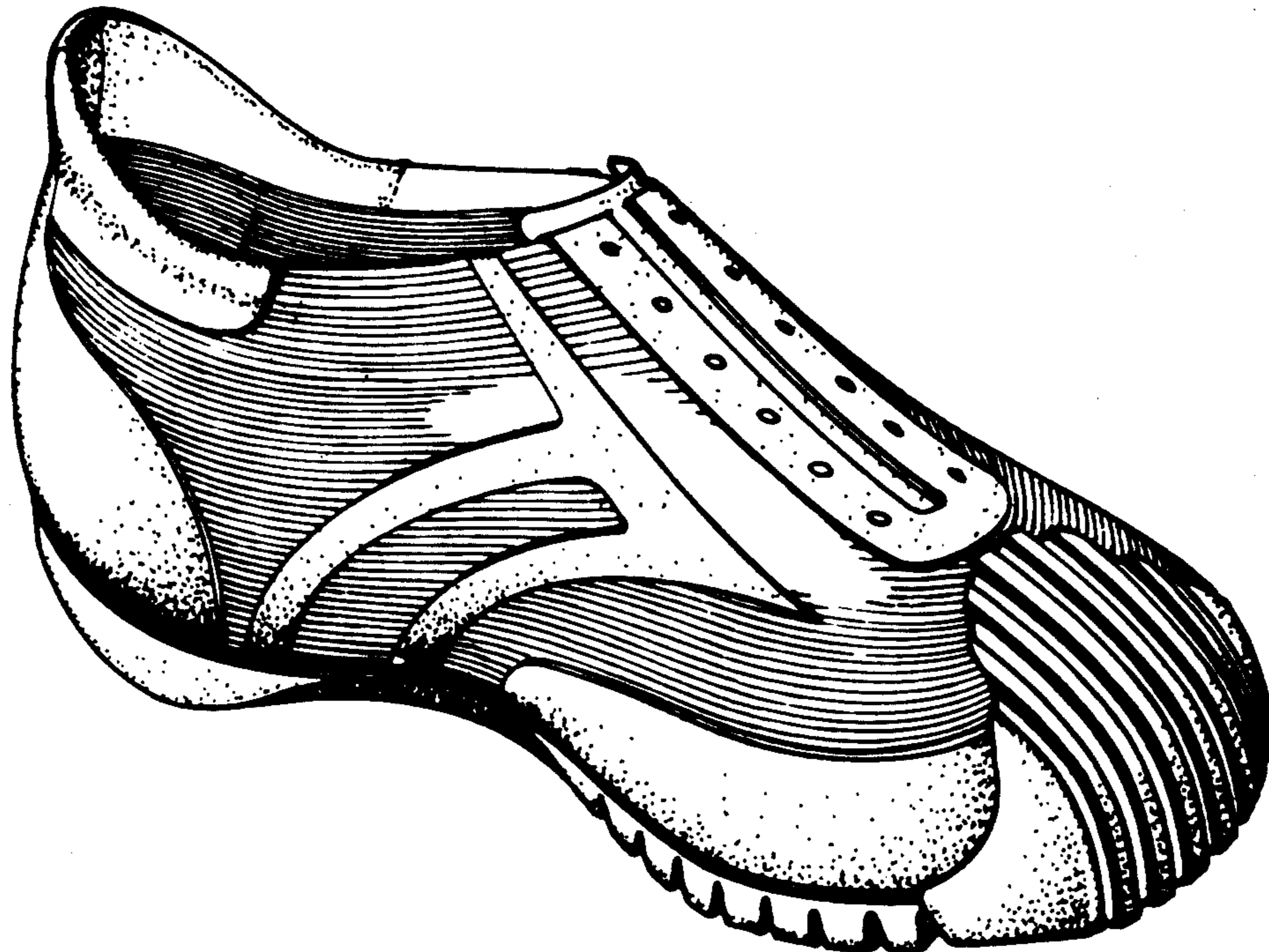

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a skate board shoe, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a skate board shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.



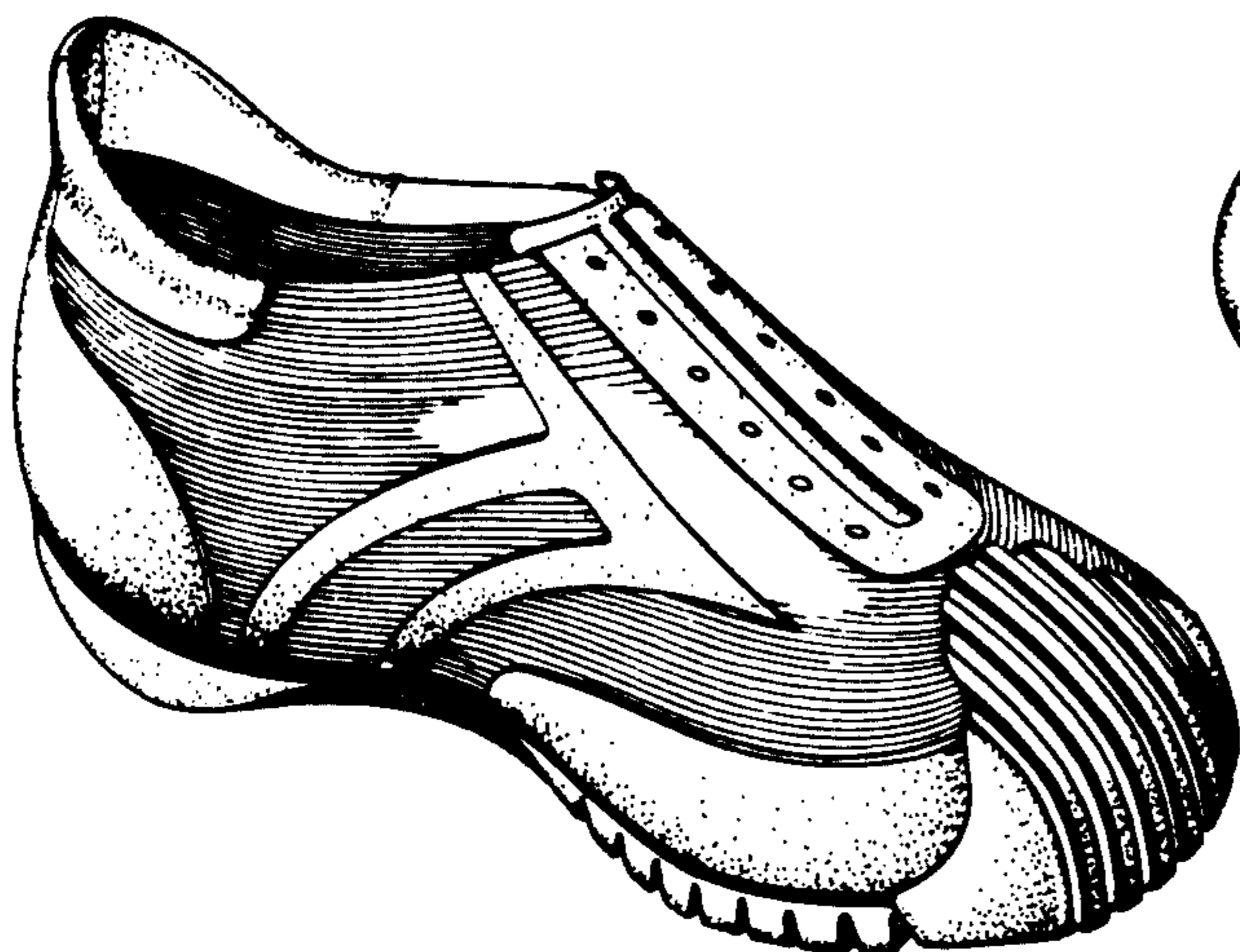

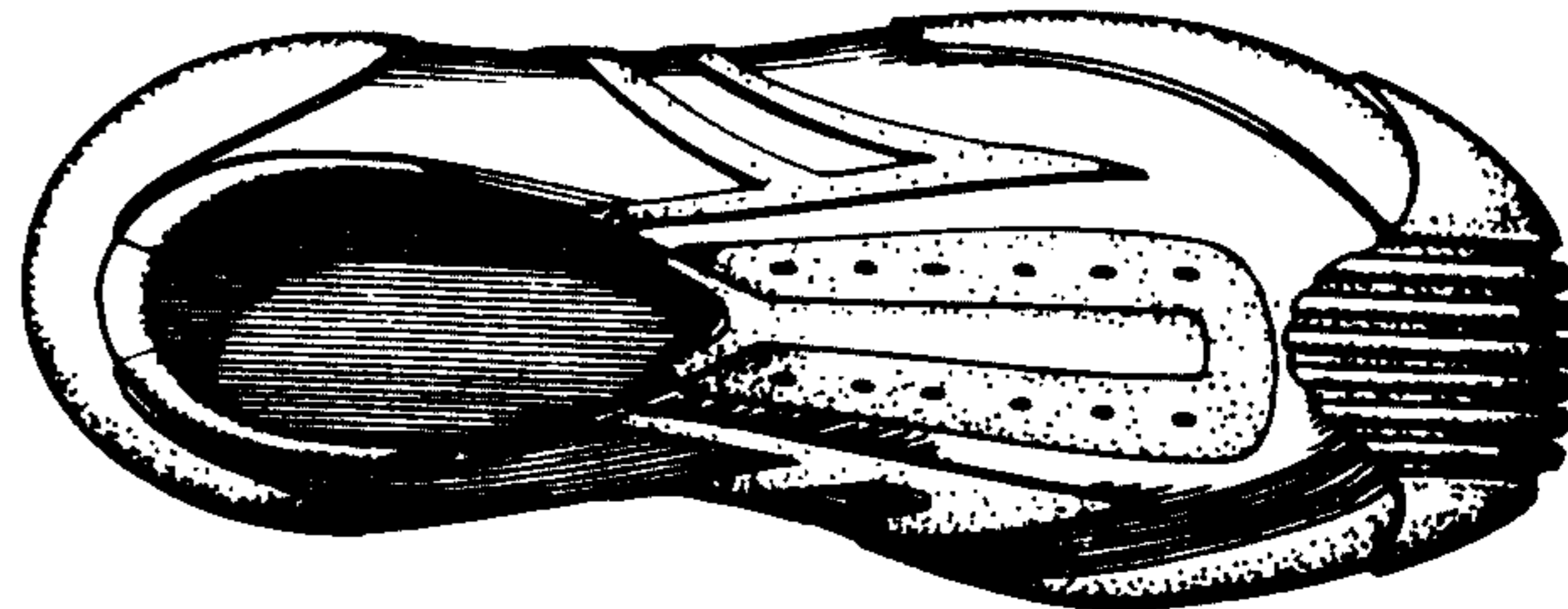

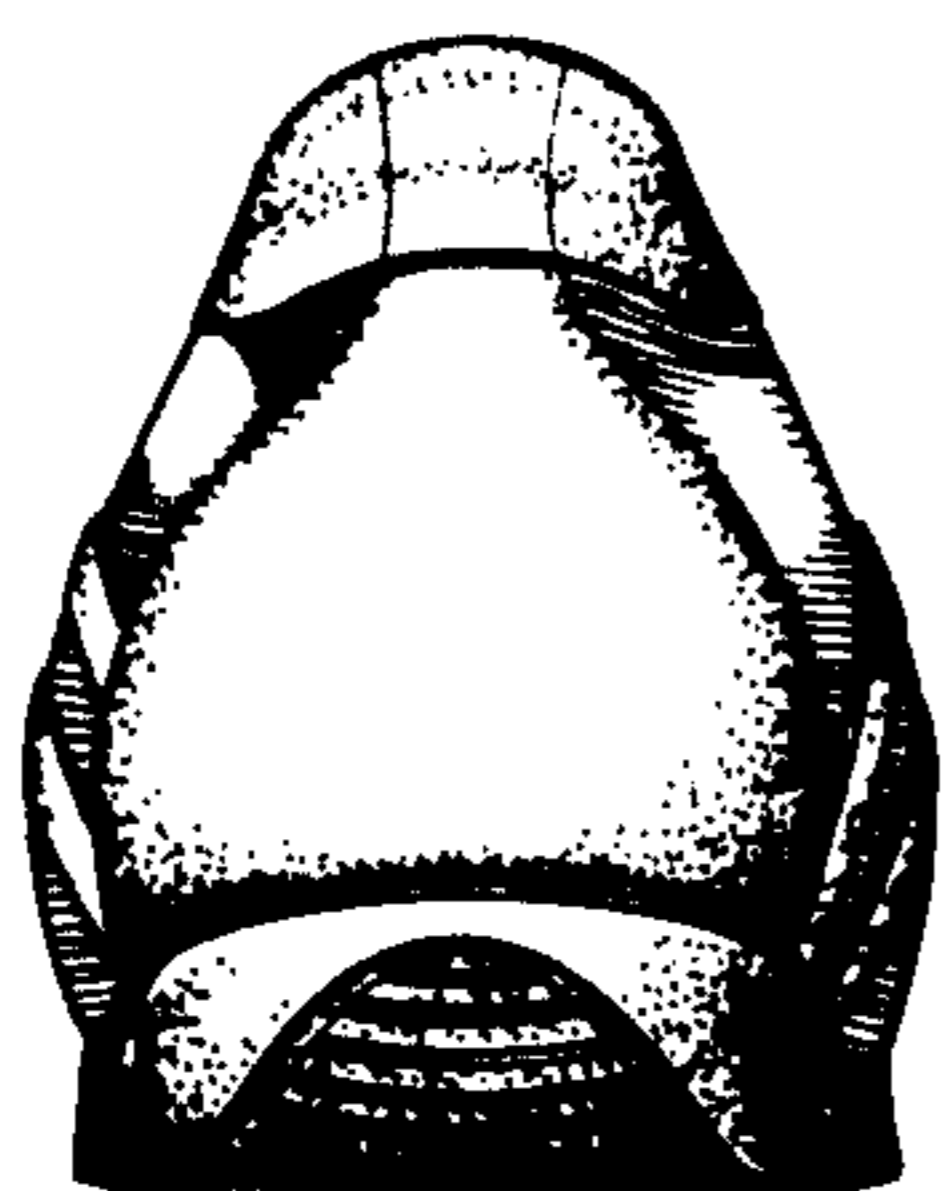

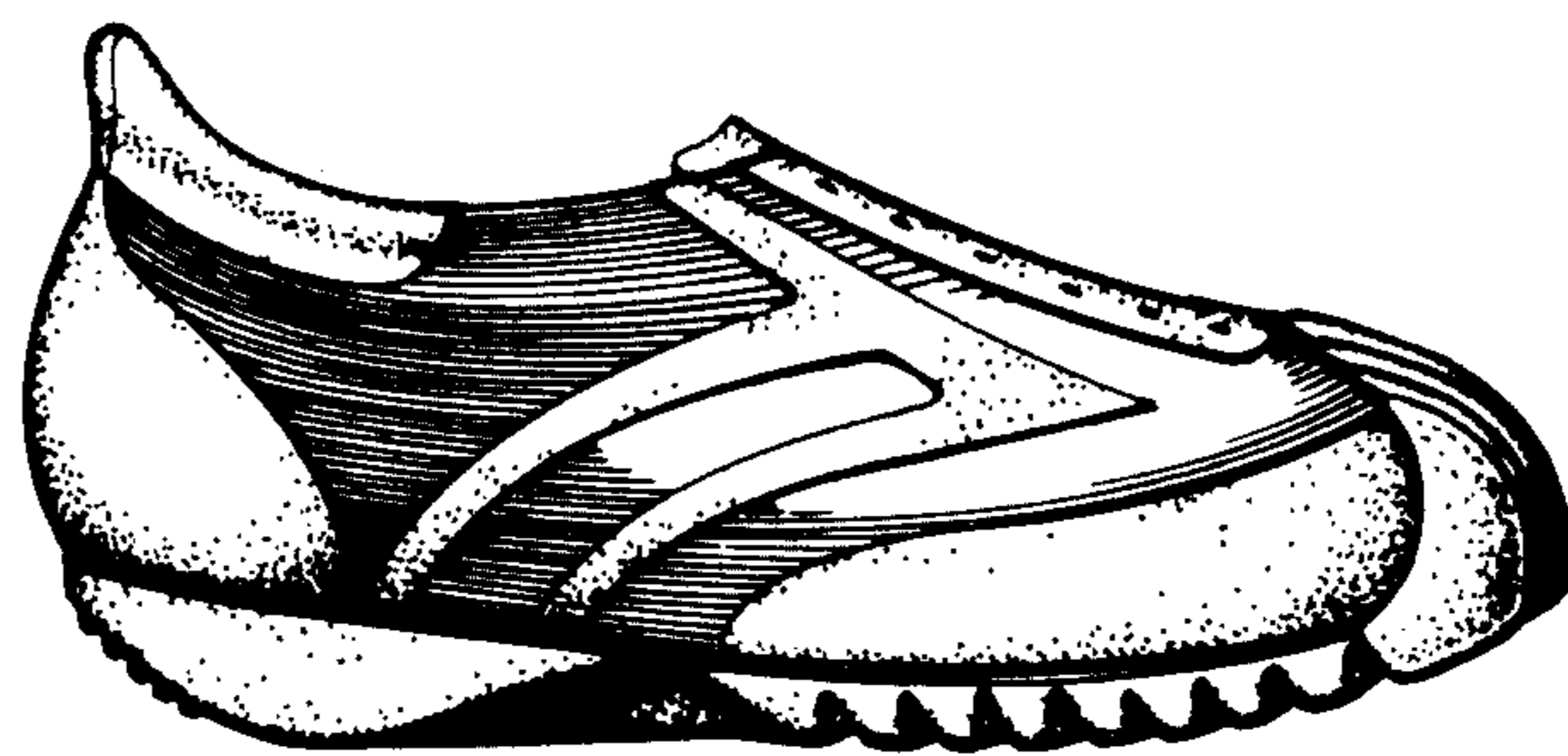

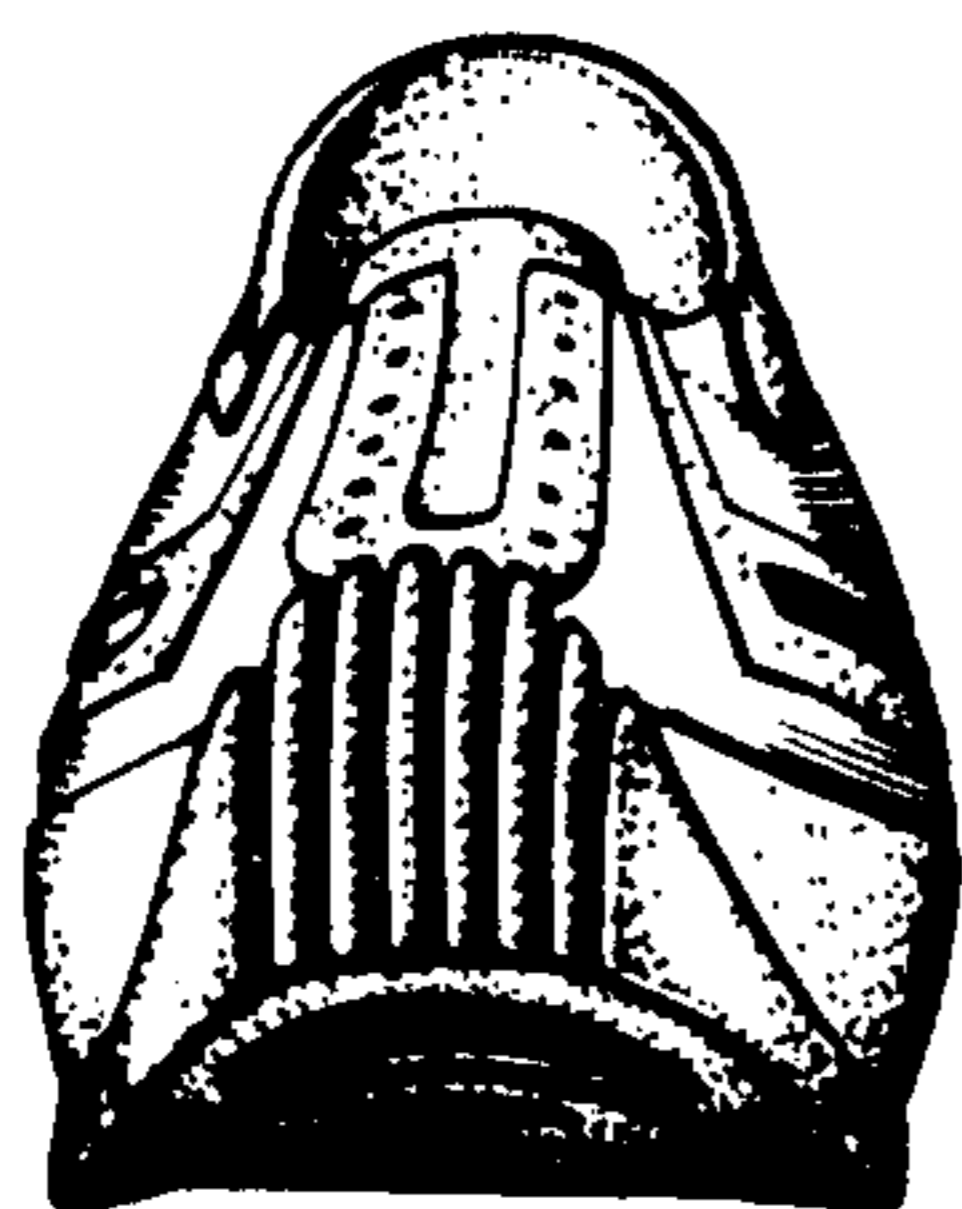

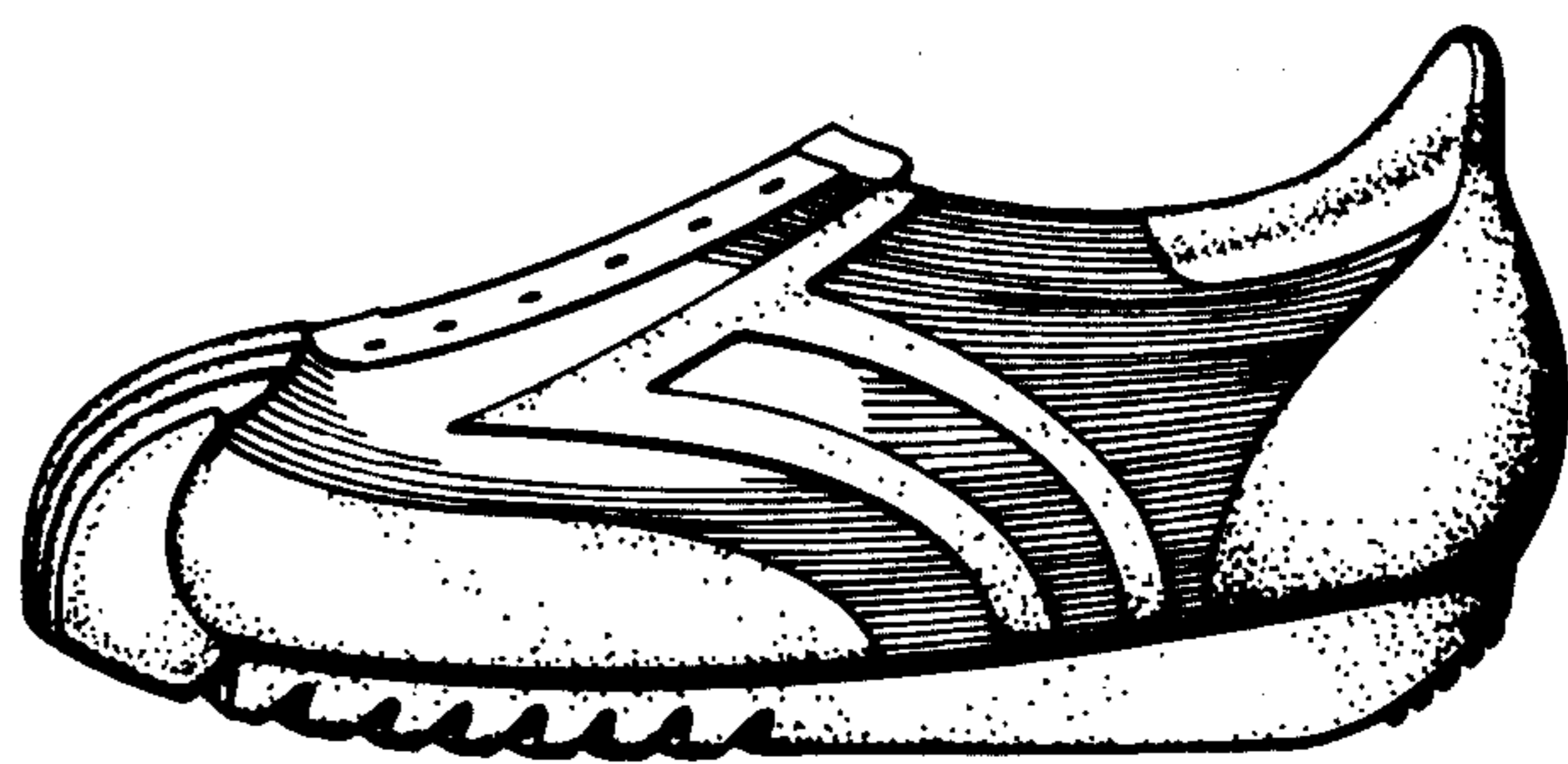
