[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sole for footwear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a sole for footwear showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a perspective fragmentary view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 2.

The top of the sole is flat, plain and unornamented.

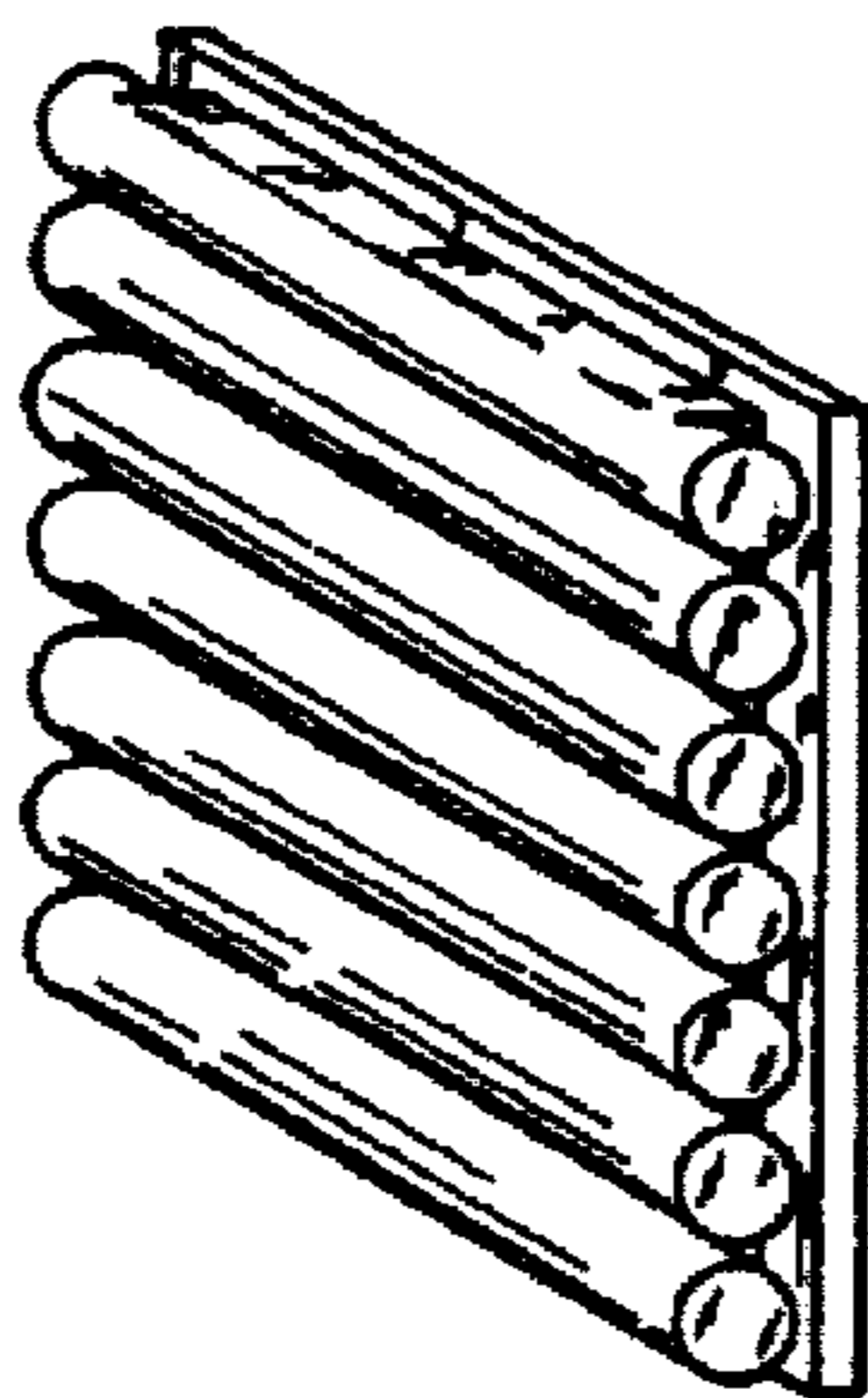

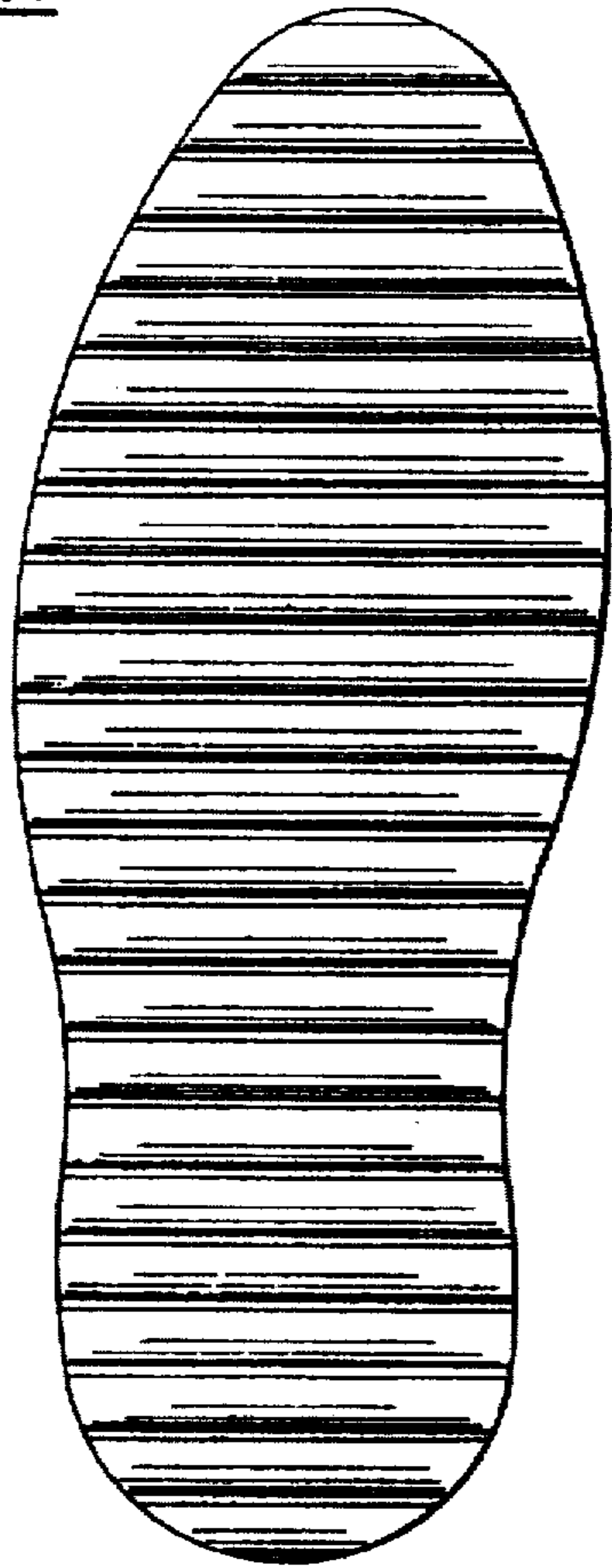

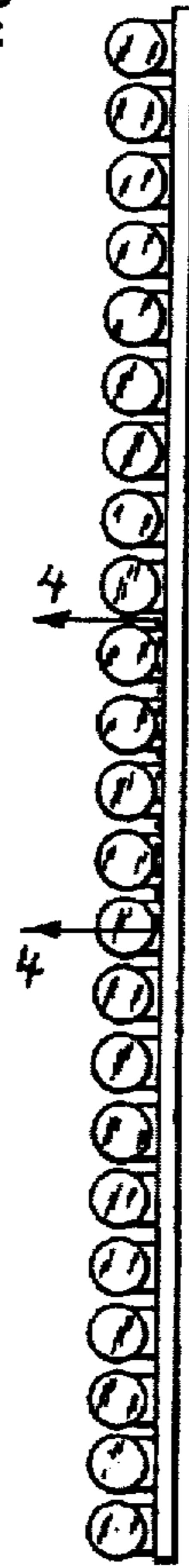

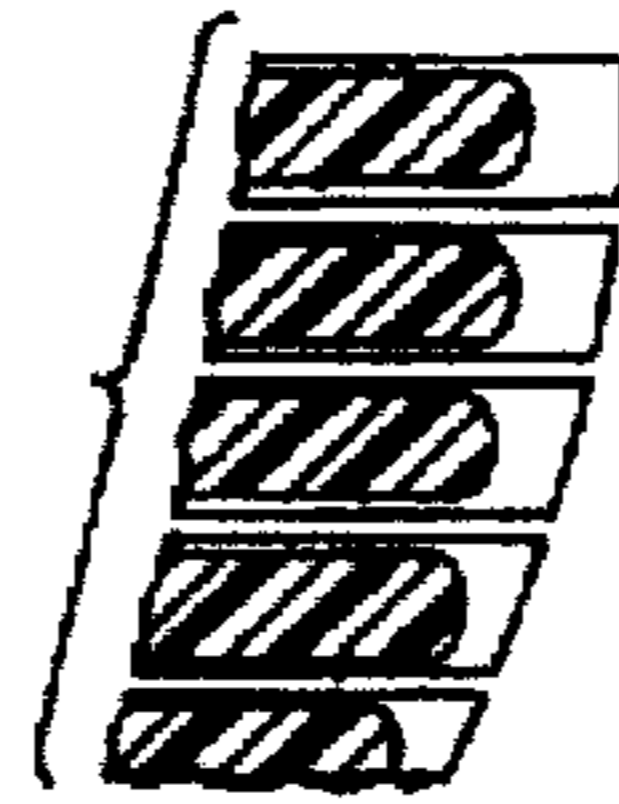
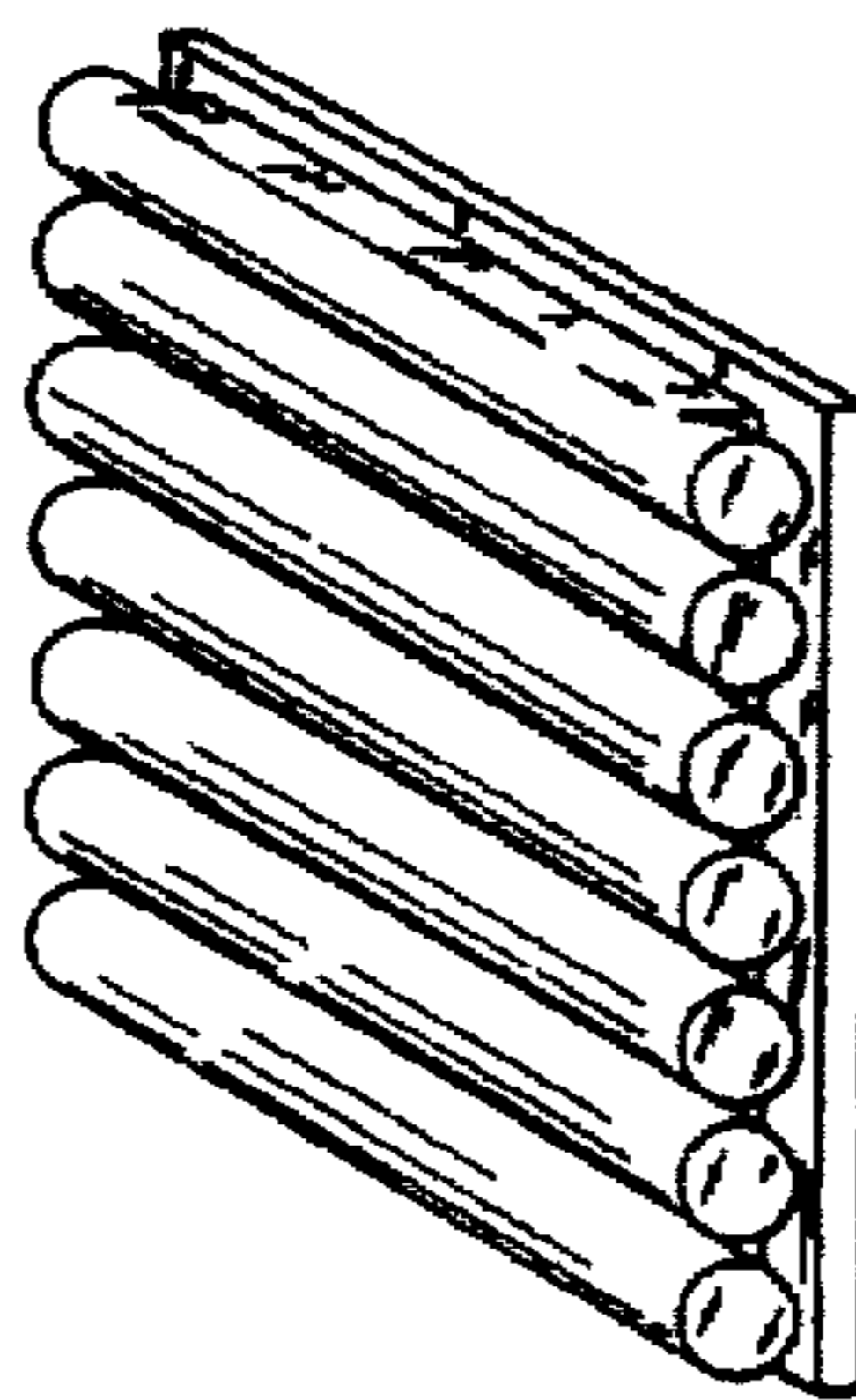
