The ornamental design for coin operated automatic blood pressure testing apparatus or the like, substantially as shown.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the coin operated automatic blood pressure testing apparatus showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a reduced front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a reduced top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a reduced bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a reduced rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a reduced right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a reduced left side elevational view thereof.
