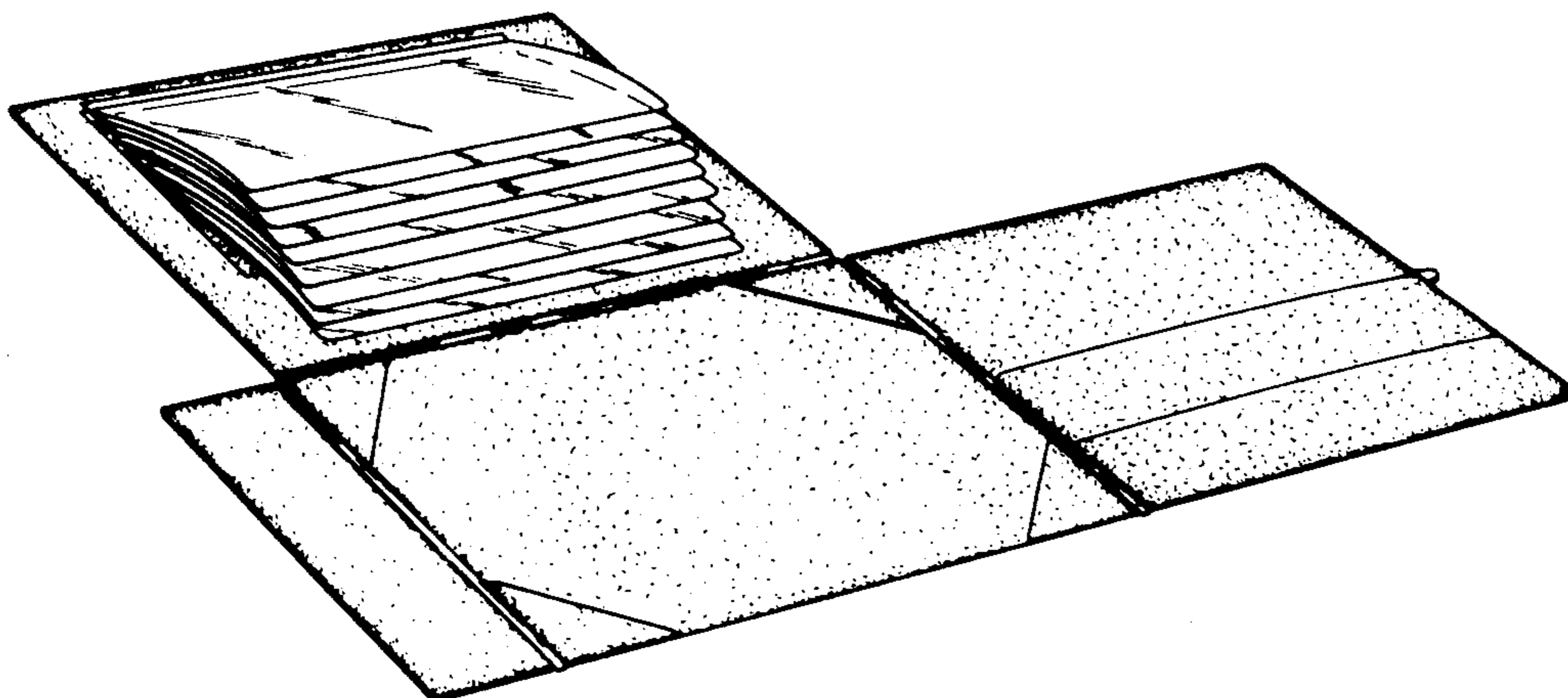
DESCRIPTION

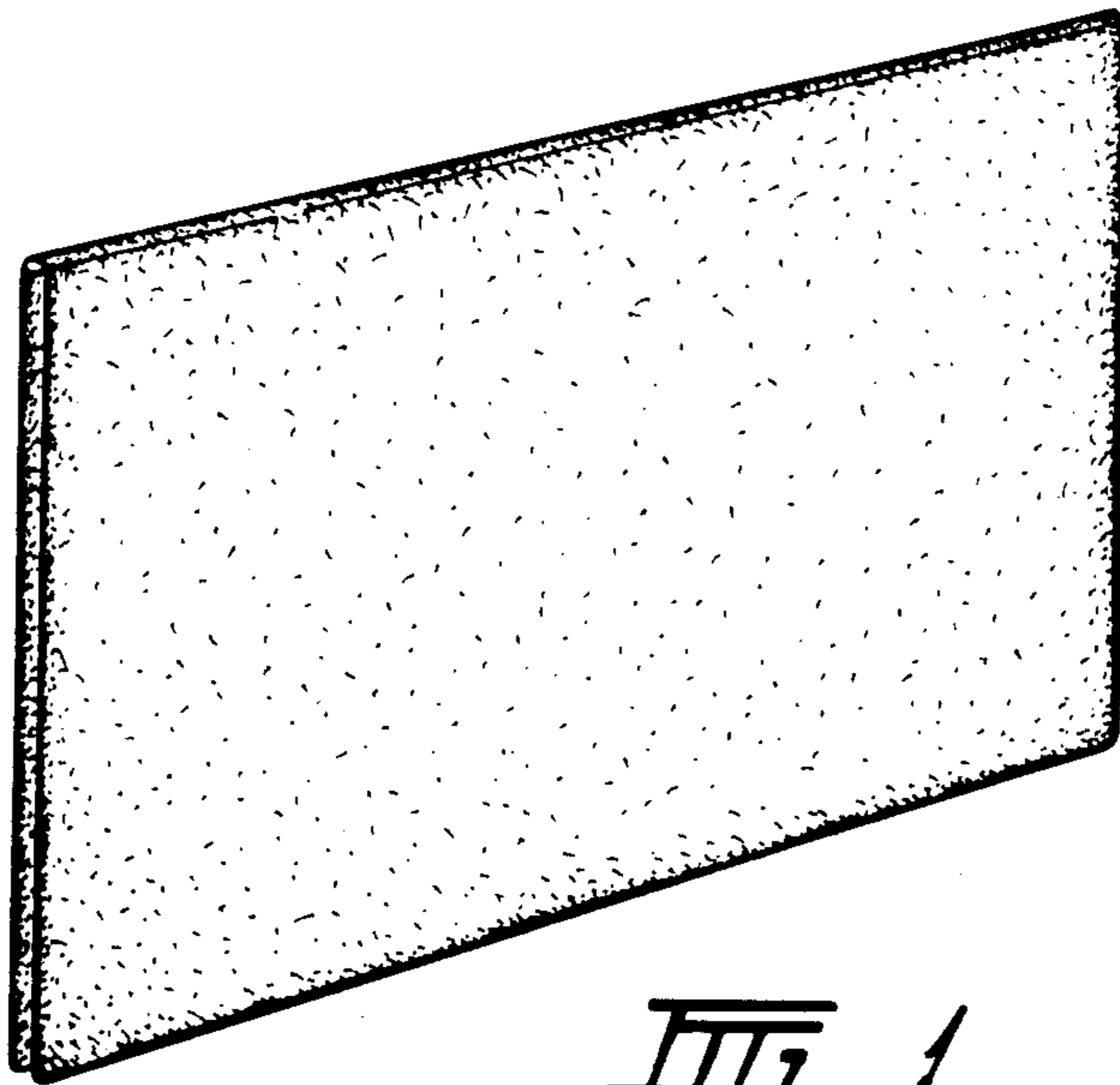
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stationery folder showing our new design, the folder being in a closed condition;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the stationery folder shown with the upper flap fully opened with insert leaves disposed to be fitted to the upper flap, and with internal flaps closed; and

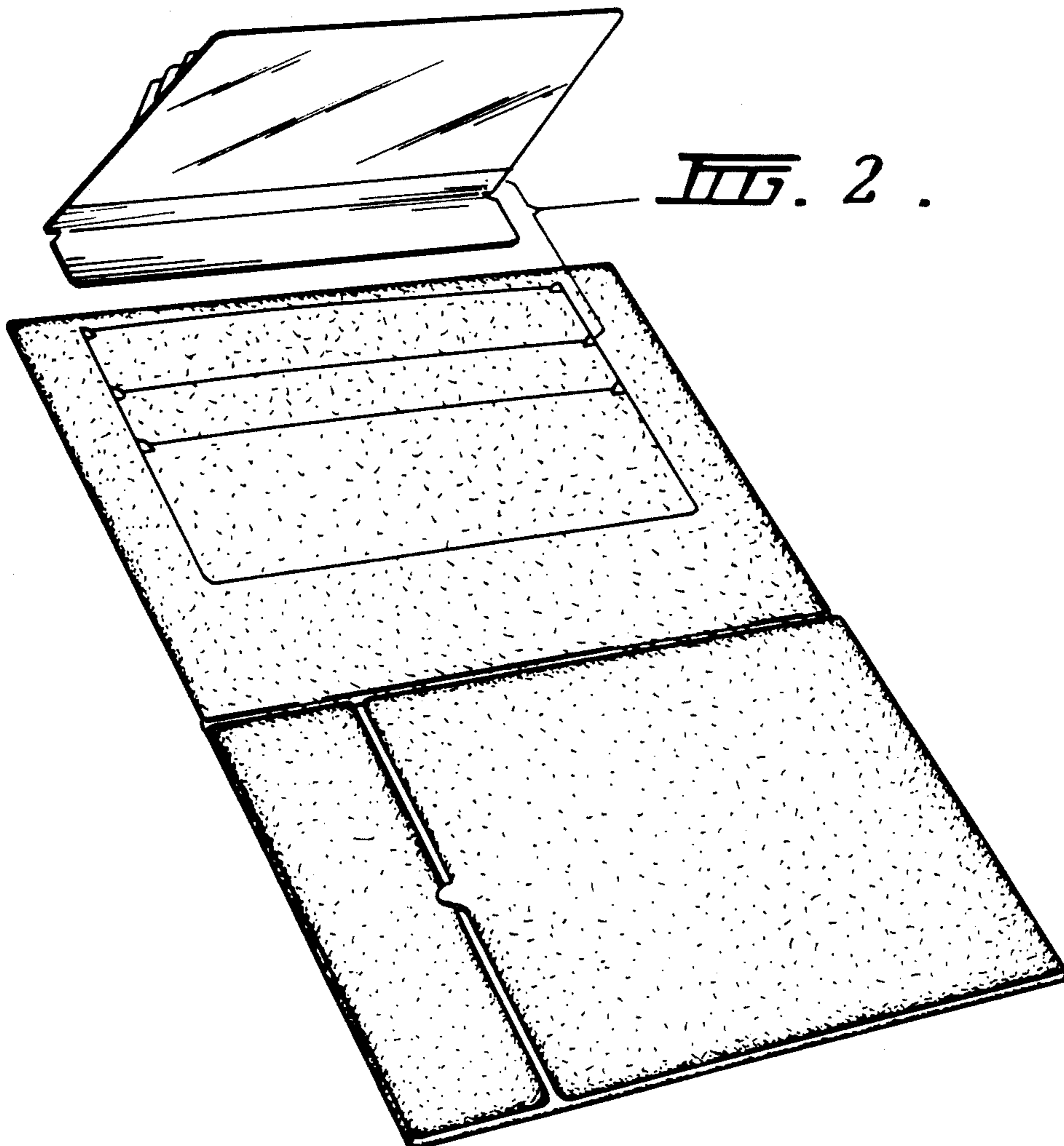
FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the stationery folder with the upper flap fully opened, with insert leaves fitted to the upper flap, and with the internal flaps fully opened.

The side not shown in FIG. 1 is the same as the side shown.
