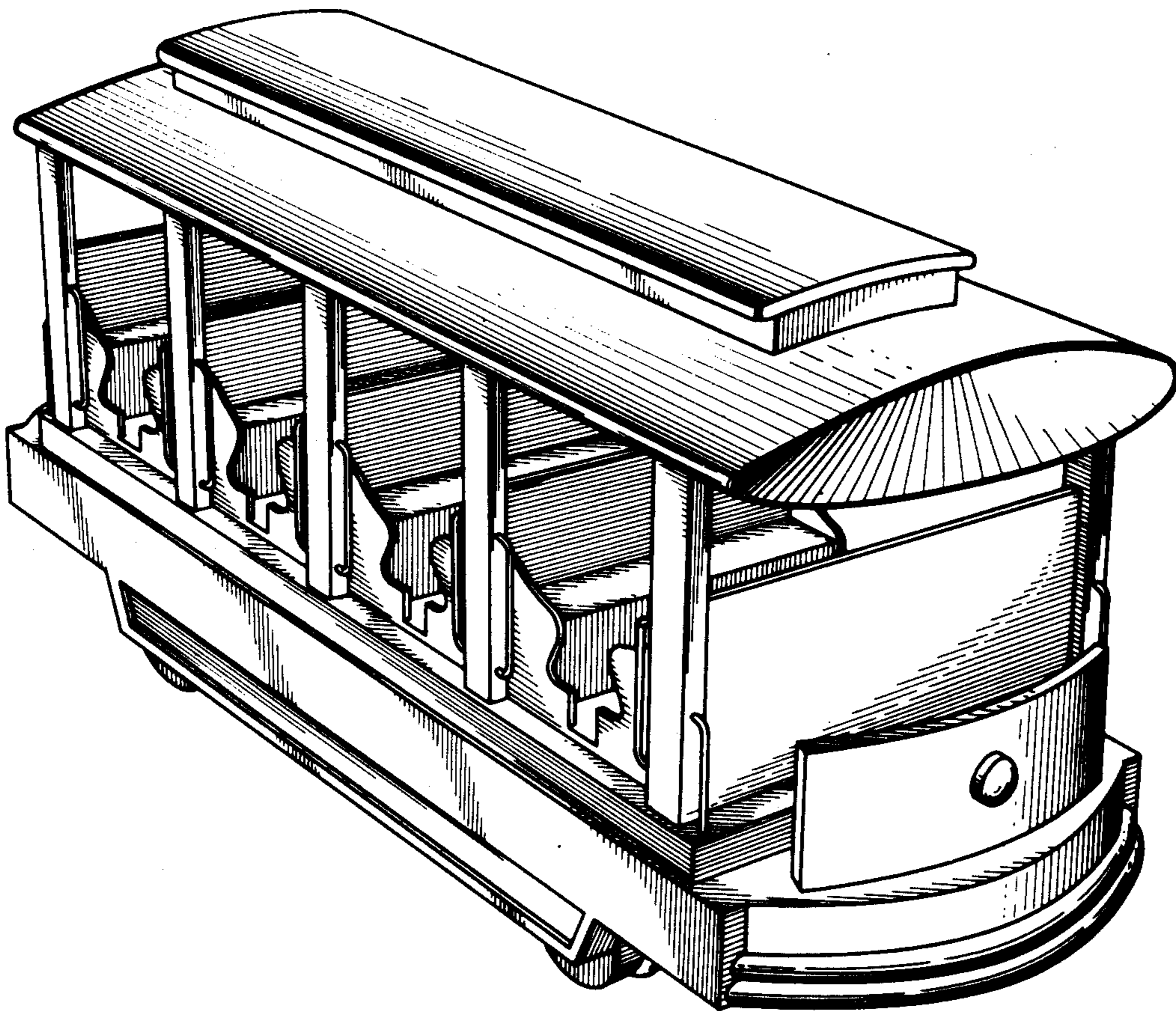

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy vehicle showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being identical thereto;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view thereof being identical thereto;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



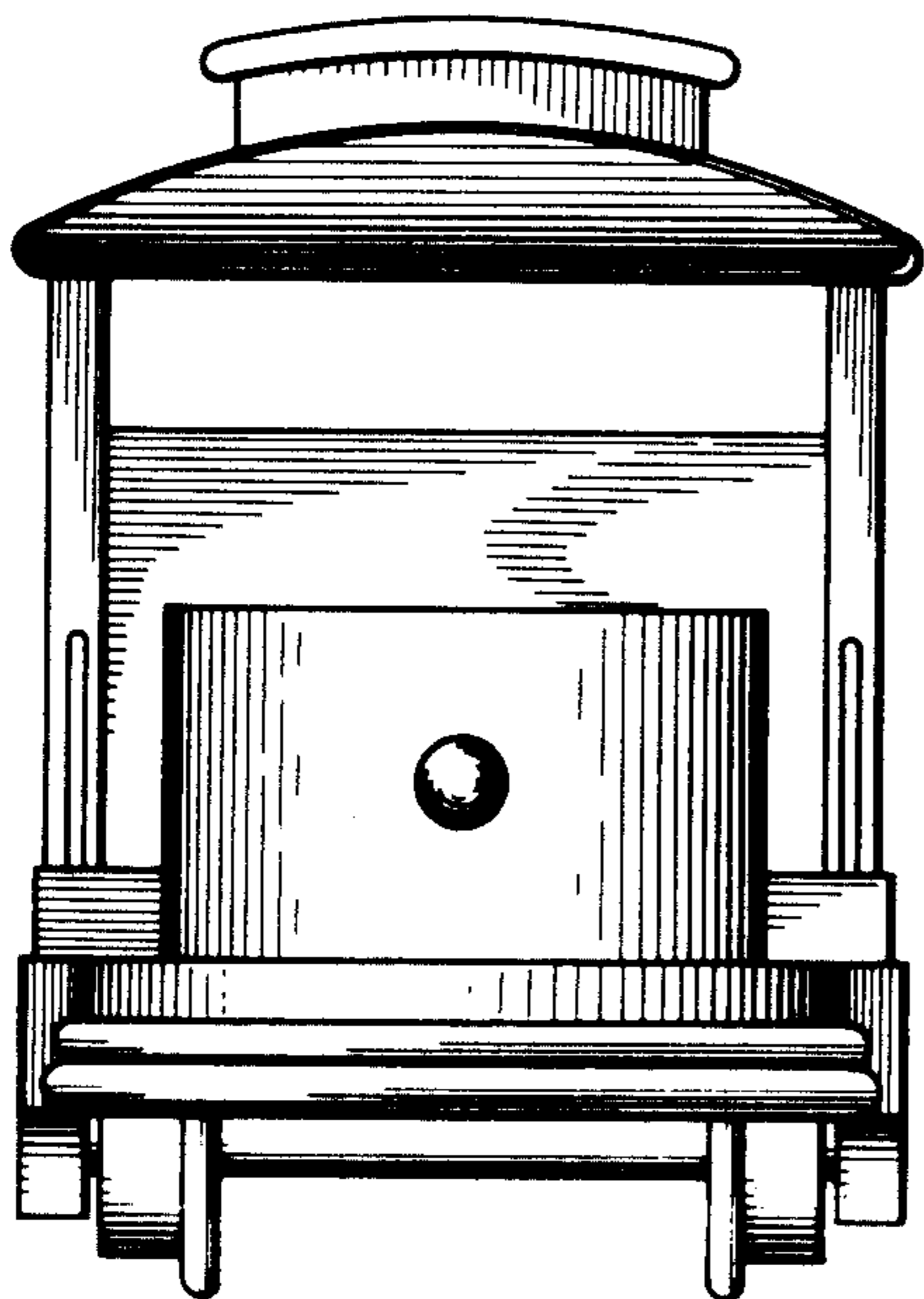
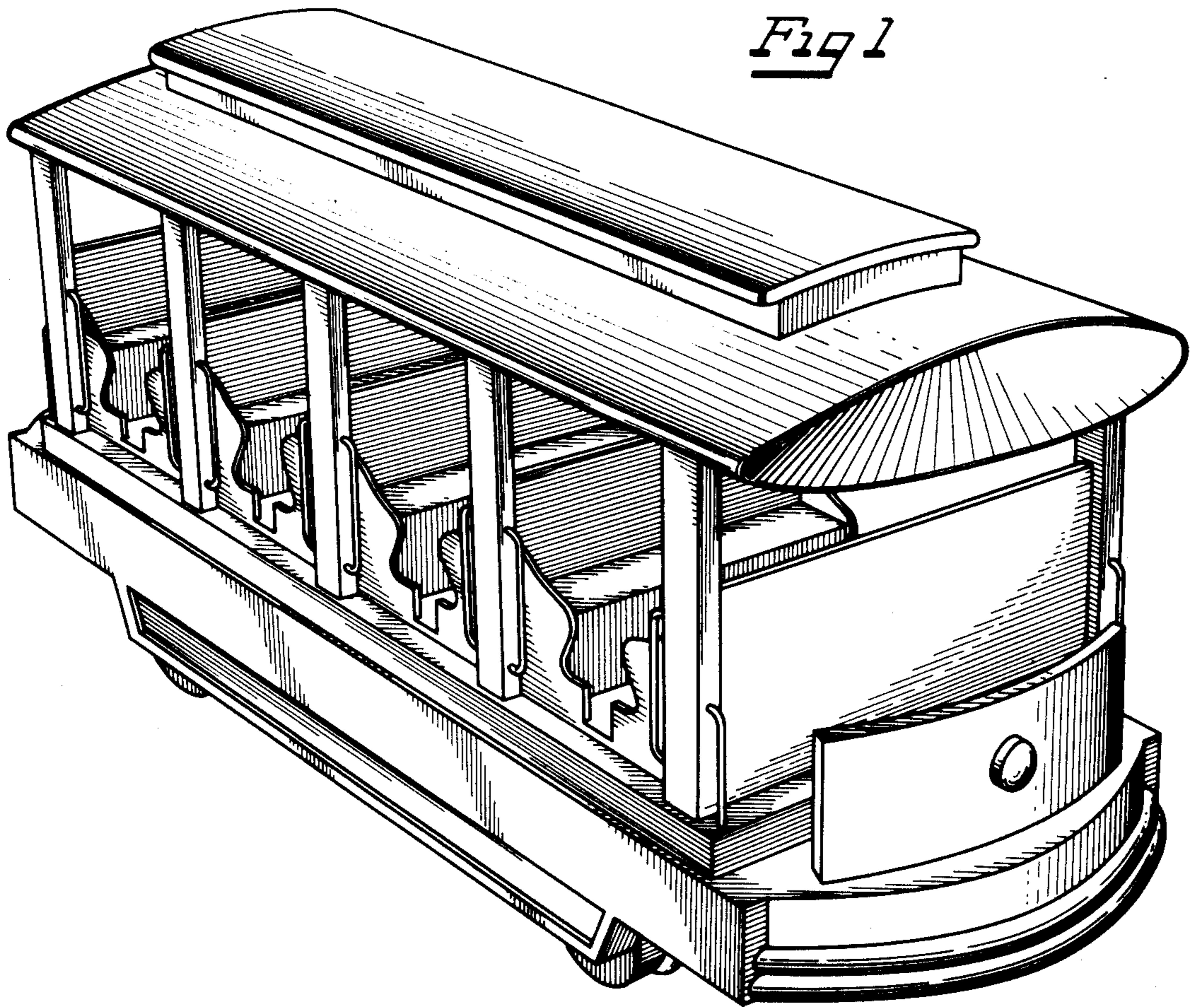

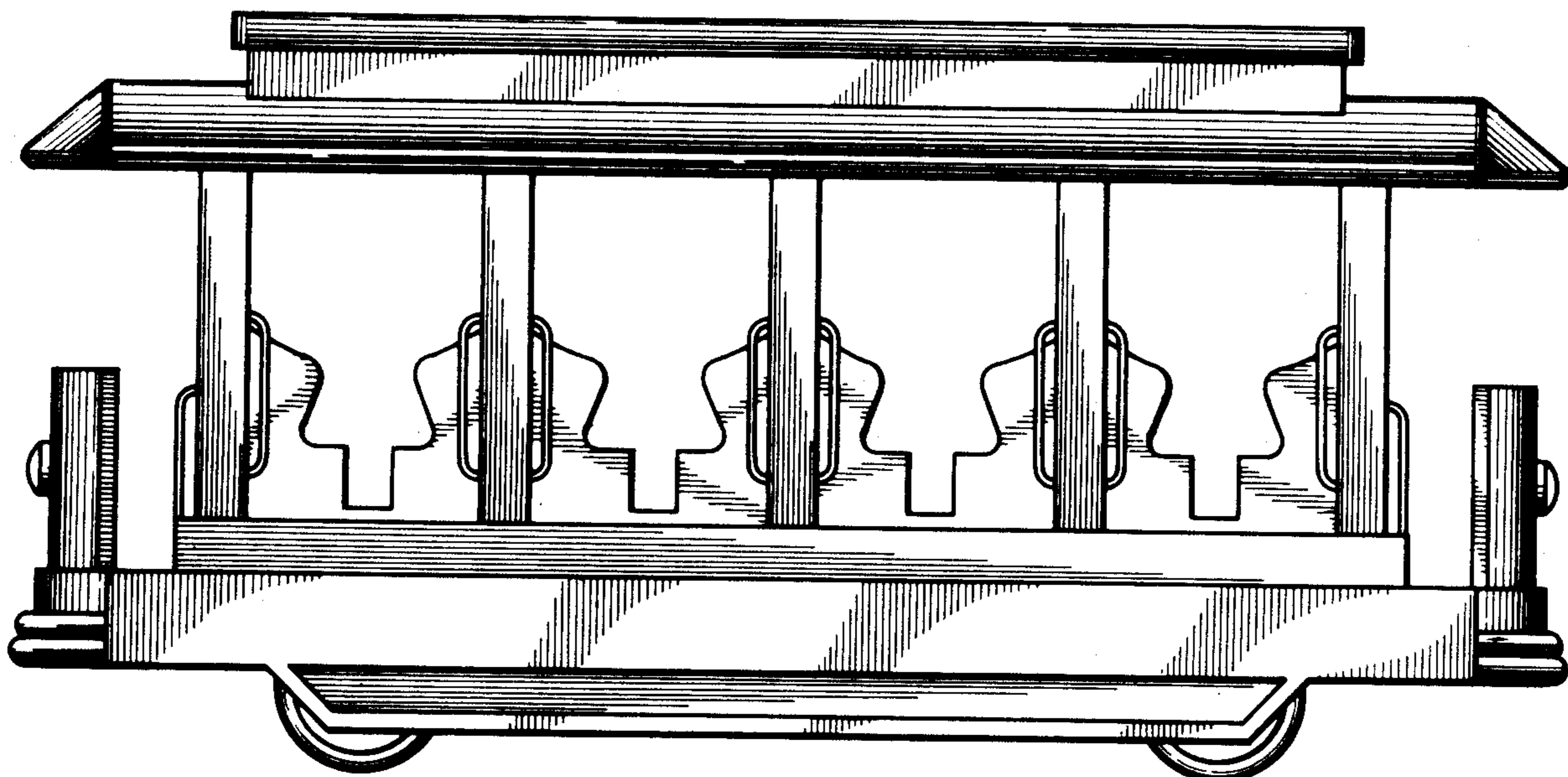

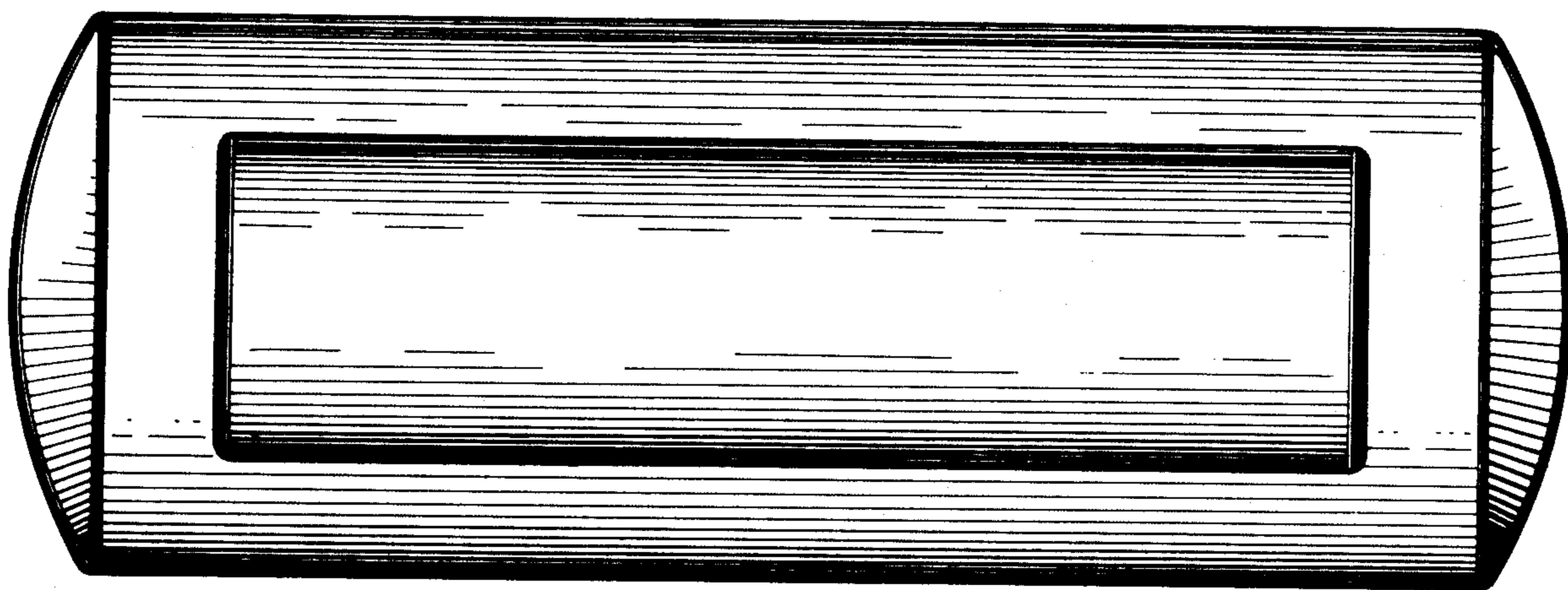
