## [57] CLAIM

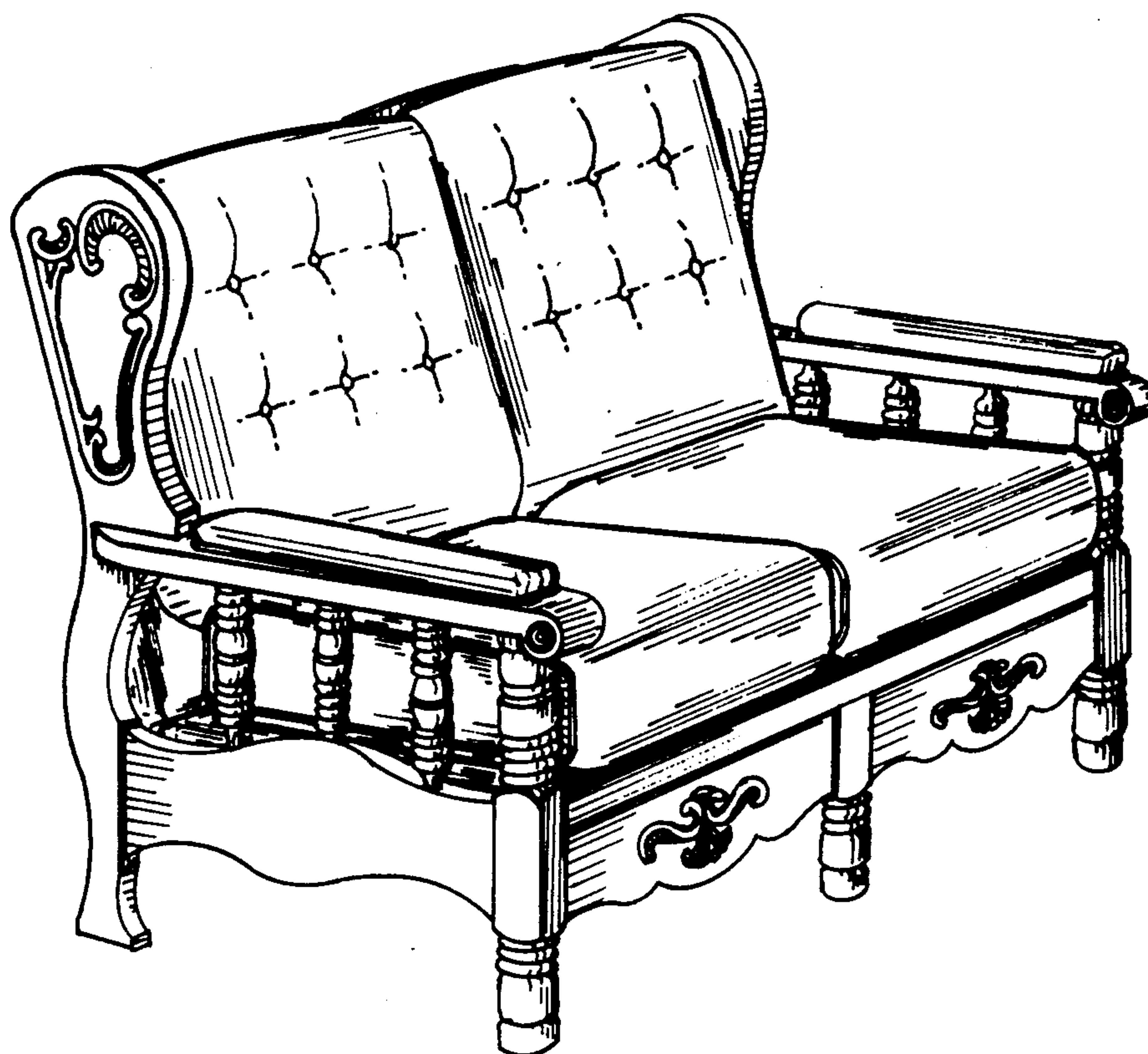
The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

The sides not shown are mirror images of the sides shown while the back of the seat is conventional in appearance.



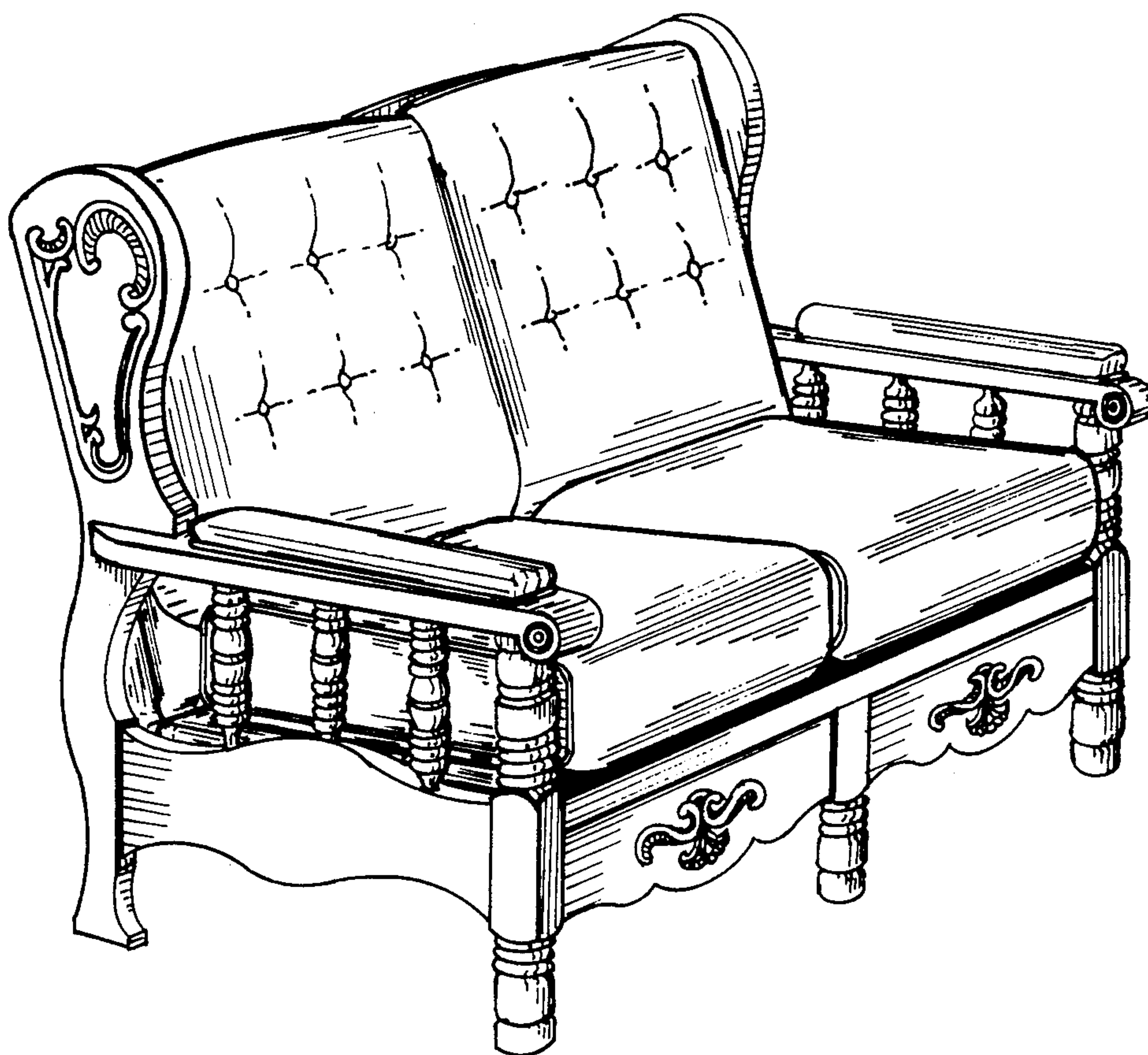

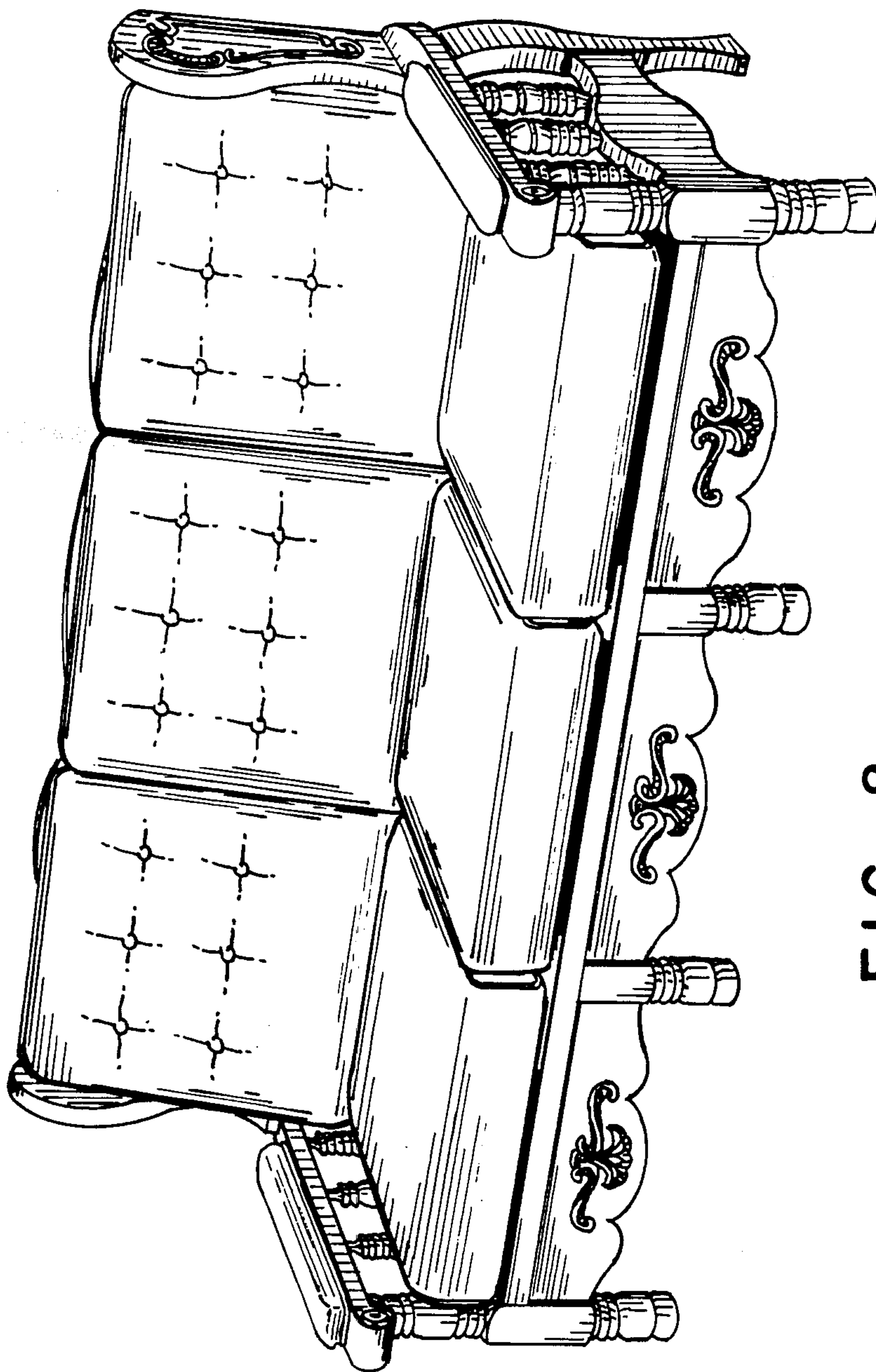
