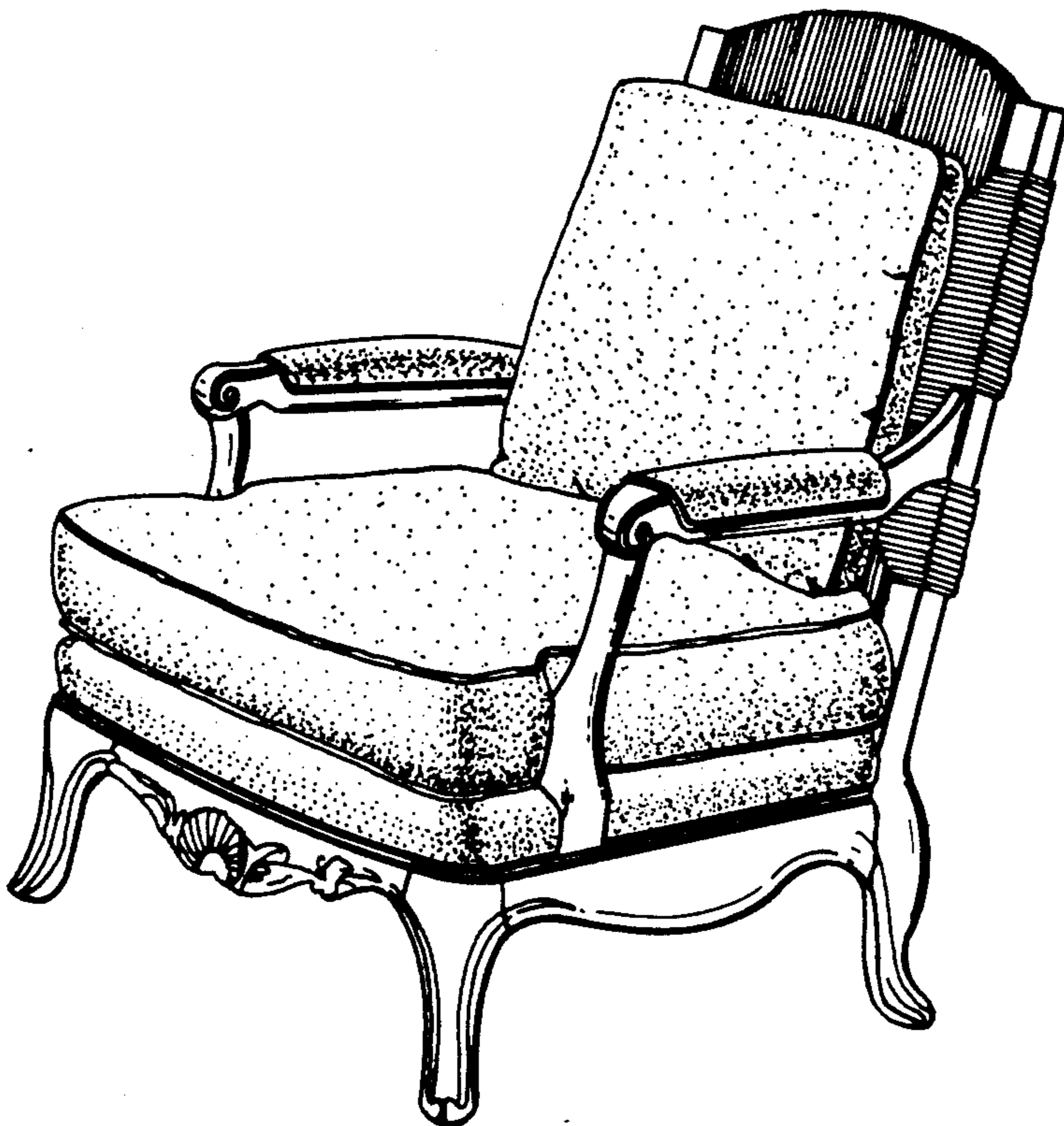

The ornamental design for an armchair or the like, substantially as shown and described.

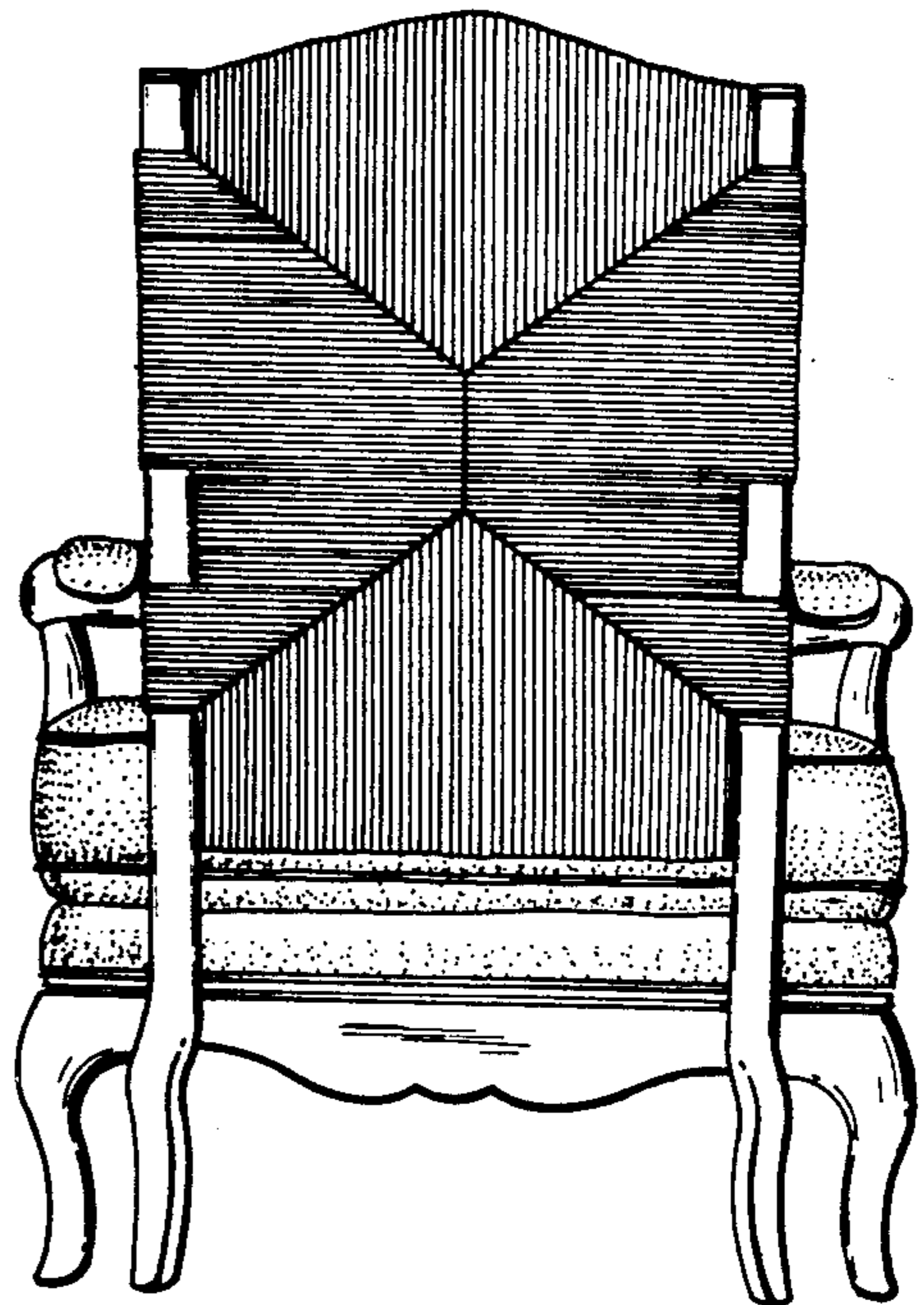
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a view in perspective of the armchair showing my design;

FIG. 4 is a view in side elevation of the armchair of FIG. 1, the opposite side being identical thereto.

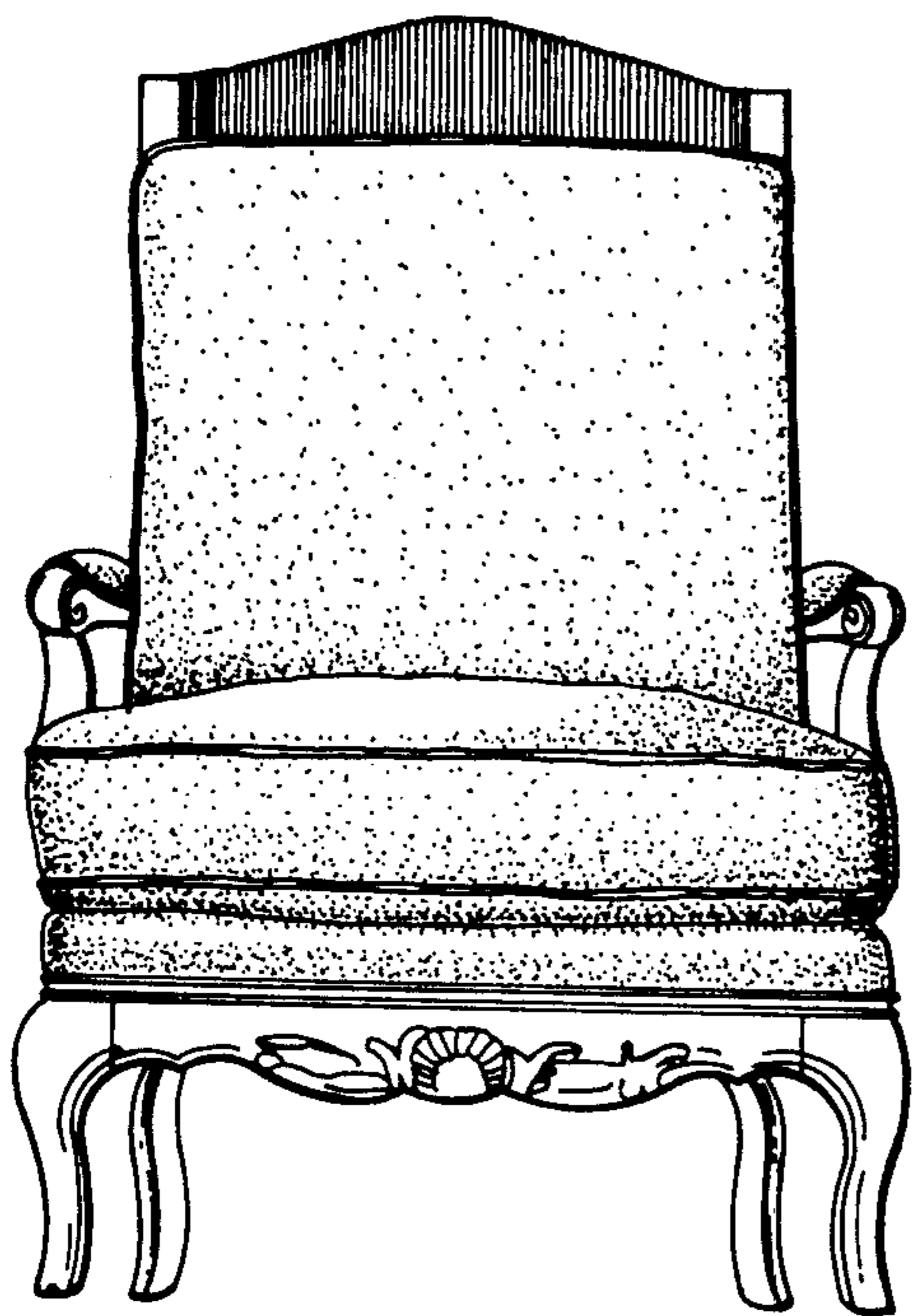




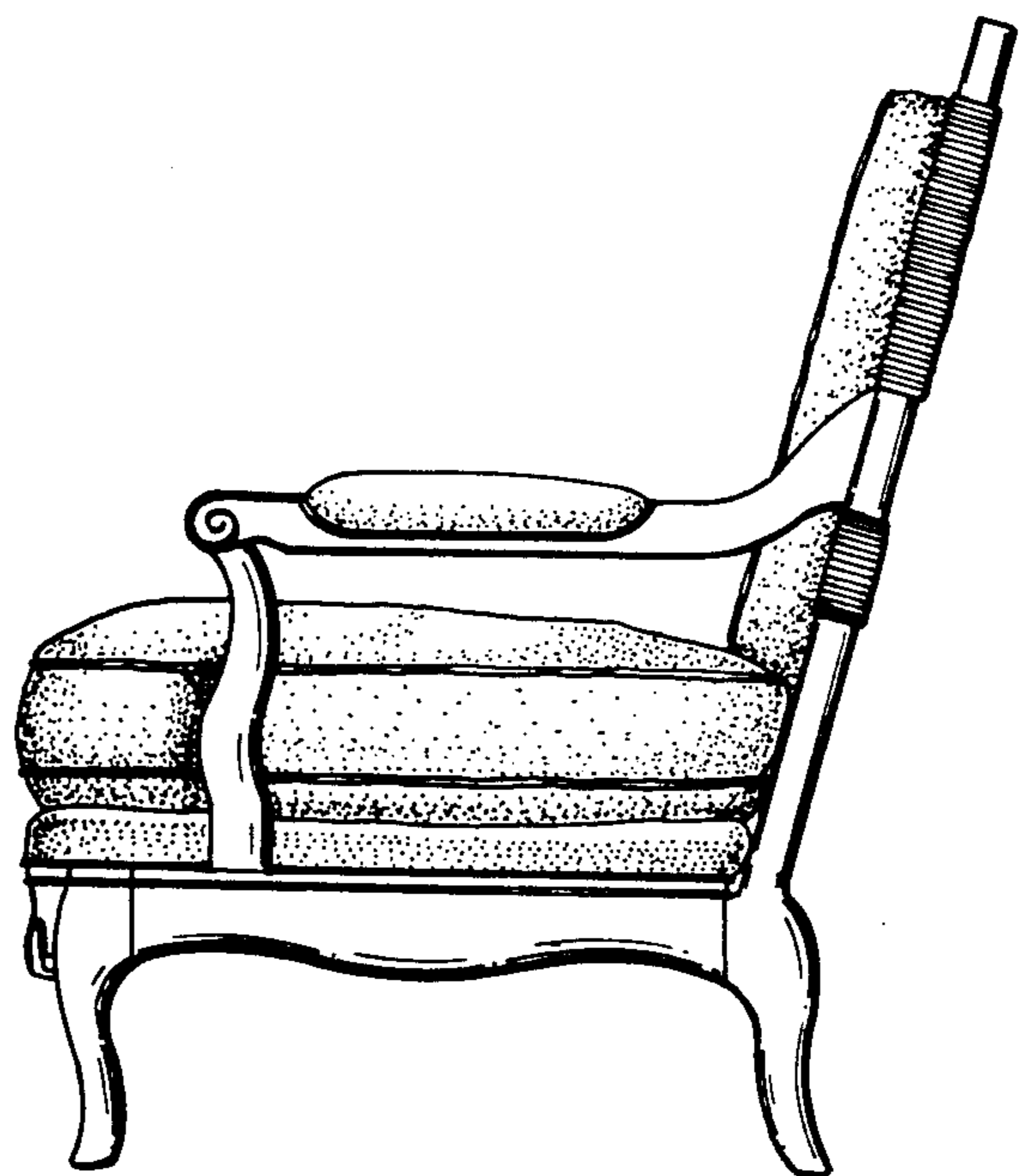
