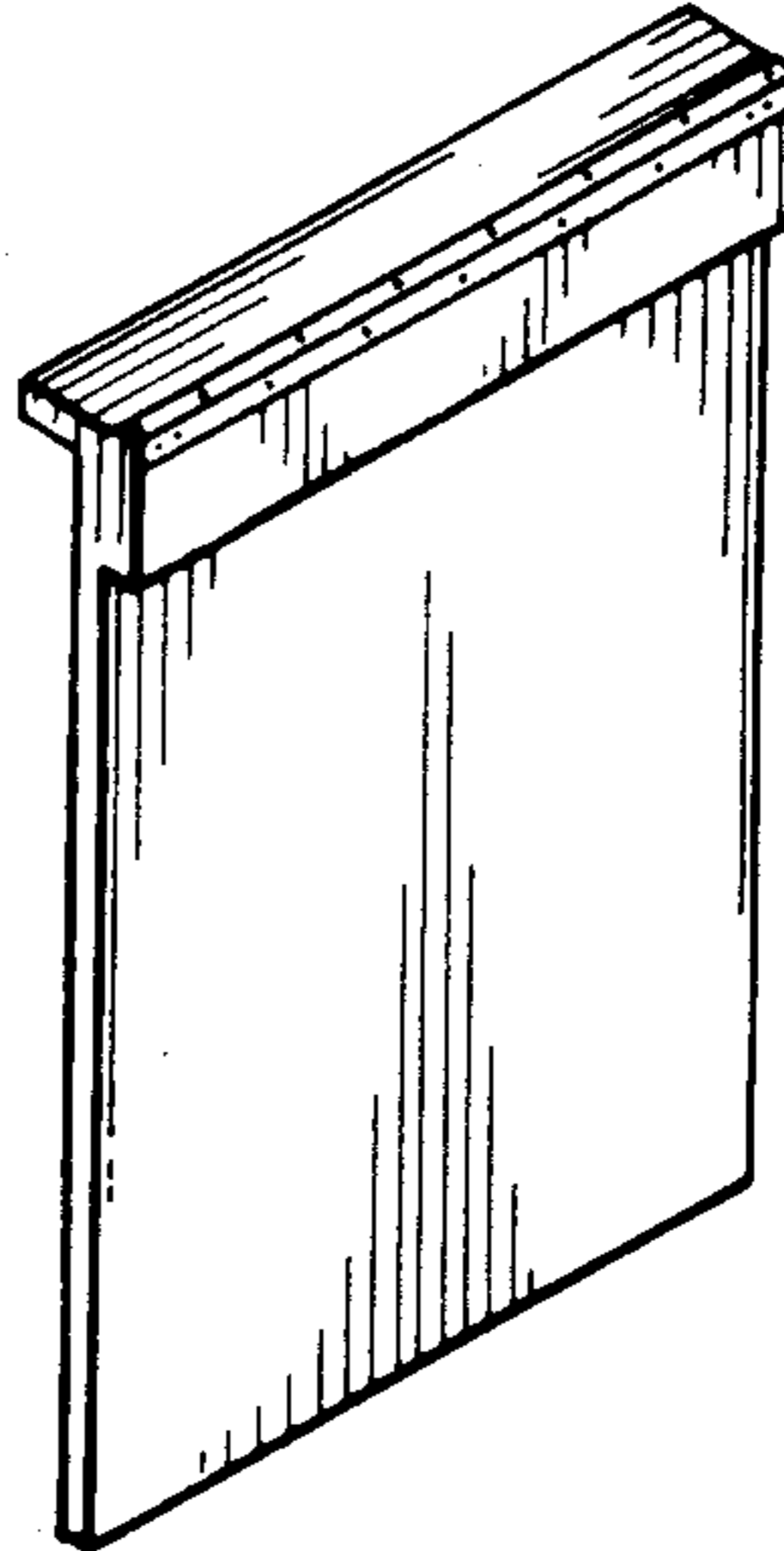
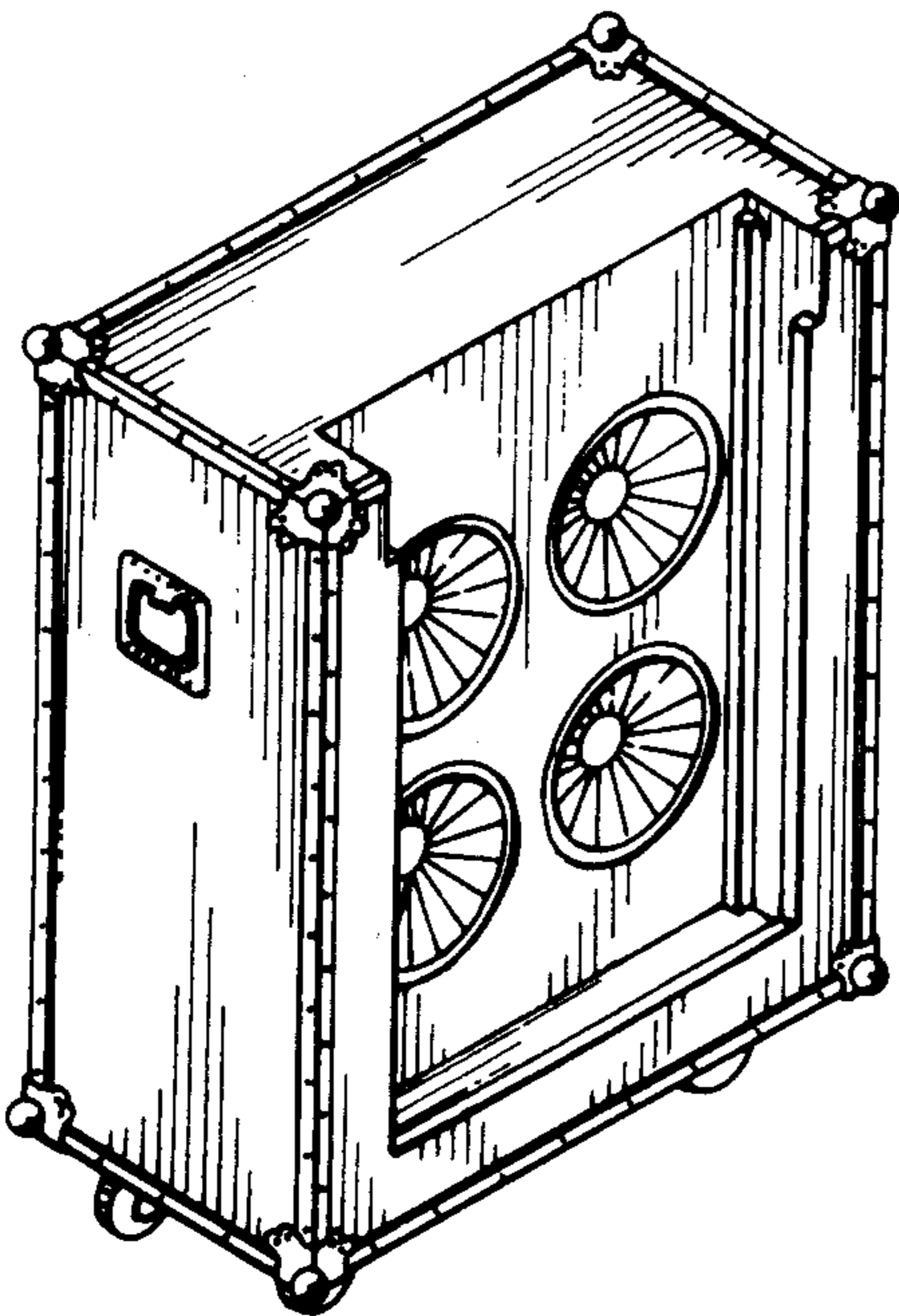

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined musical amplifier and traveling case, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined musical amplifier and traveling case showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plane view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational thereof; FIG. 5 is a side elevational thereof; and FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof with the case cover removed for clarity of illustration.



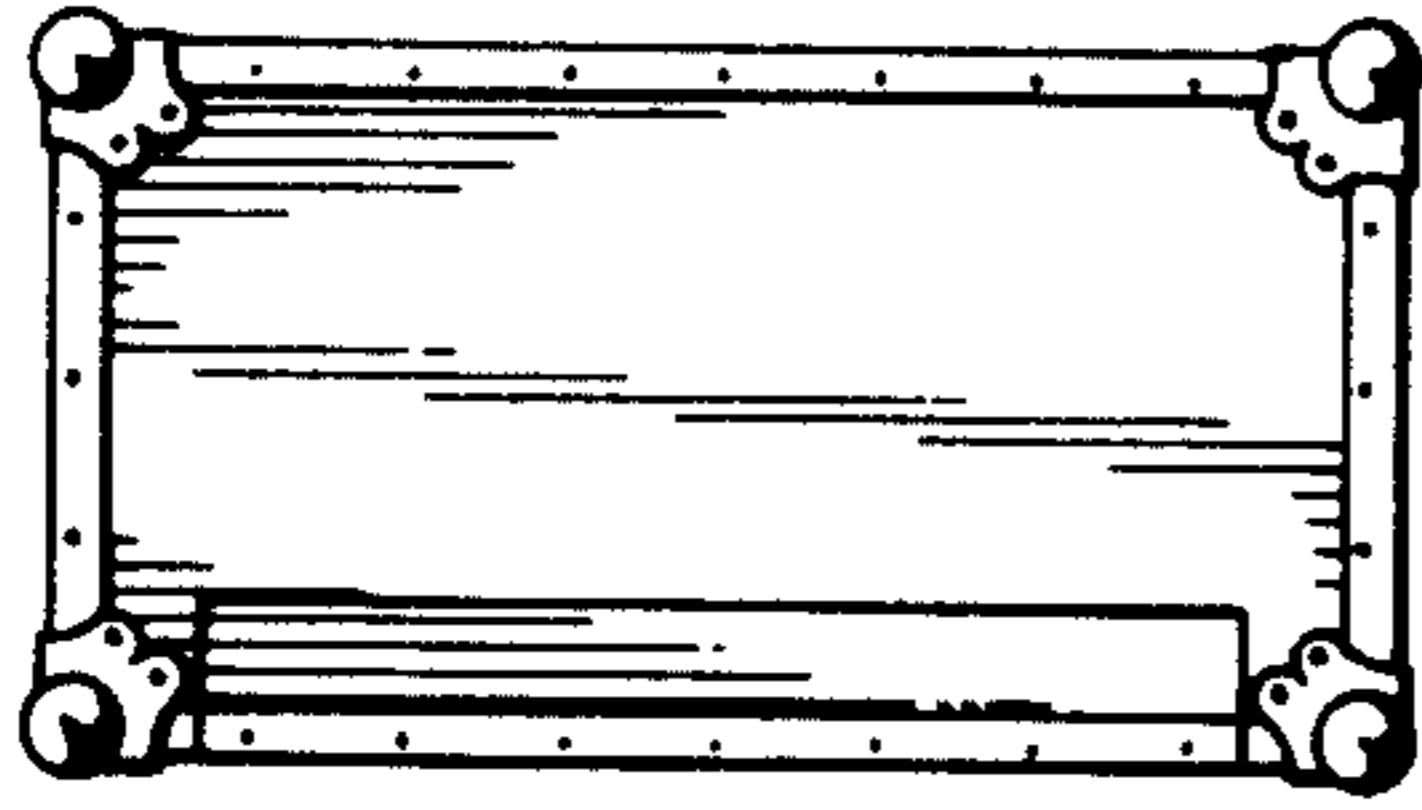

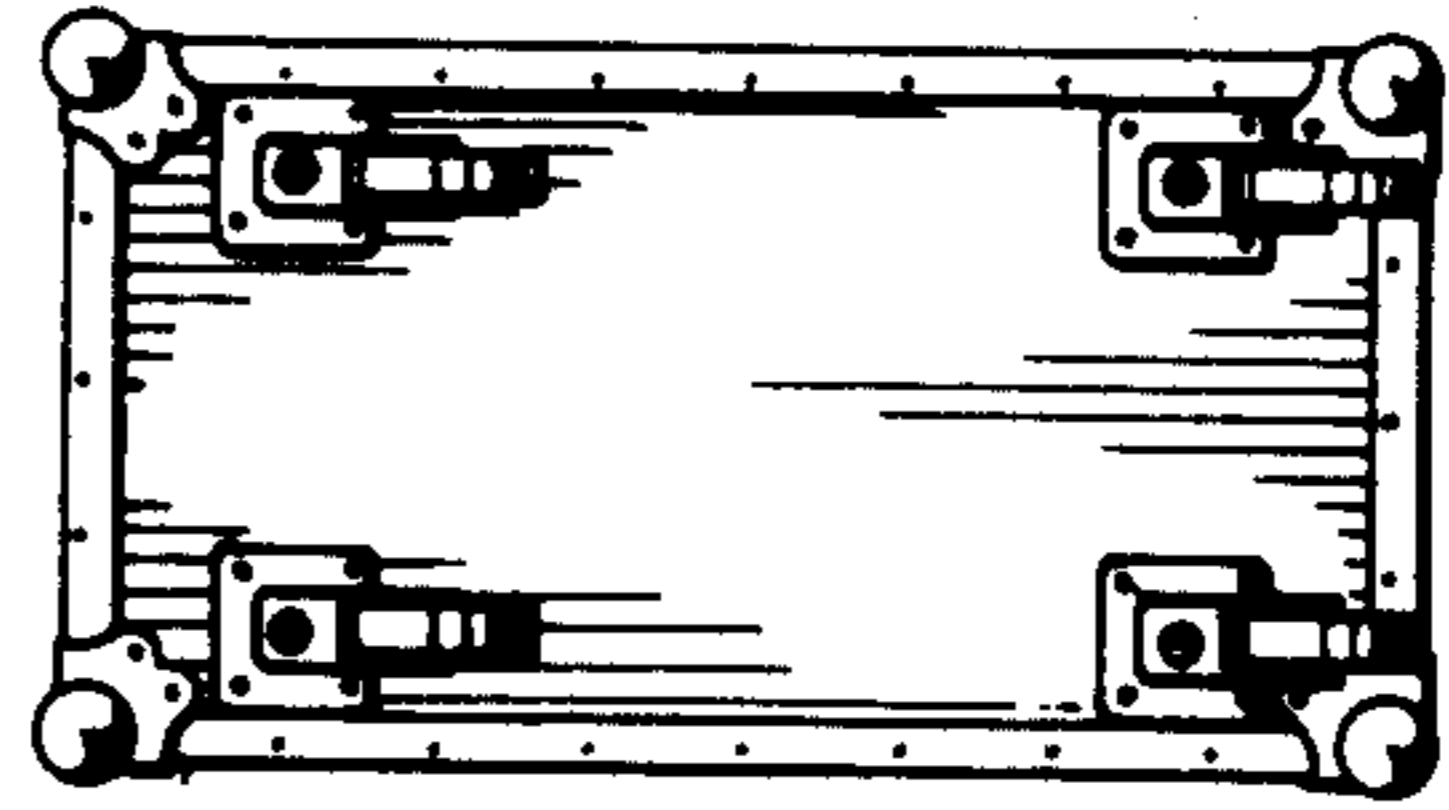

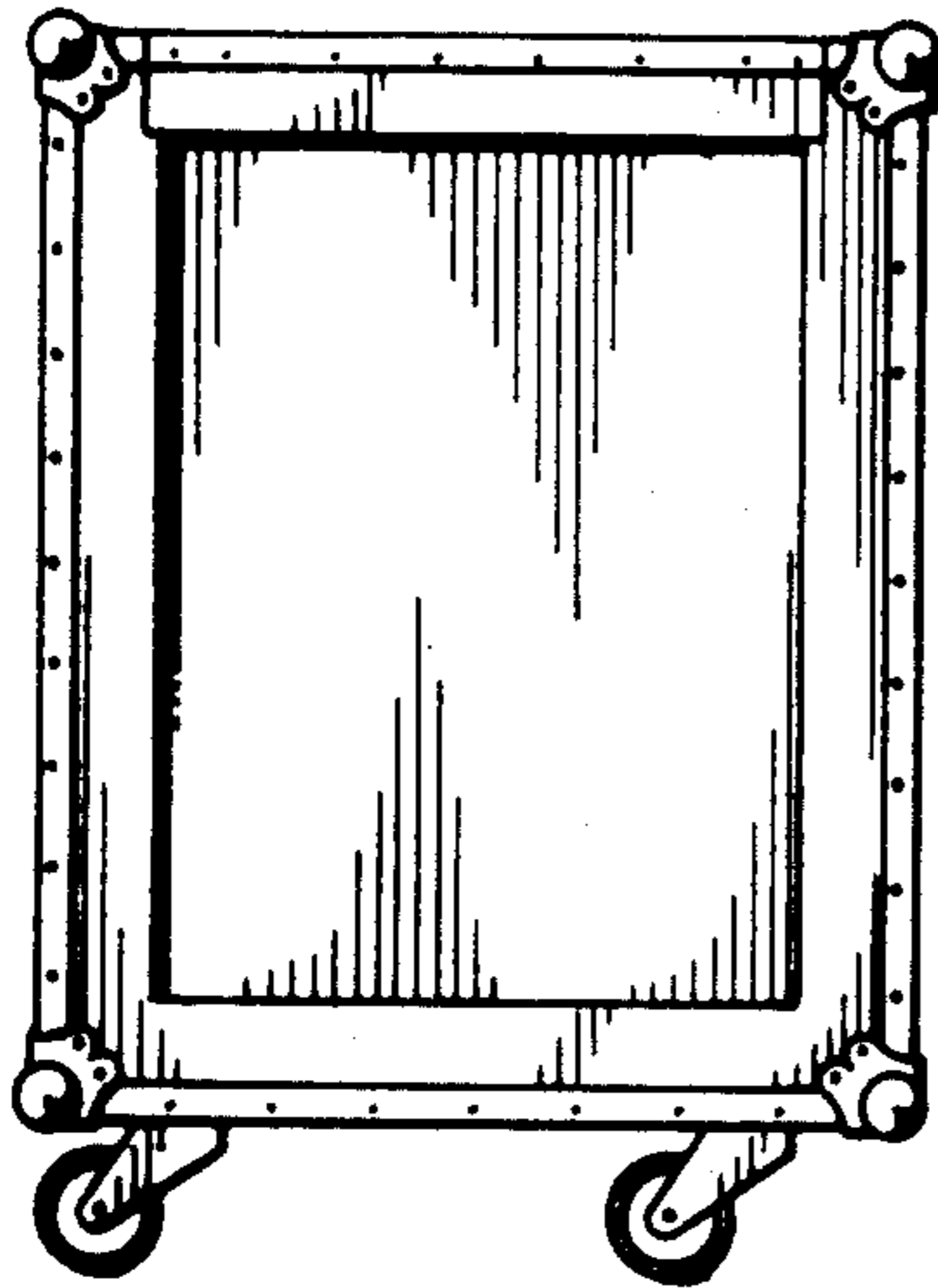

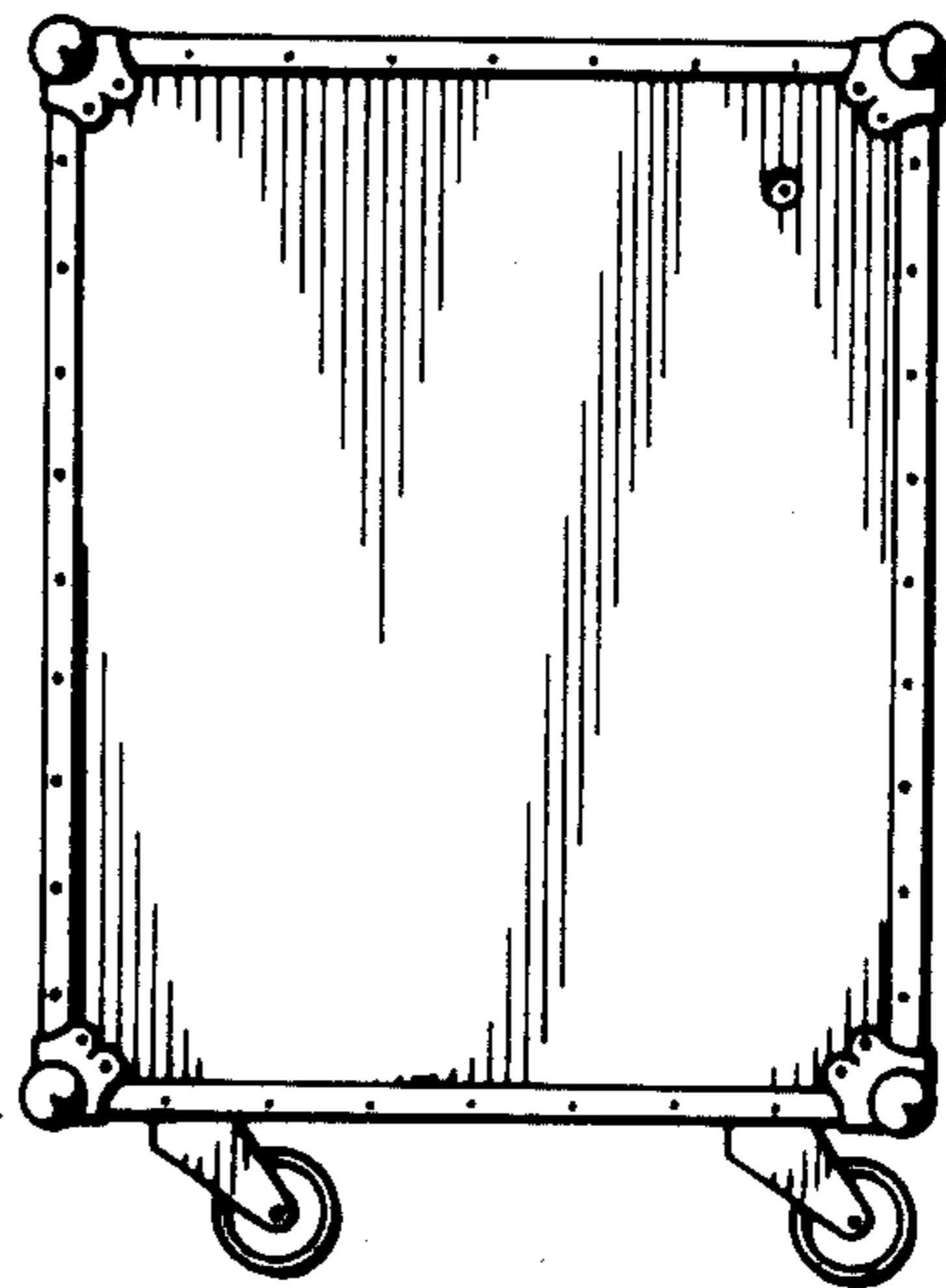

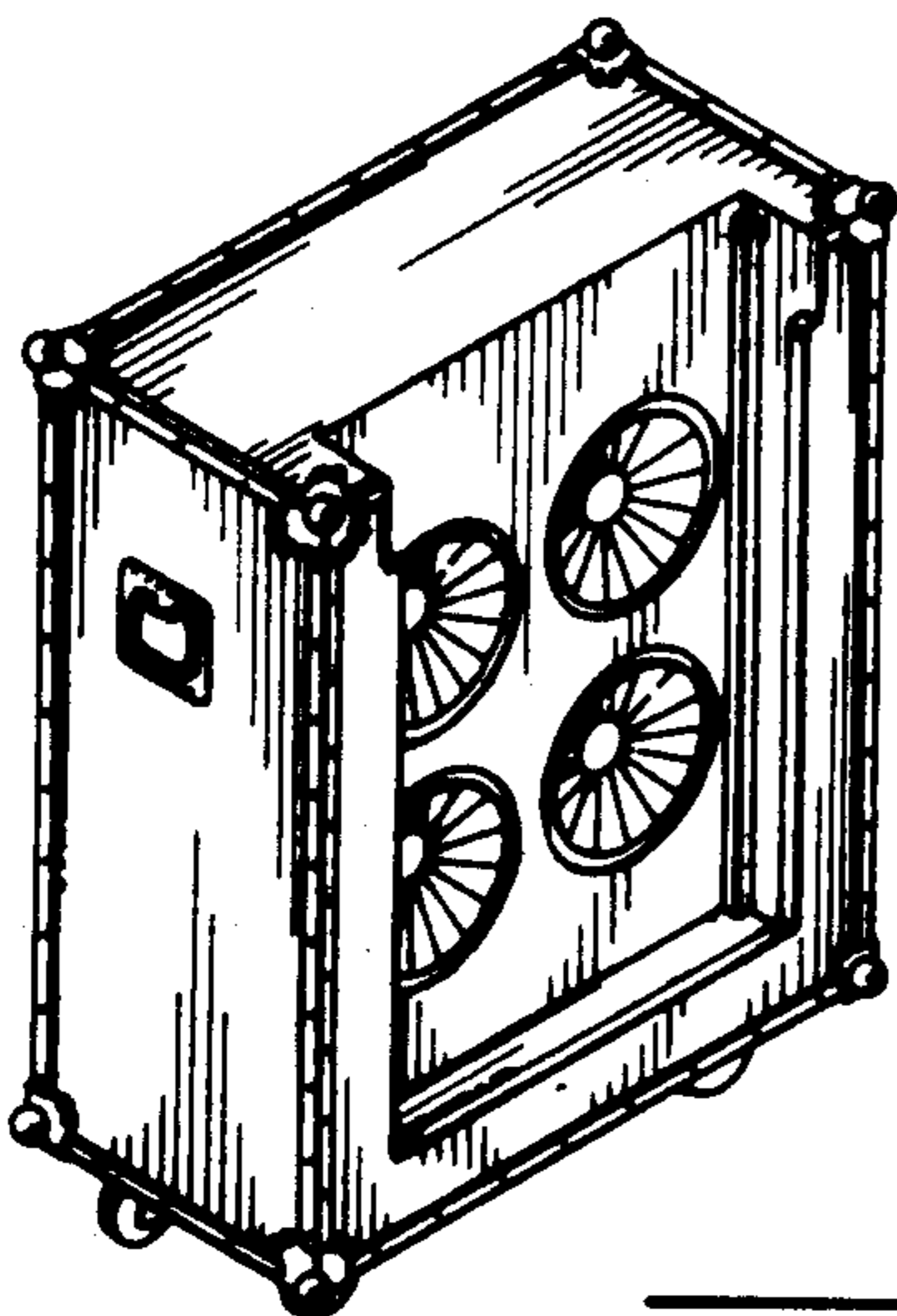

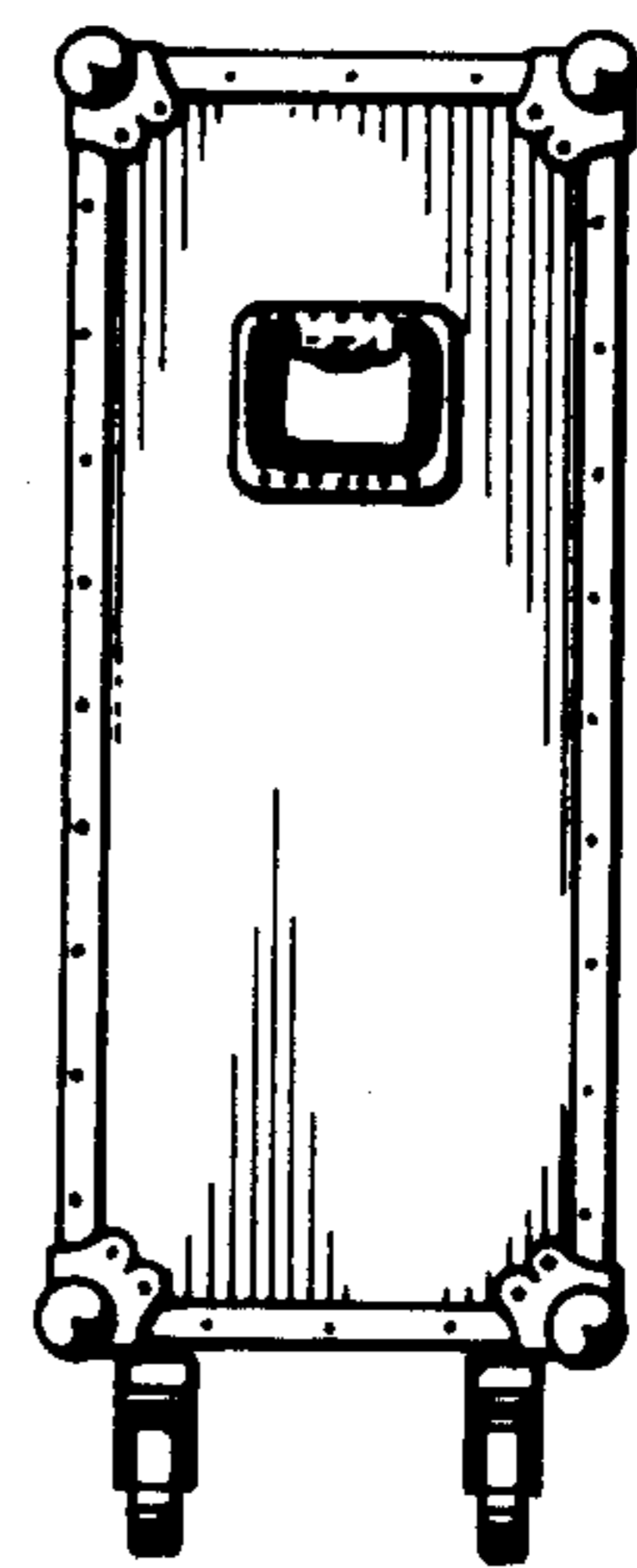
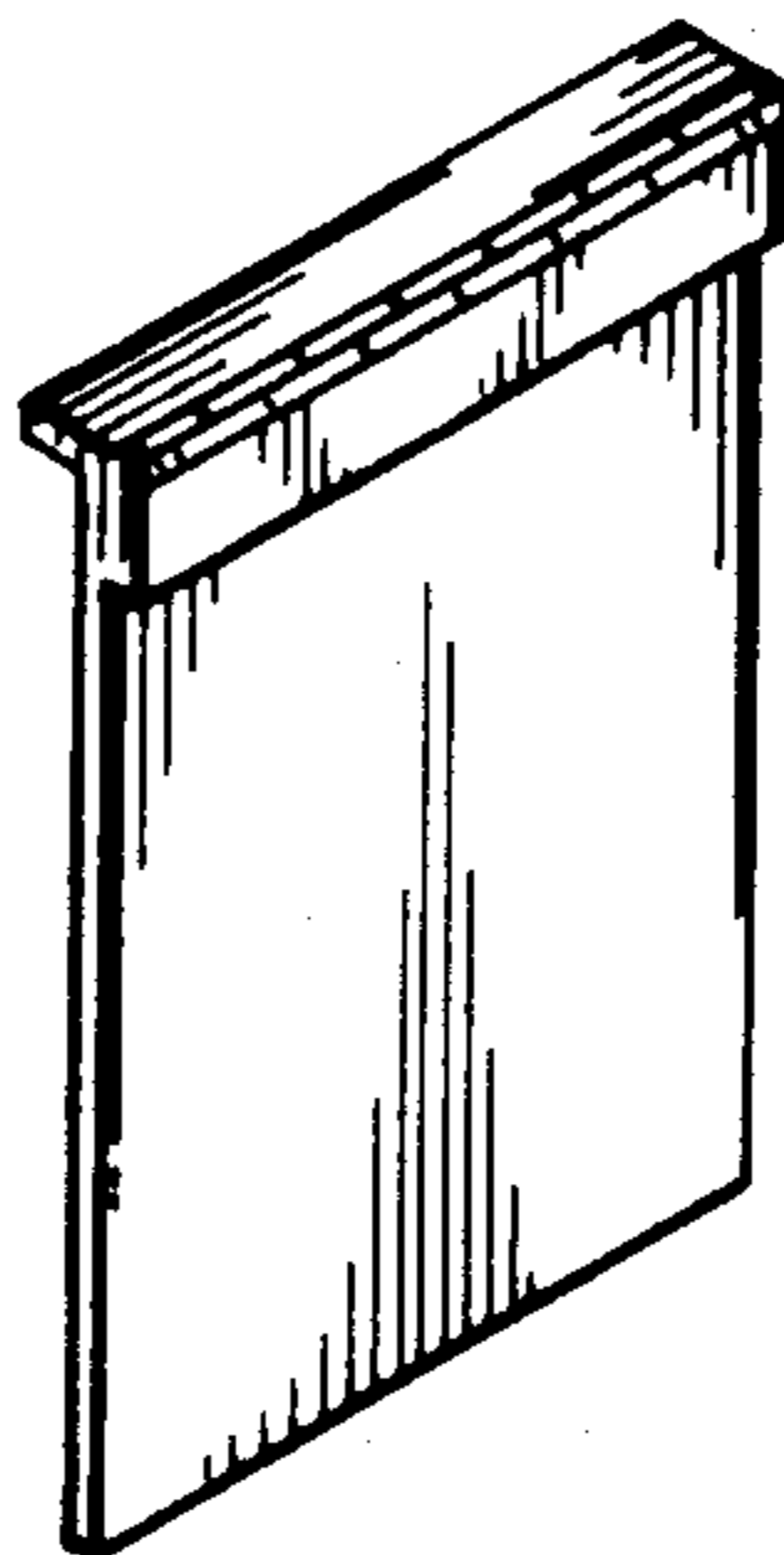
