DESCRIPTION

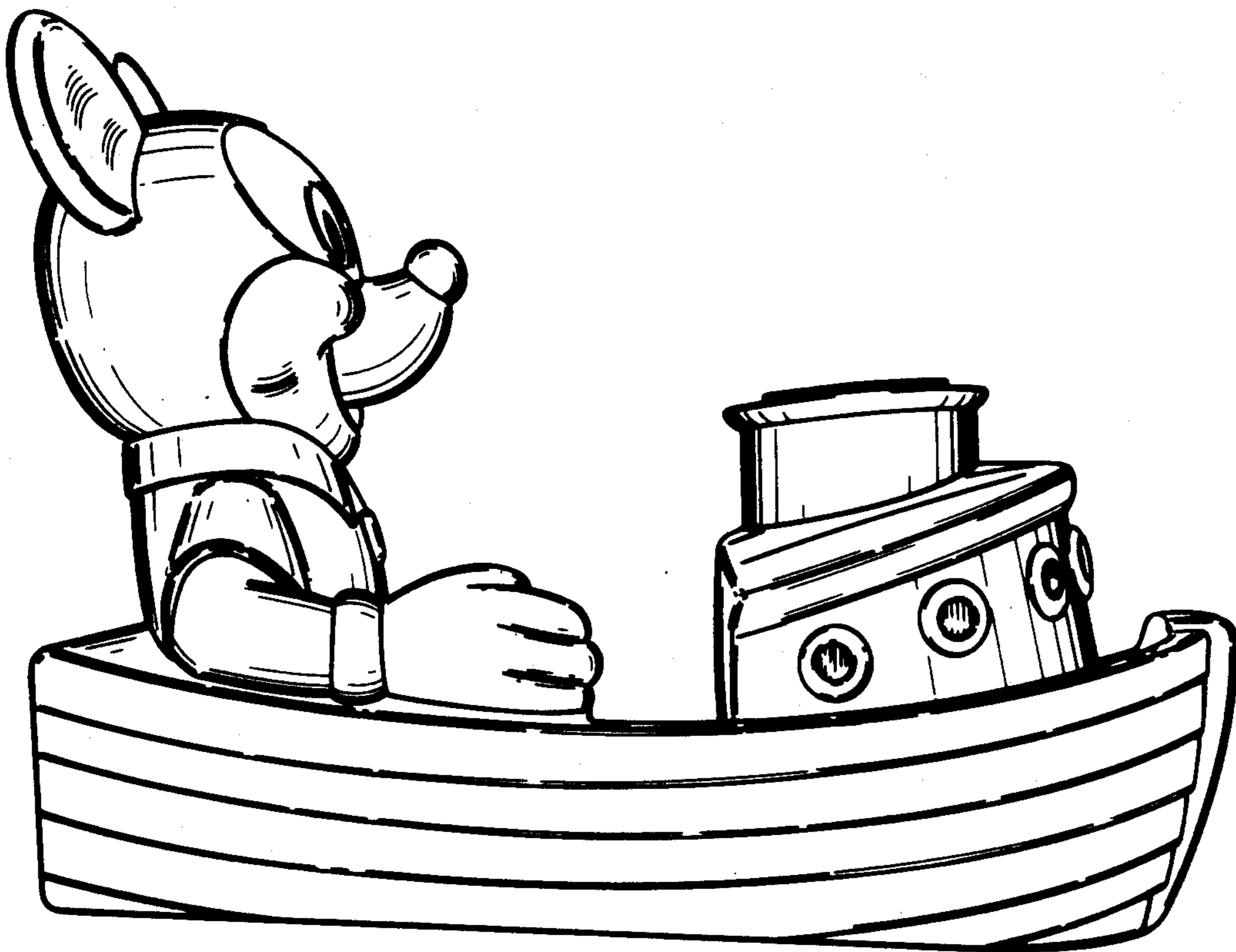
FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a toy boat showing my new design;

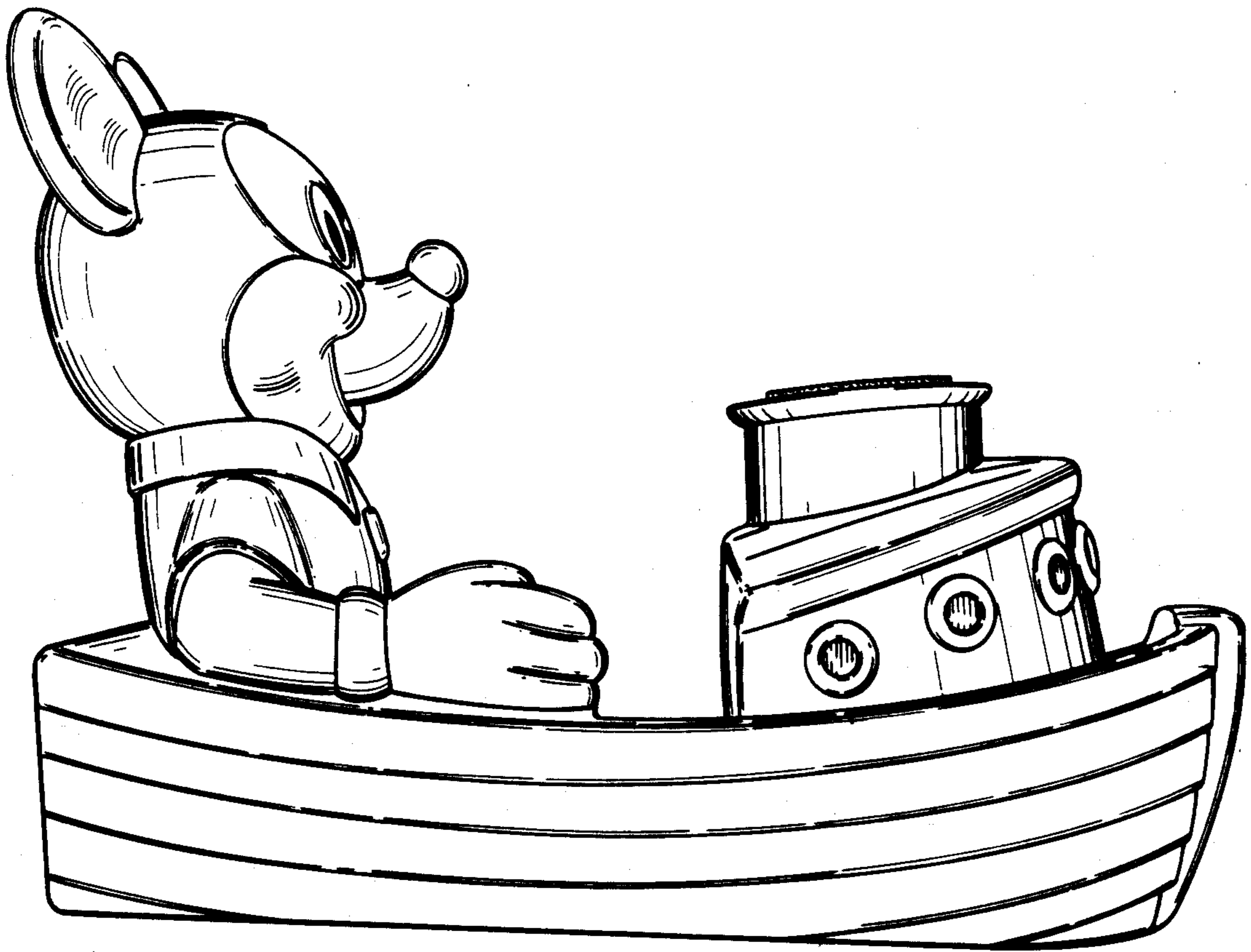
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof;

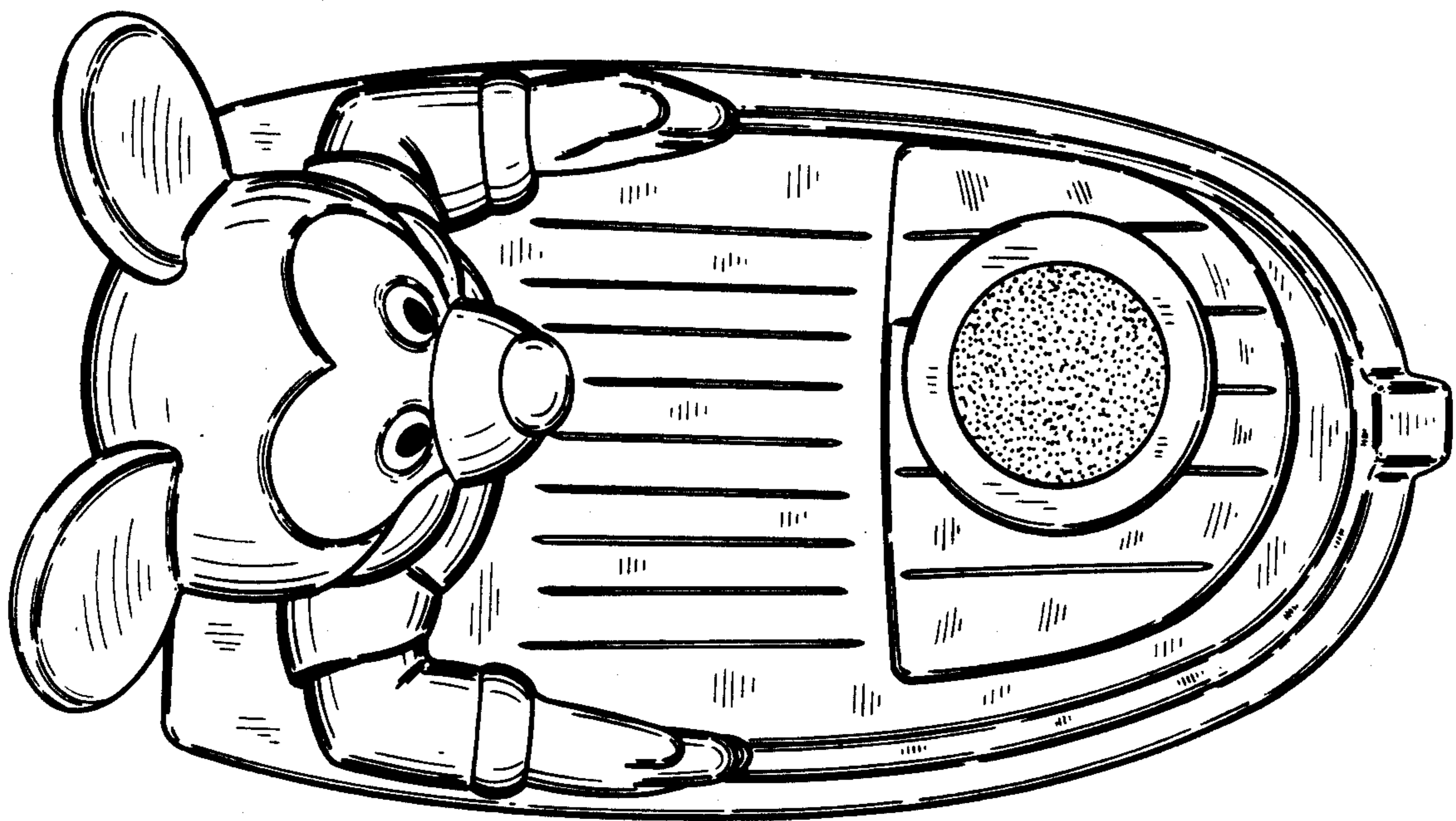
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,

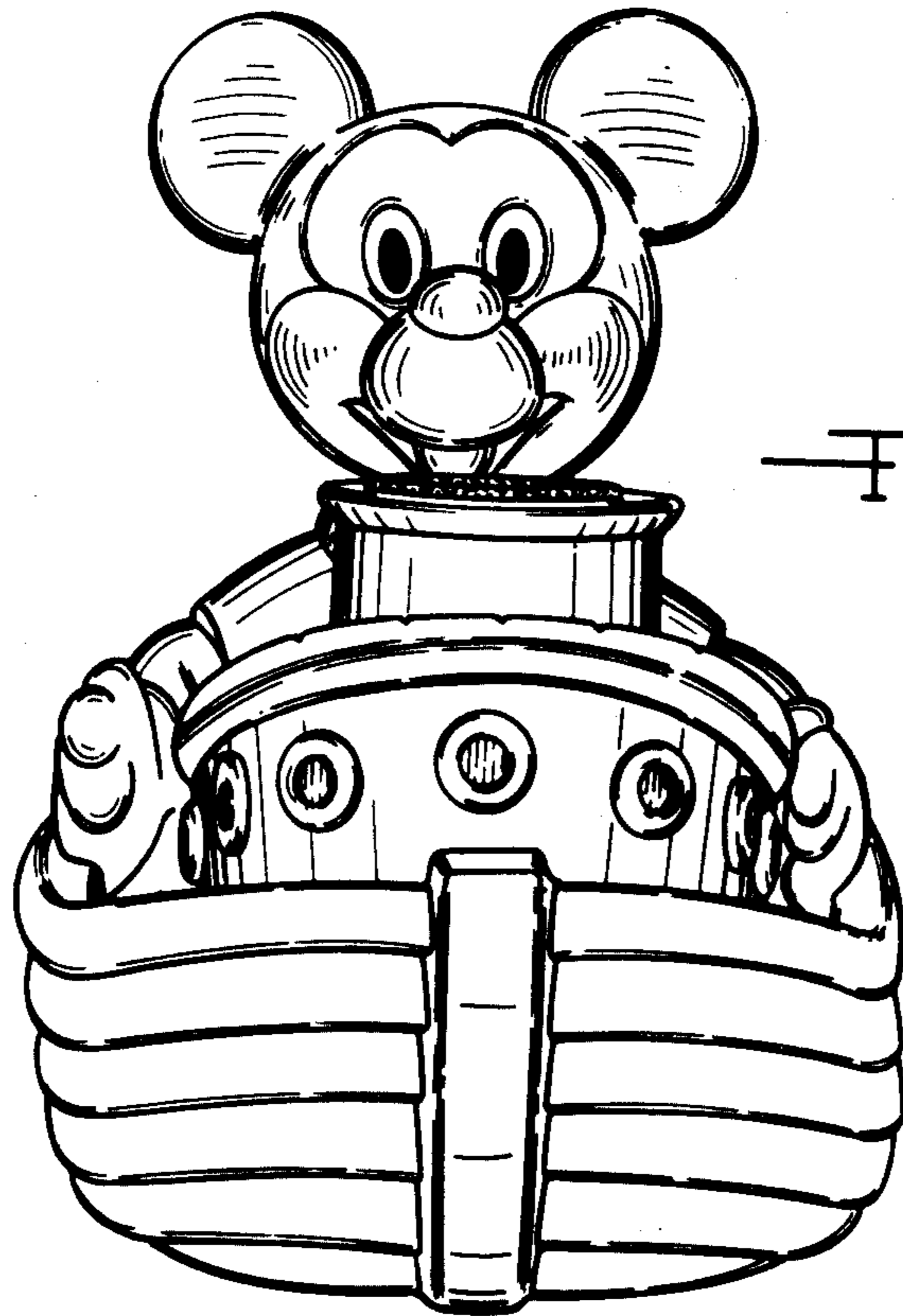

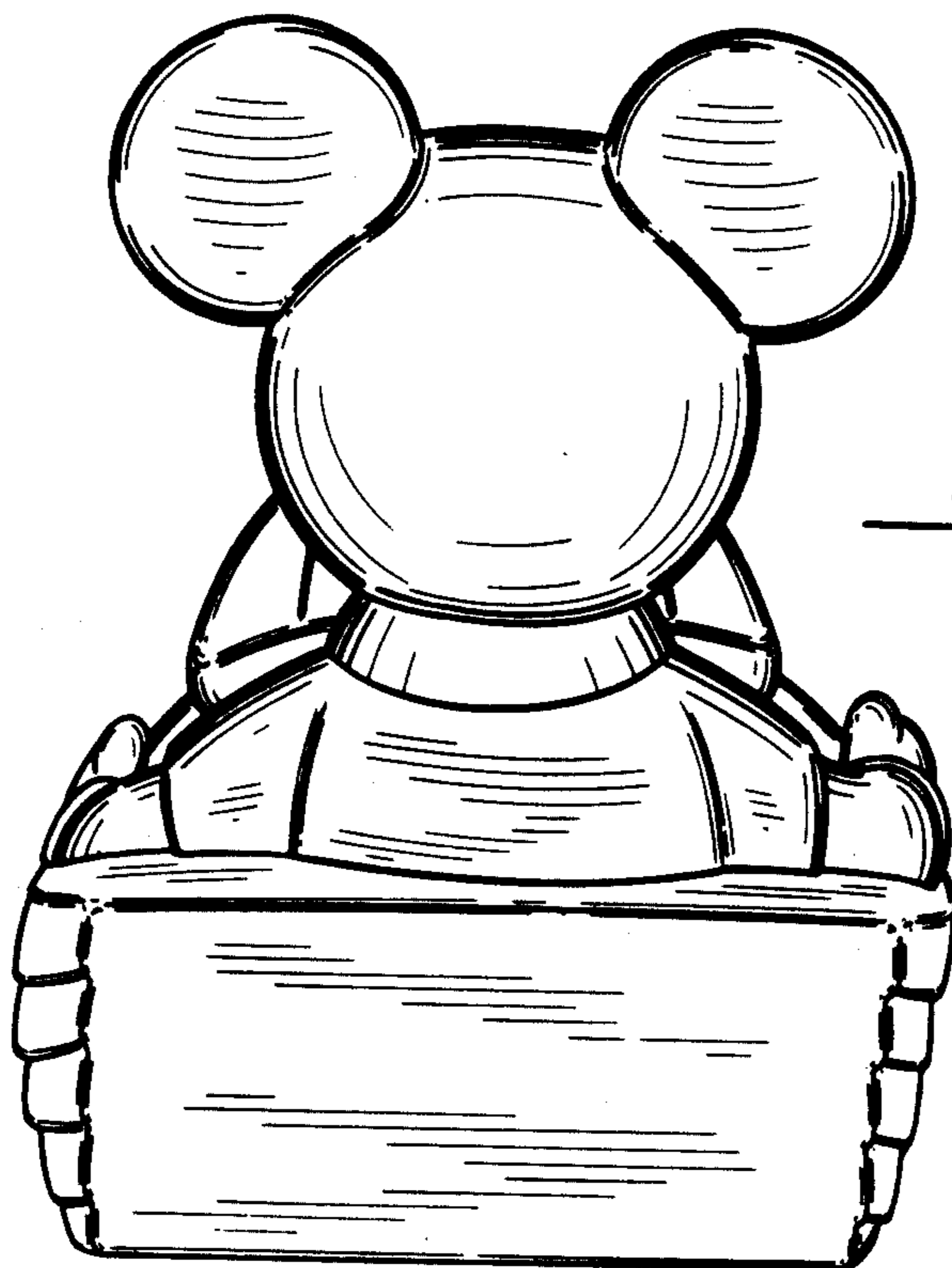
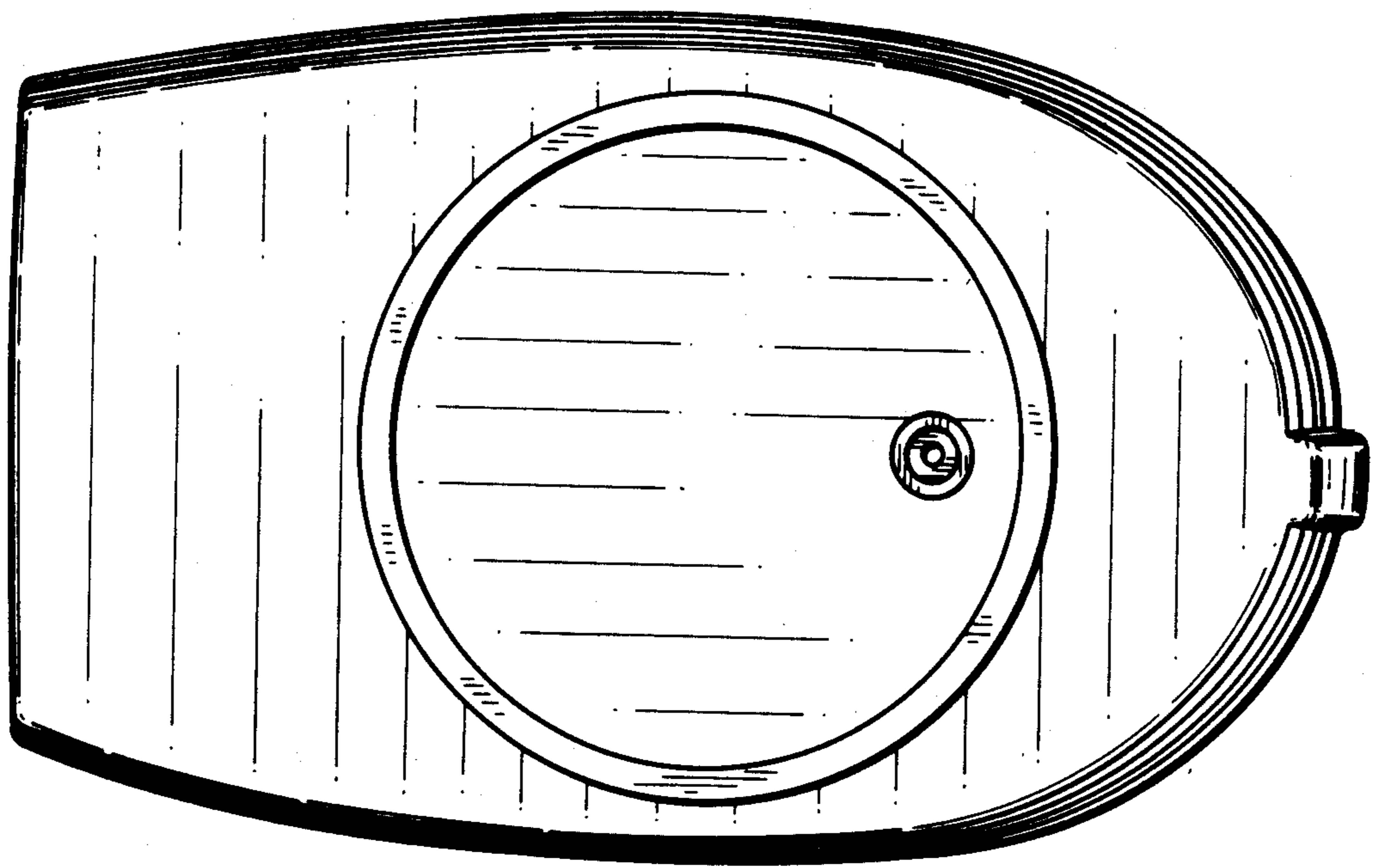
