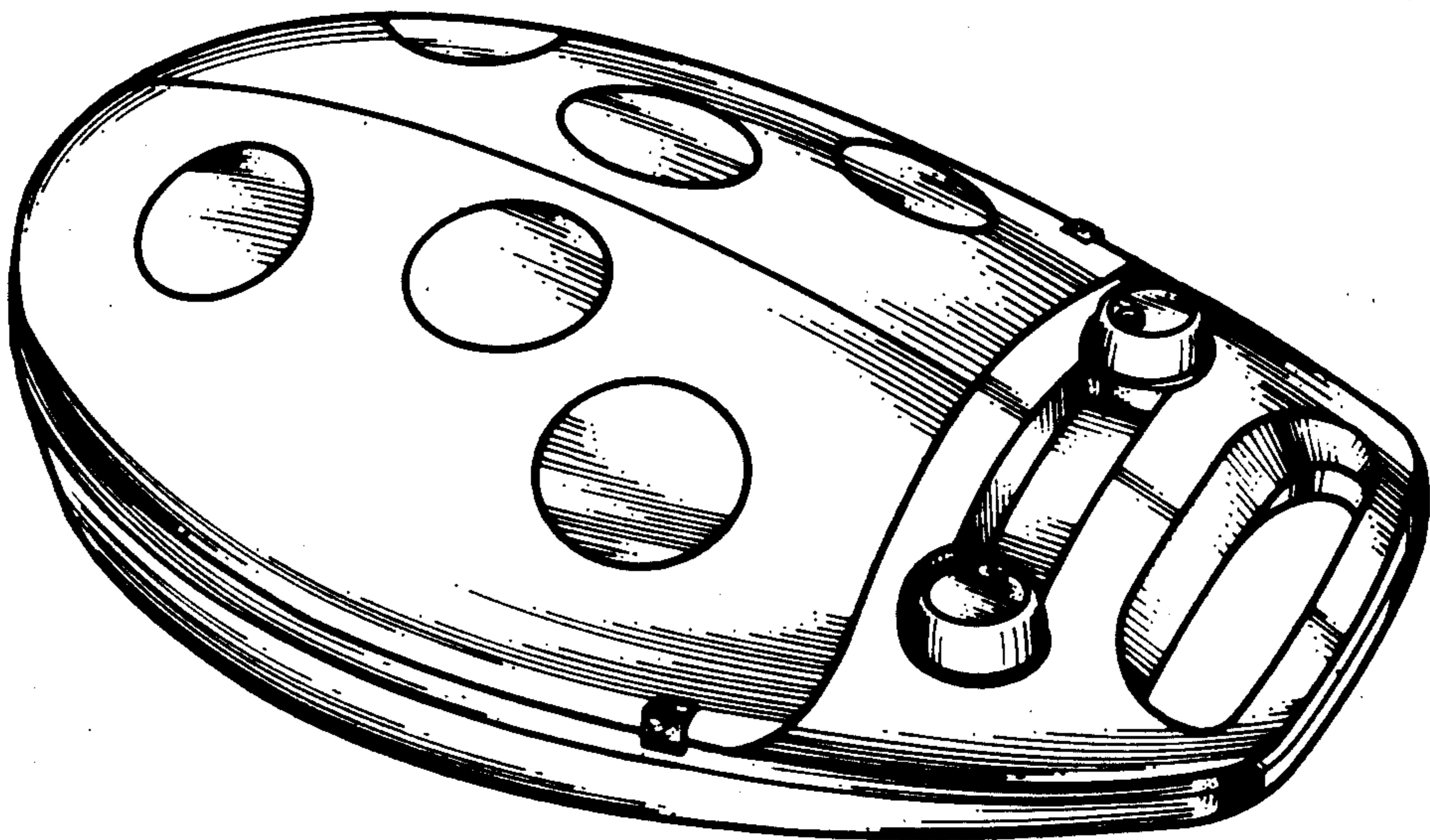

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a phonograph, substantially as shown and described.

The FIGURE is a front, top and left side perspective view of a phonograph showing our new design, the right side being a mirror image of the left. The edge of the phonograph is of uniform height and the bottom is plain.
