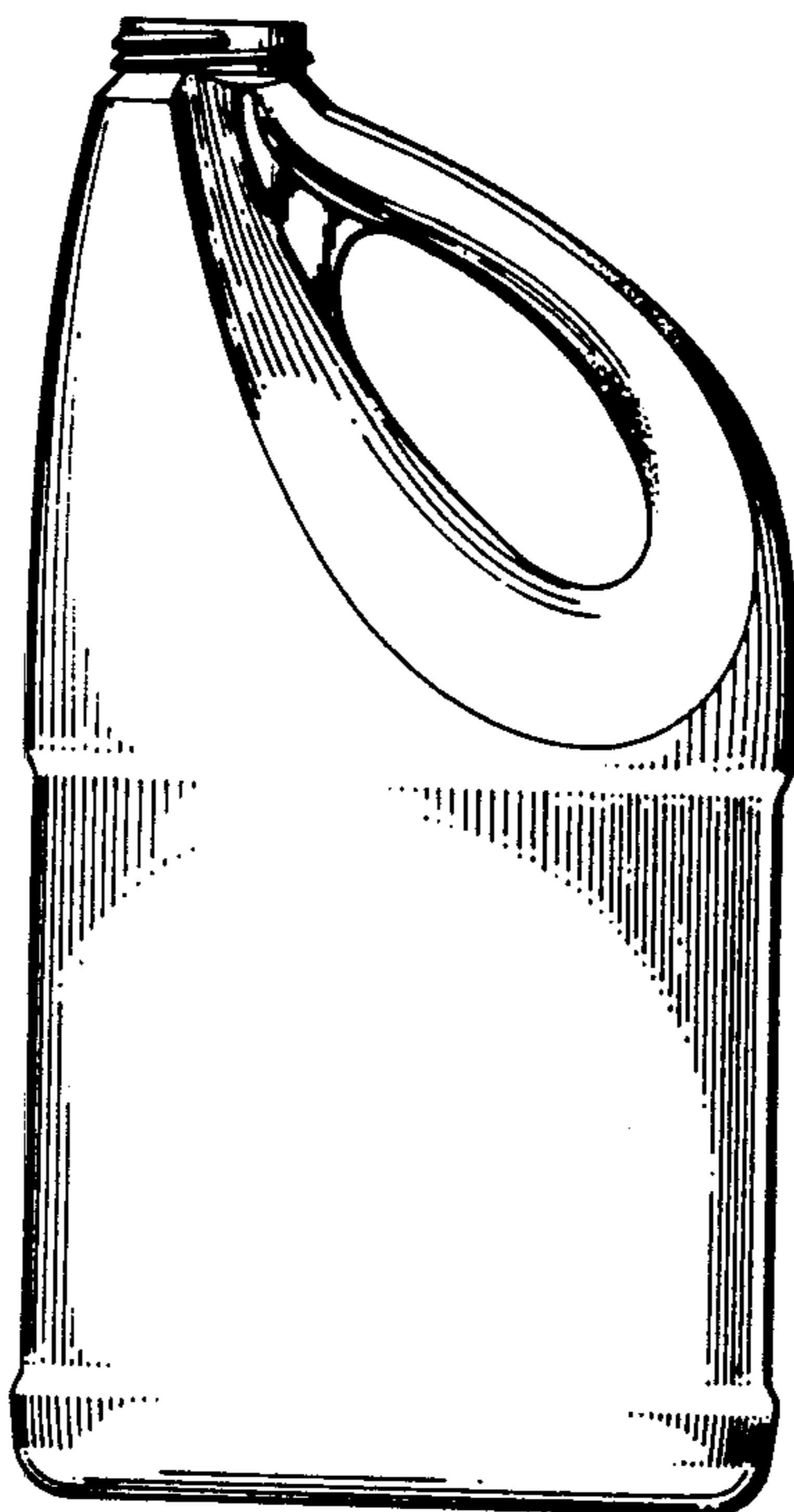

The ornamental design of a bottle, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view looking from the right of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view looking from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along lines 6—6 in FIG. 1.



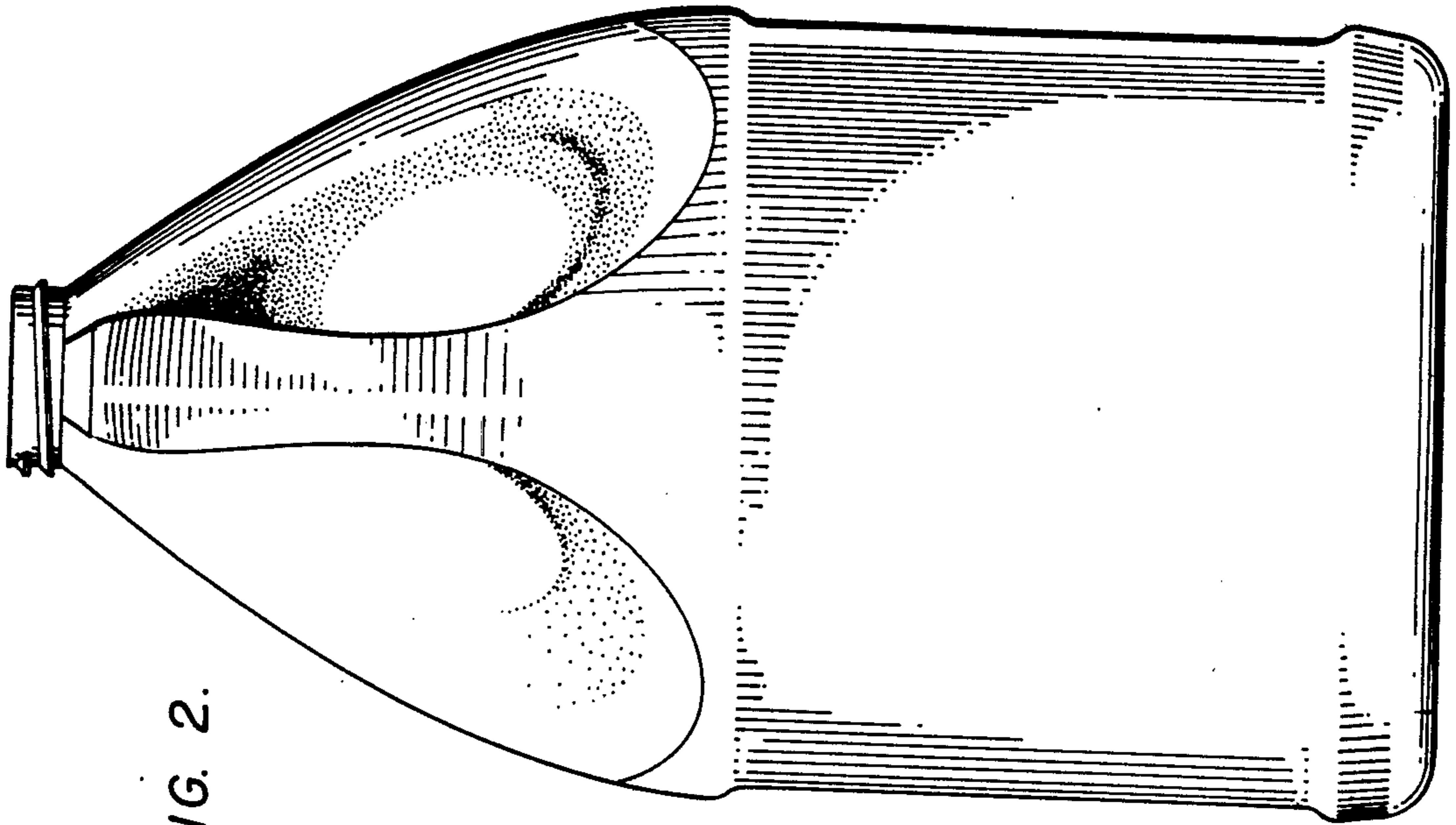

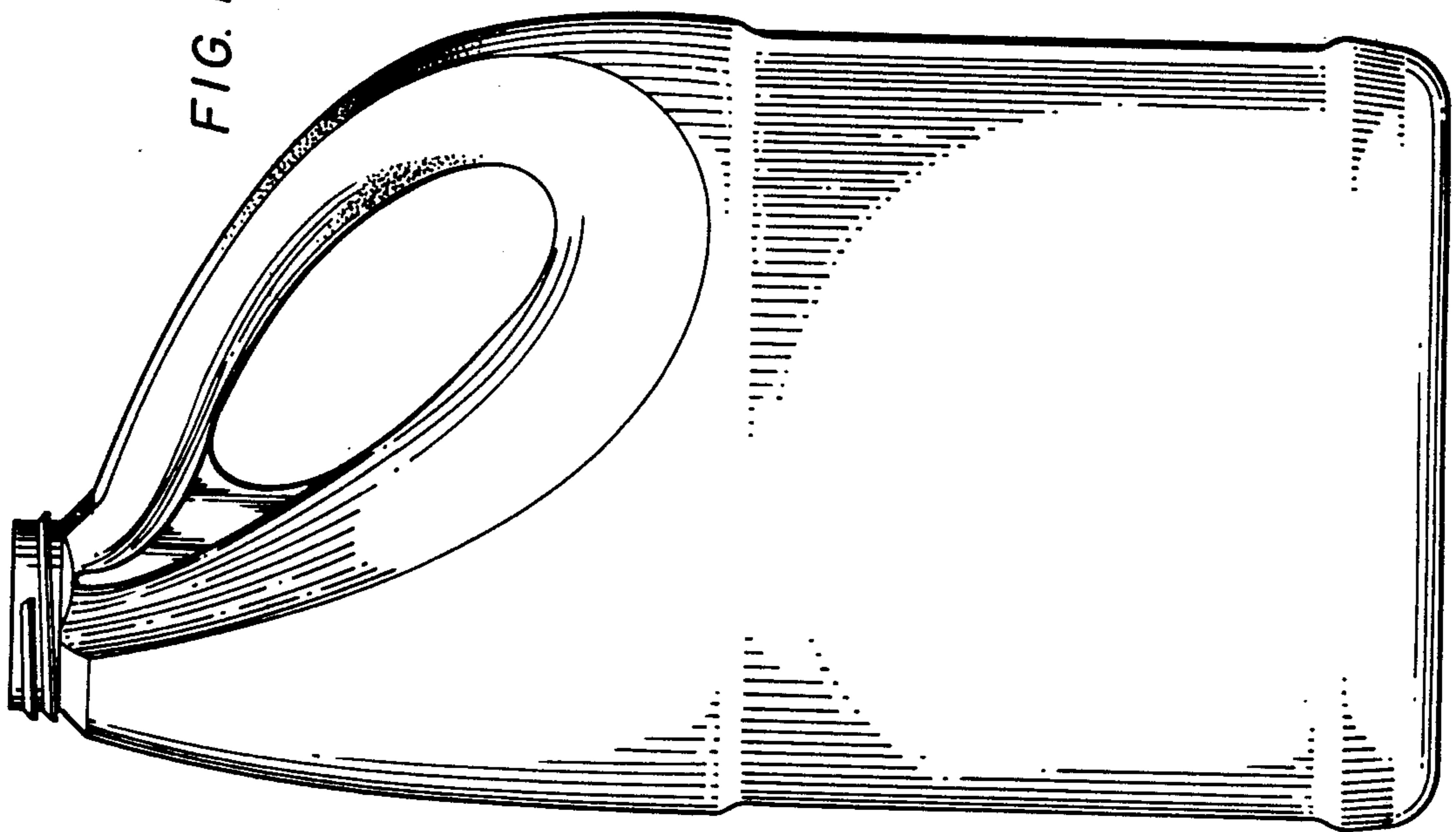

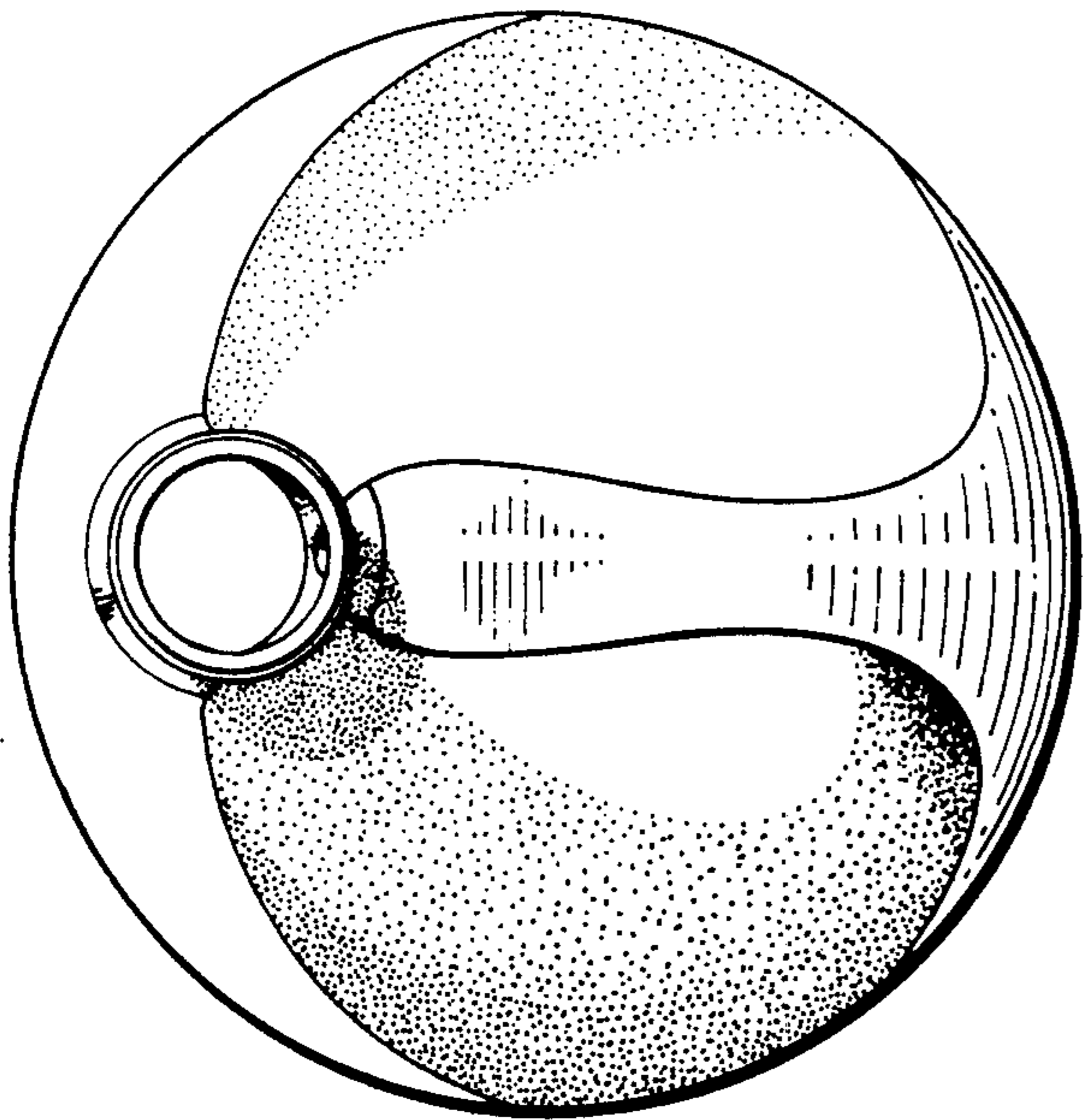

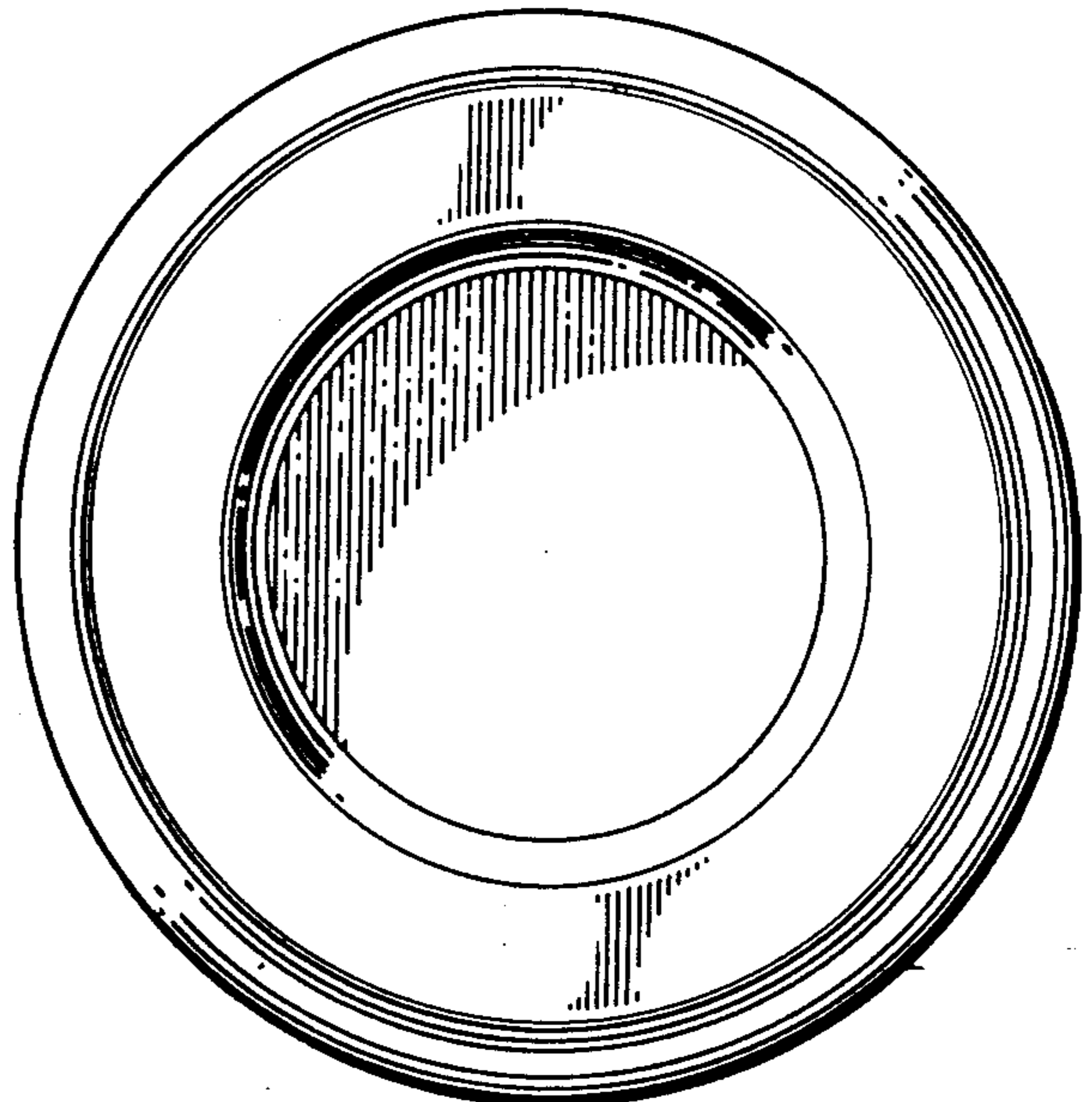
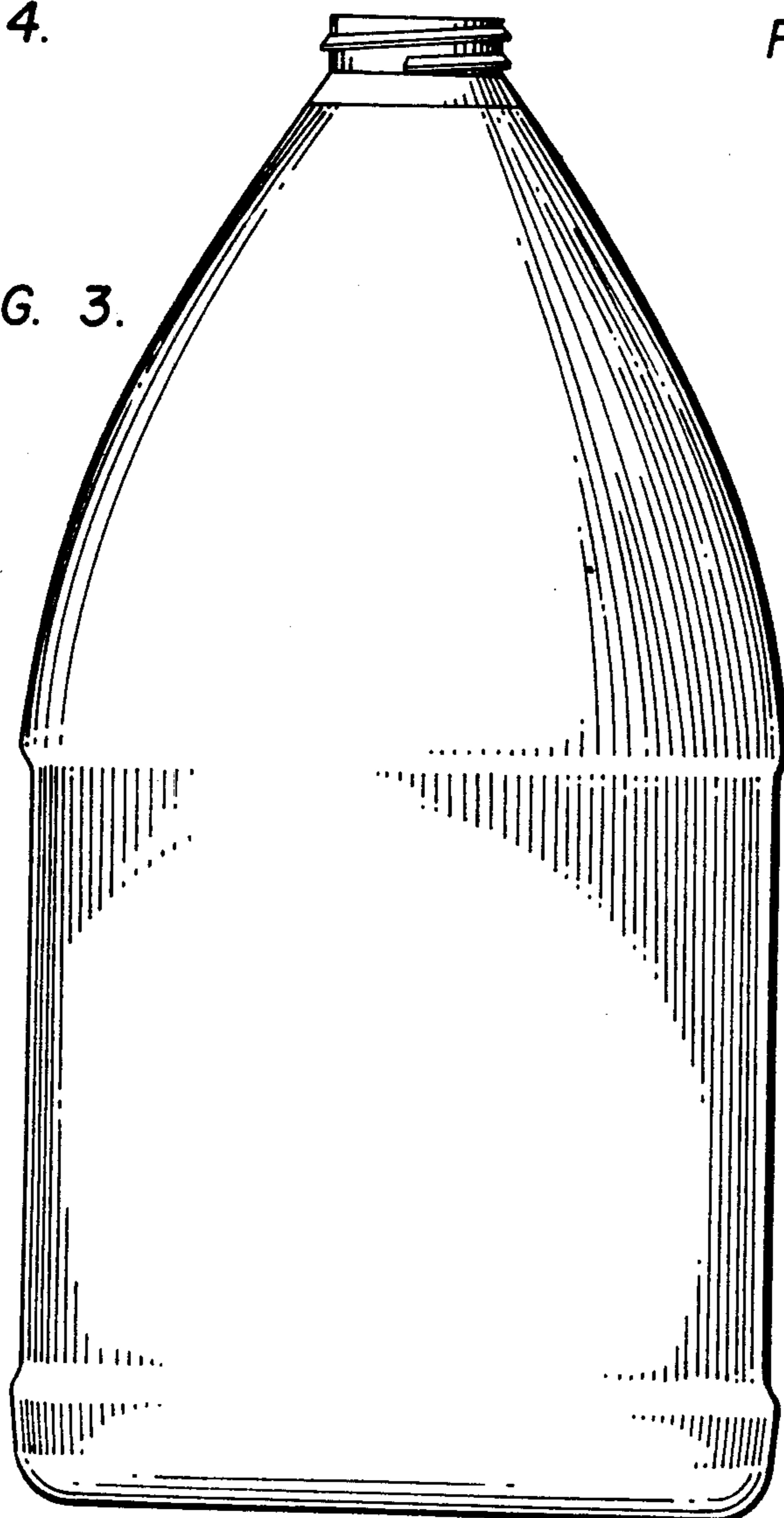

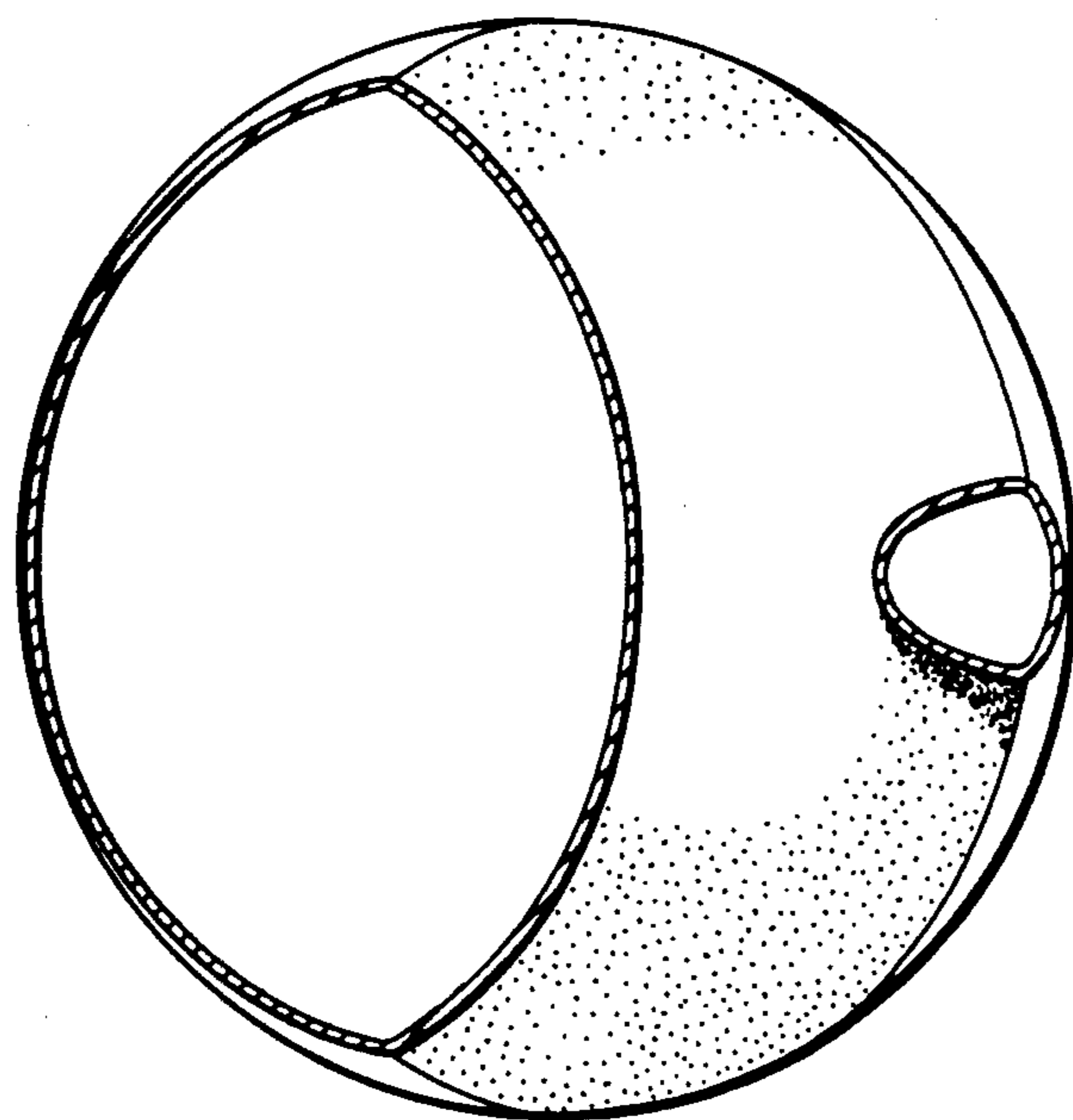
