DESCRIPTION

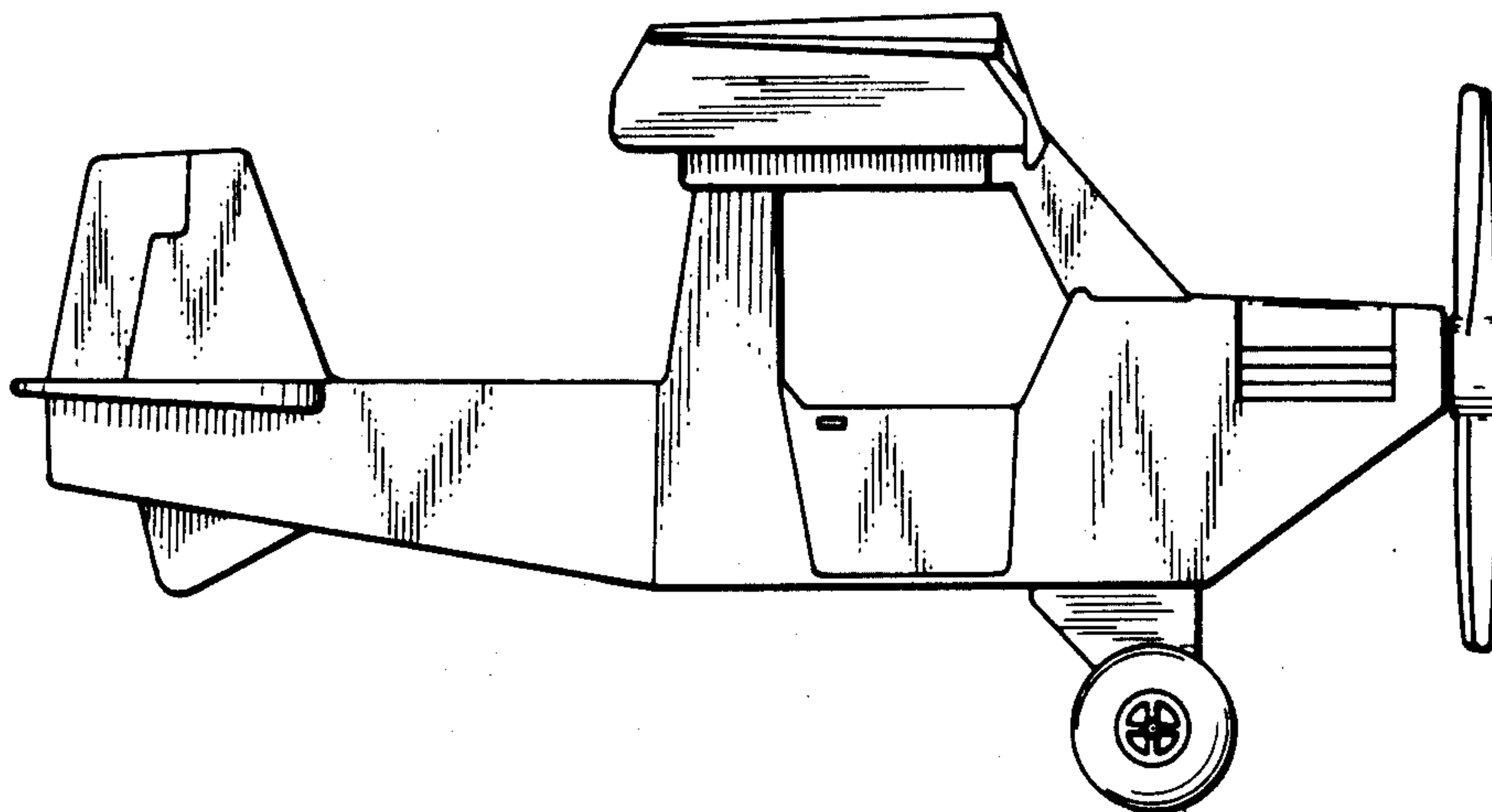
FIG. 1 is a right-side elevational view of a toy airplane showing my new design the left-side being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



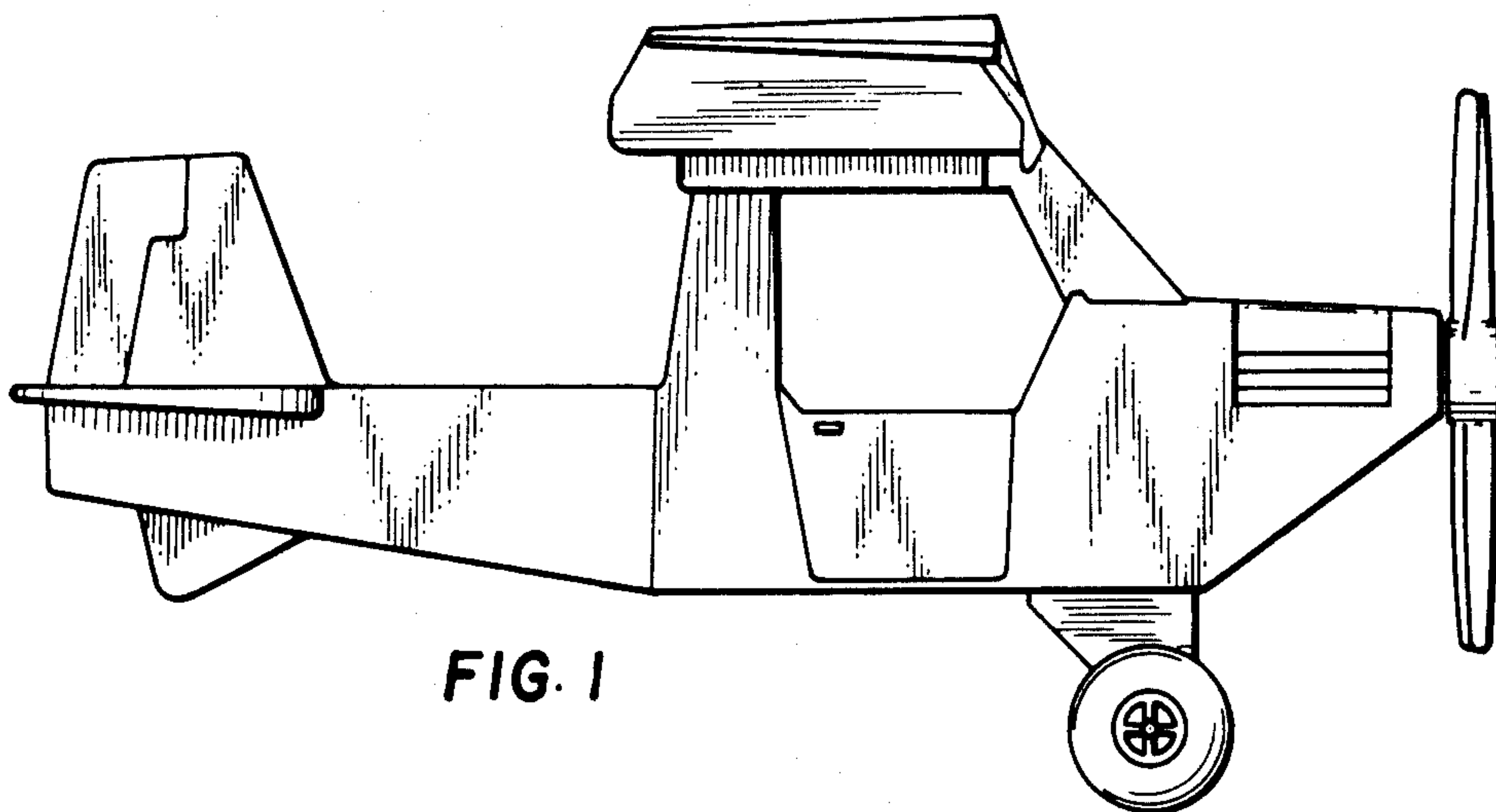

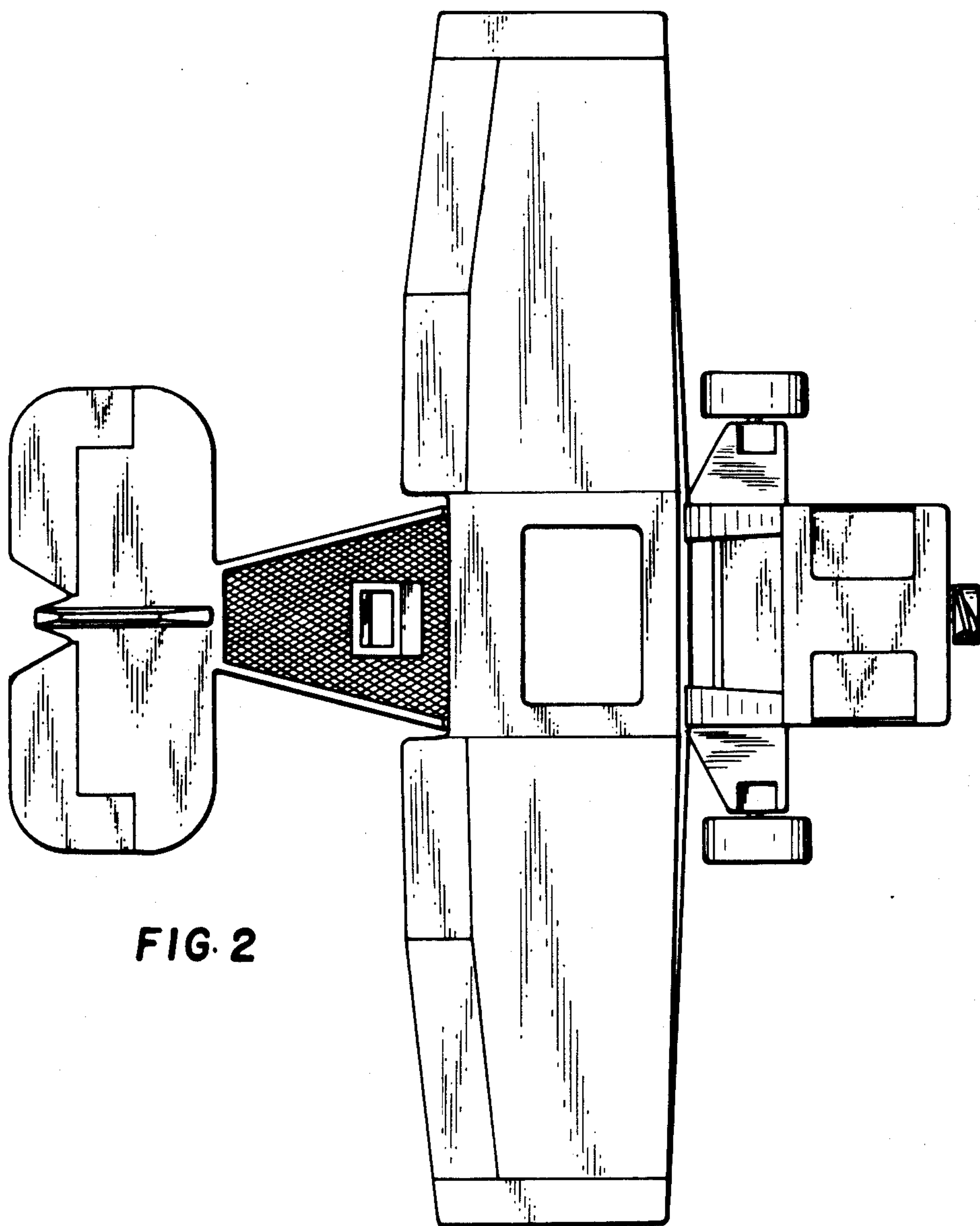

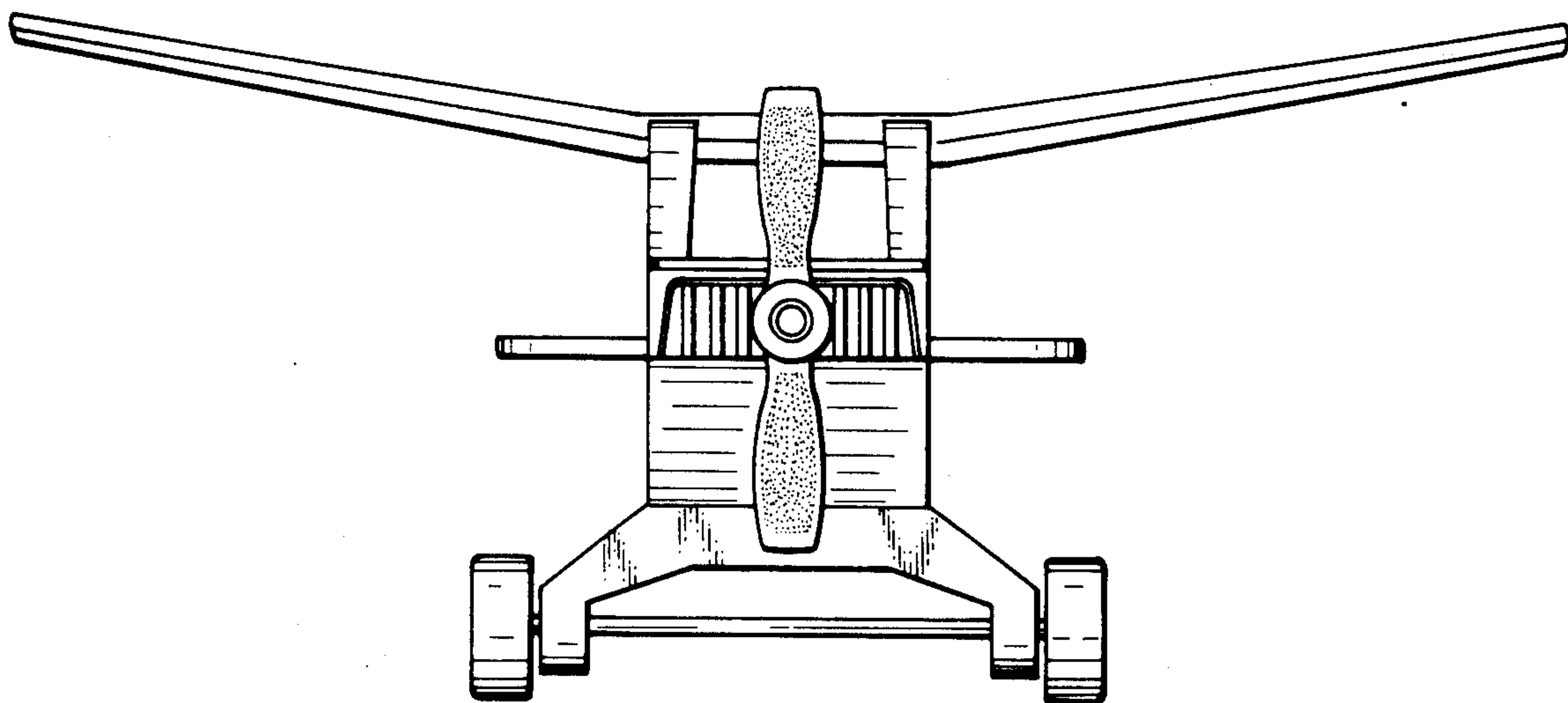

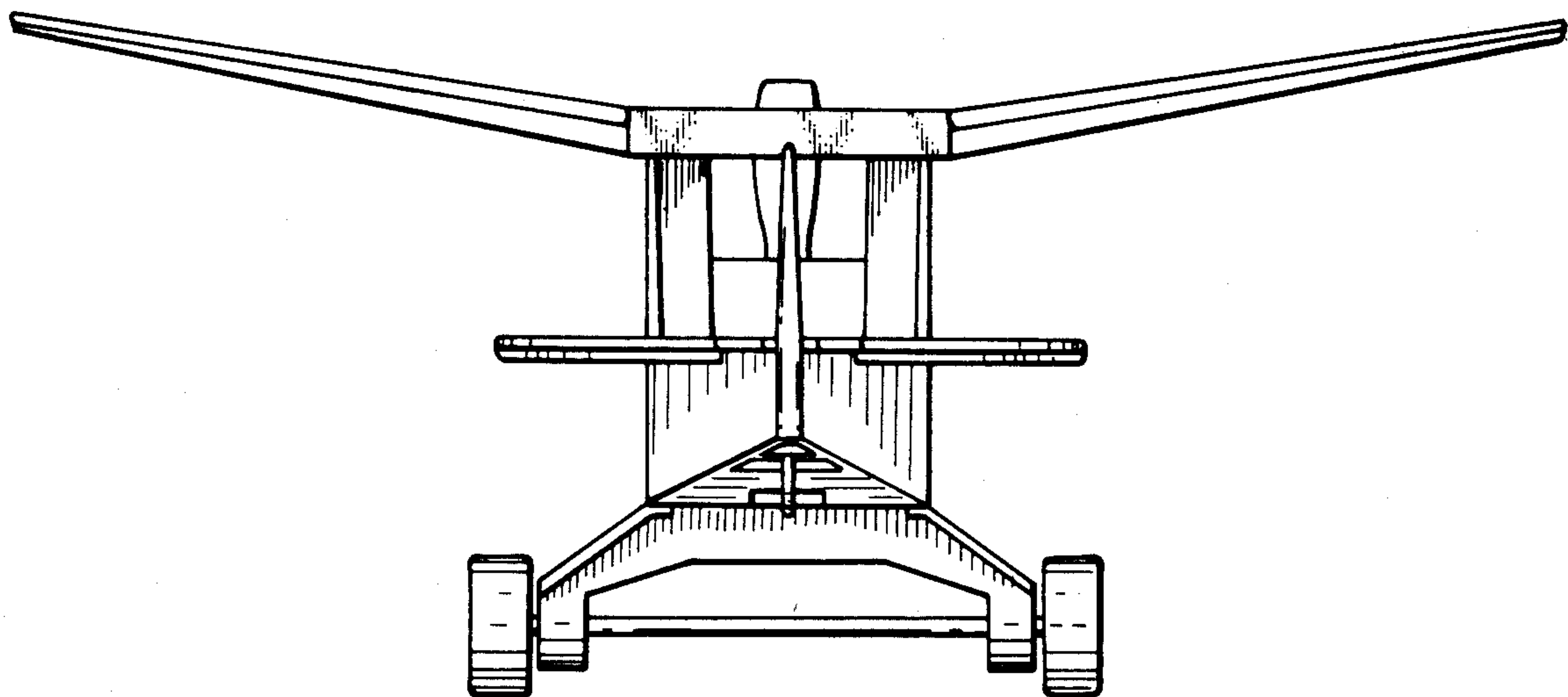

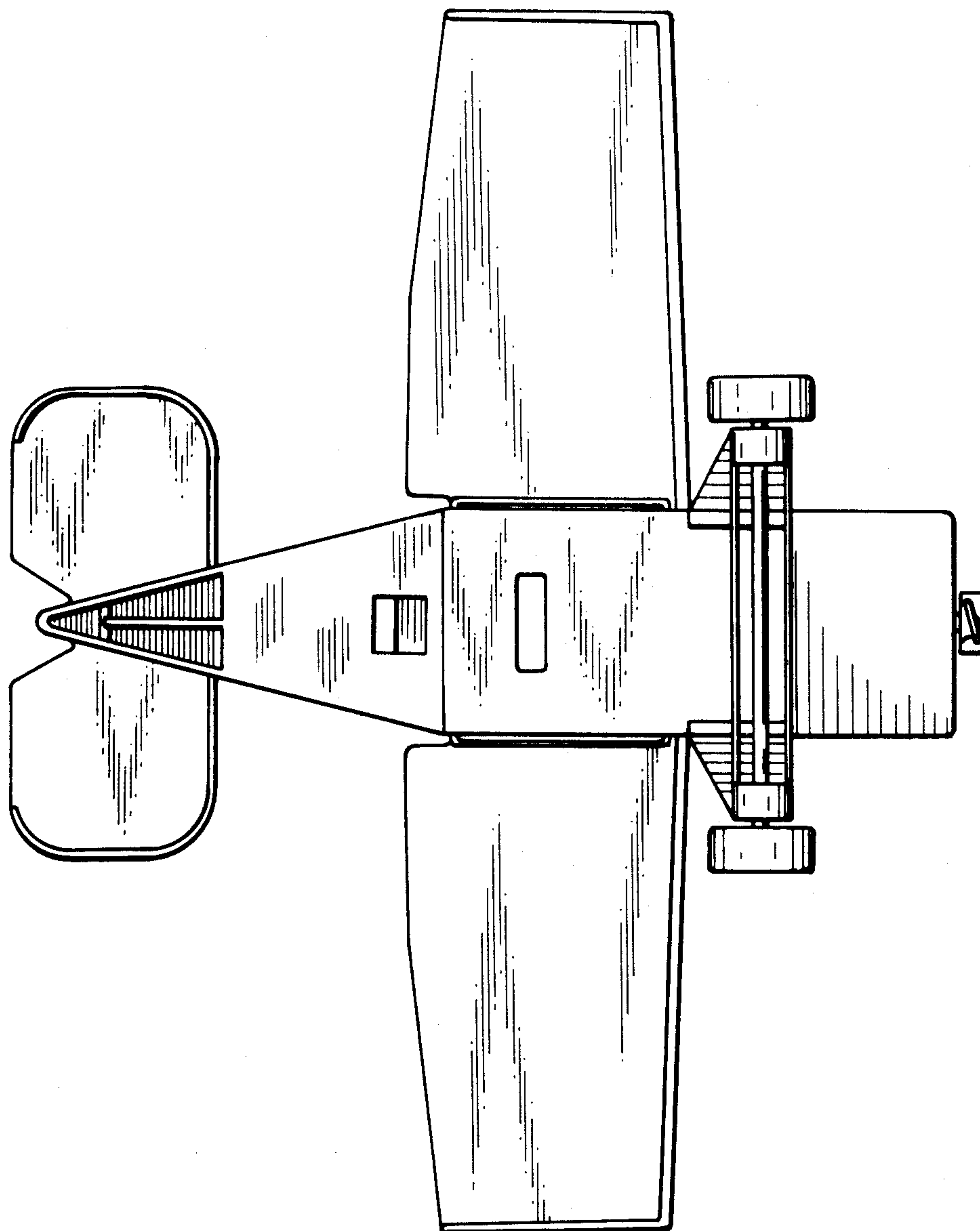
