DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a seam-free can body showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a vertical sectional view taken through the center of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a perspective view showing a modified form of my new design;
FIG. 5 is a vertical sectional view taken through the center of FIG. 4; and
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.

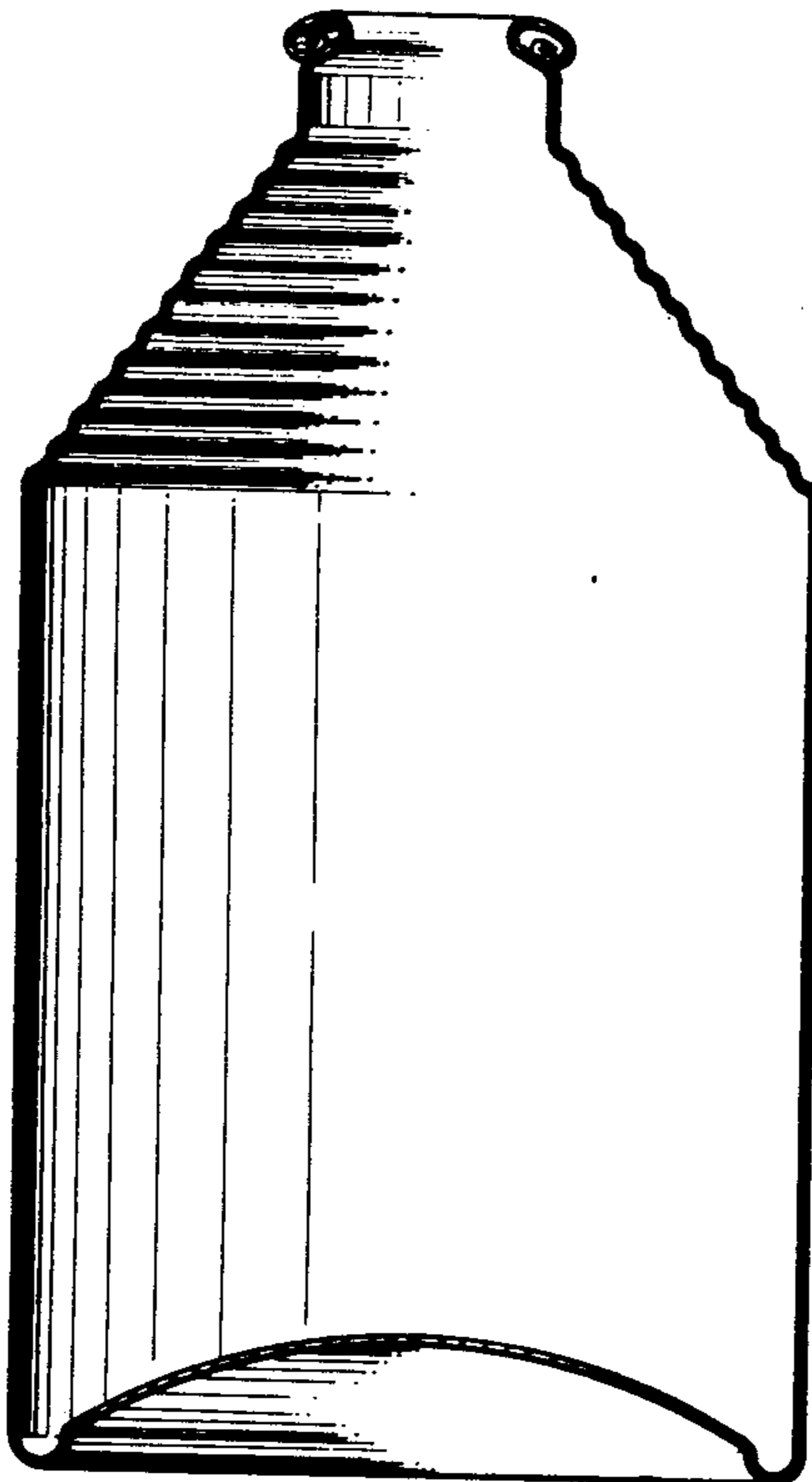

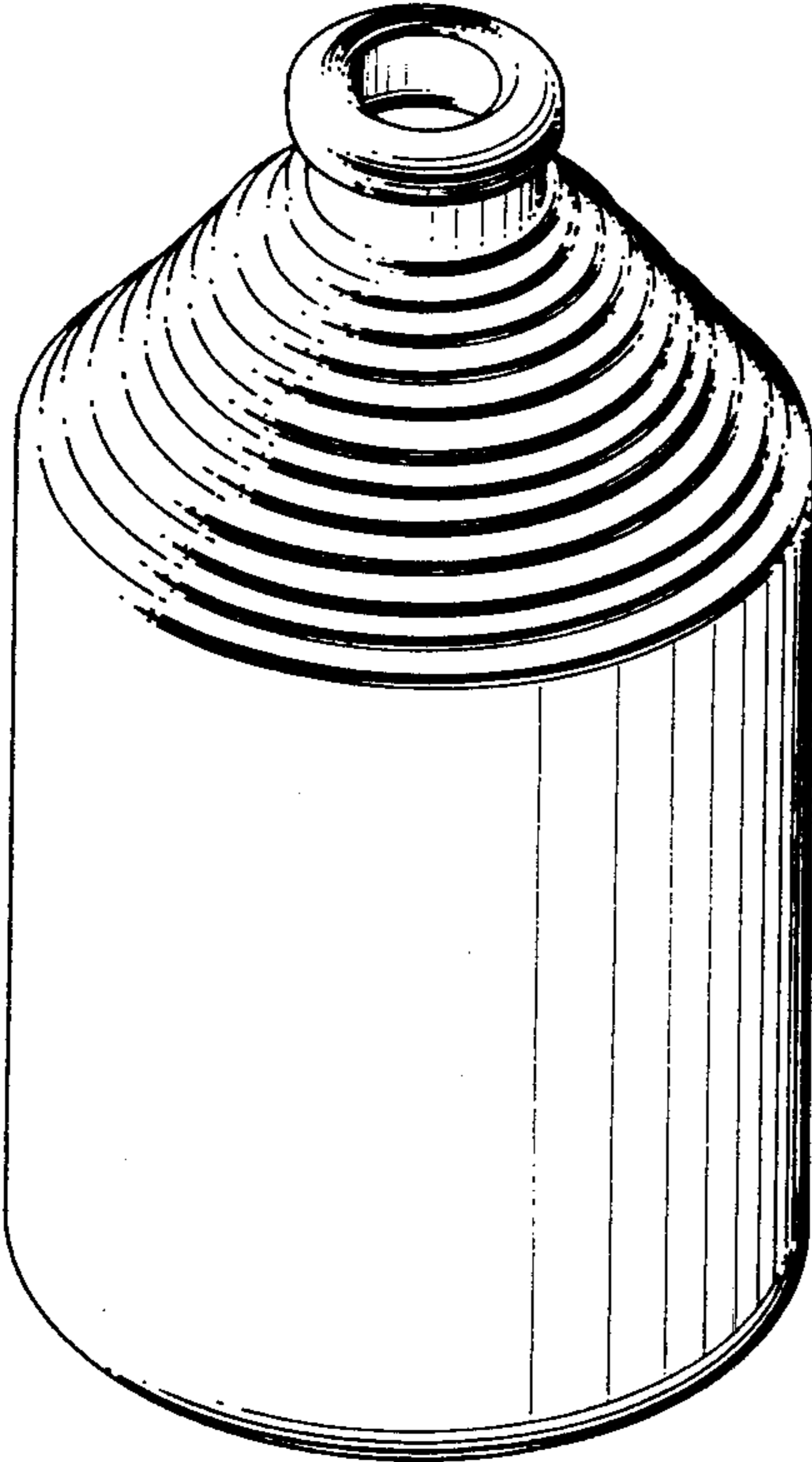

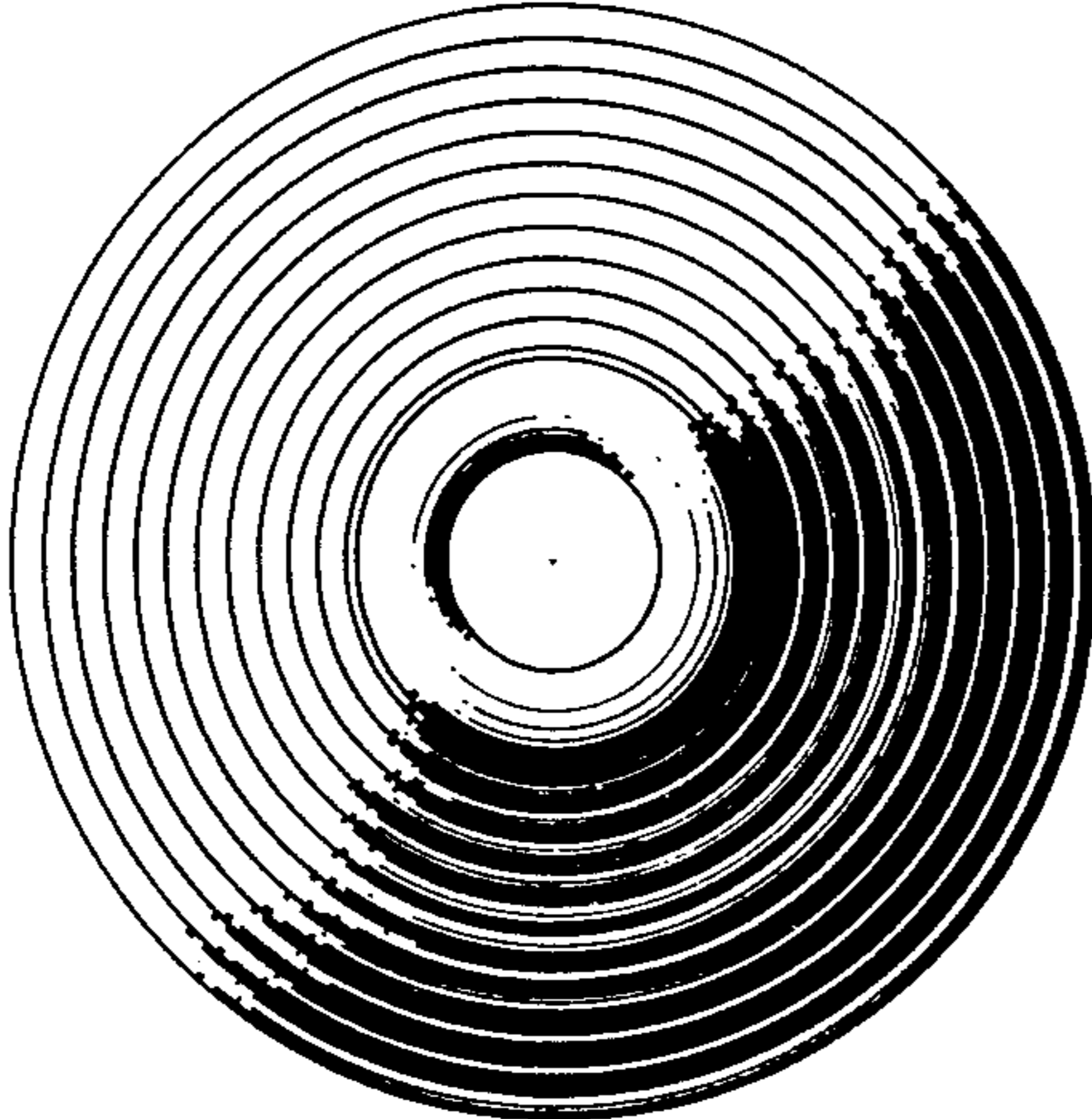
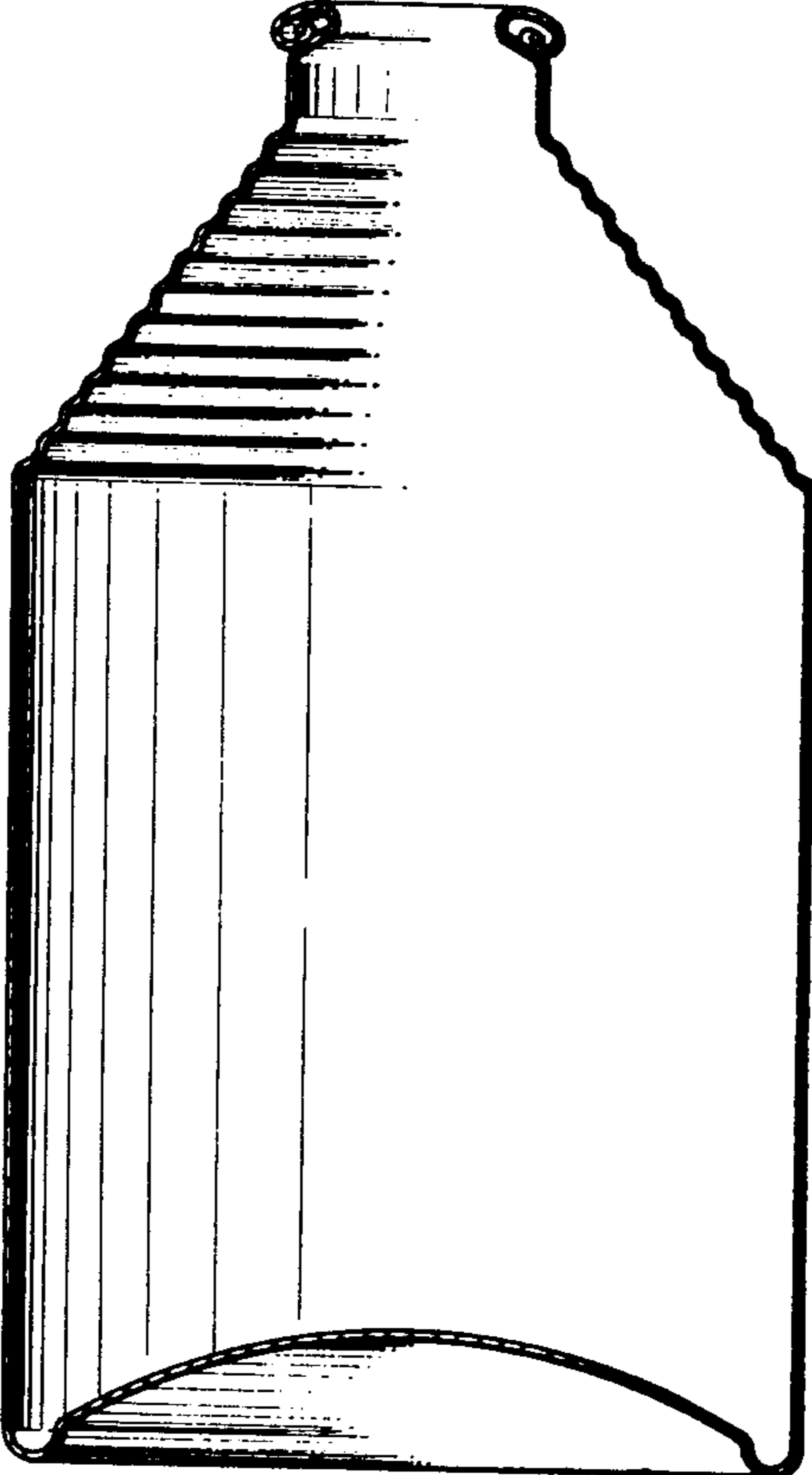

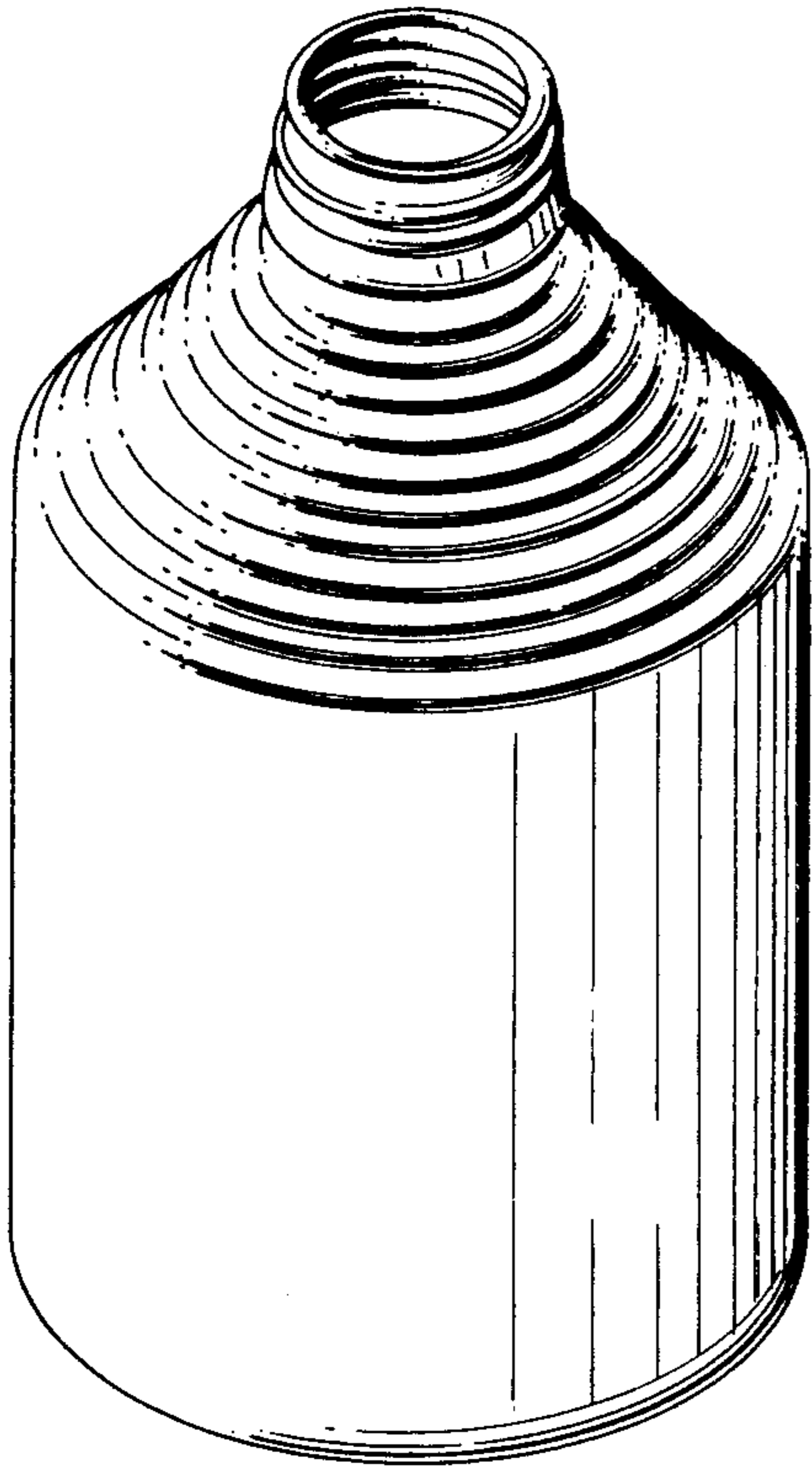

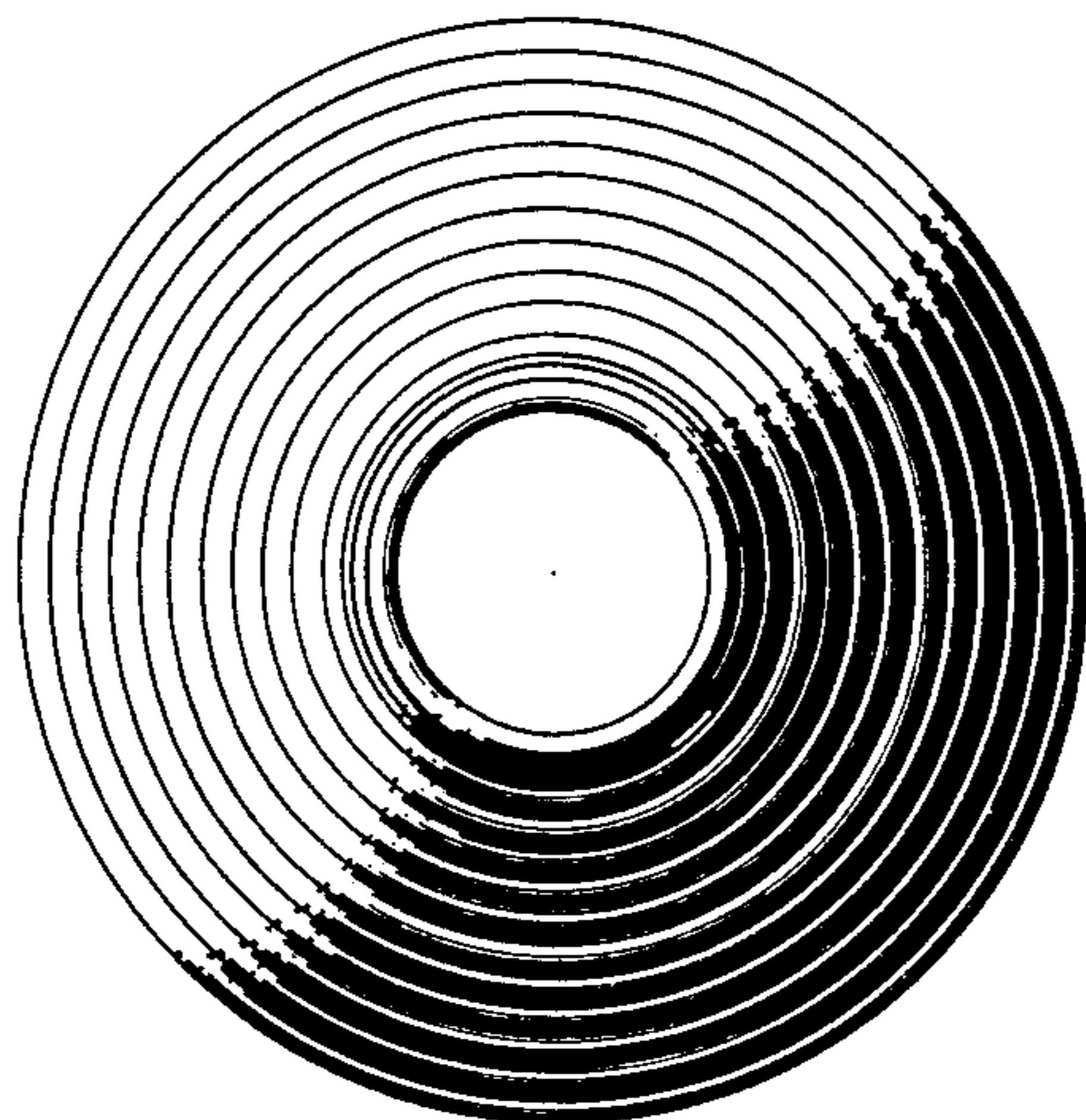
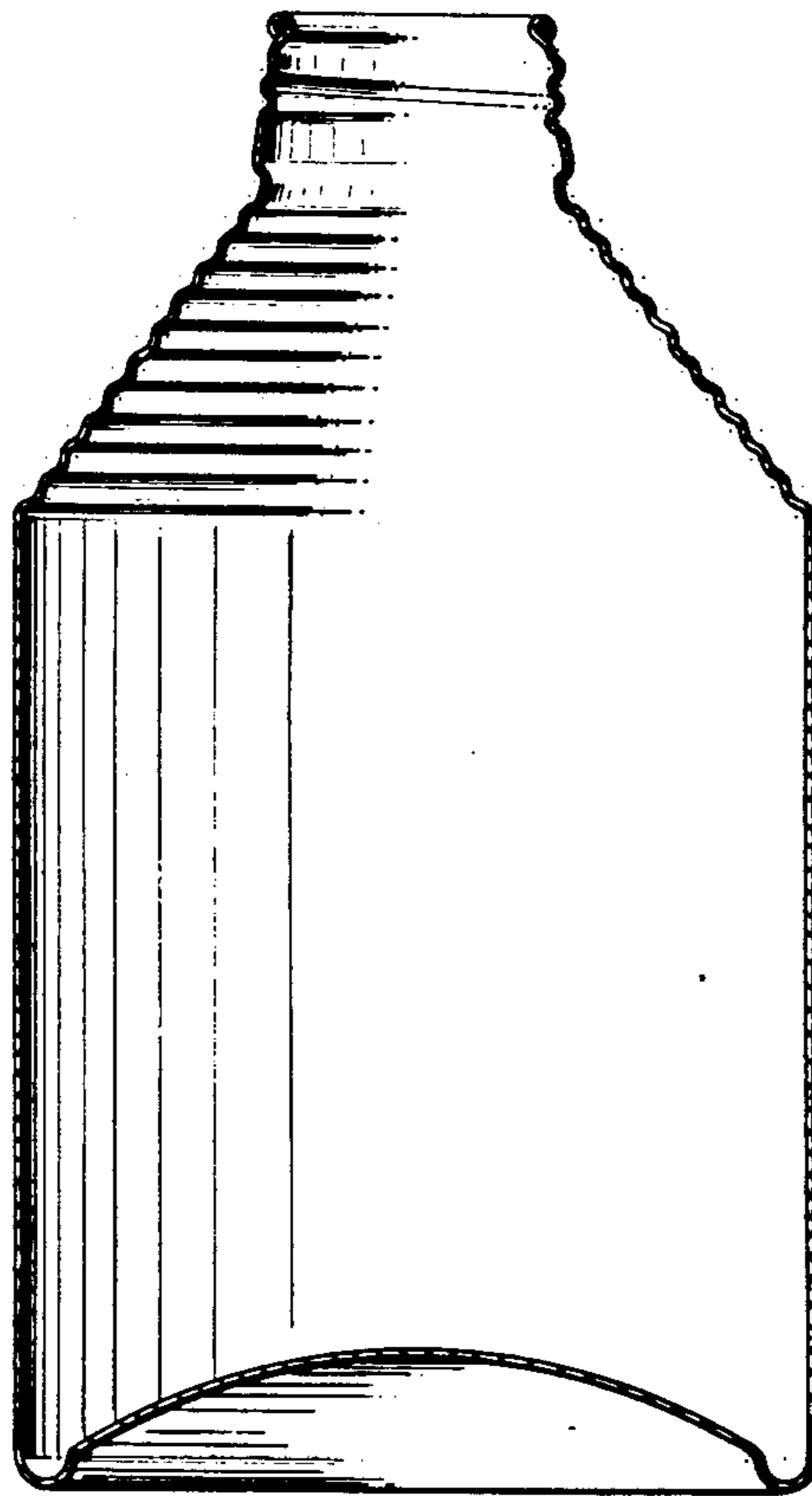
