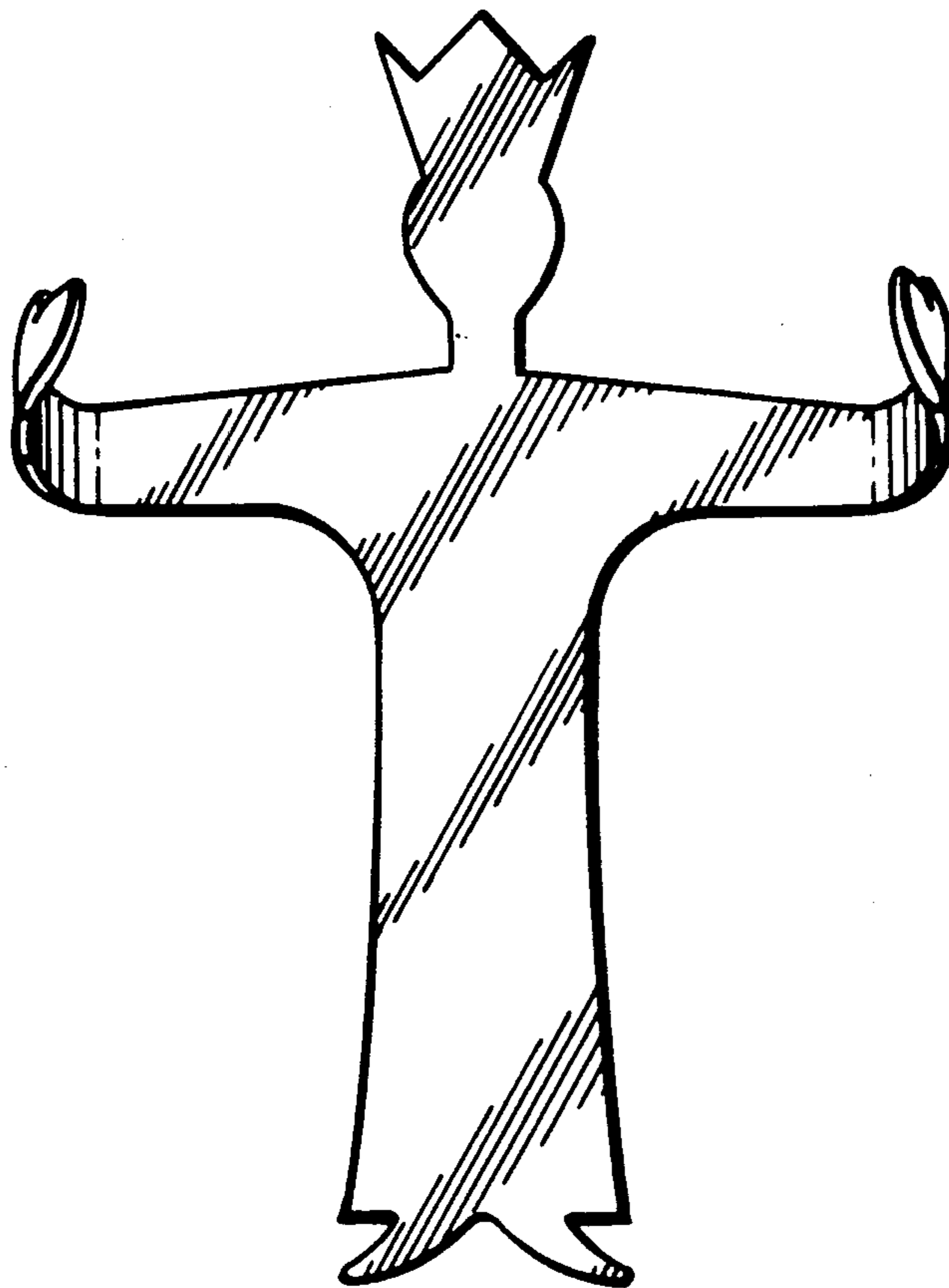

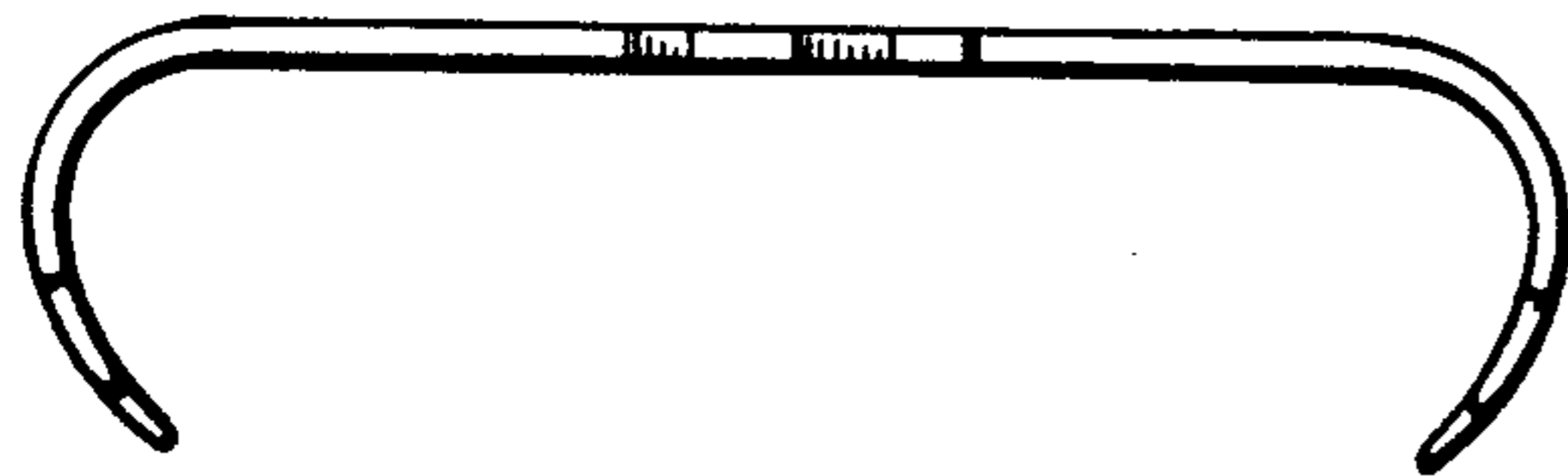
The ornamental design for religious figure, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

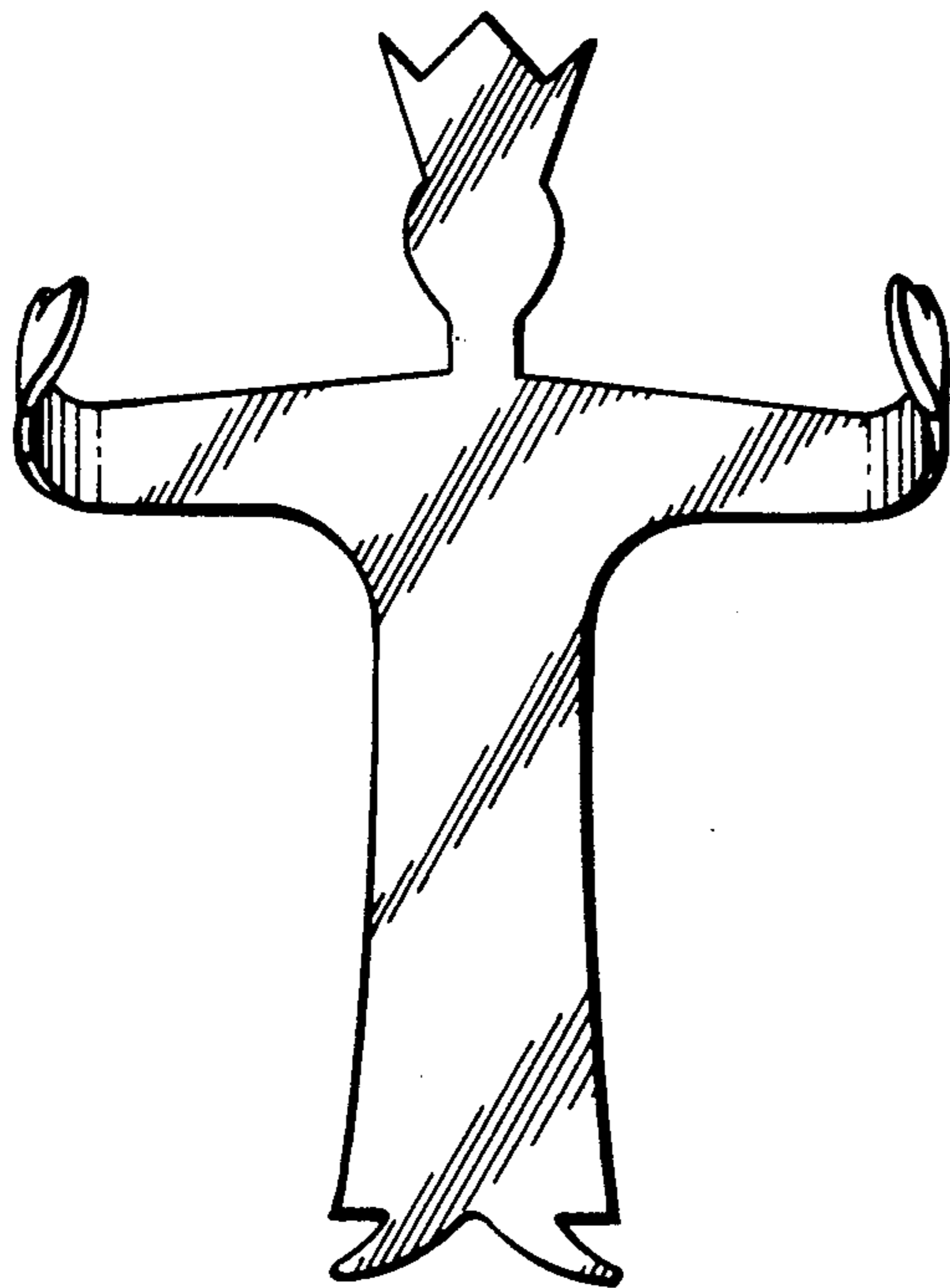

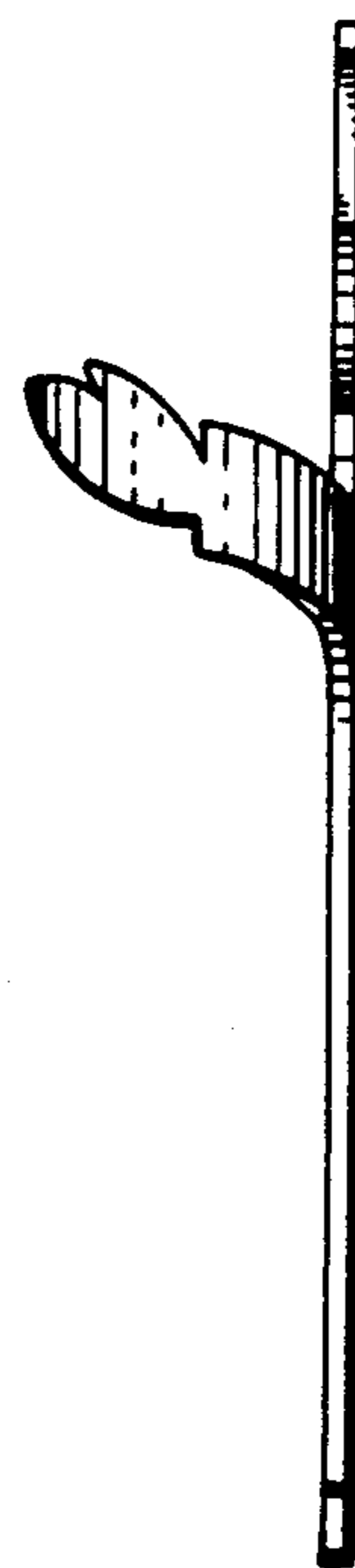
