[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for nonwoven sheet material or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a plan view of nonwoven sheet material or the like showing my new design. The unit shown within the broken lines is repeated in regular succession as indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.
