DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the arm chair depicted in FIG. 1.

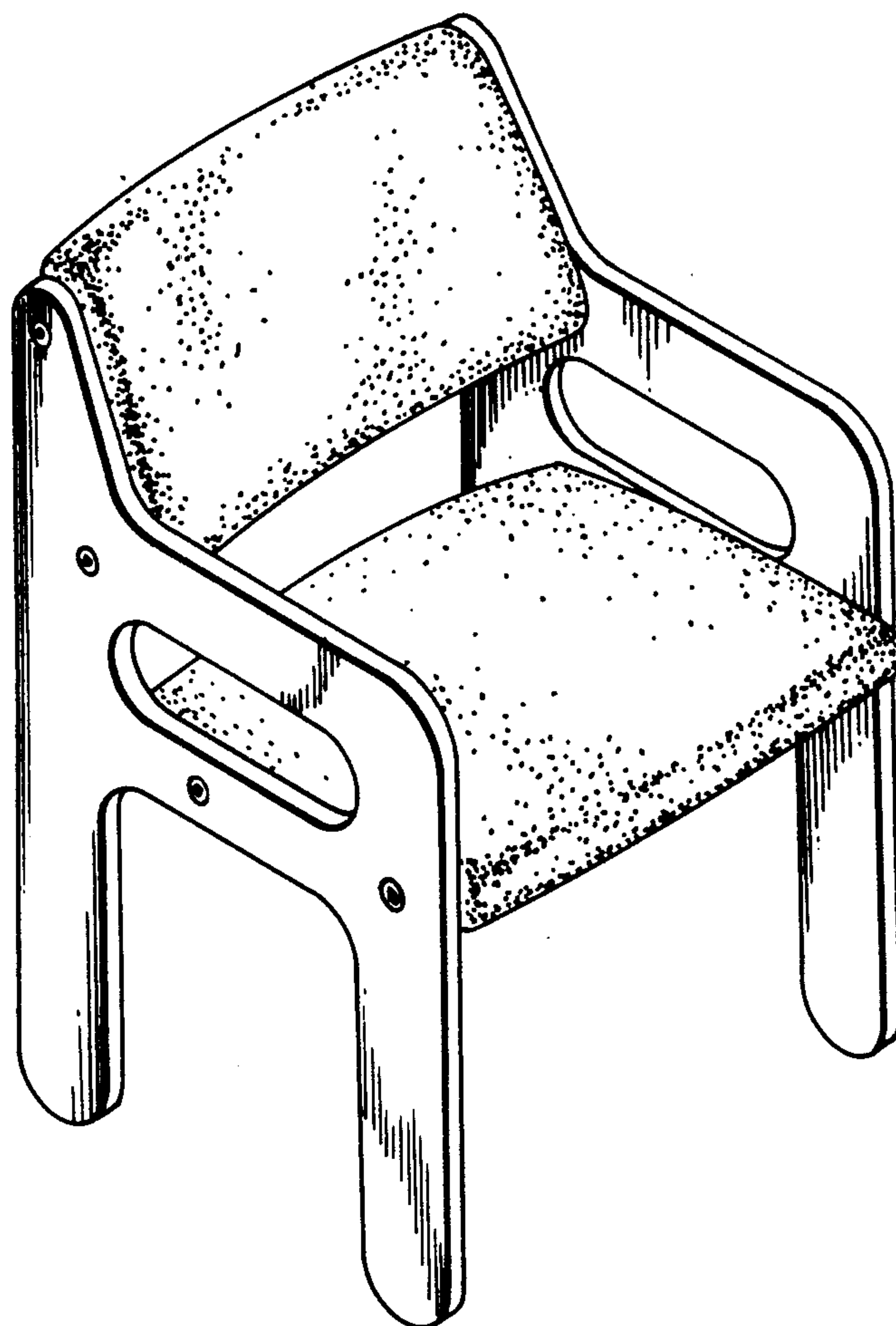

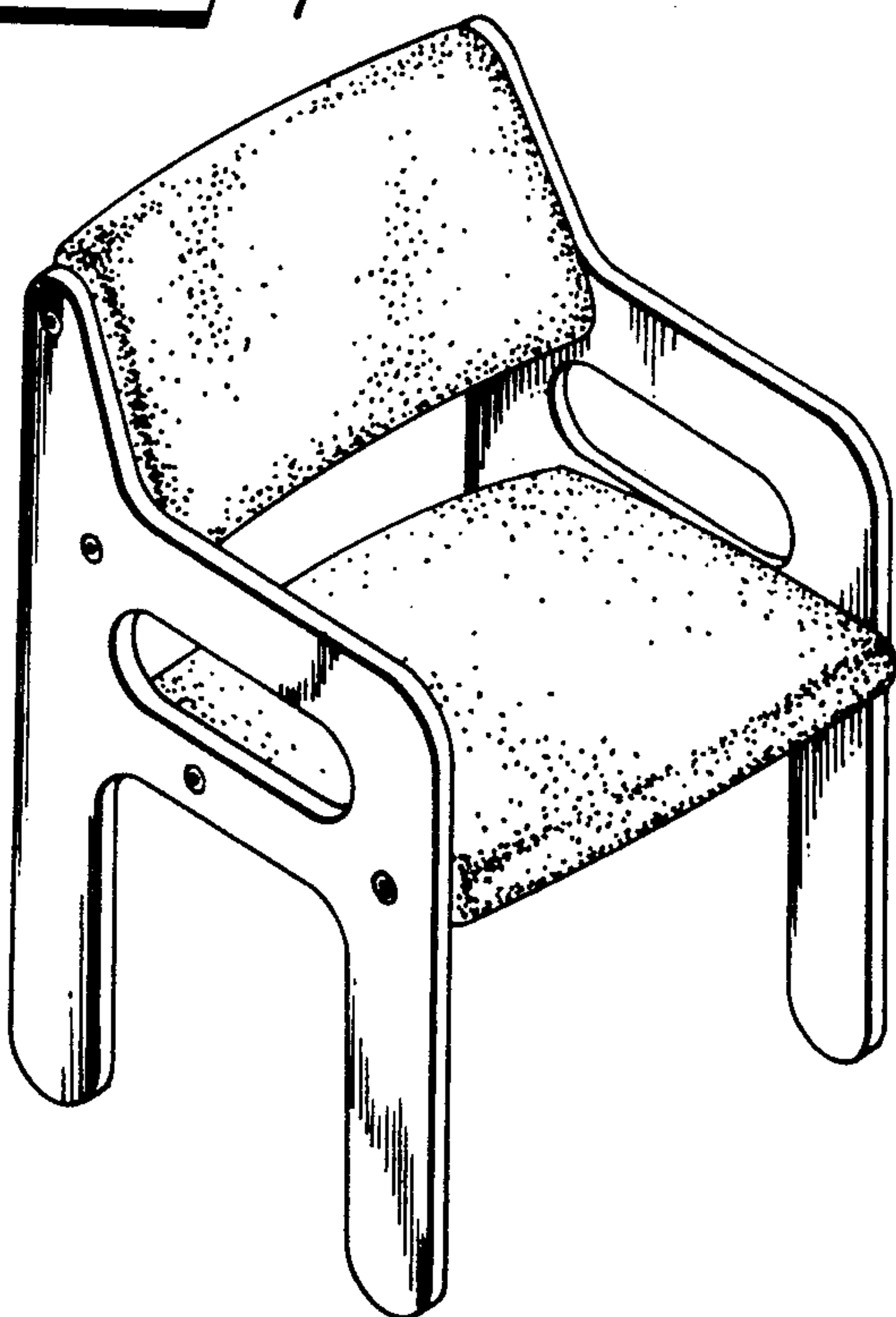

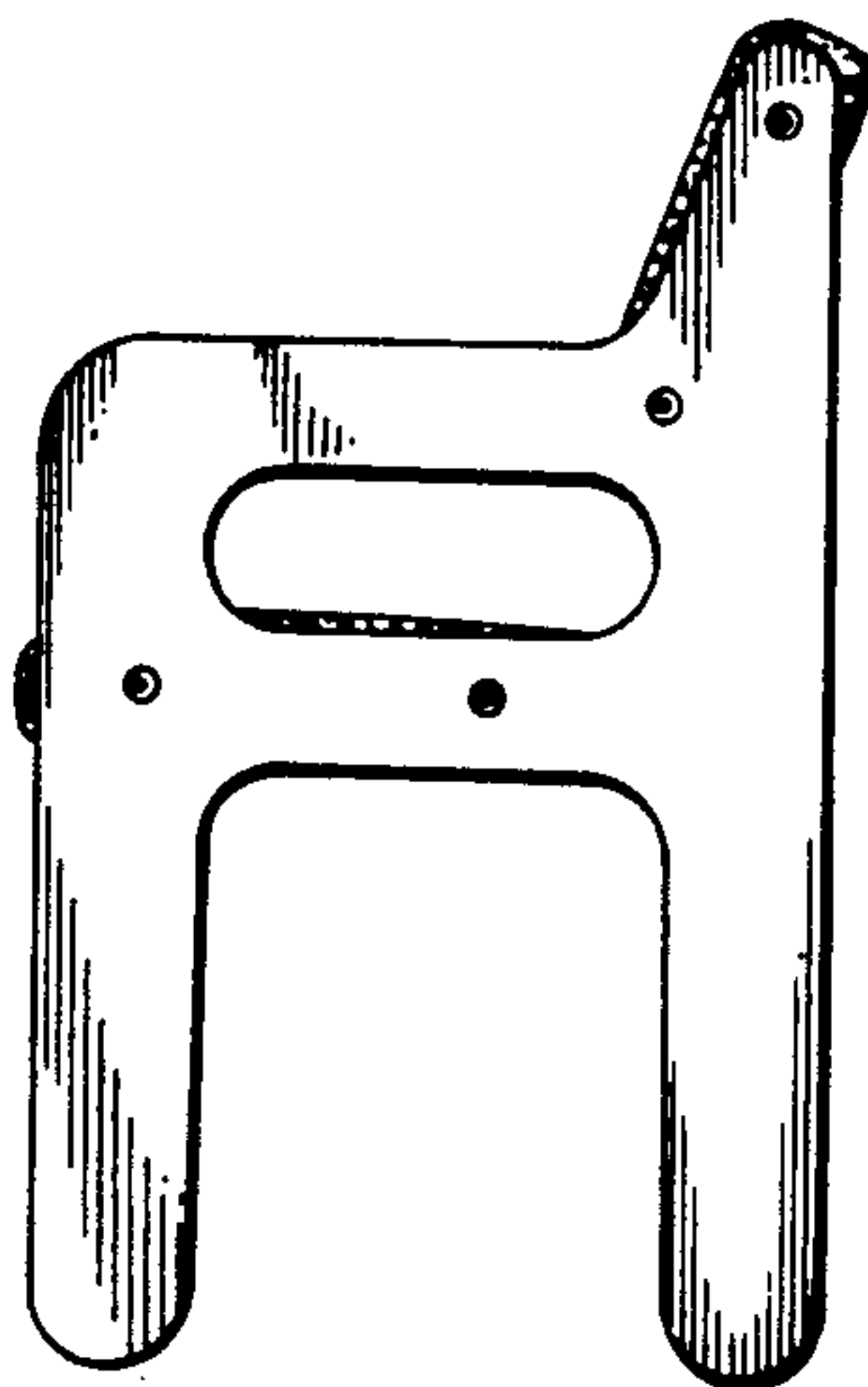

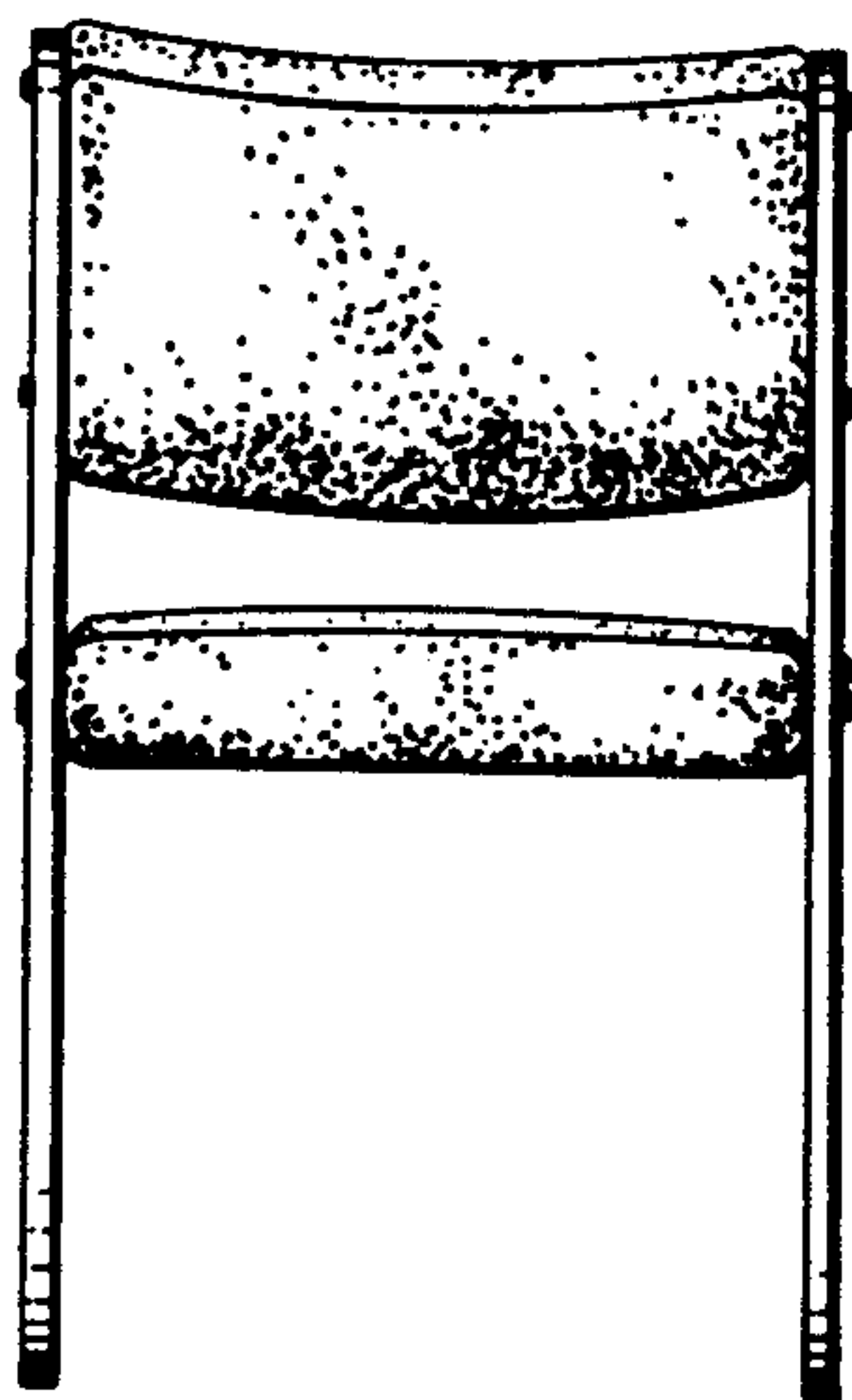

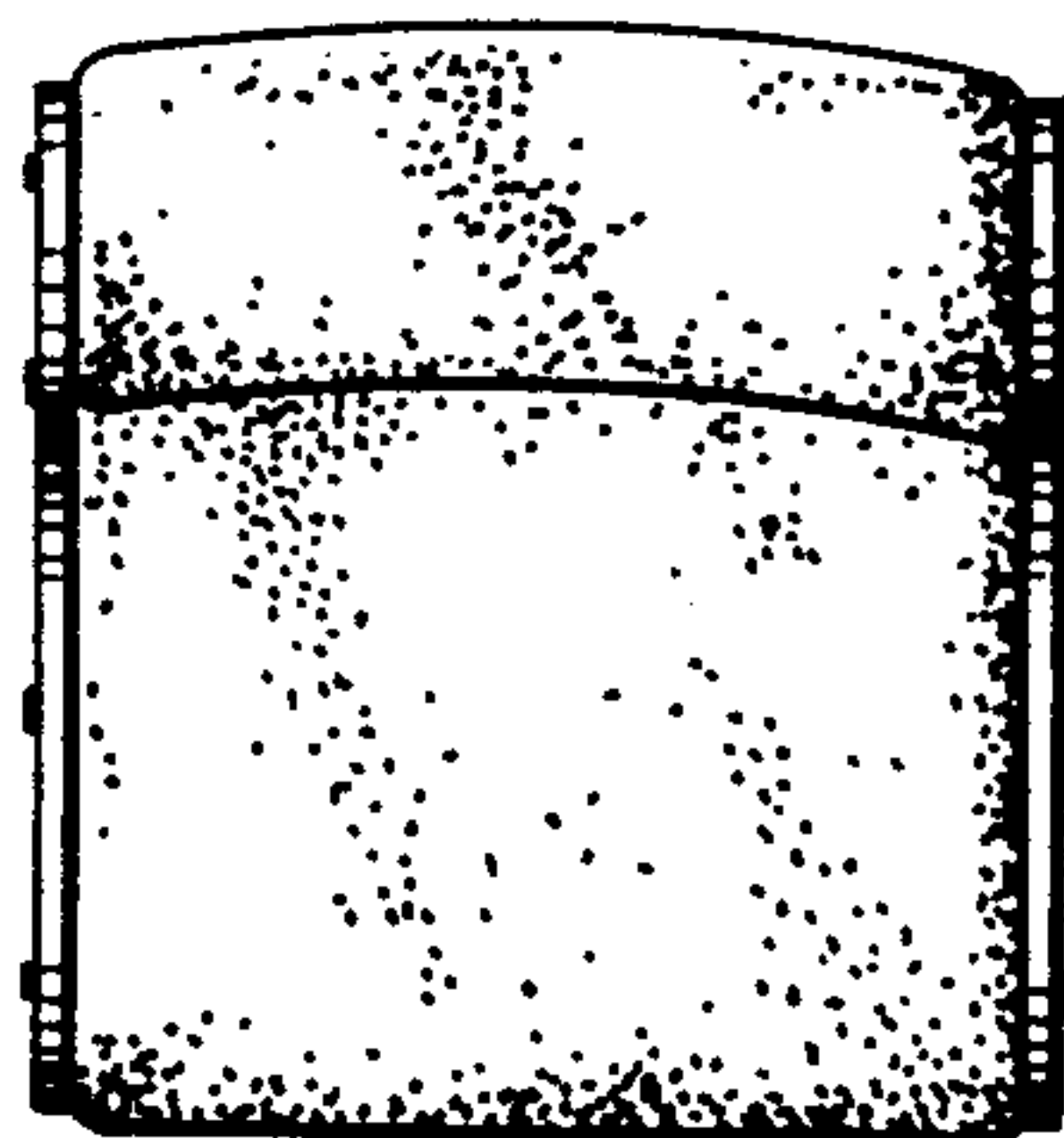
