[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a rack for tennis rackets, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a rack for tennis rackets showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only differences being the number and location of the pegs.
