DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a crucifix showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

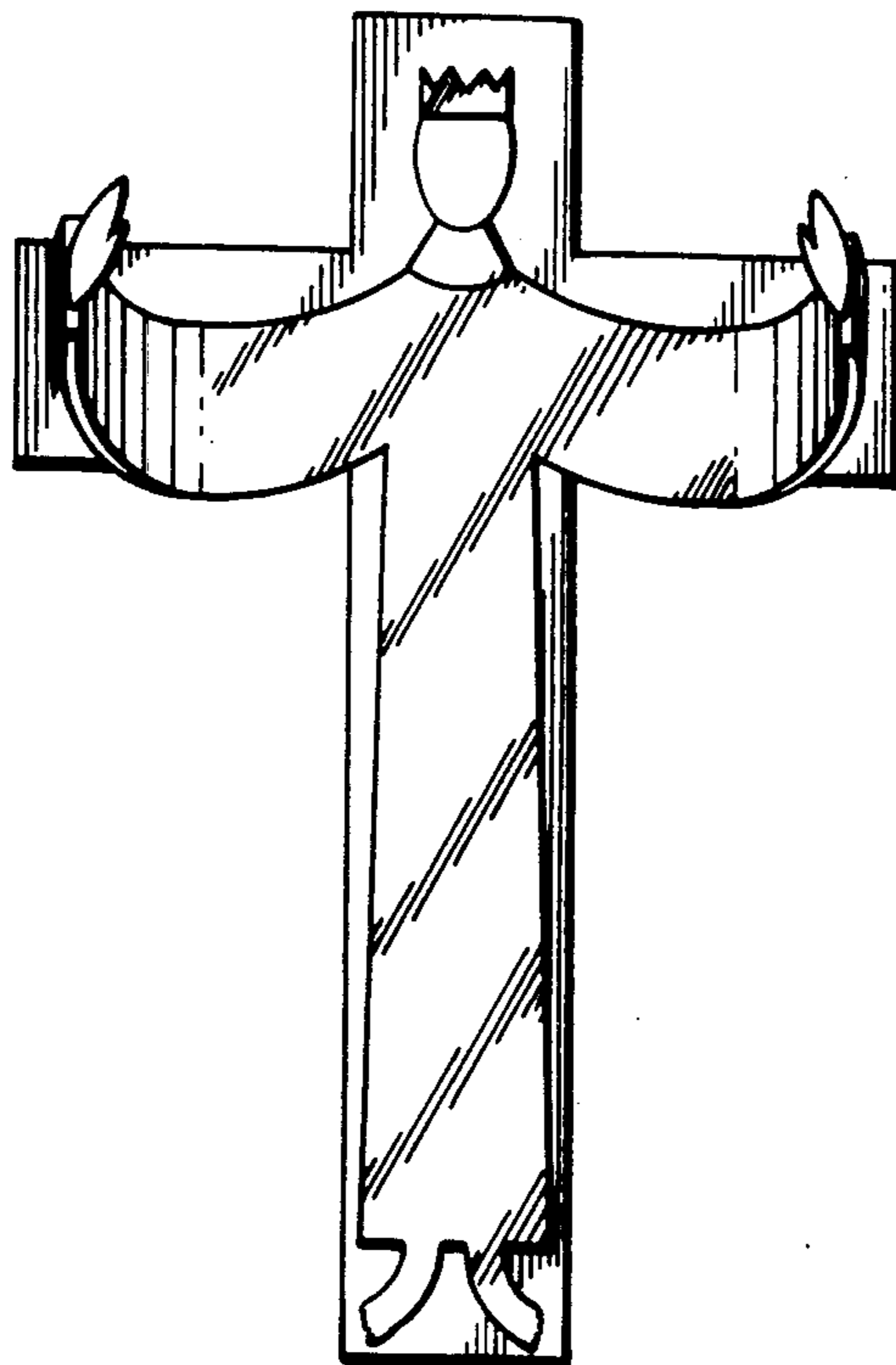

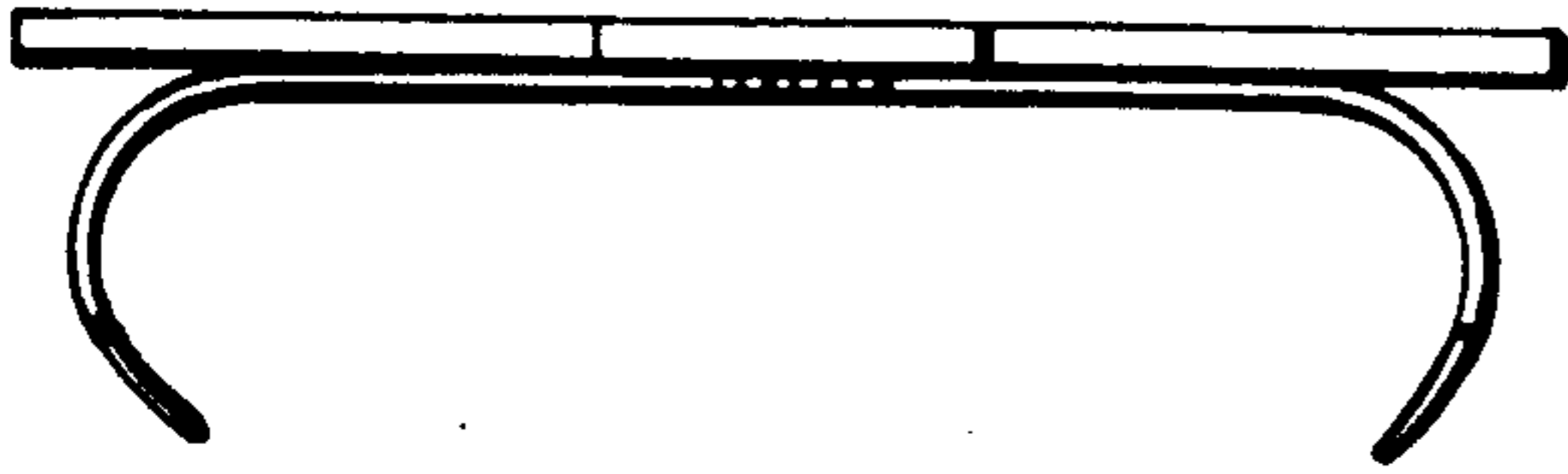

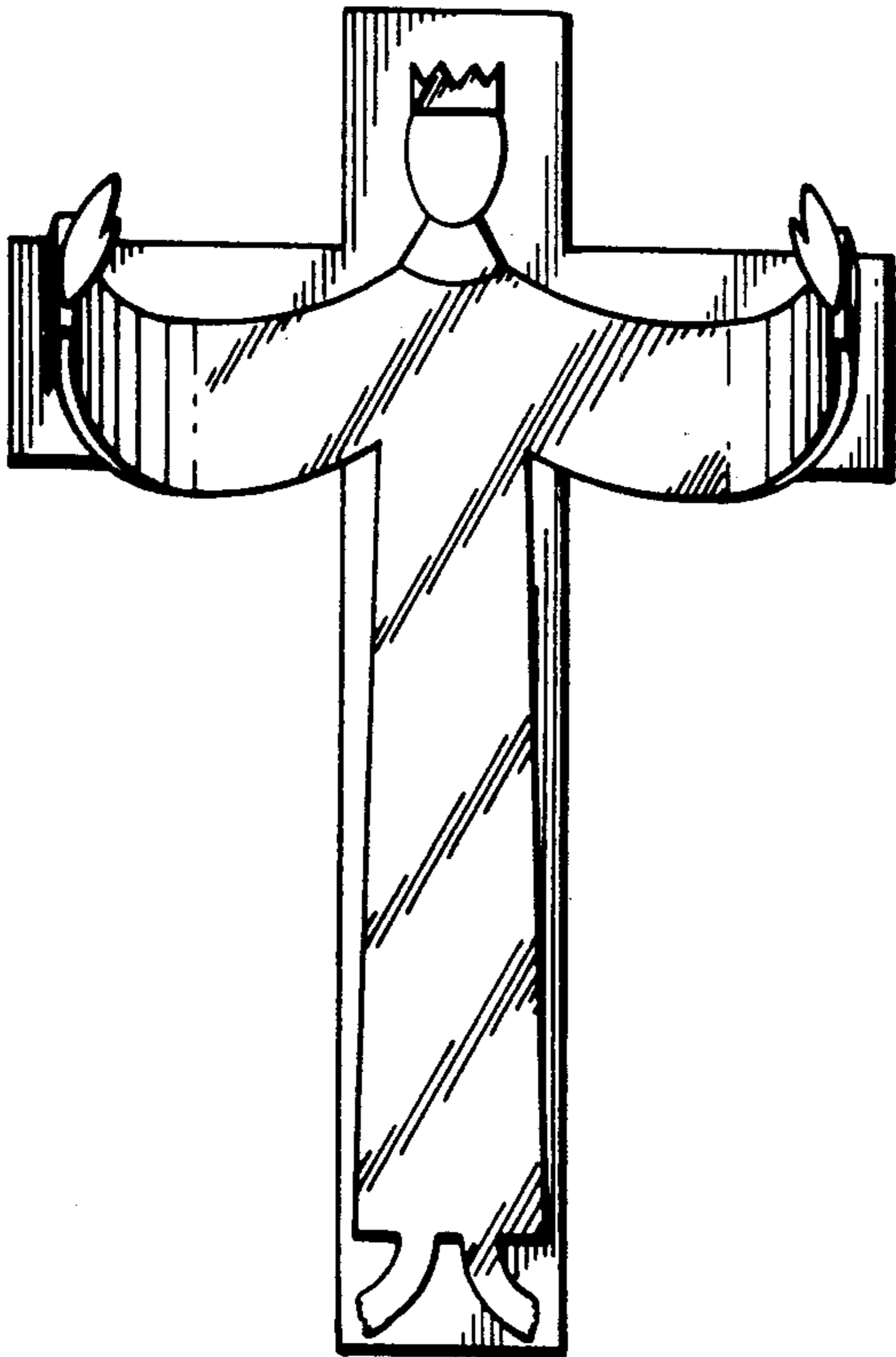
