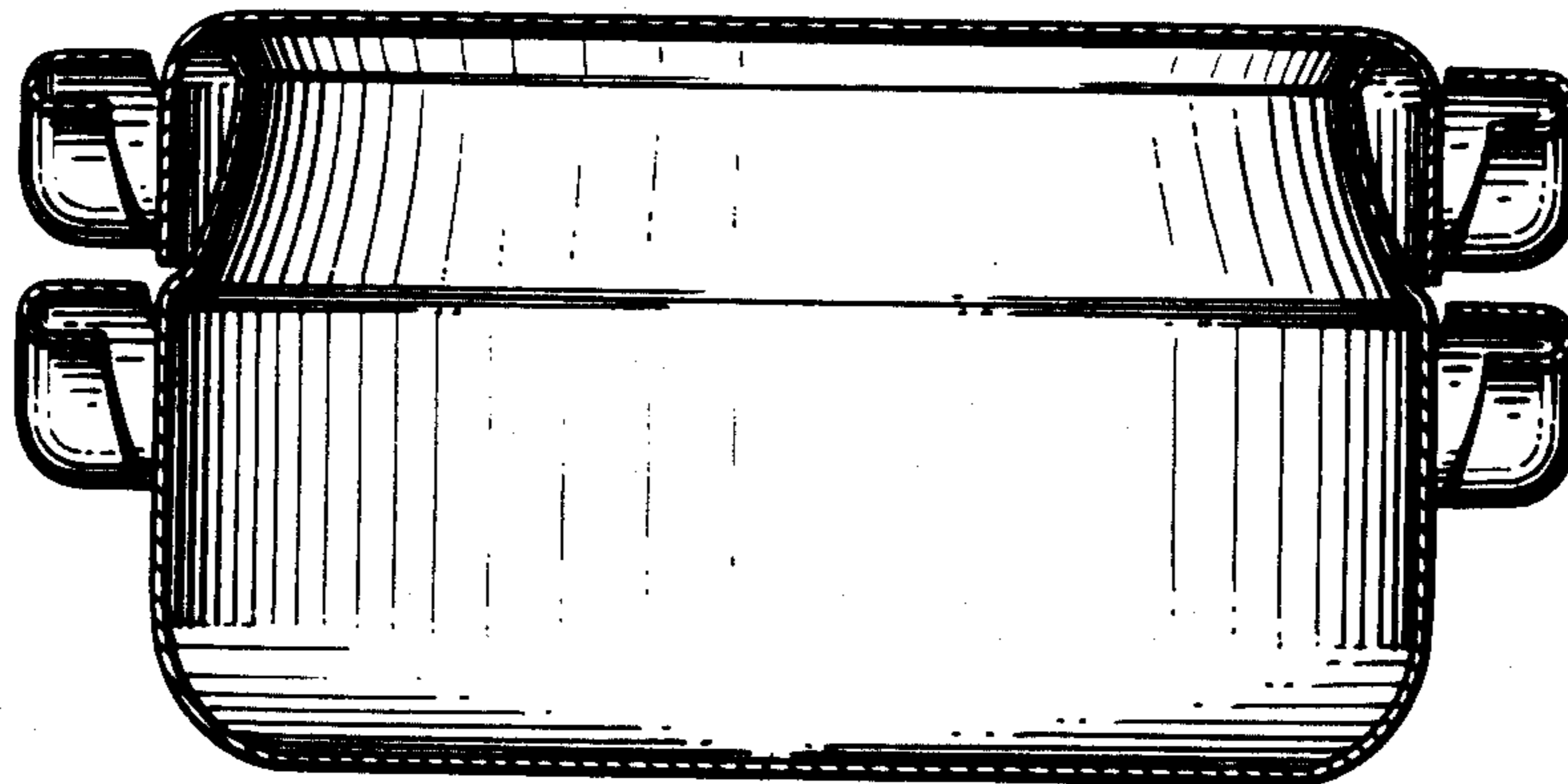
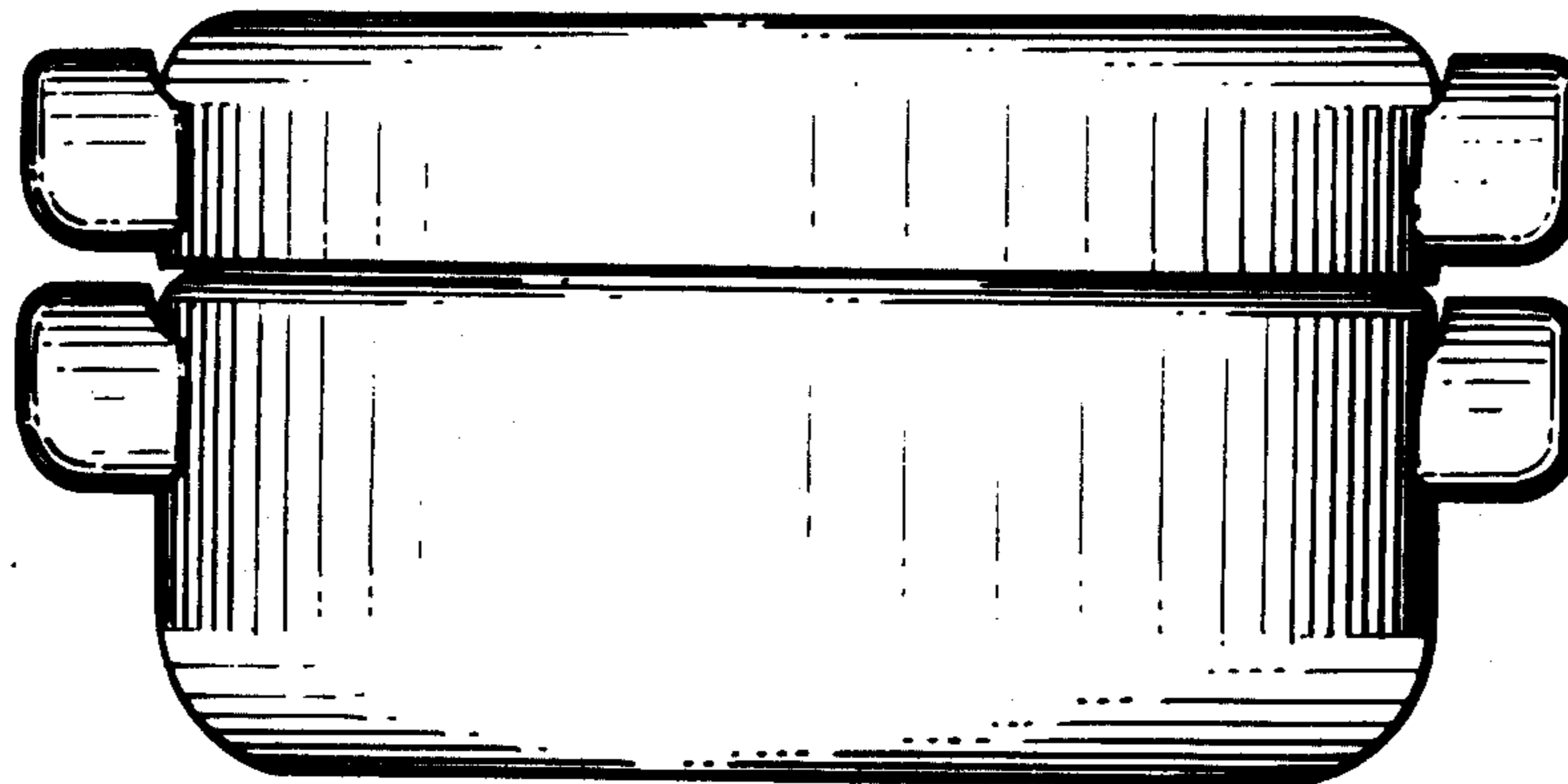

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a covered casserole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a covered casserole showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an end elevation thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom elevation thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a side sectional view thereof, taken along the section line 5—5 of FIG. 1 in the direction of the arrows;
 FIG. 6 is a top view of the cover thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevation of the cover thereof;
 FIG. 8 is an end elevation of the cover thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a bottom elevation of the cover thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a top view of the casserole thereof;
 FIG. 11 is a side elevation of the casserole thereof;
 FIG. 12 is an end elevation of the casserole thereof;
 FIG. 13 is a bottom elevation of the casserole thereof.



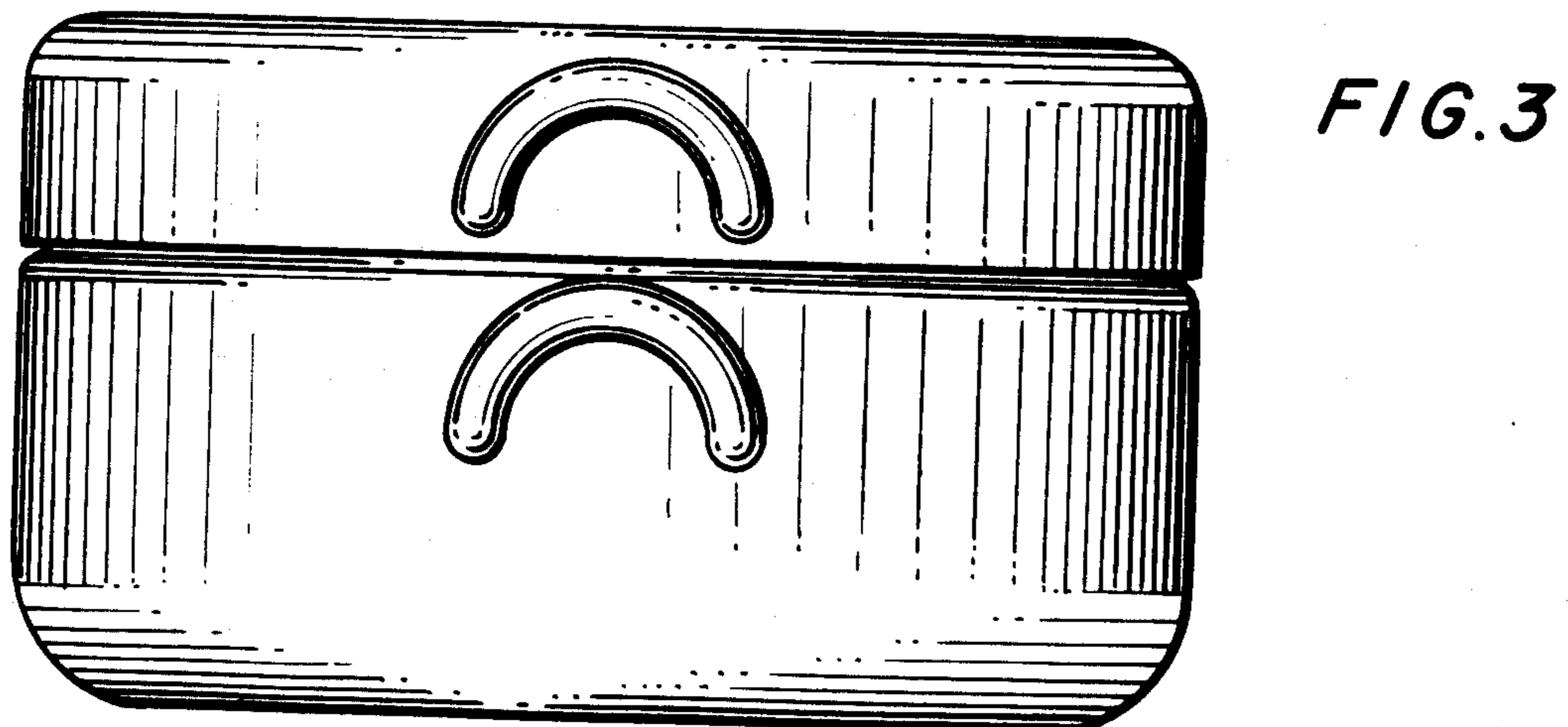
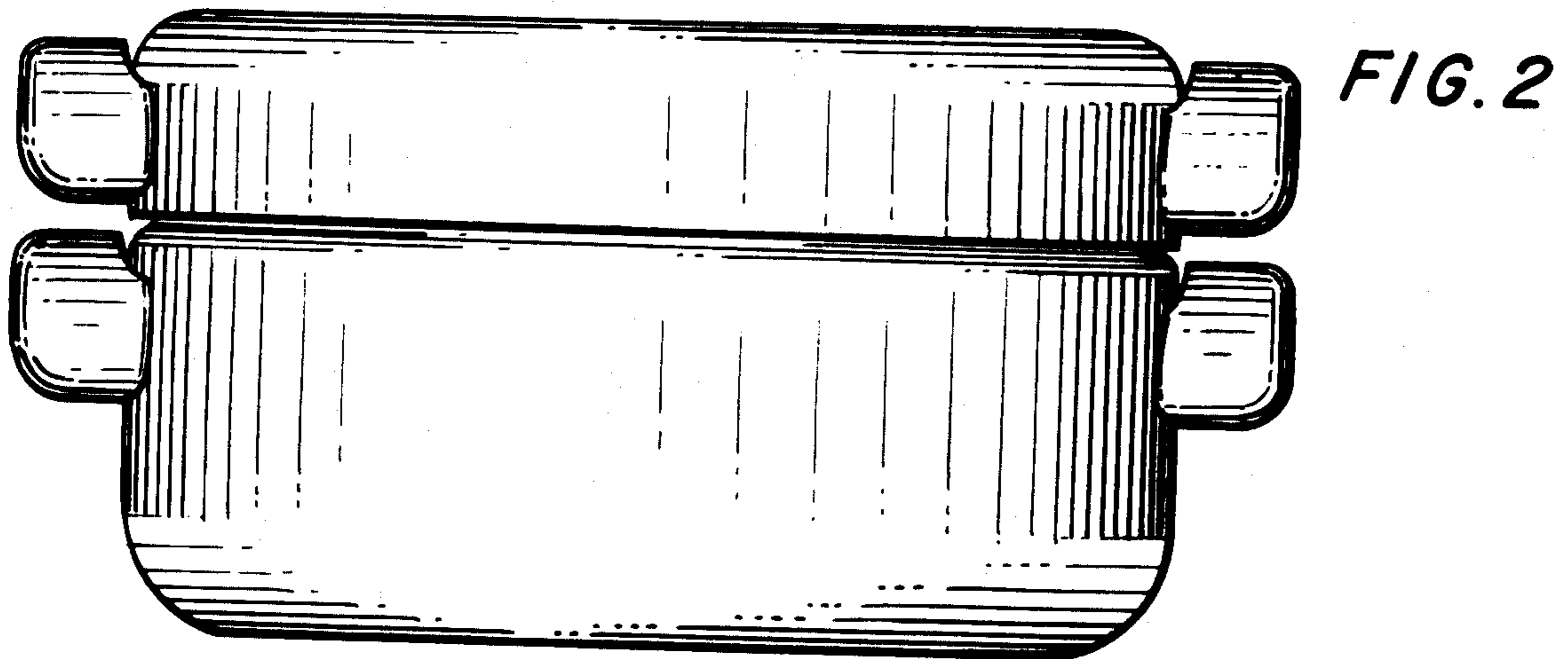
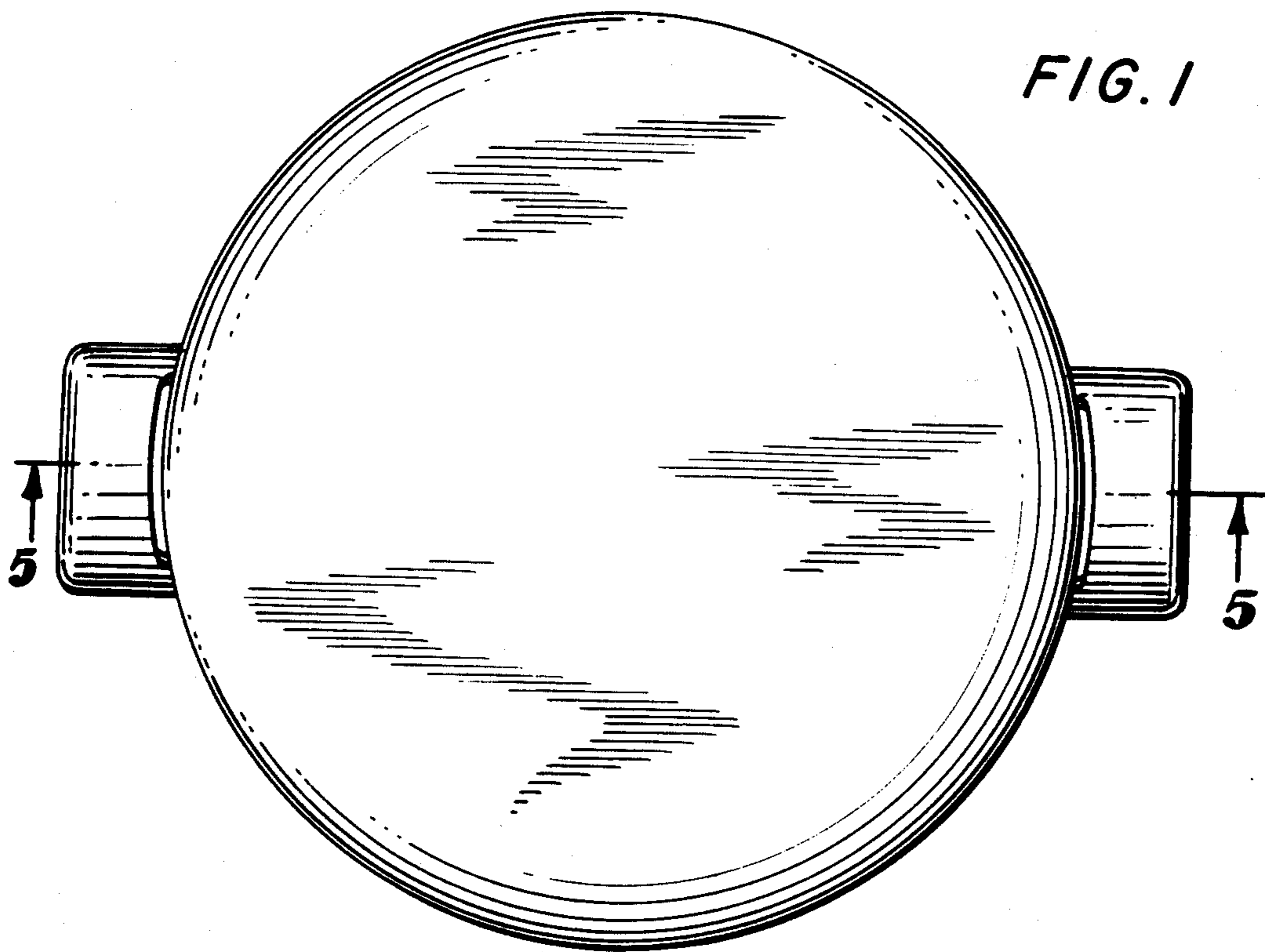

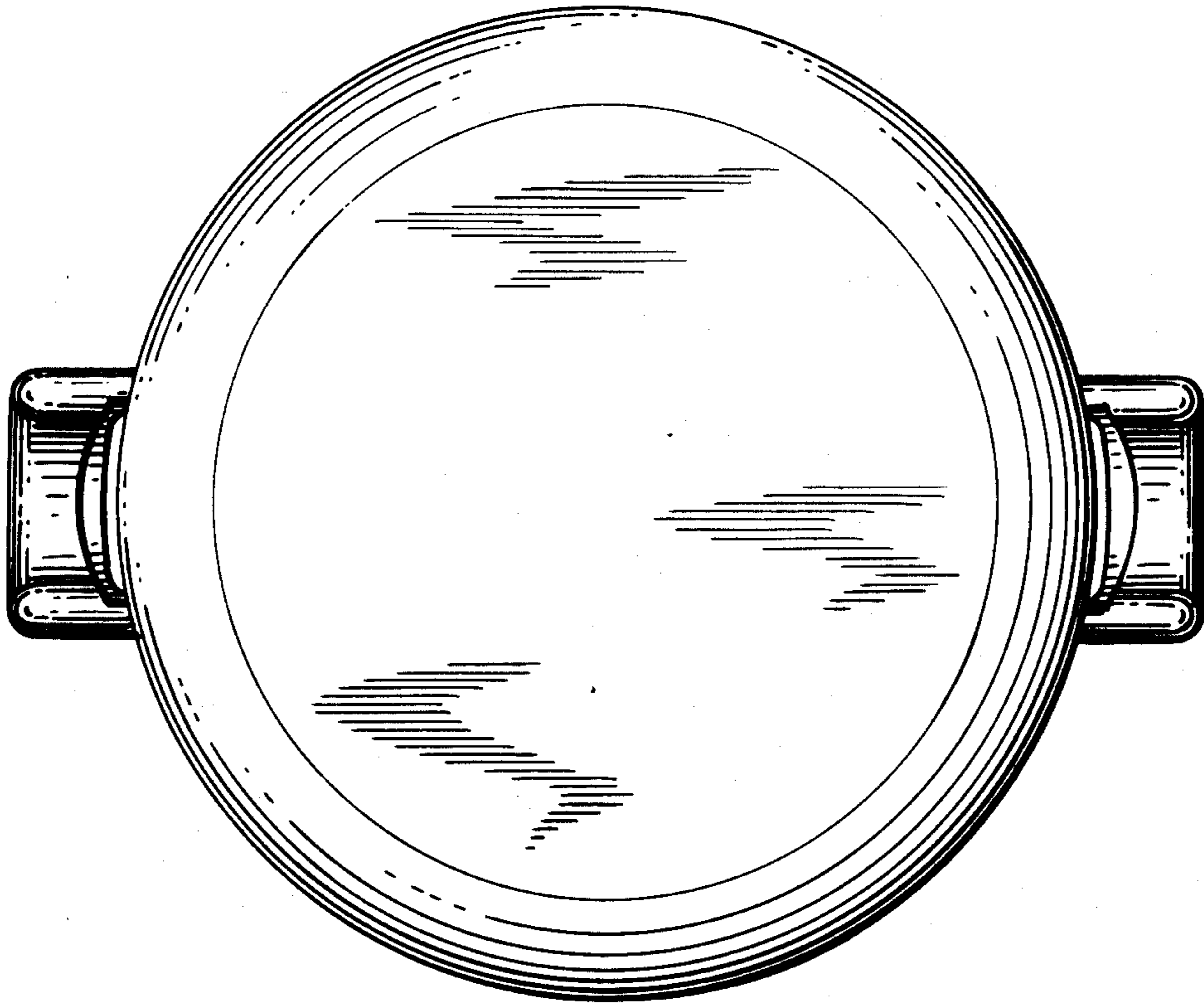

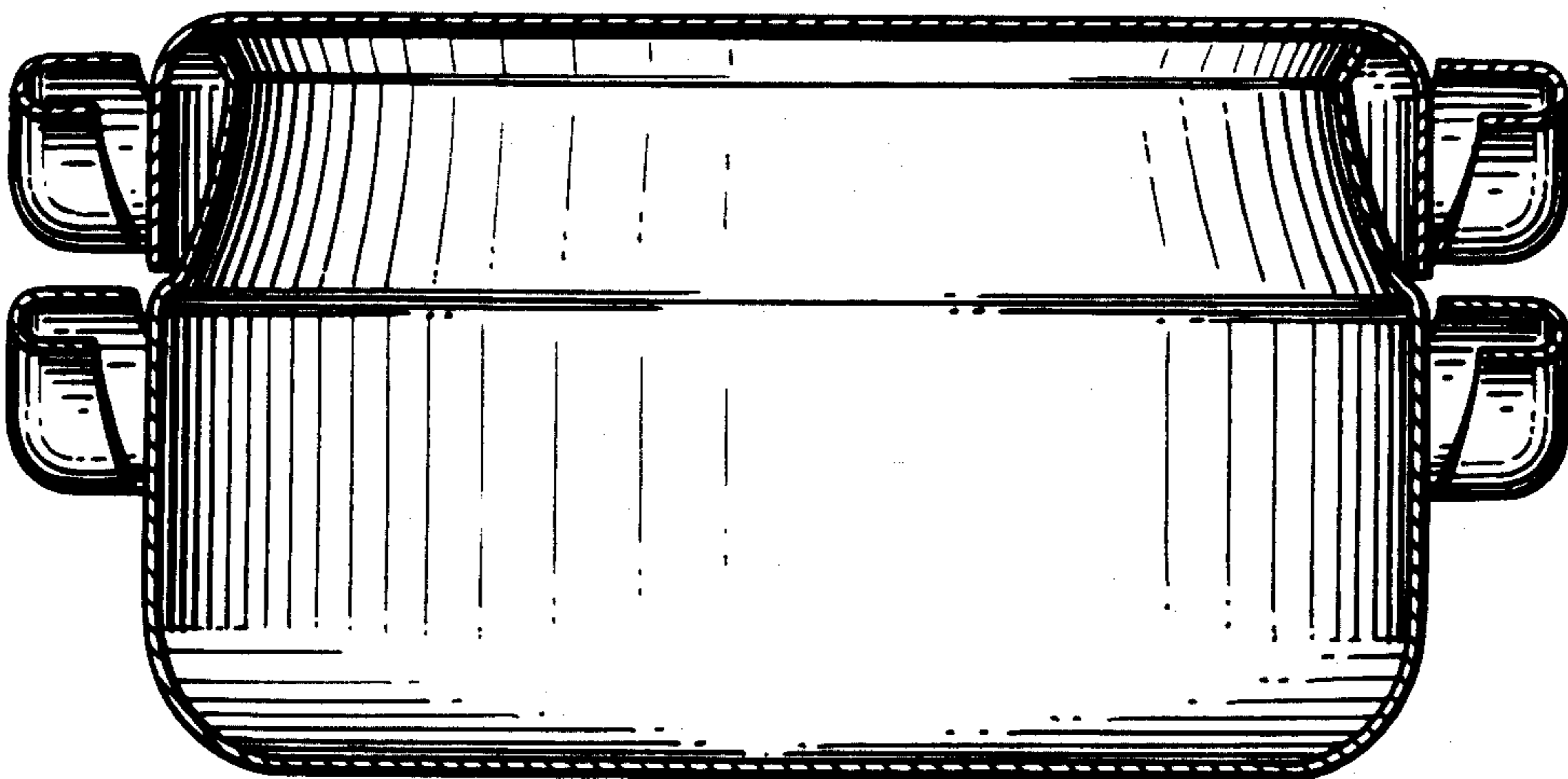

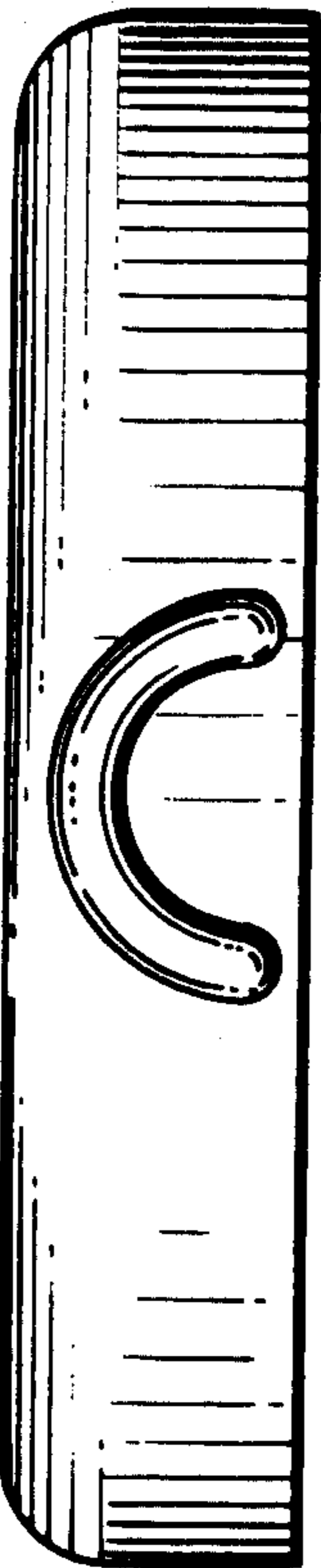

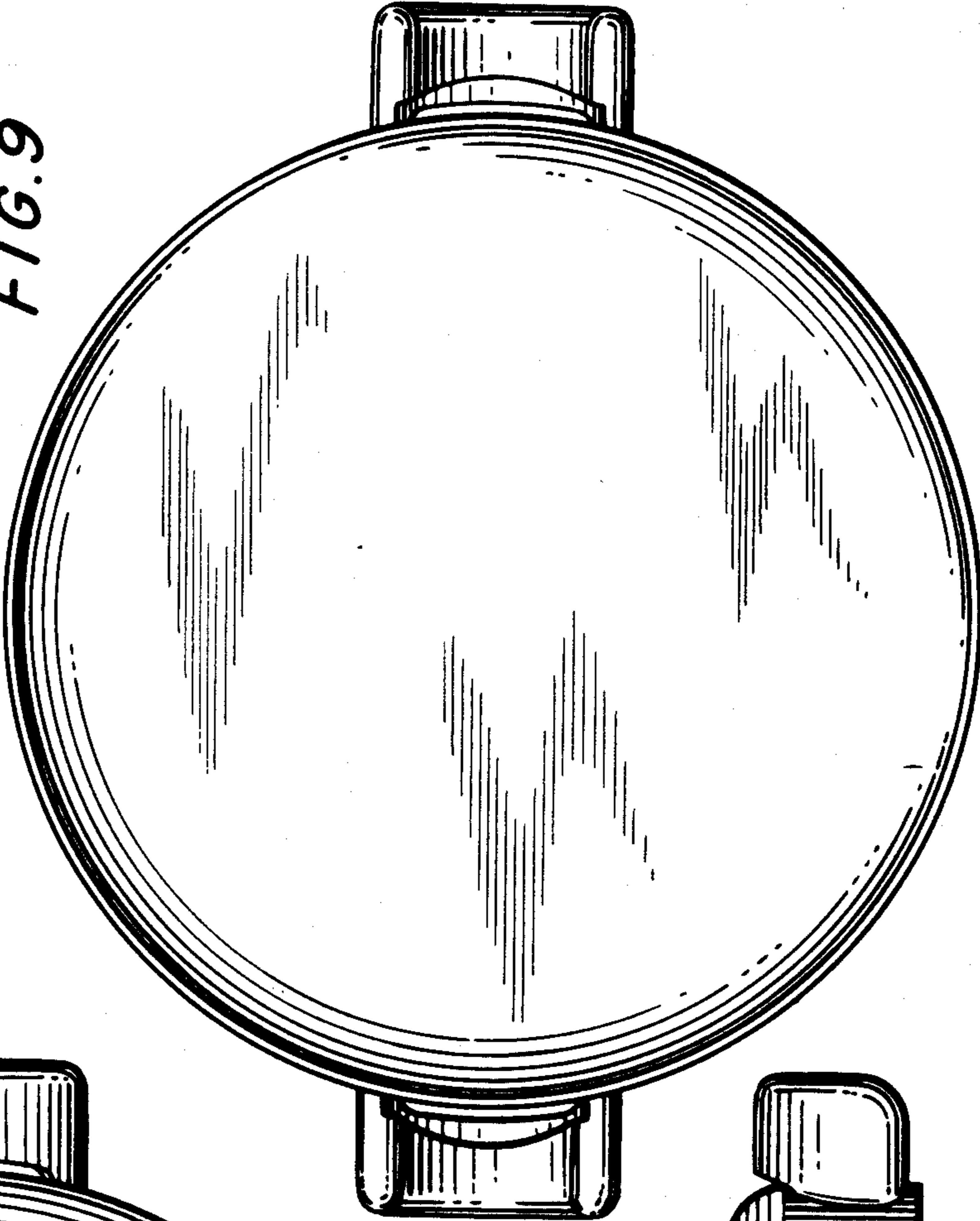

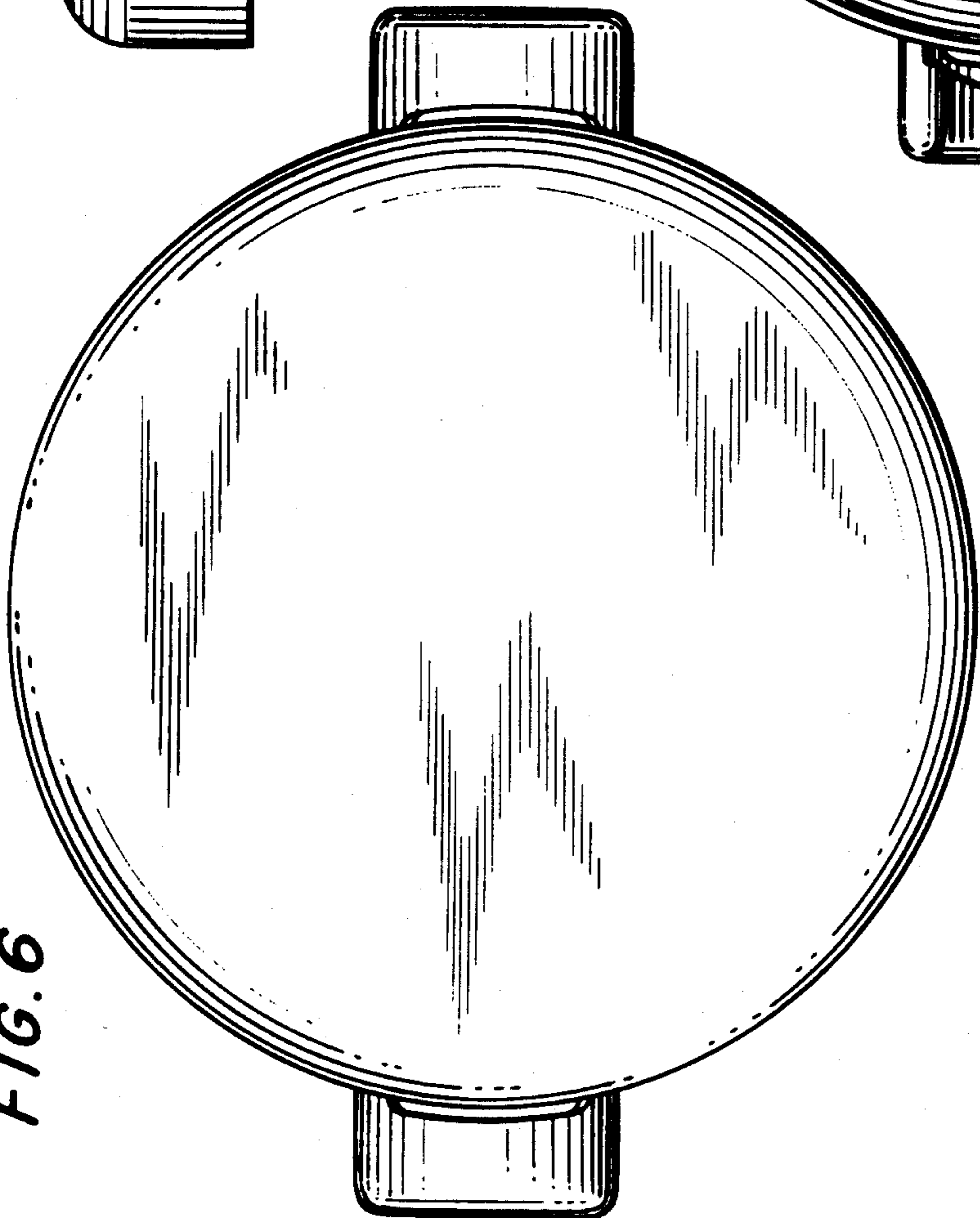
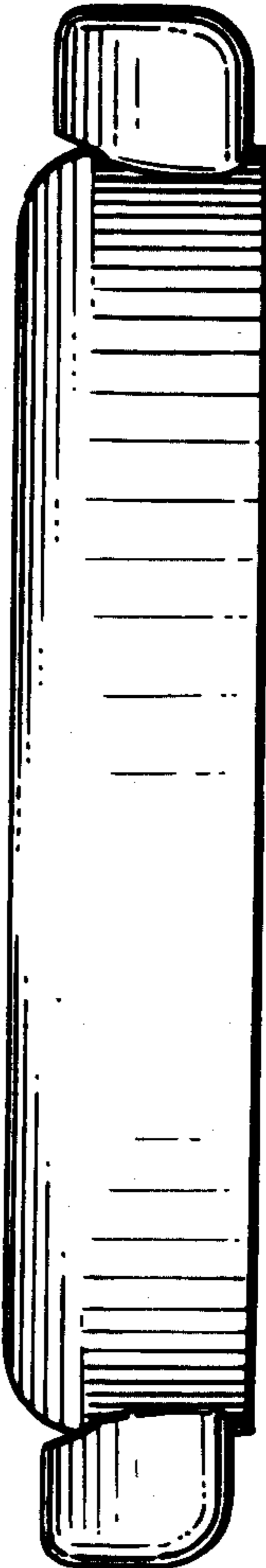

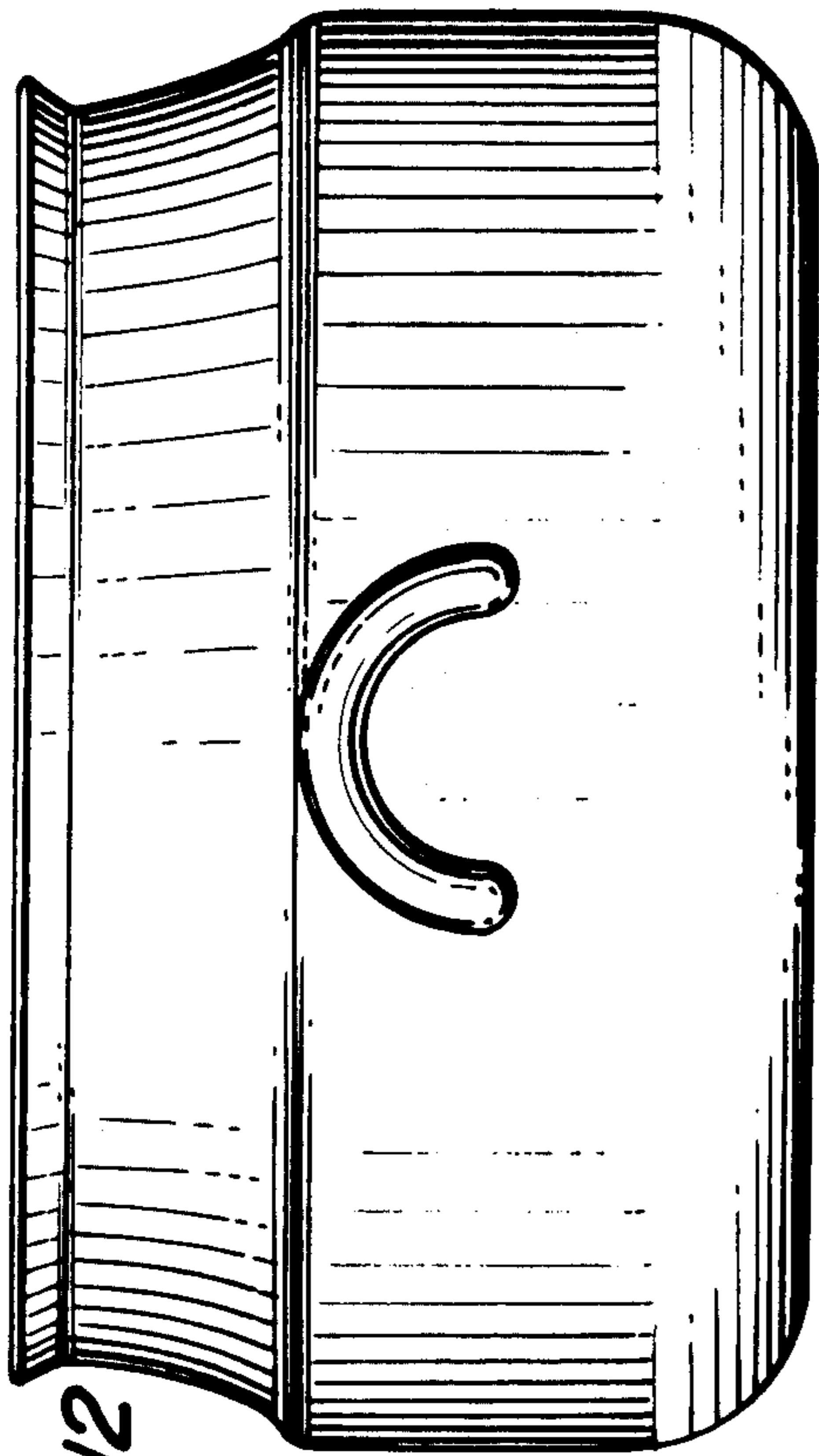

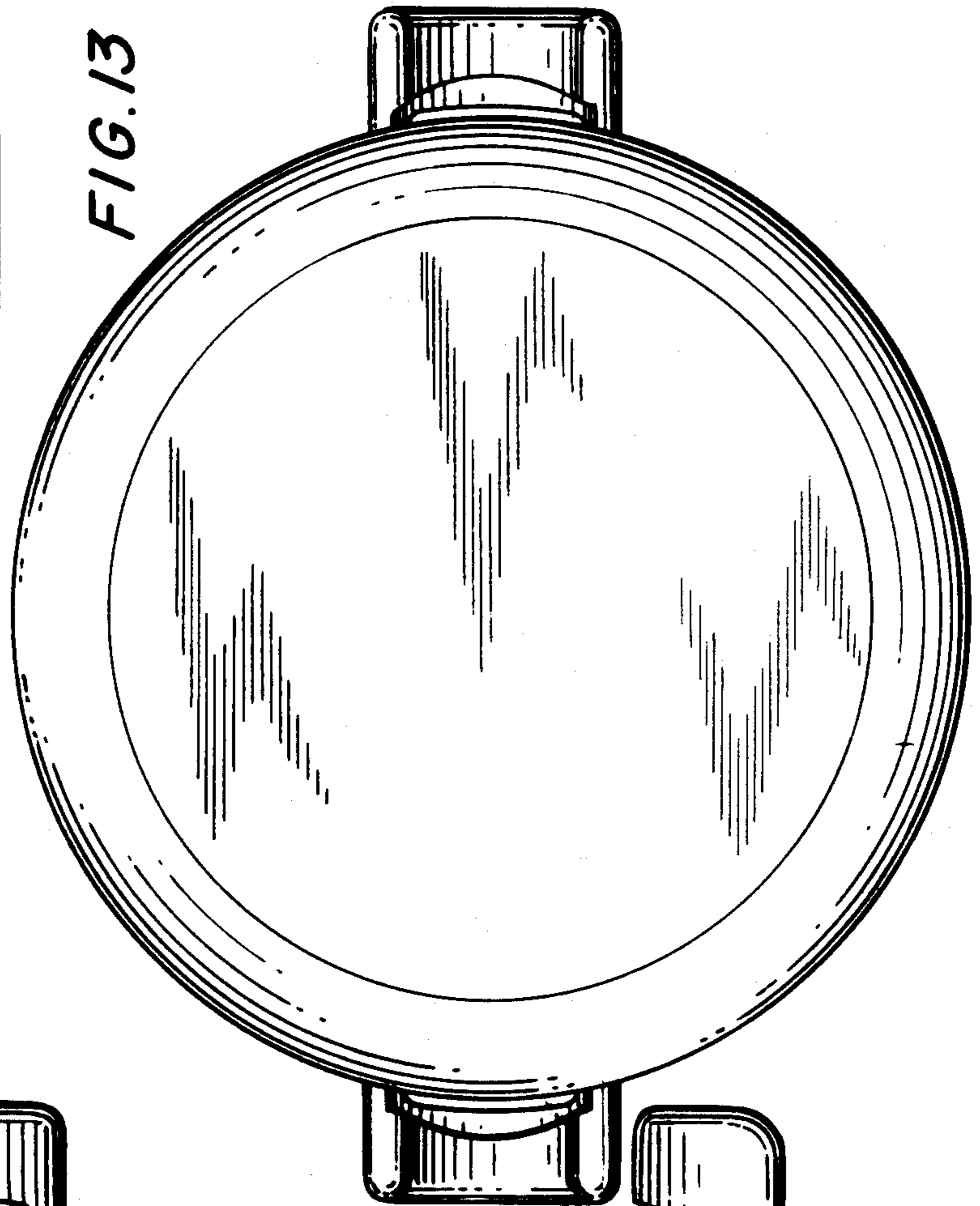

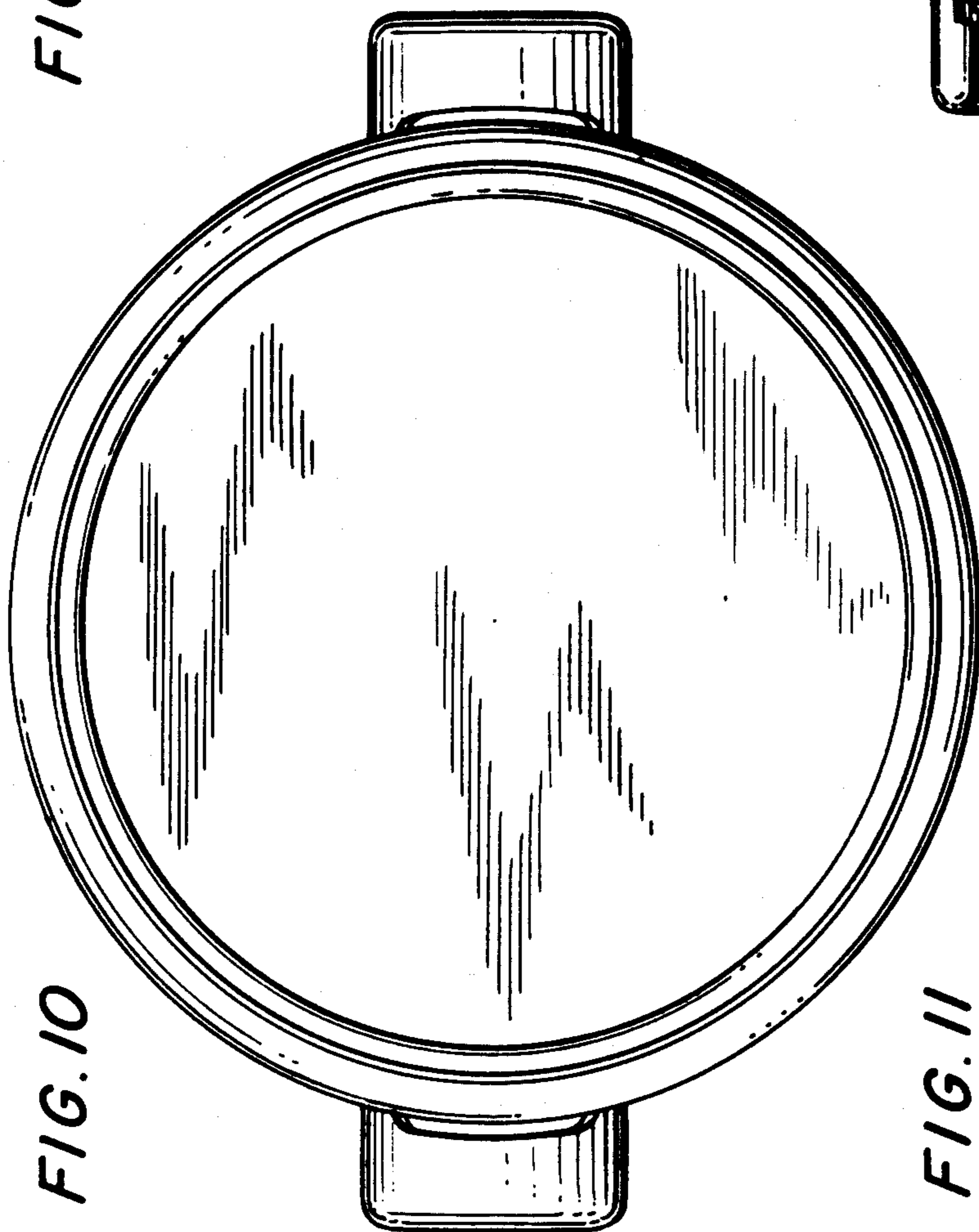

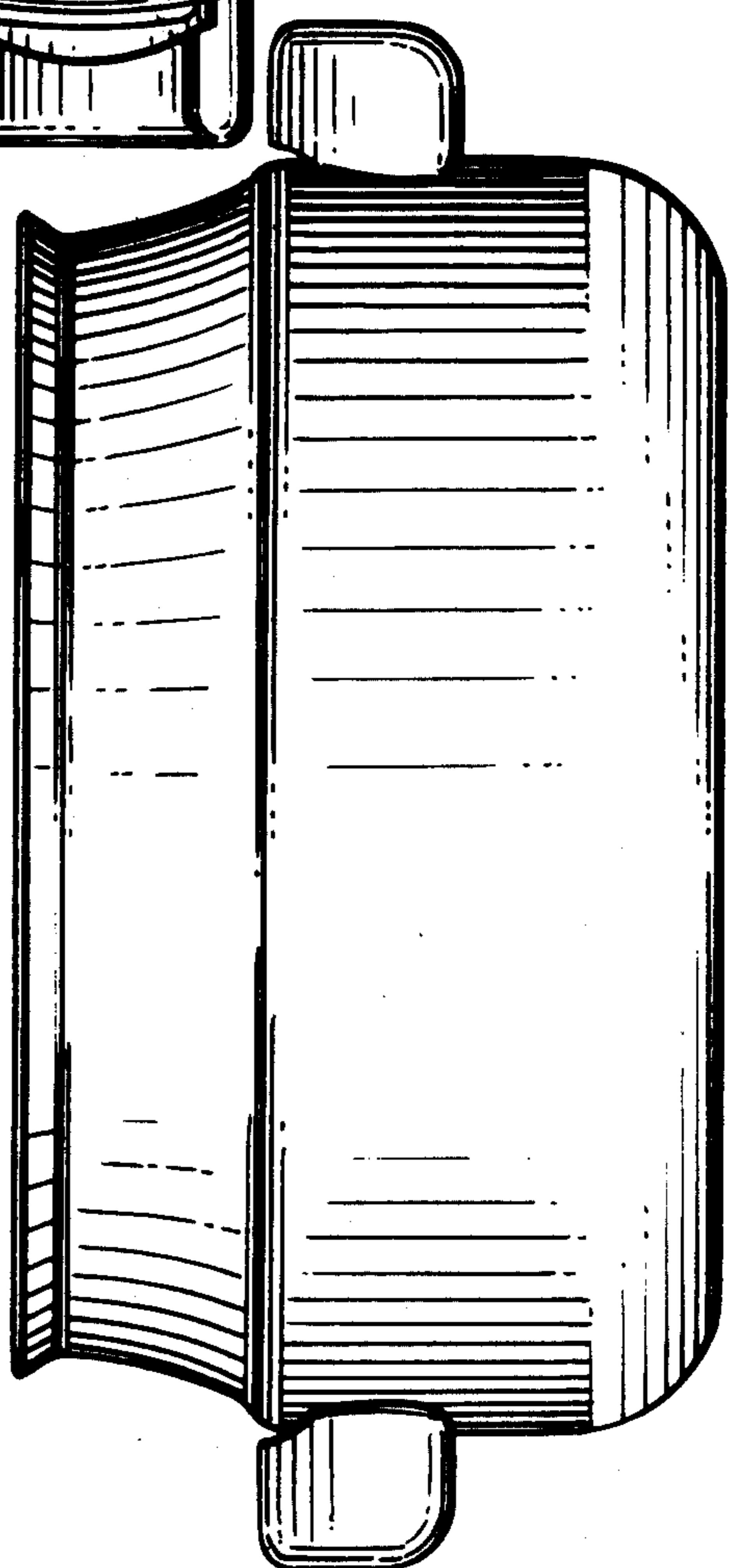
