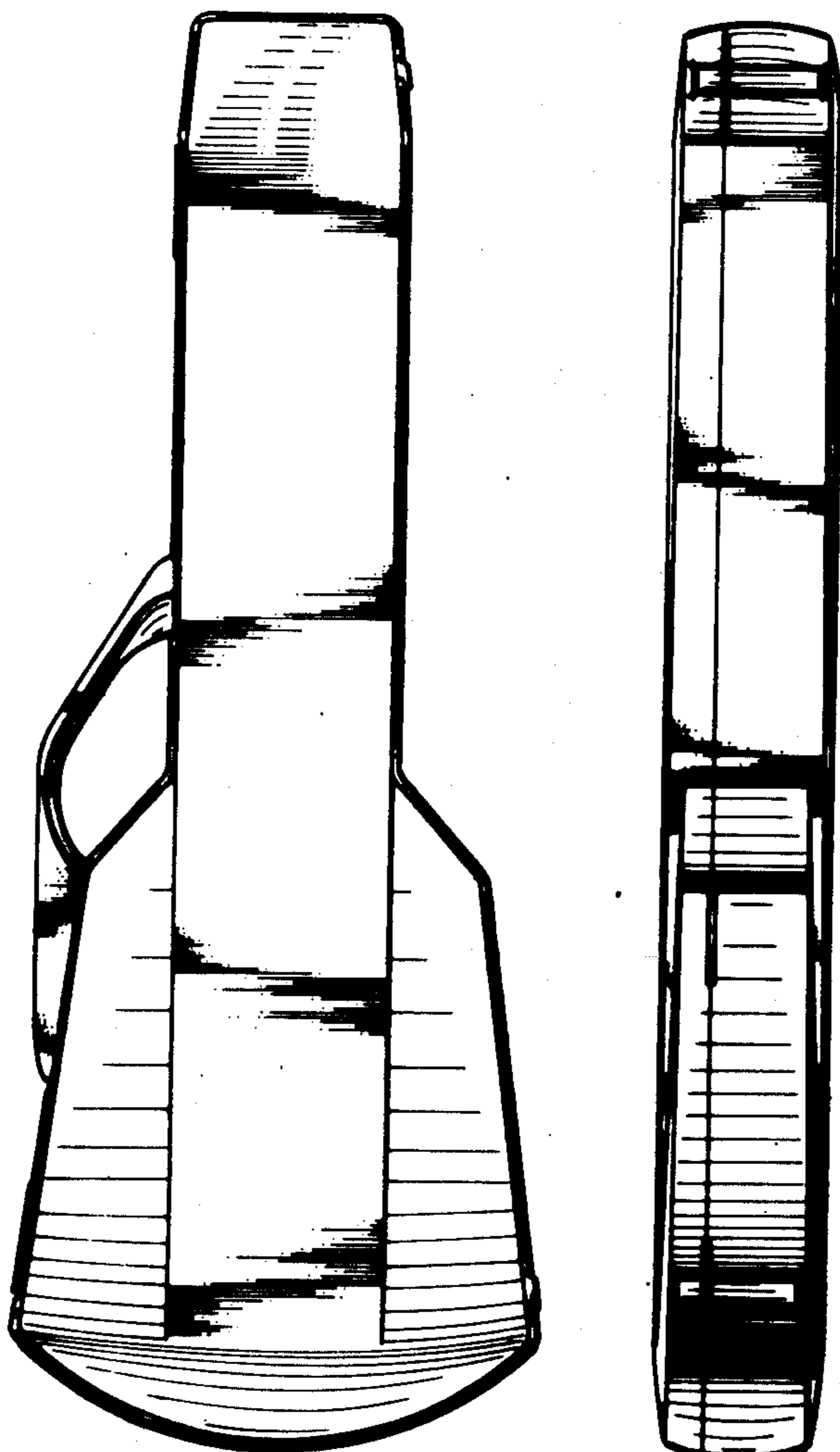

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a carrying case for a musical instrument or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a carrying case for a musical instrument or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



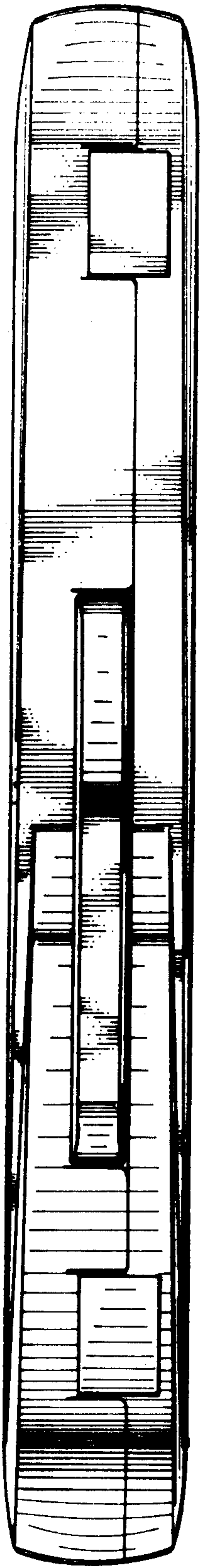

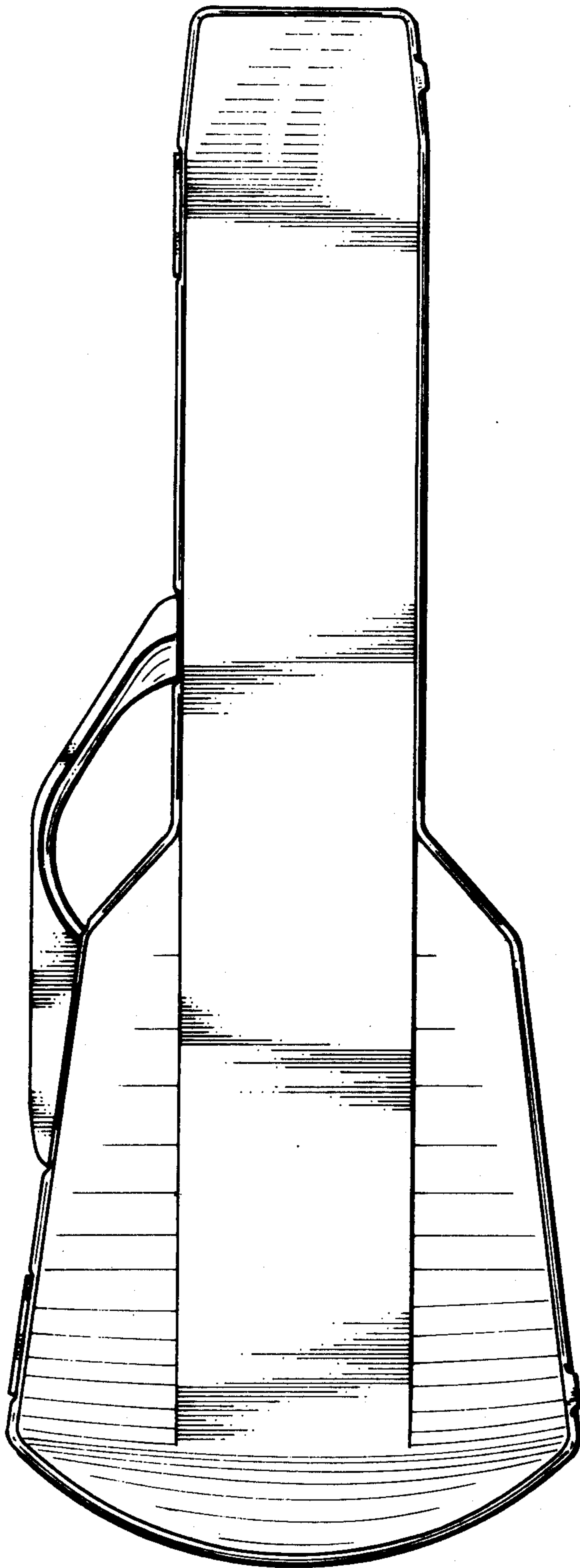

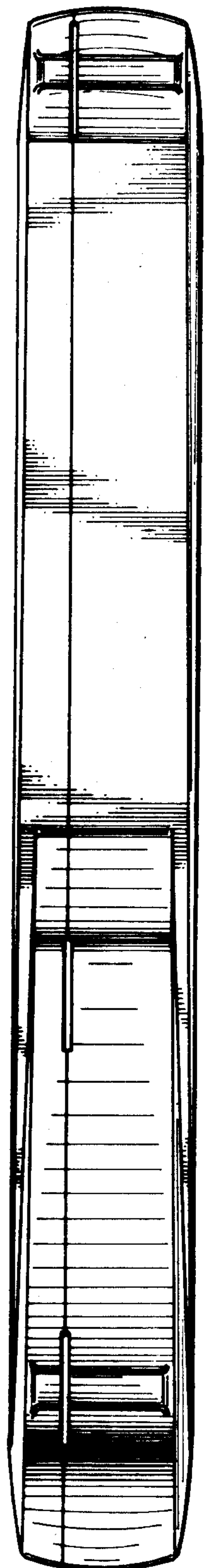

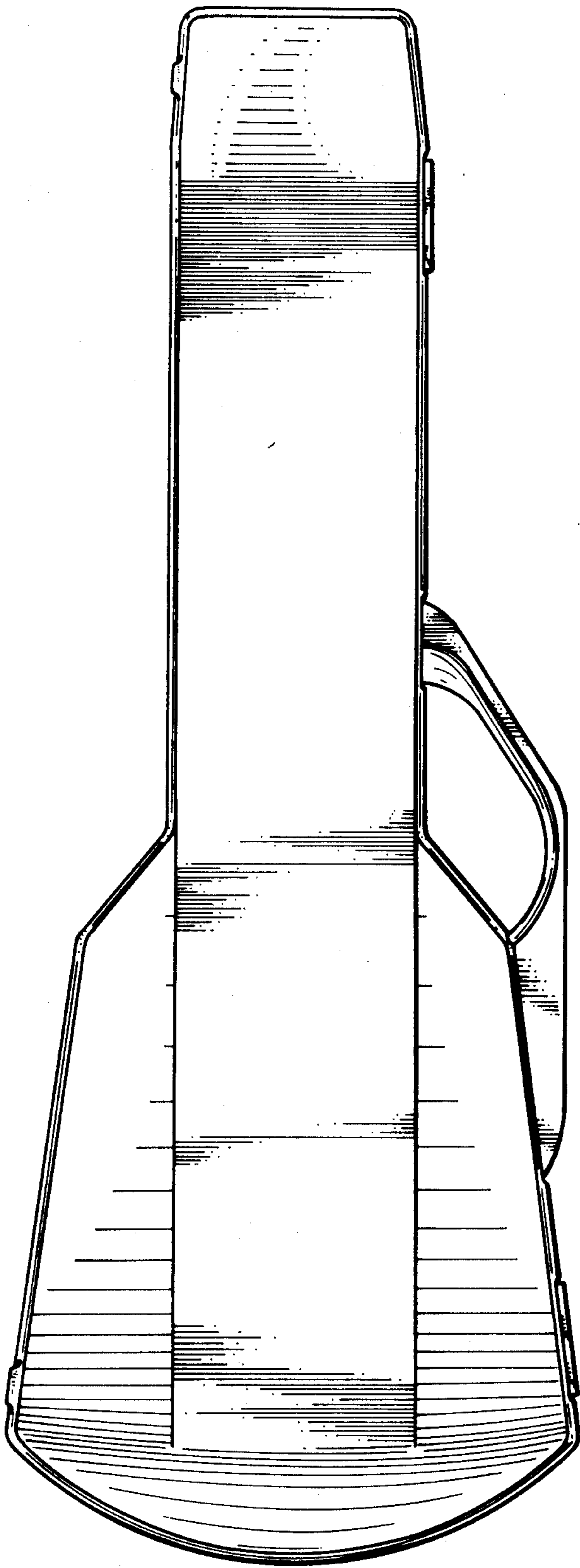
