The ornamental design for shower stall for handicapped persons, substantially as shown.

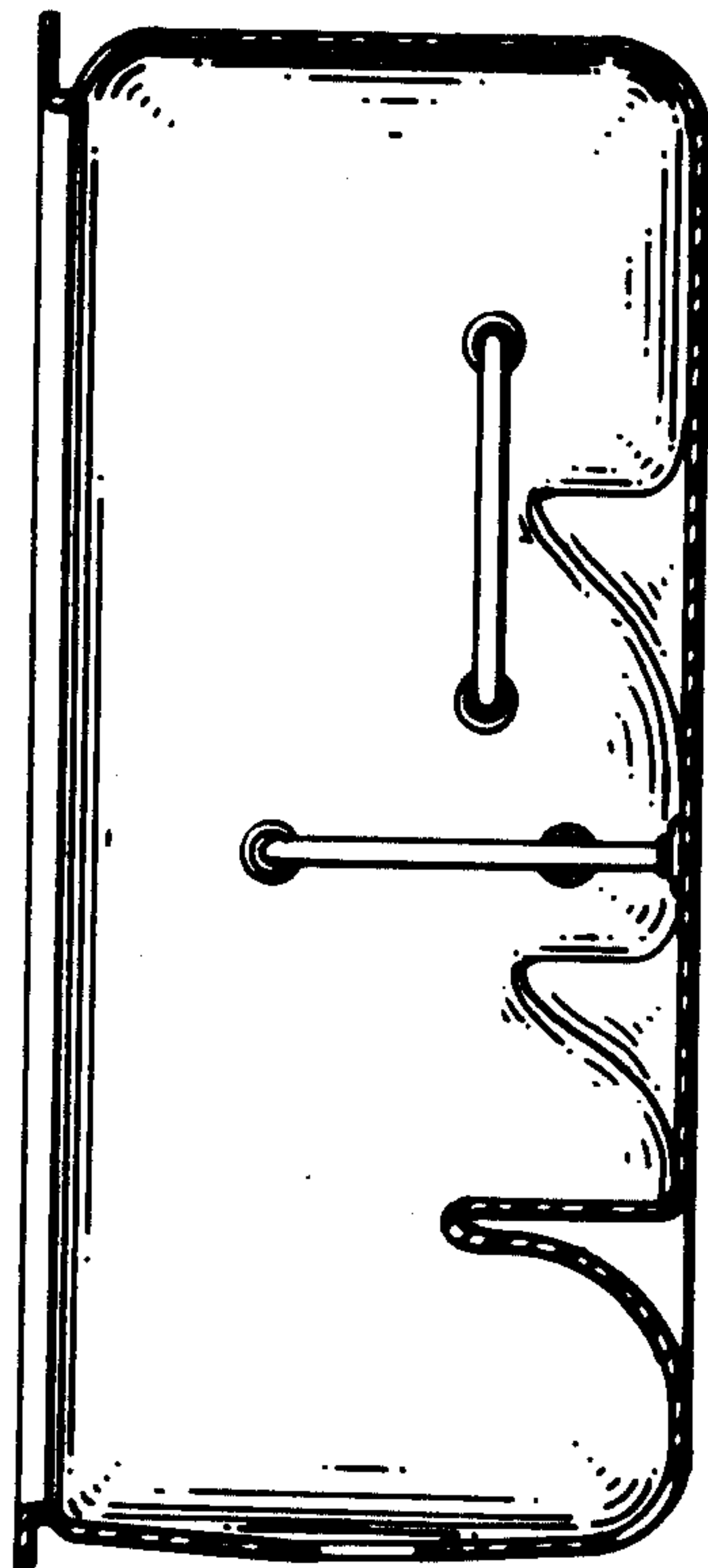
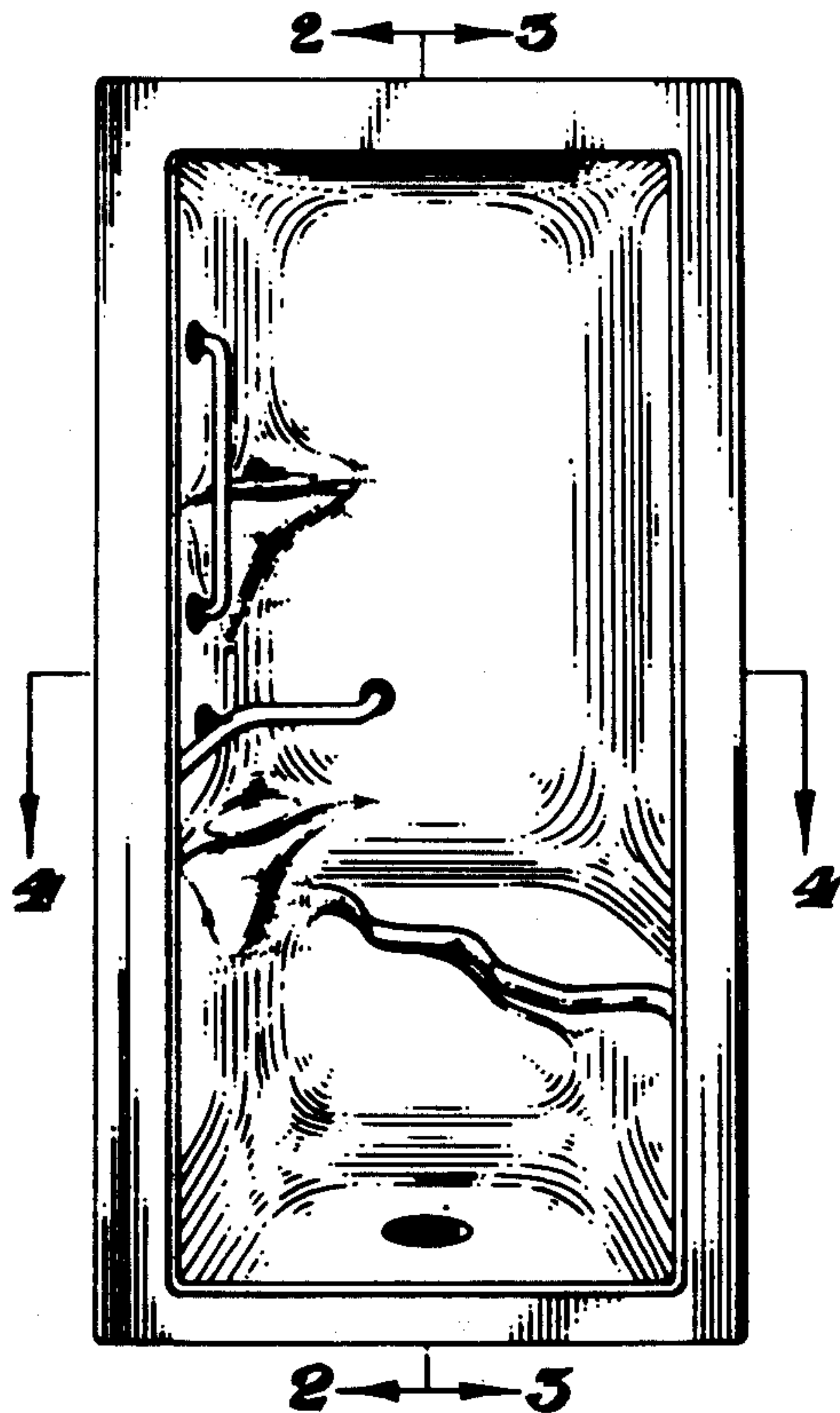
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shower stall embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a cross sectional view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1.



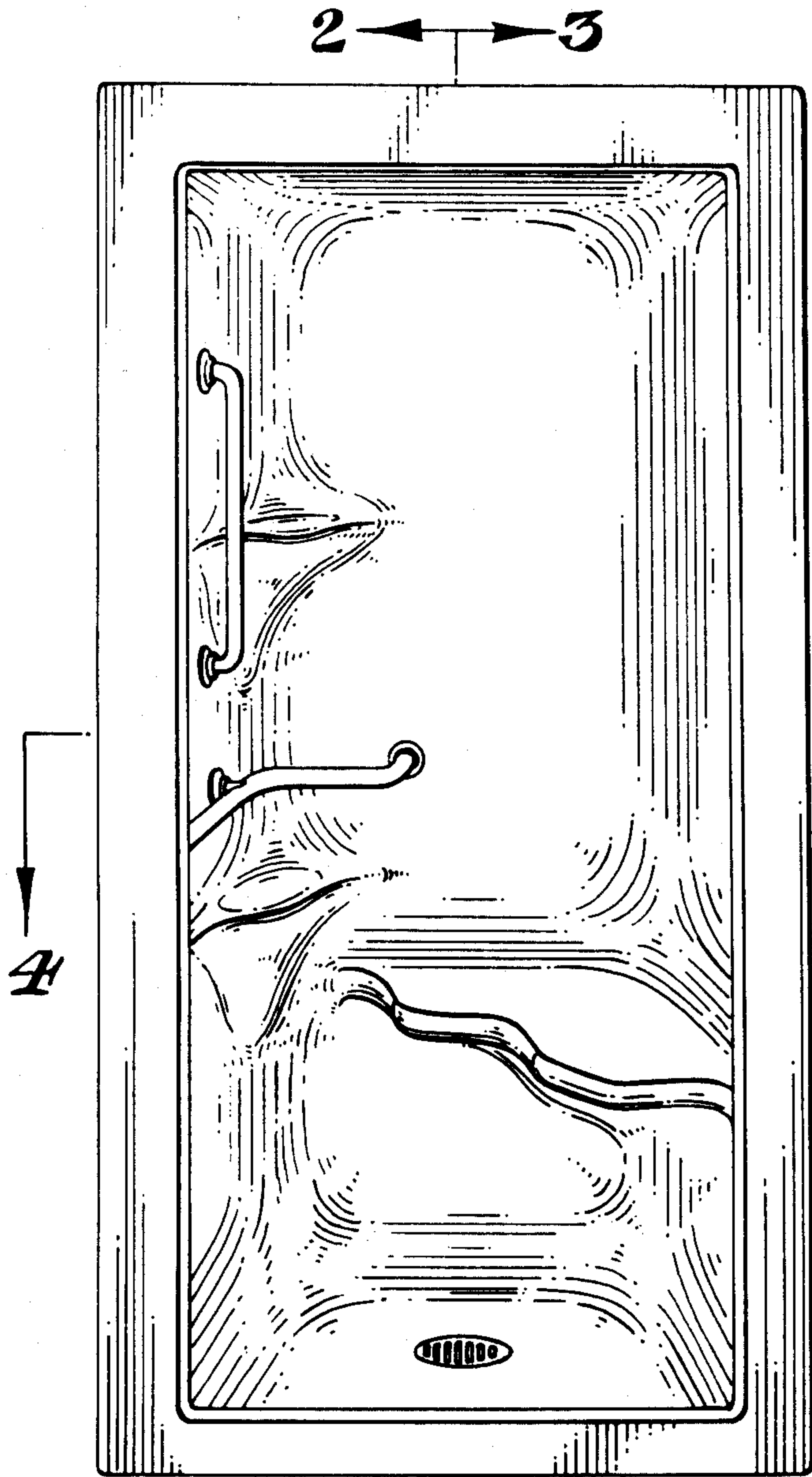

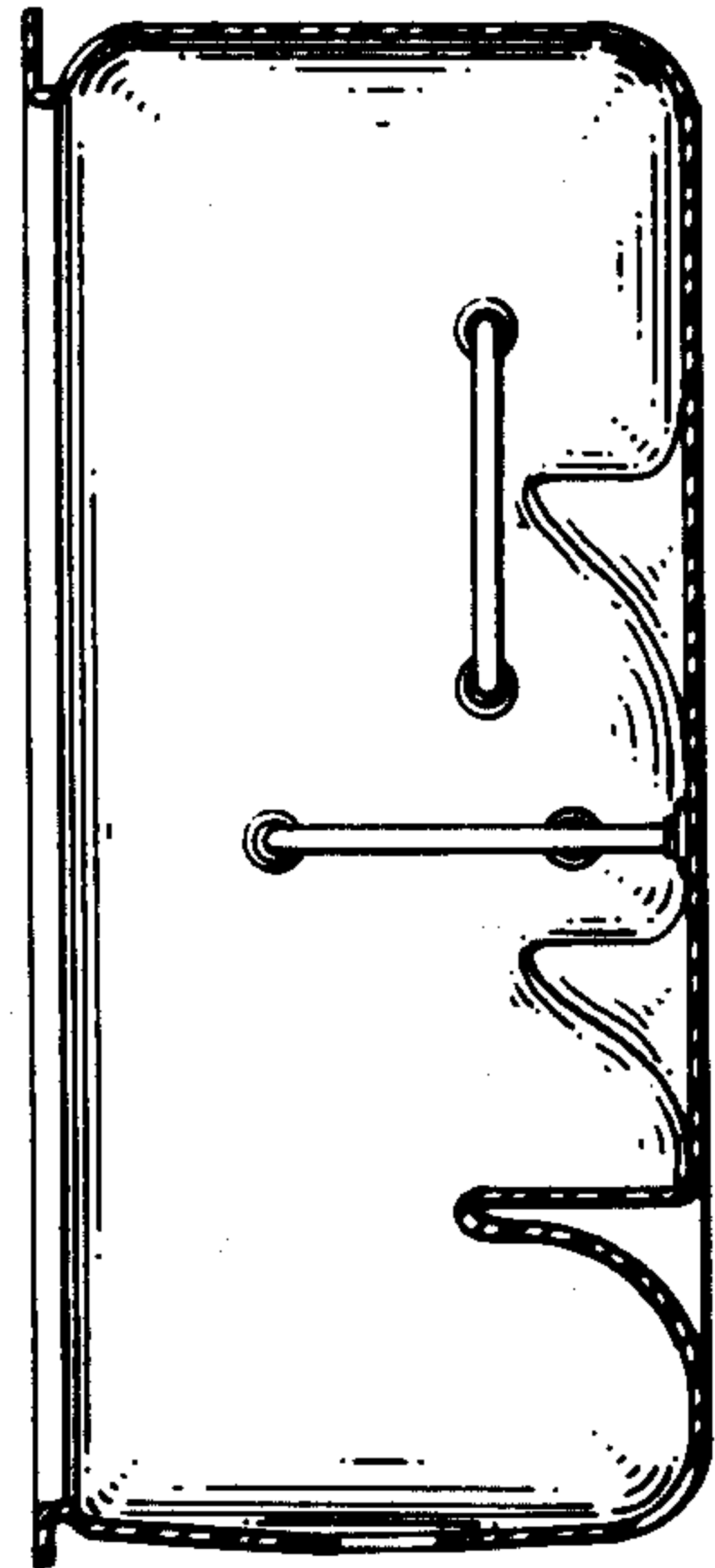

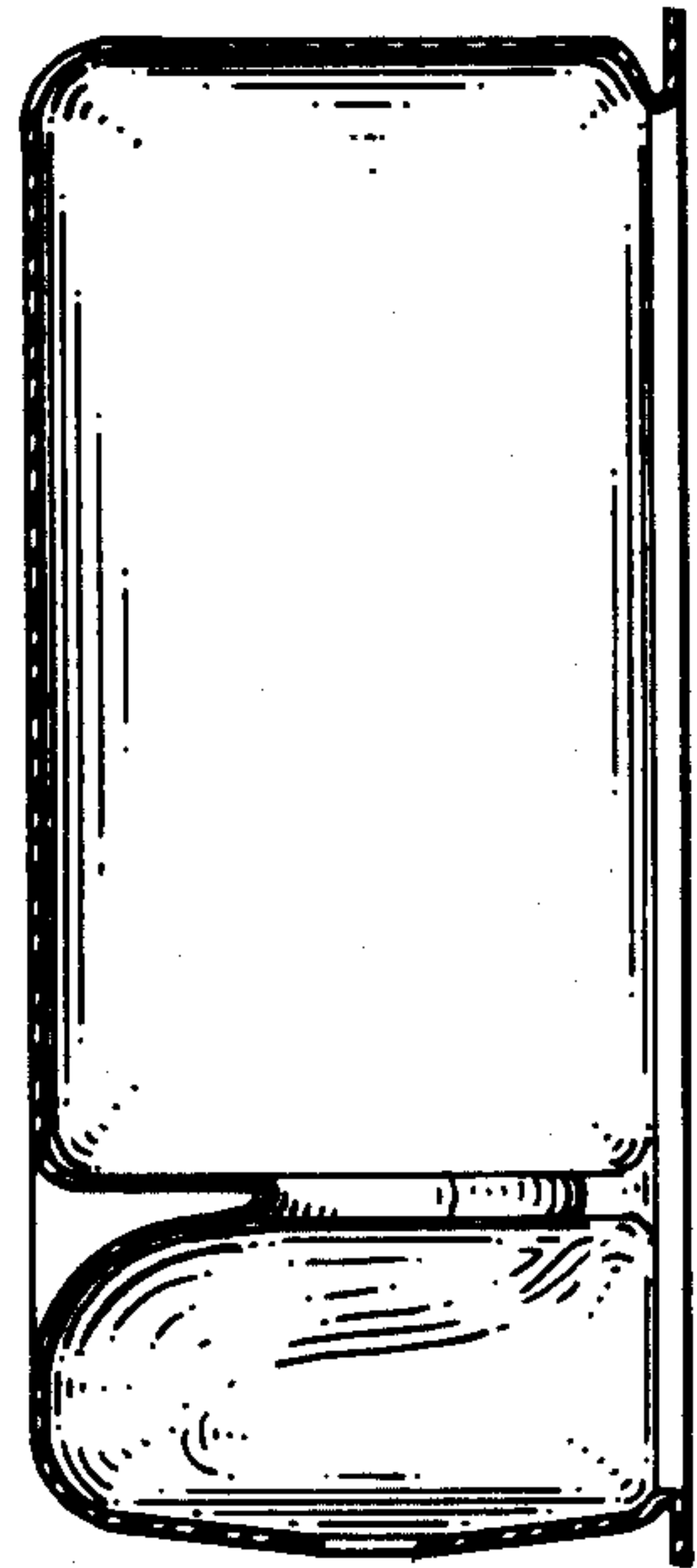

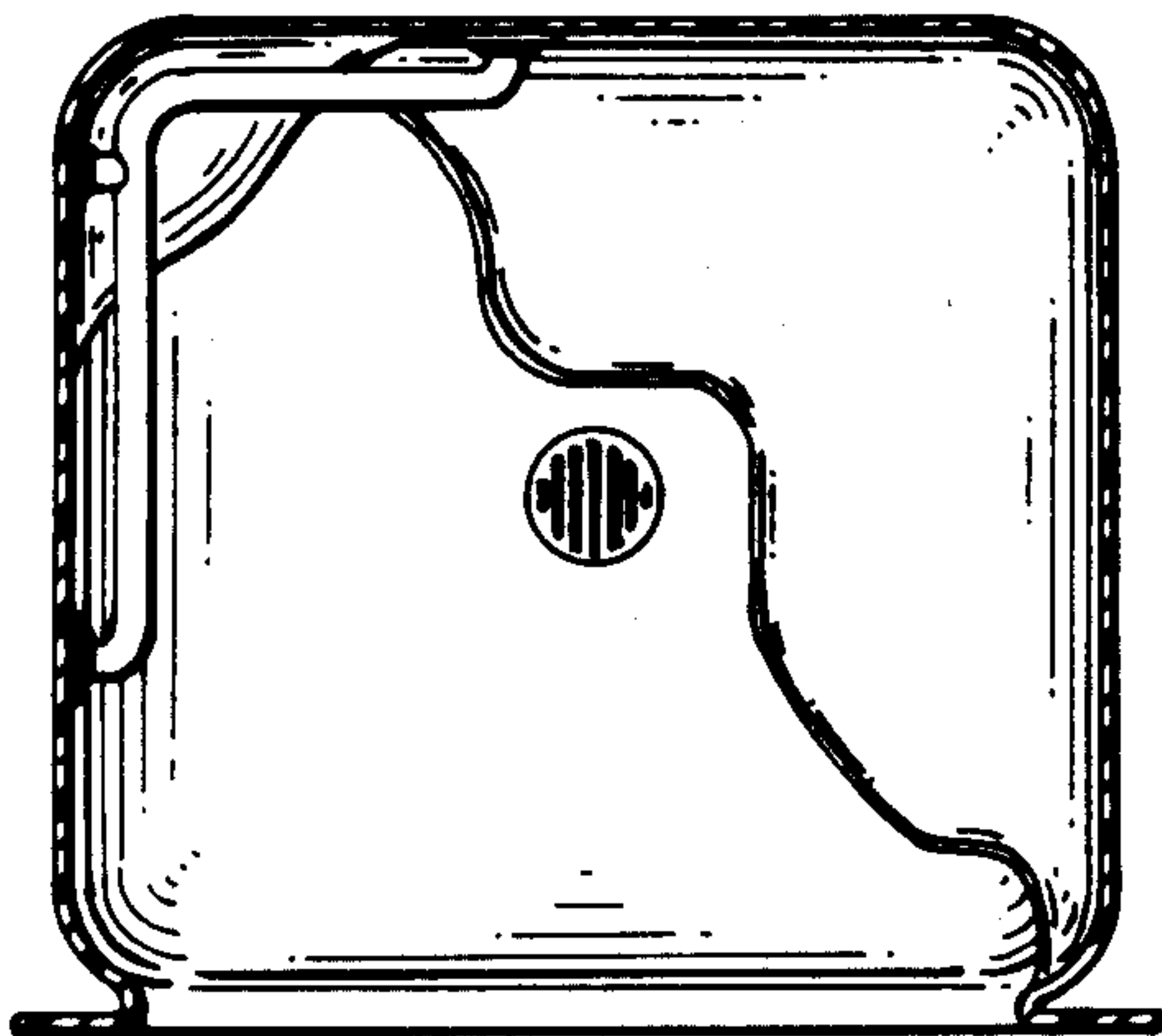
