FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a game cabinet employ-
ing my new design.

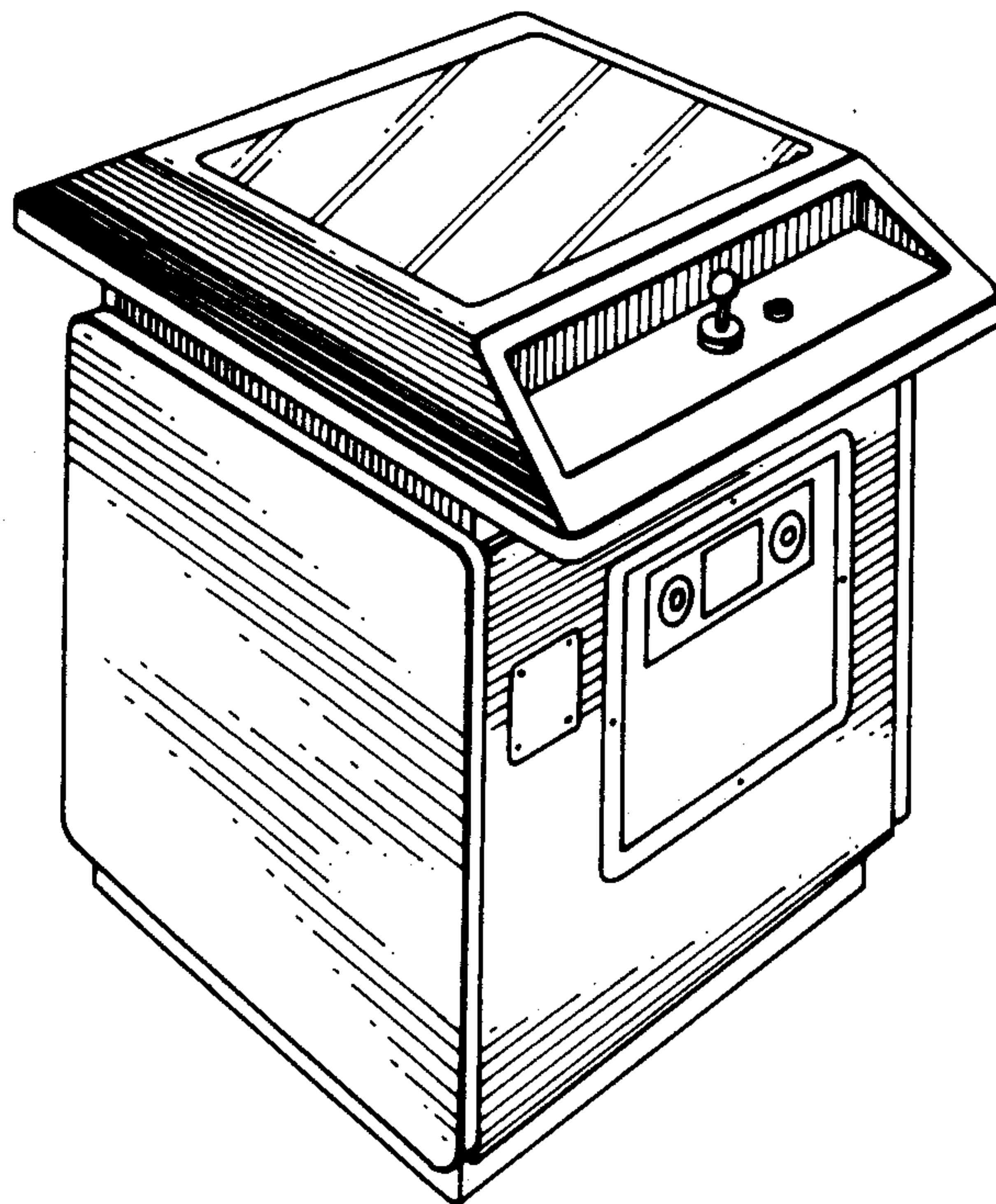
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the game cabi-

surface and the left side is identical to the right side.



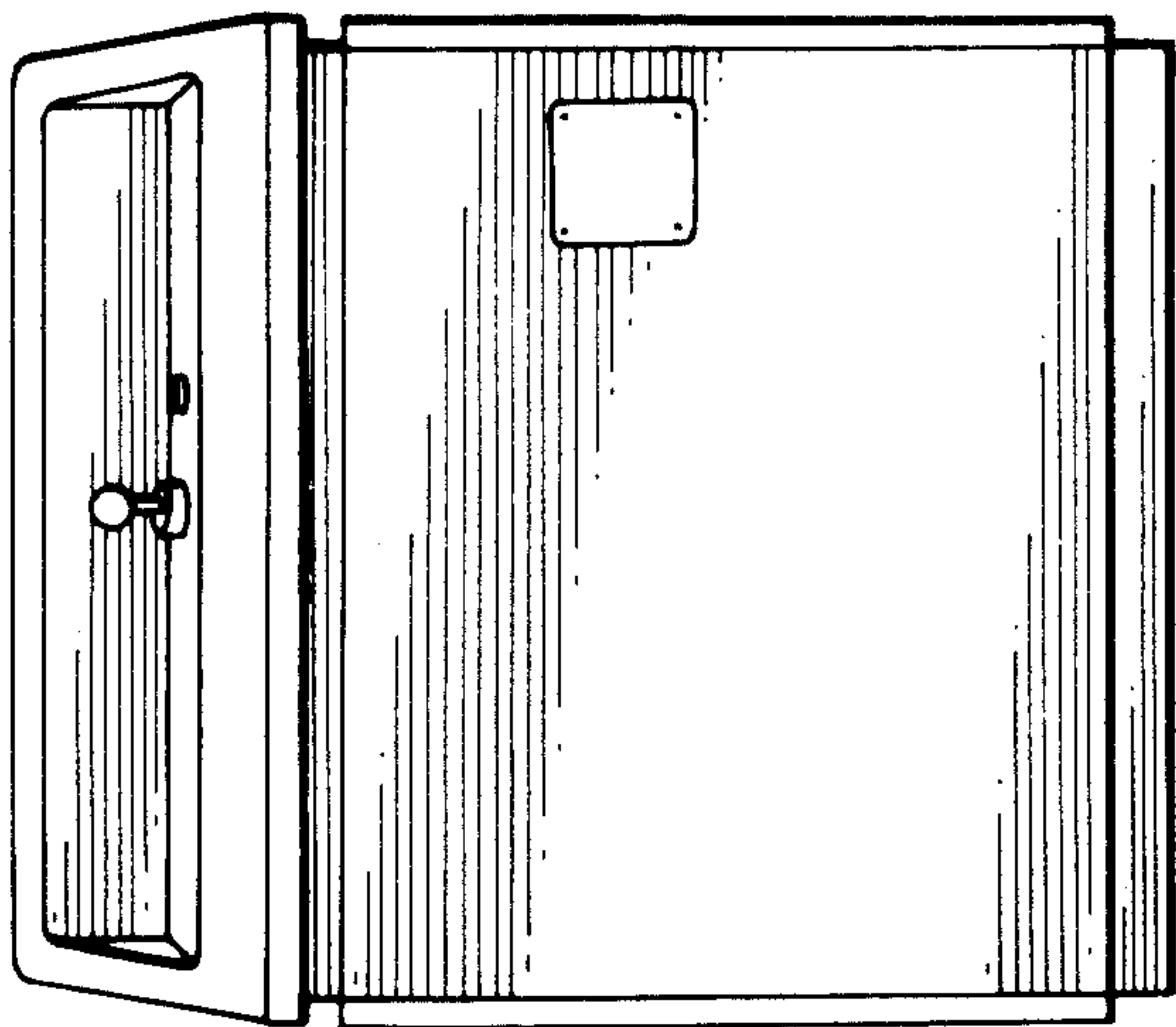

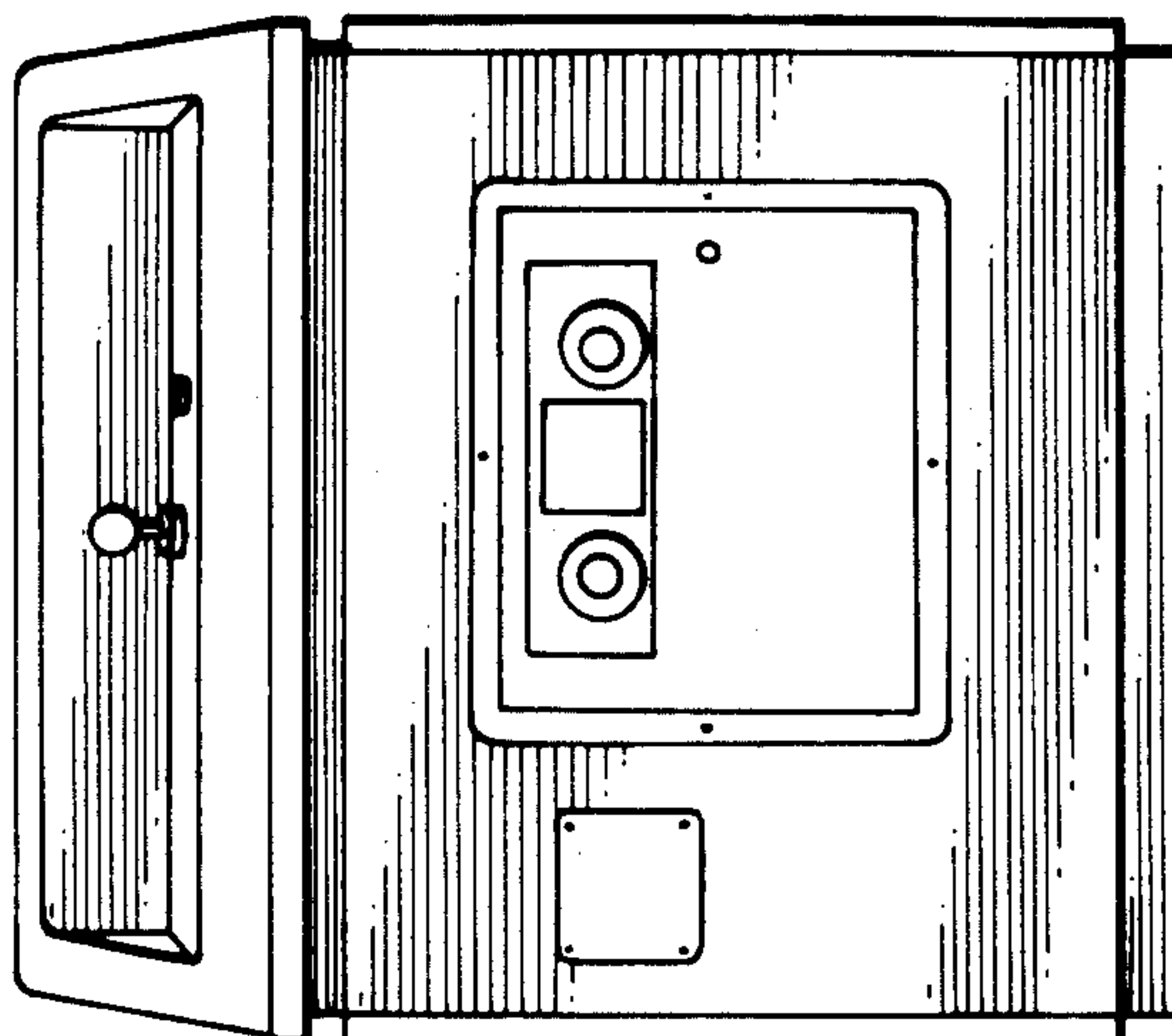

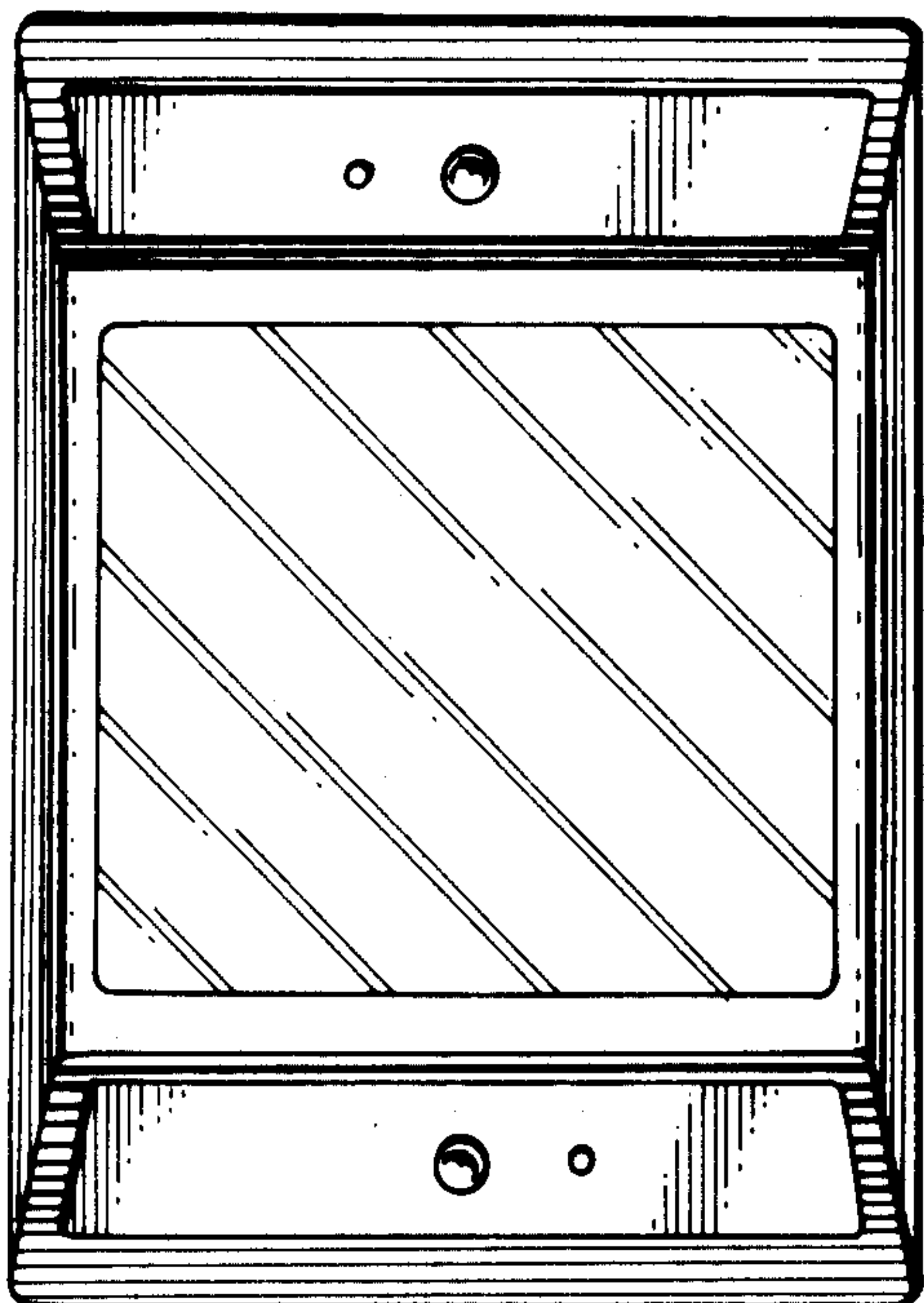

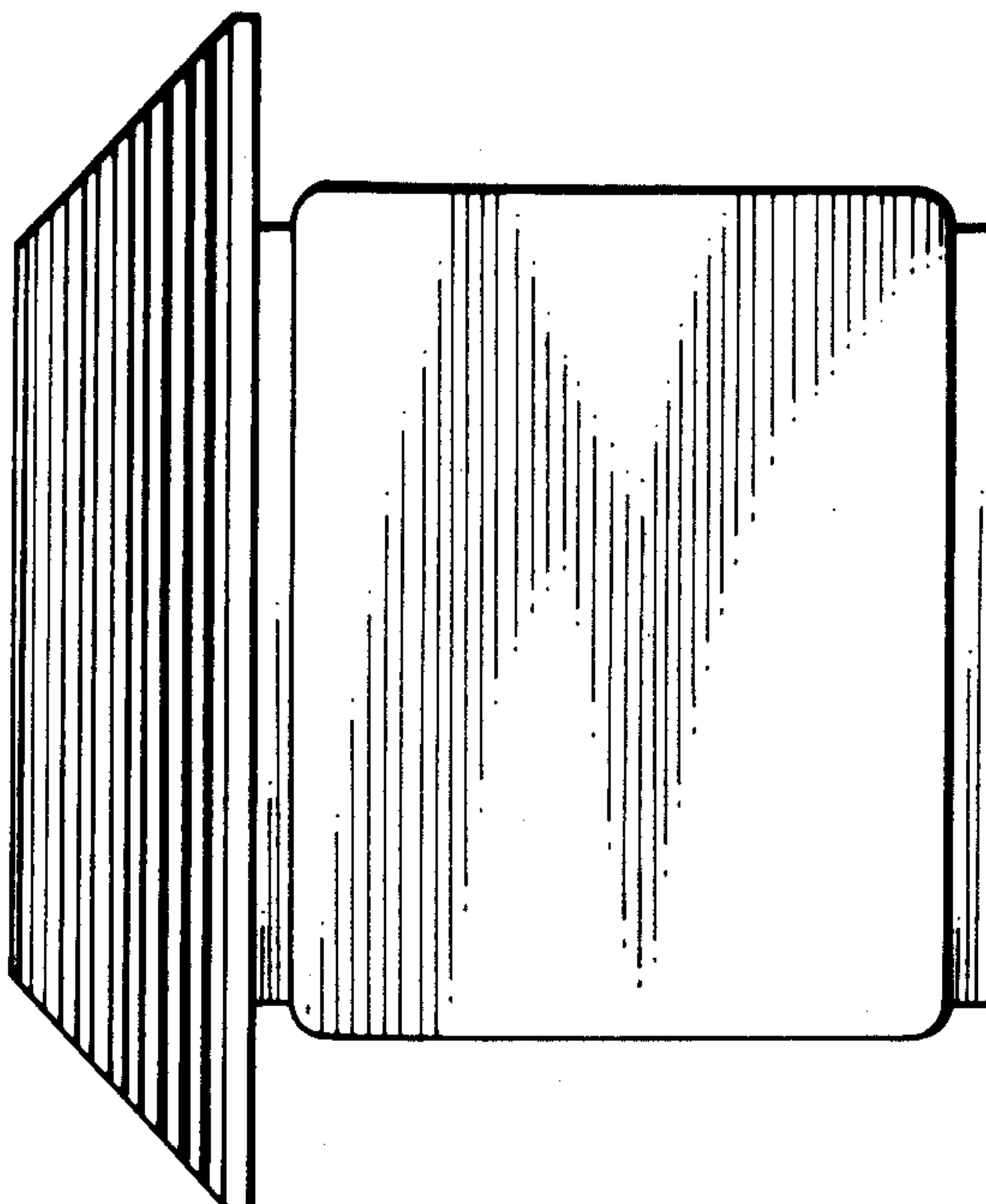

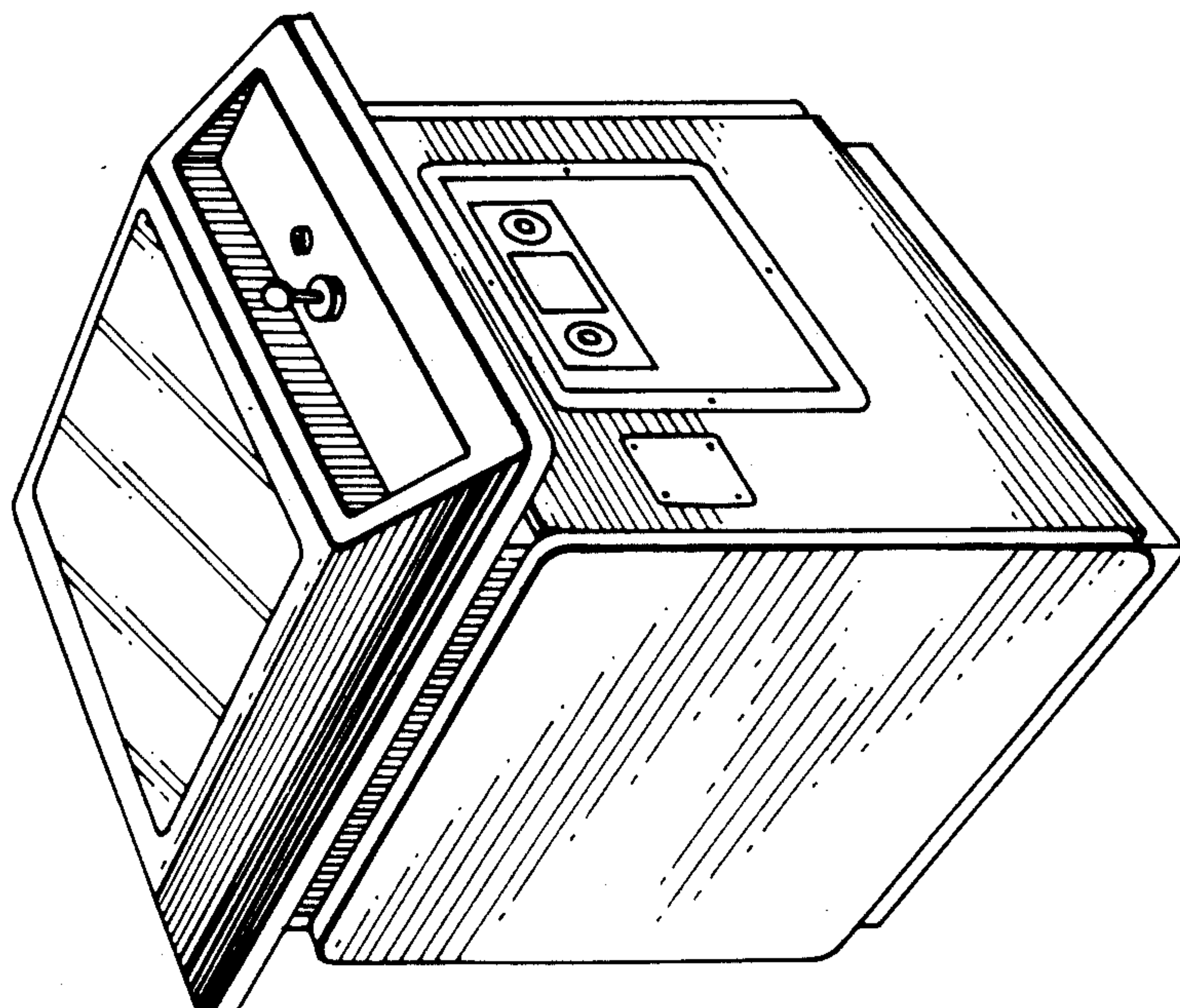
