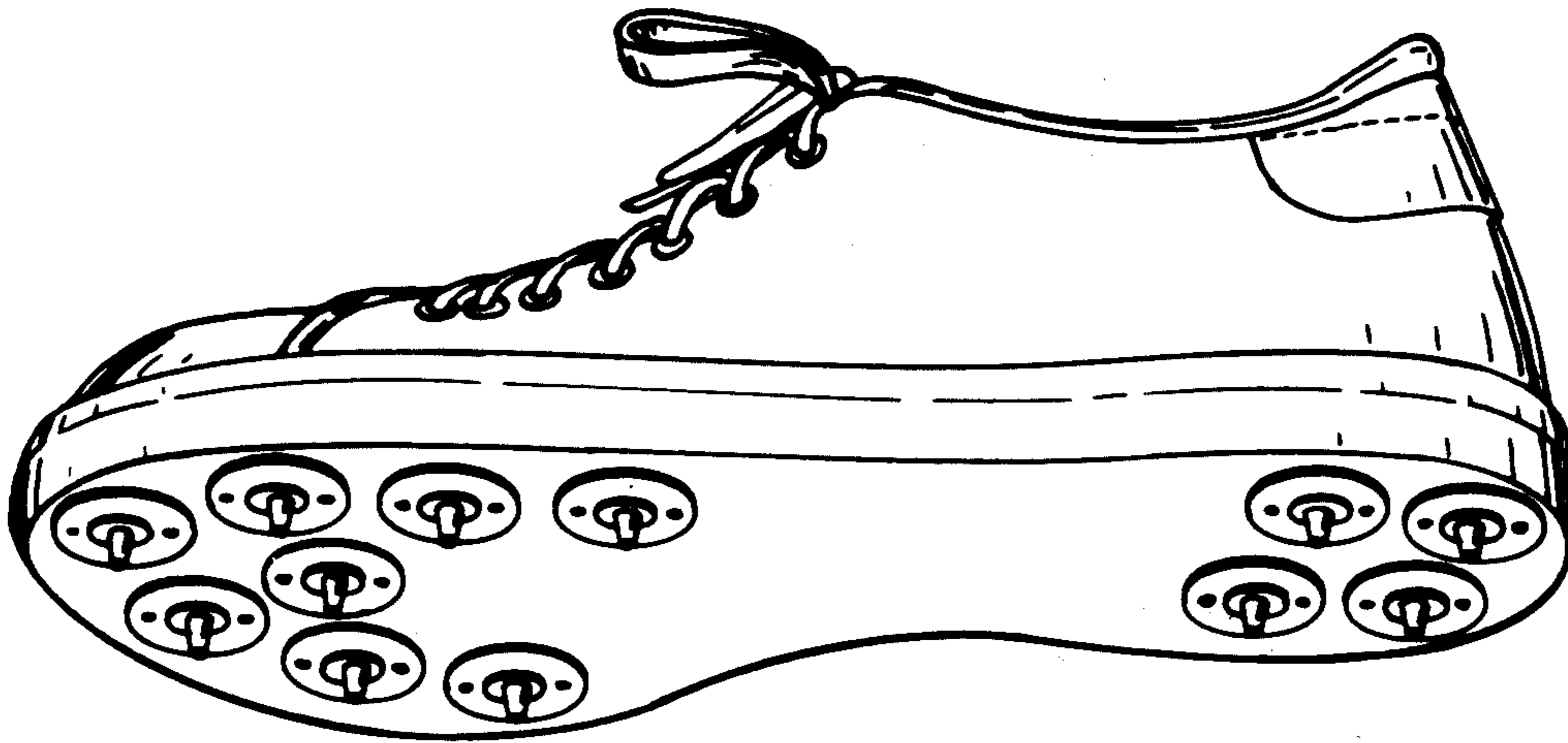

The ornamental design for a golf shoe, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom right side perspective view of a golf shoe showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



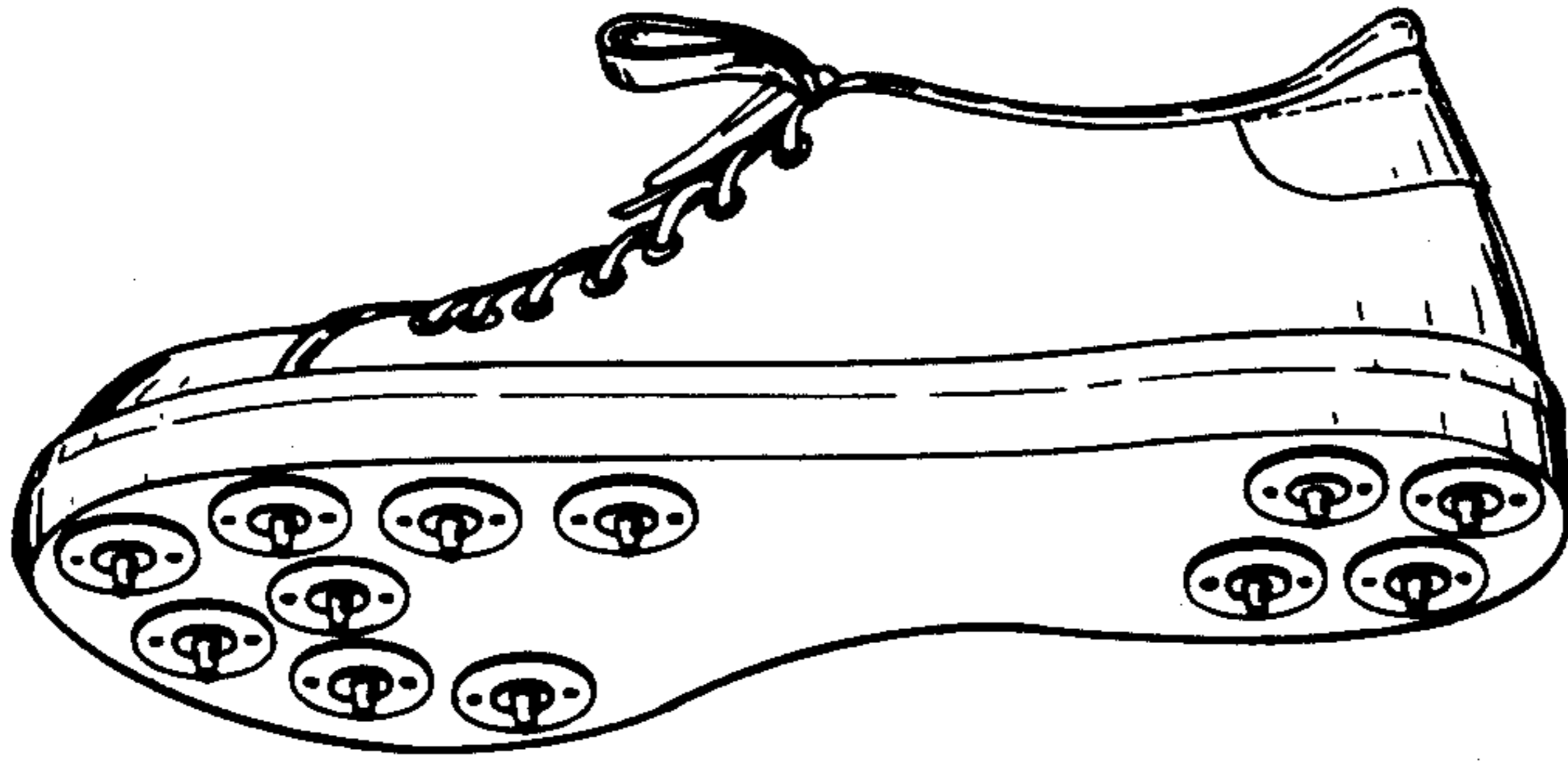

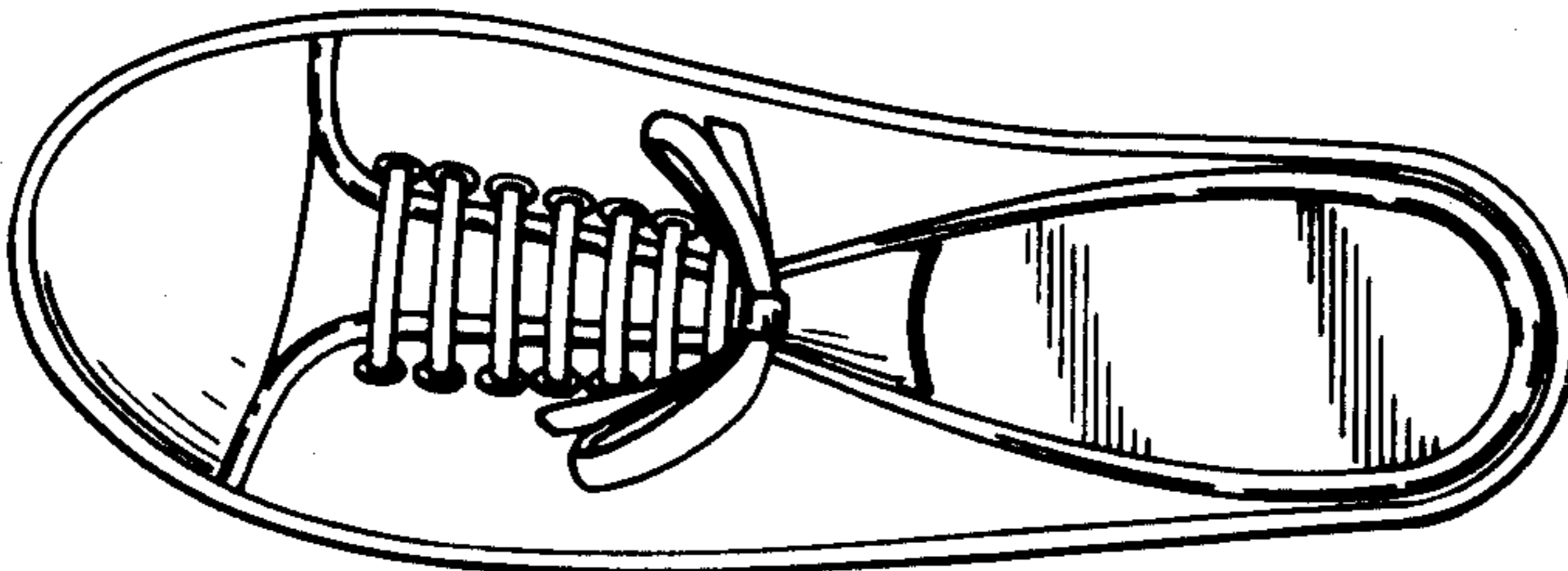

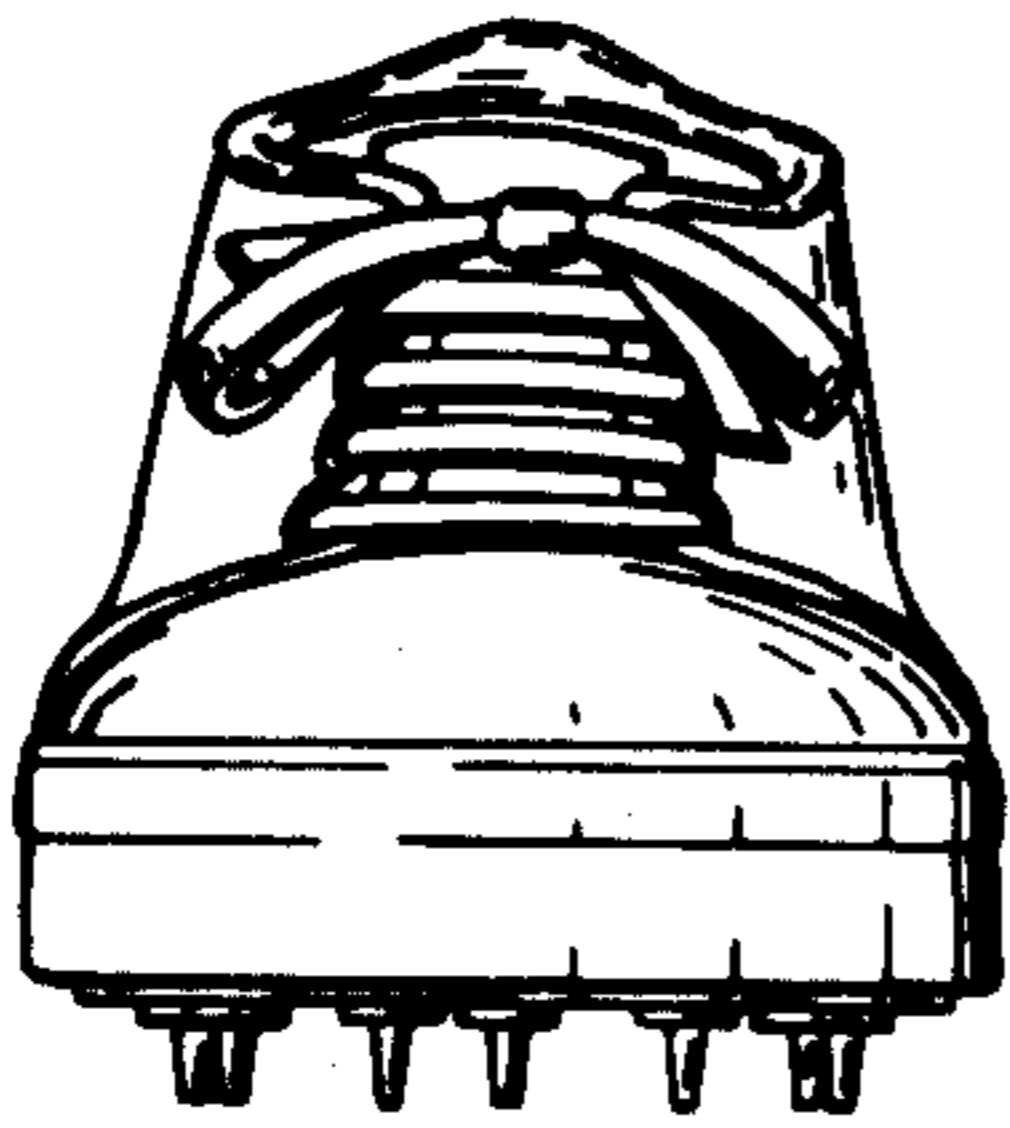

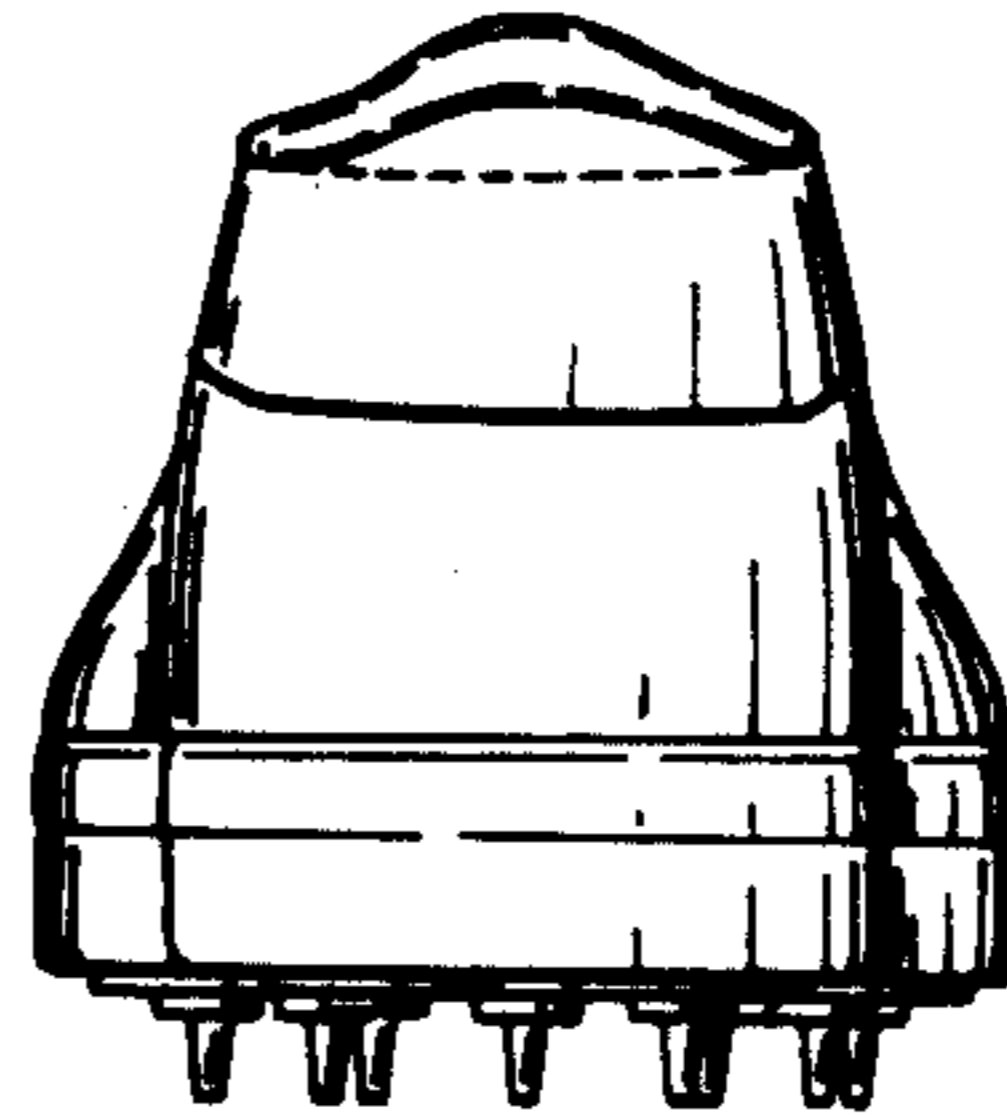

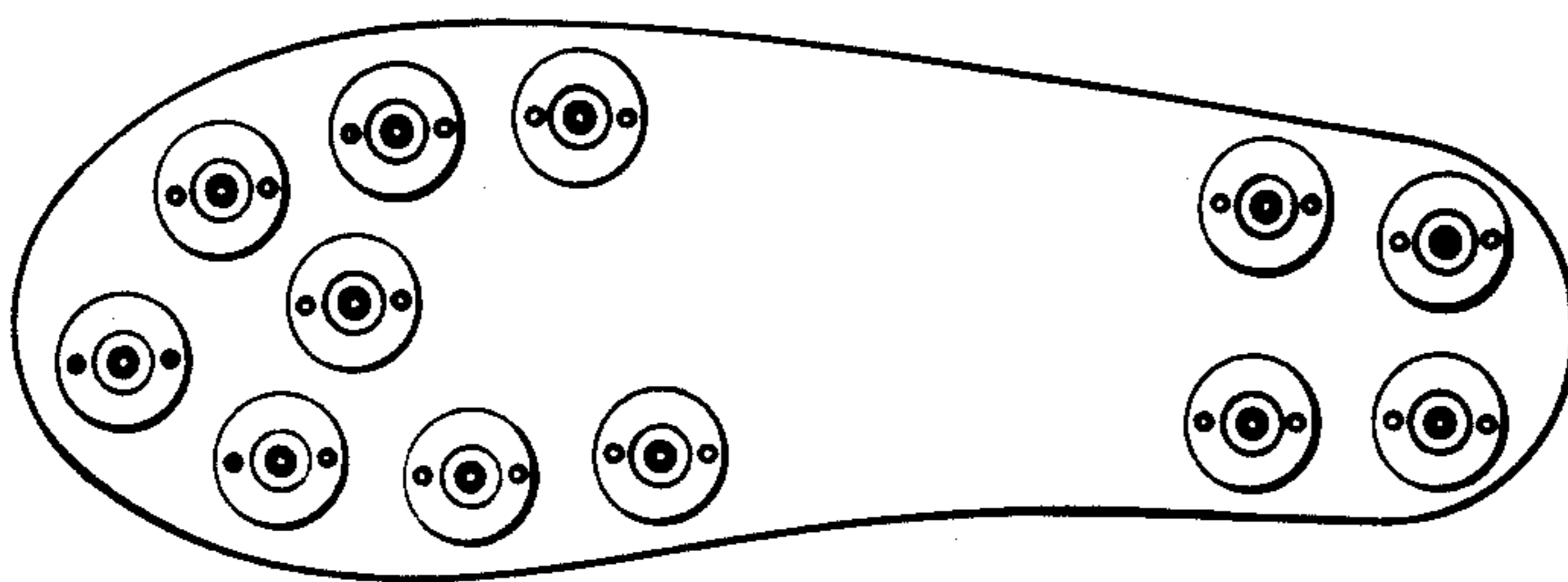
