DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined cassette and palette for water colors showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view with a portion of the side panel broken away; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 7 is a front perspective view; FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view in a fully open position; FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof with the palette removed; and FIG. 10 is a perspective view thereof in a partially open position.
