[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fish lure, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fish lure embodying the present design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the fish lure shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the side of the fish lure opposite that seen in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view.

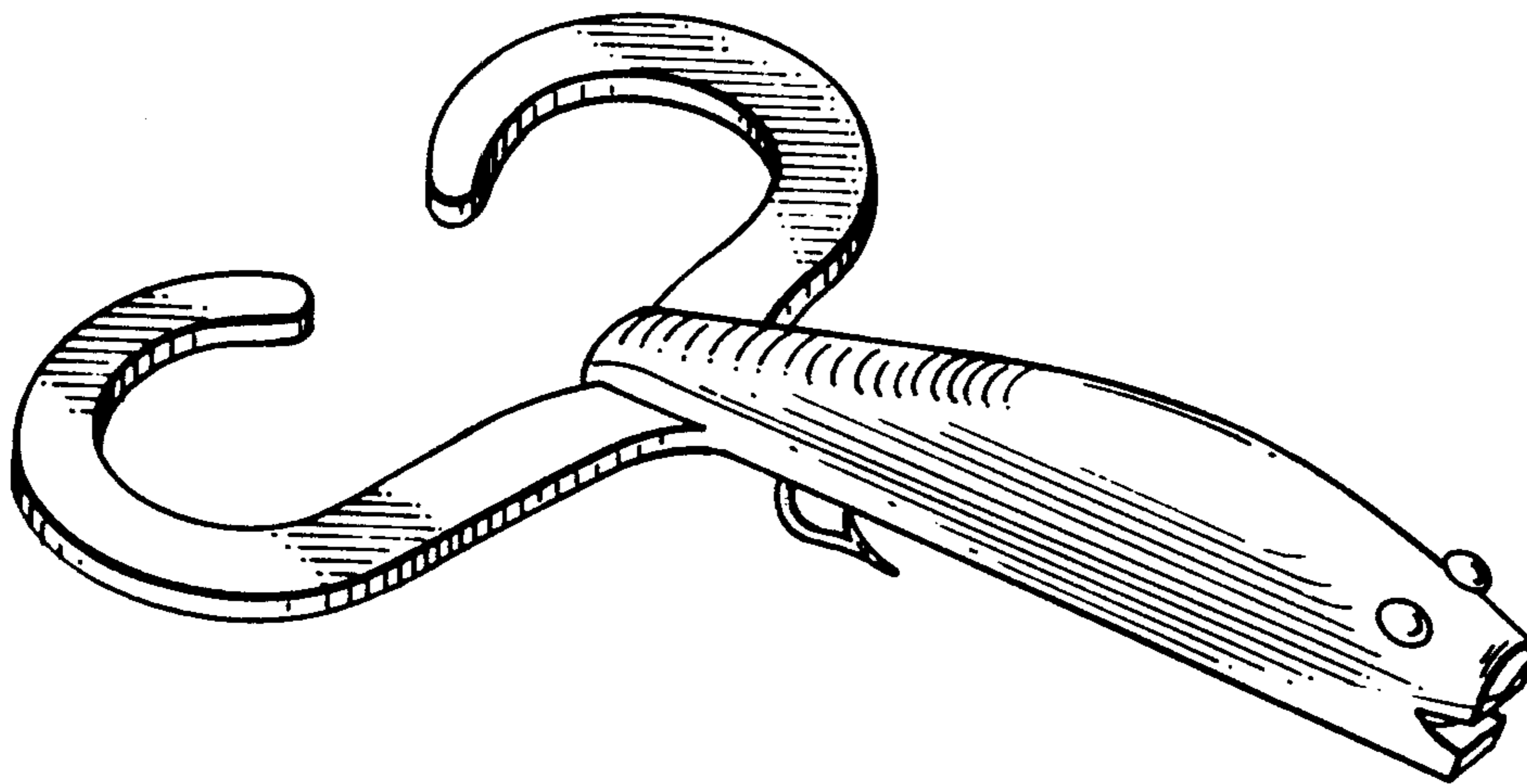

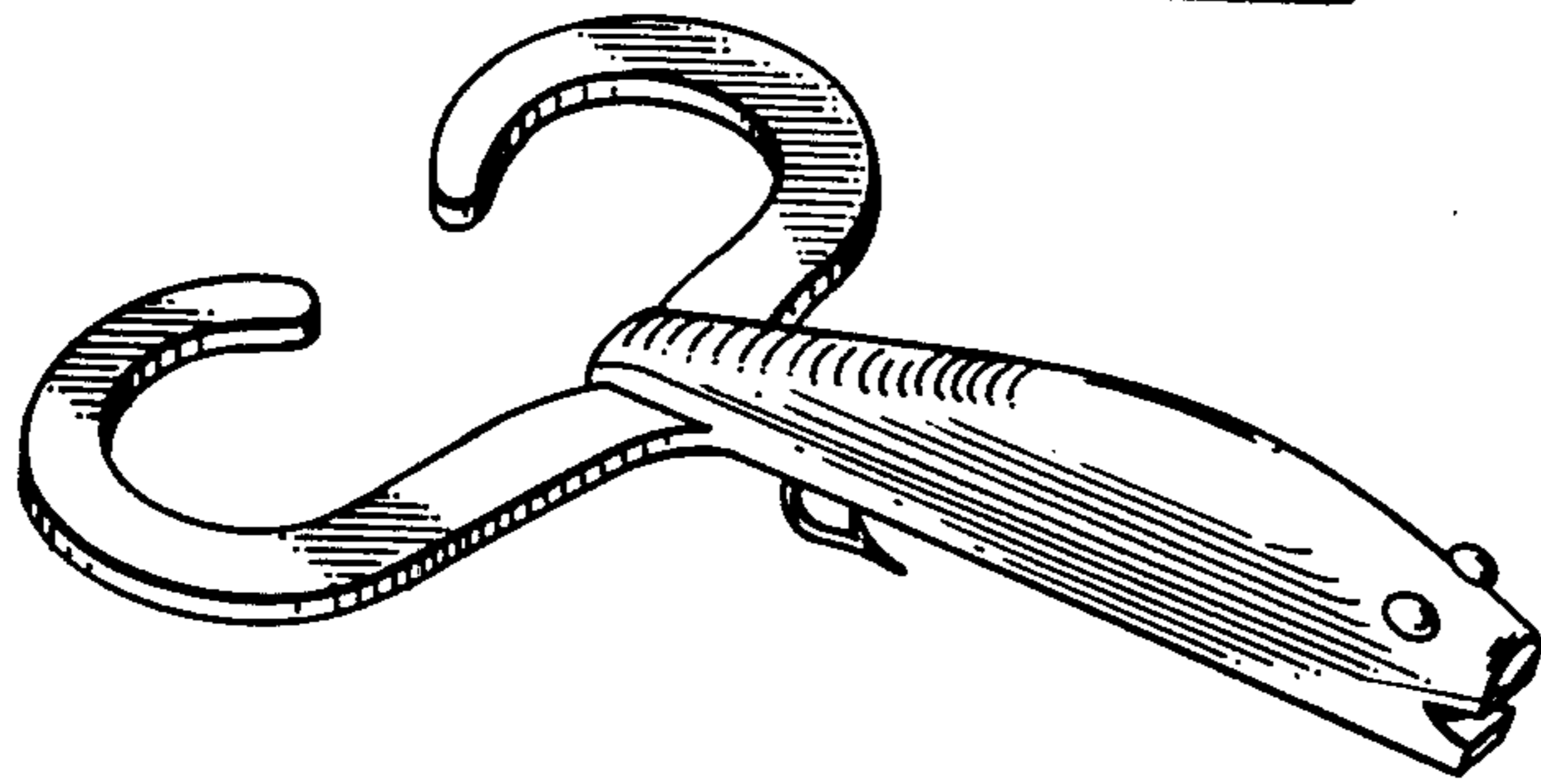

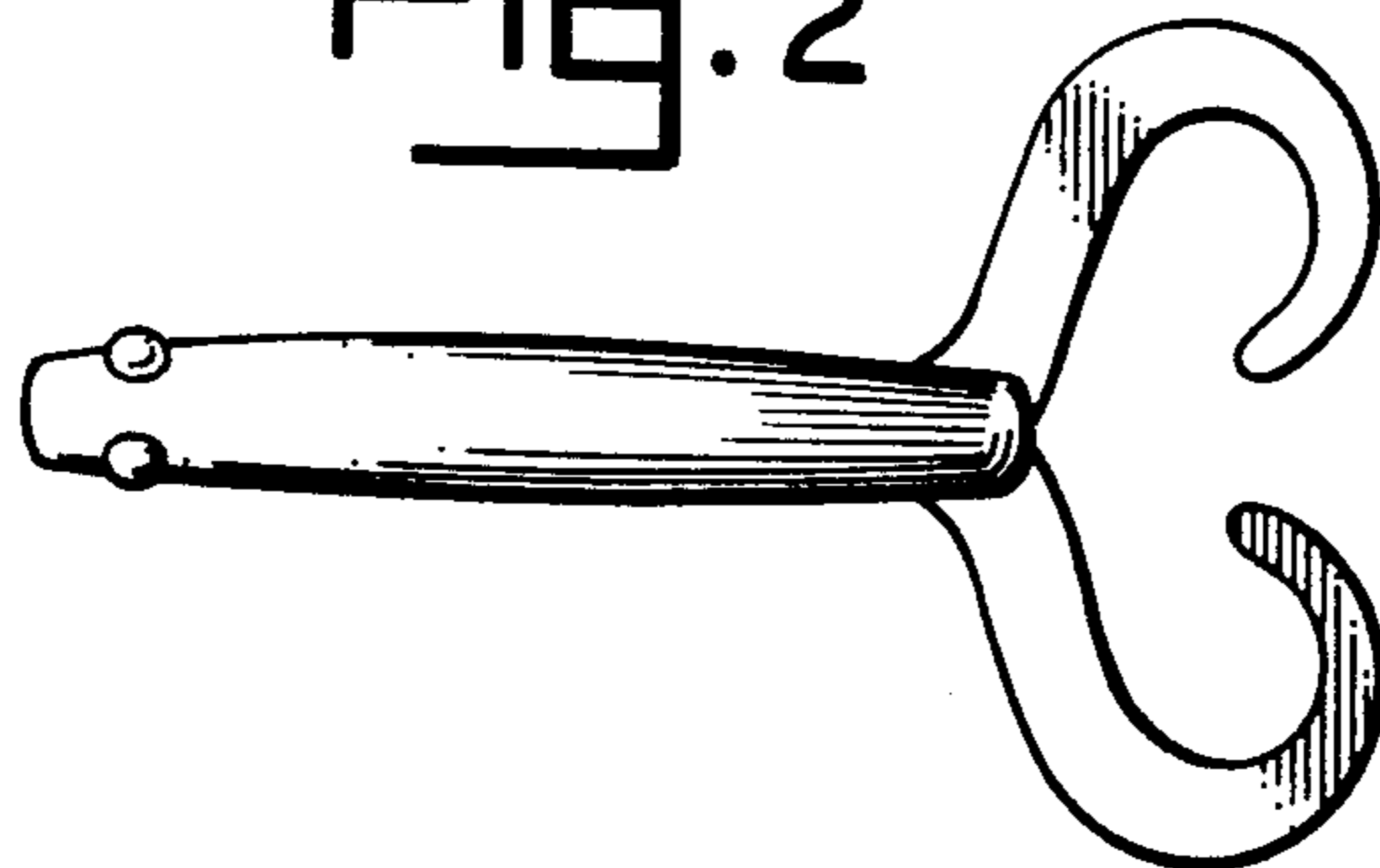

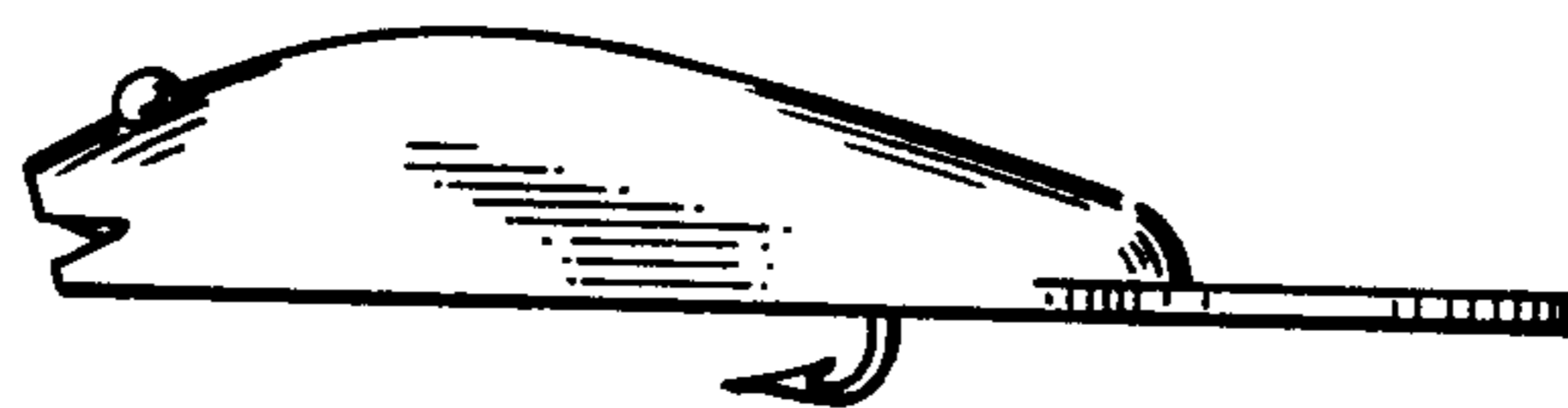

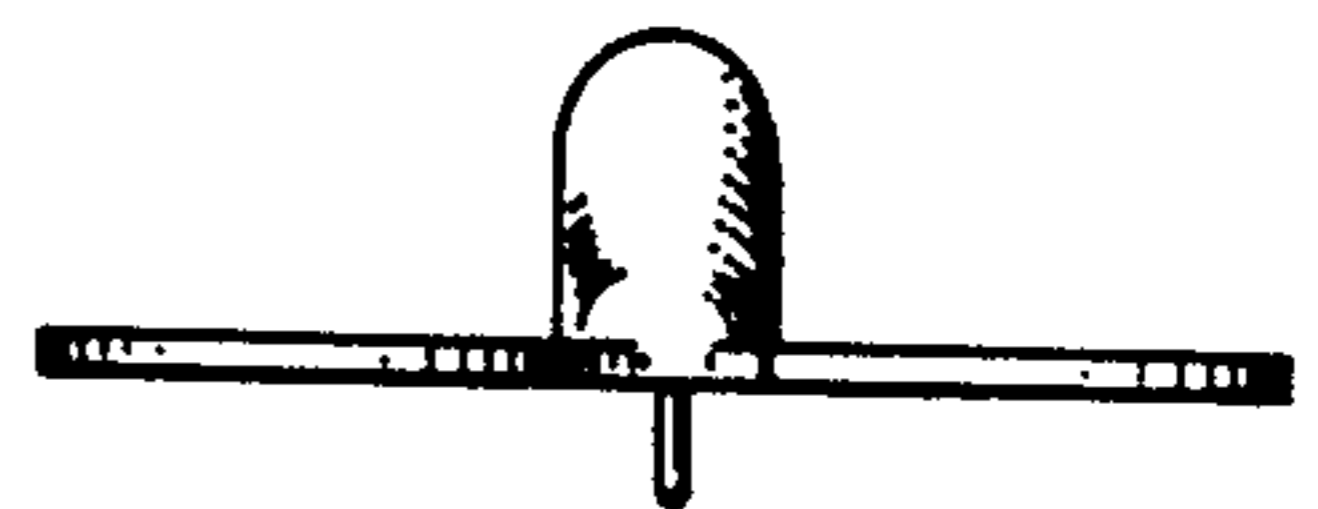
