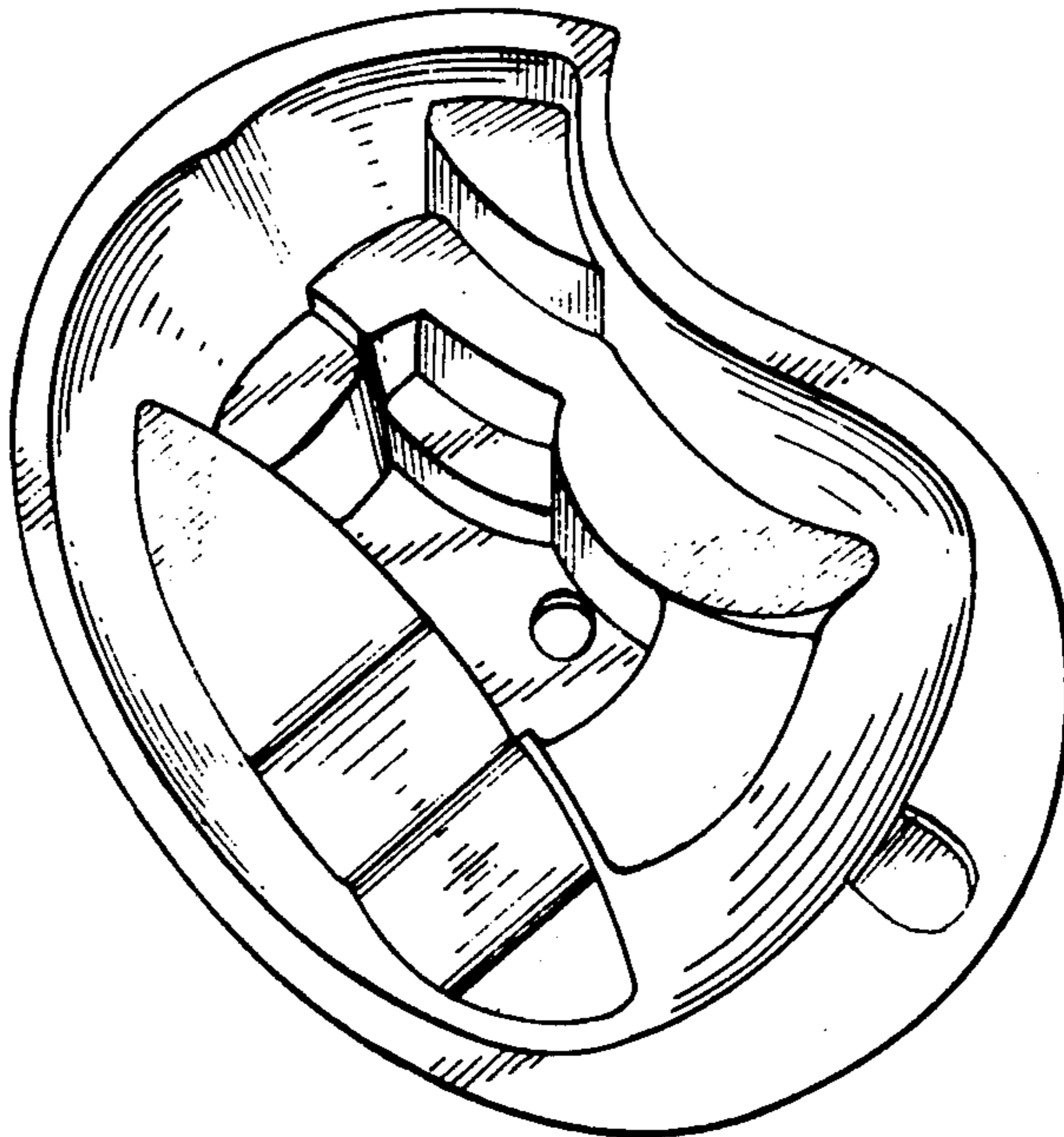

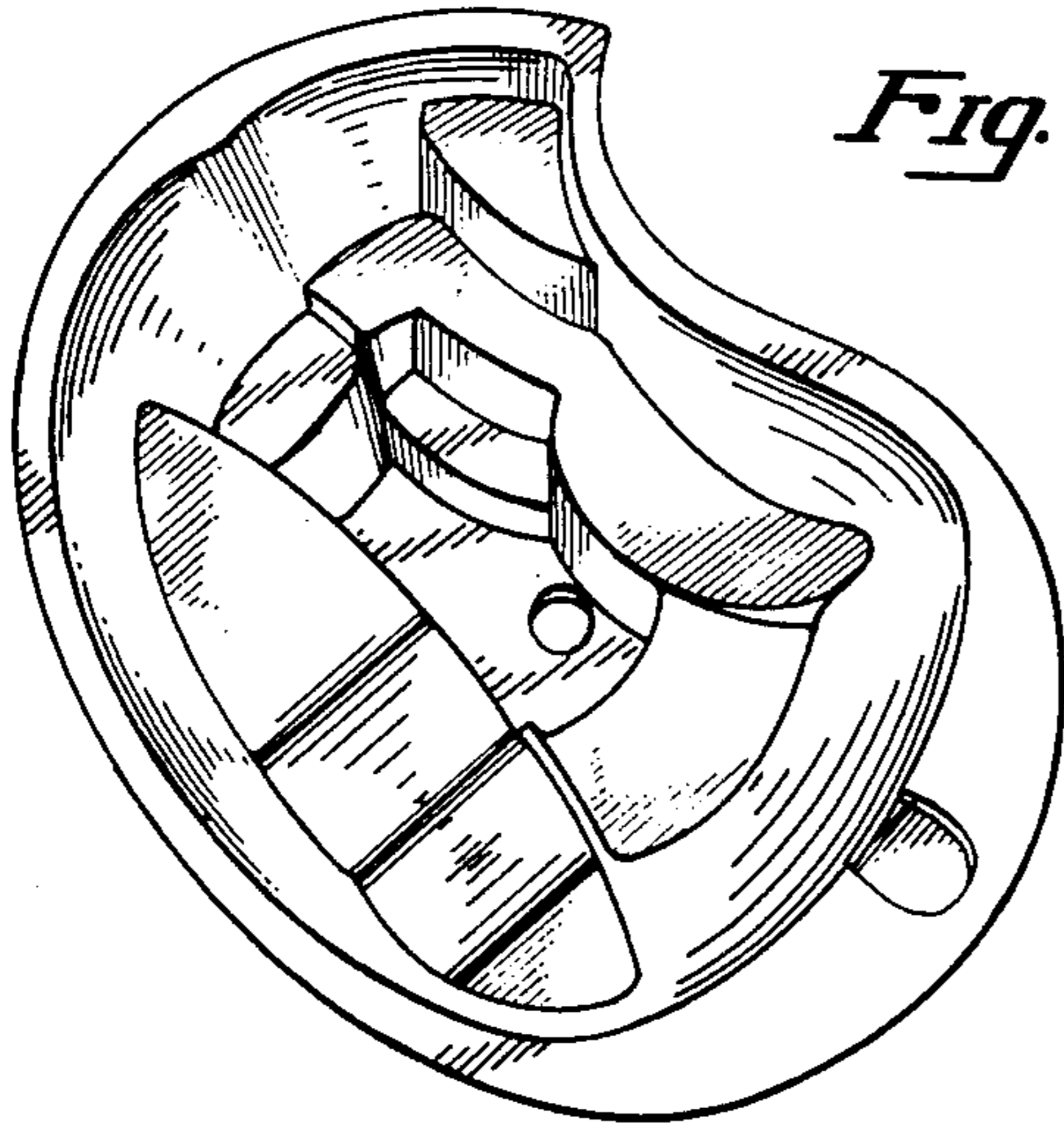
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a Spa hydrotherapy pool, substantially as shown.

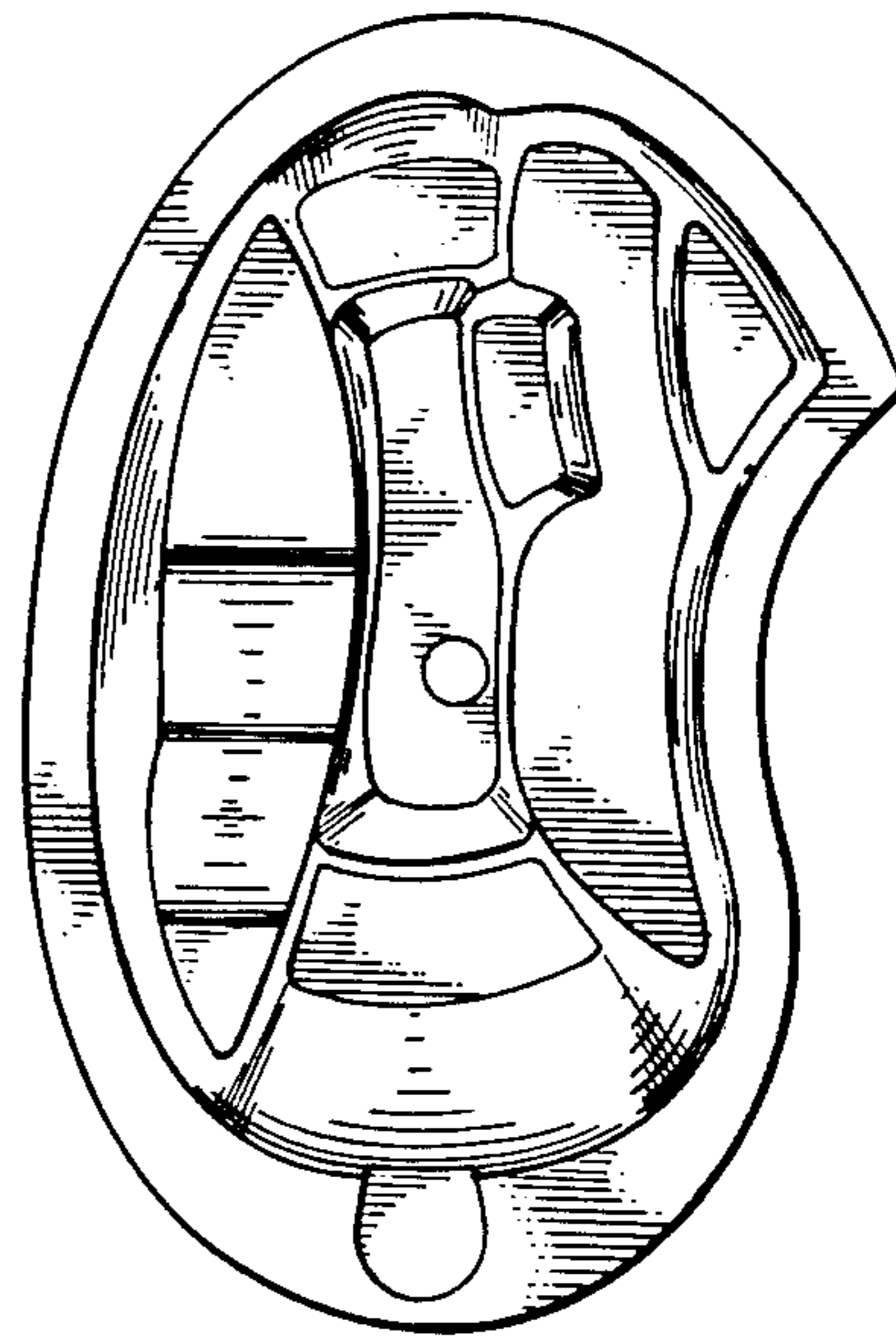
DESCRIPTION

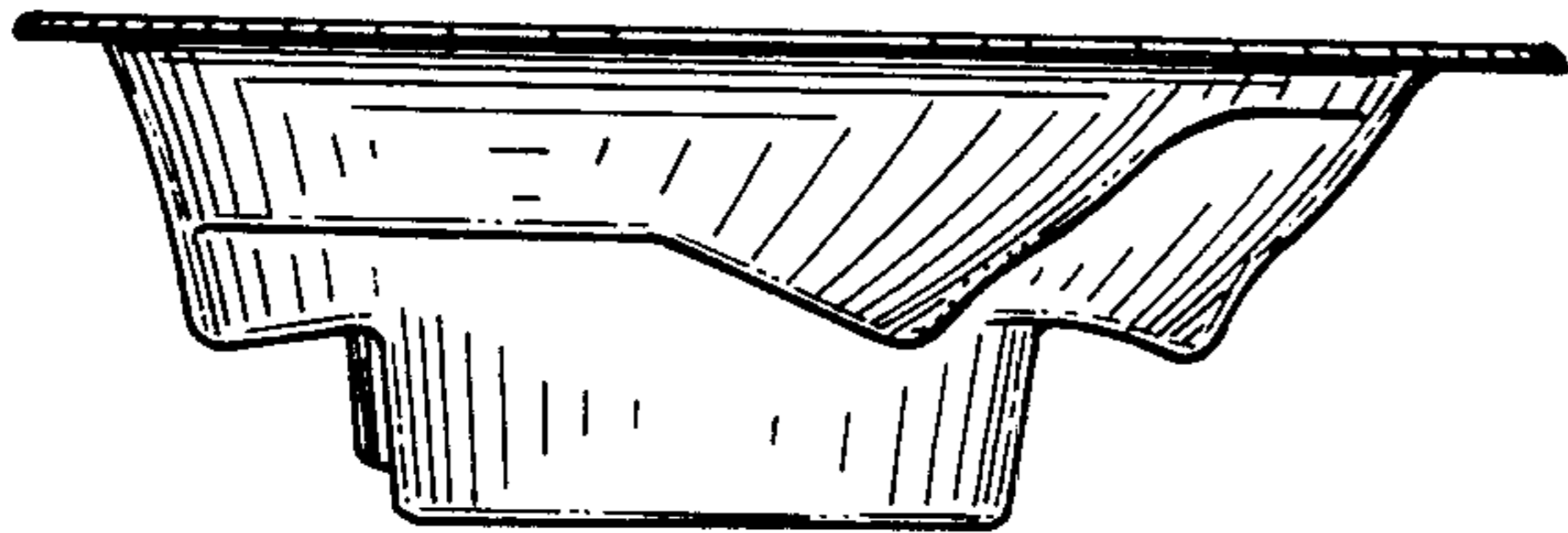

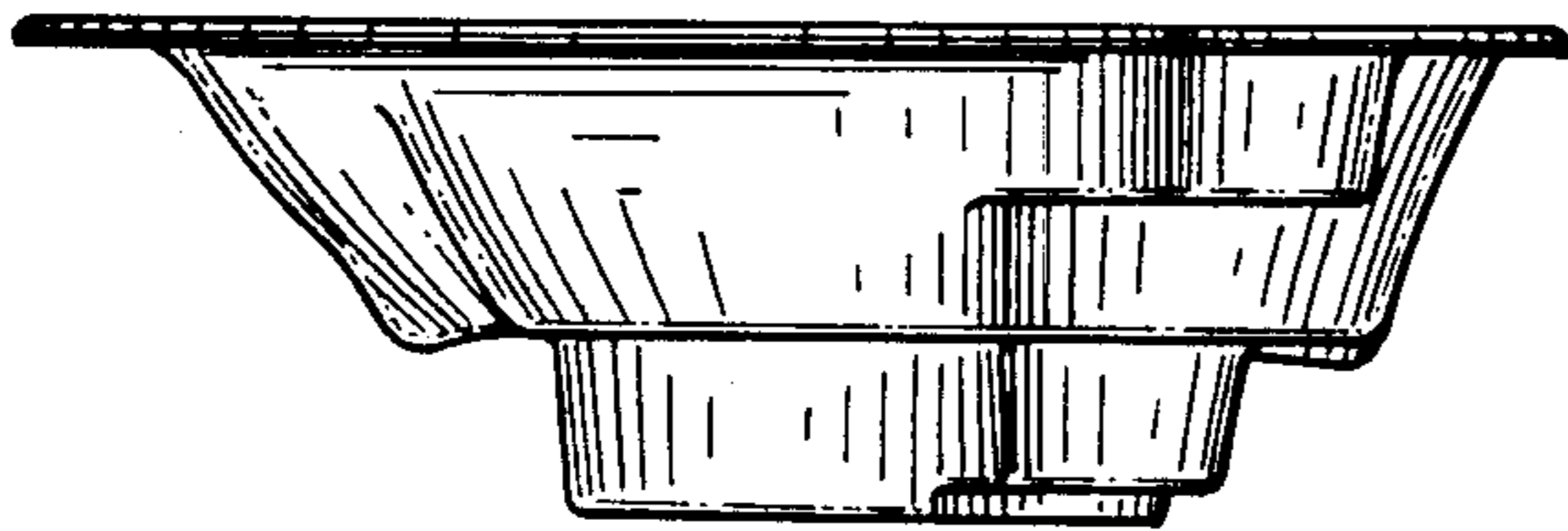
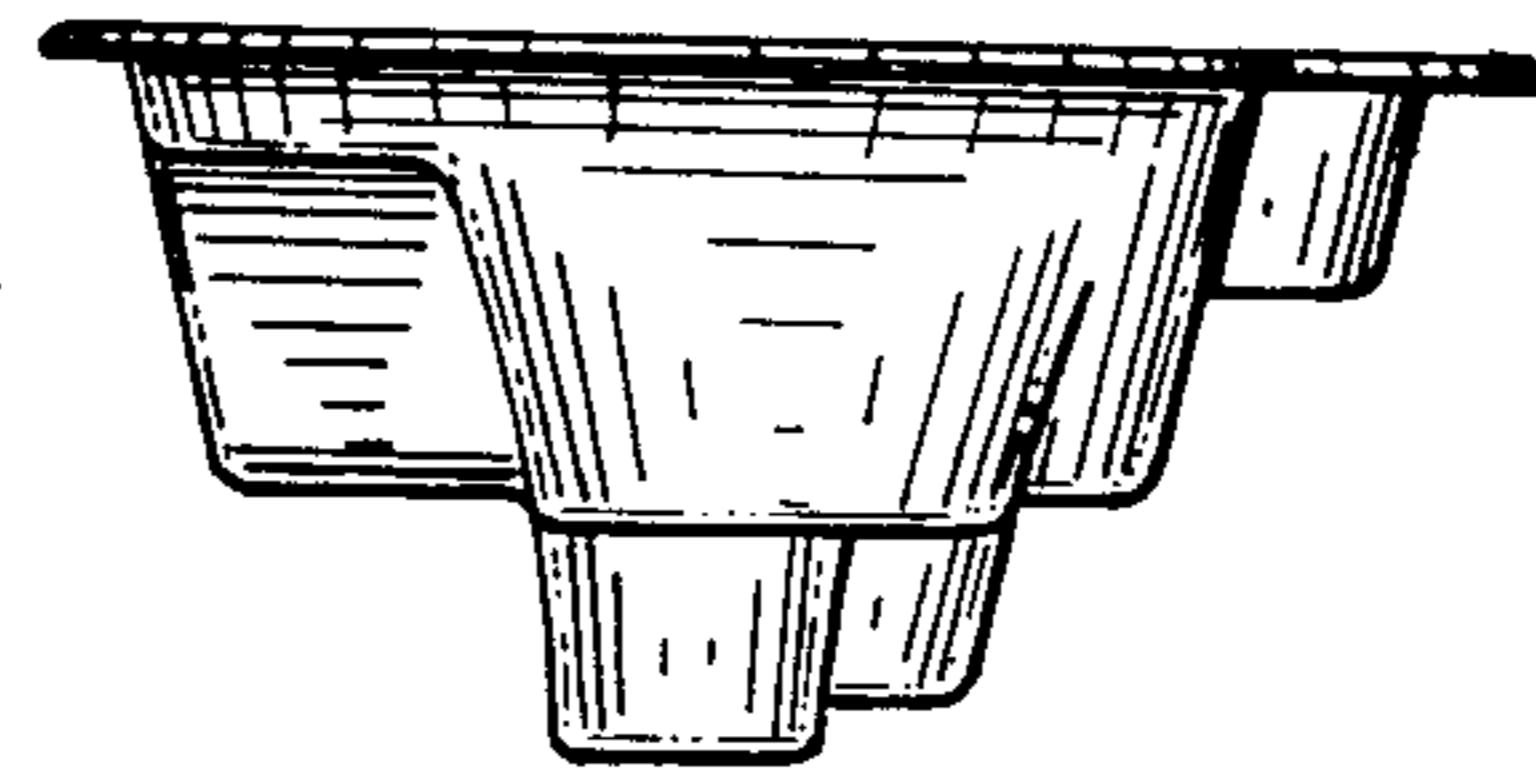

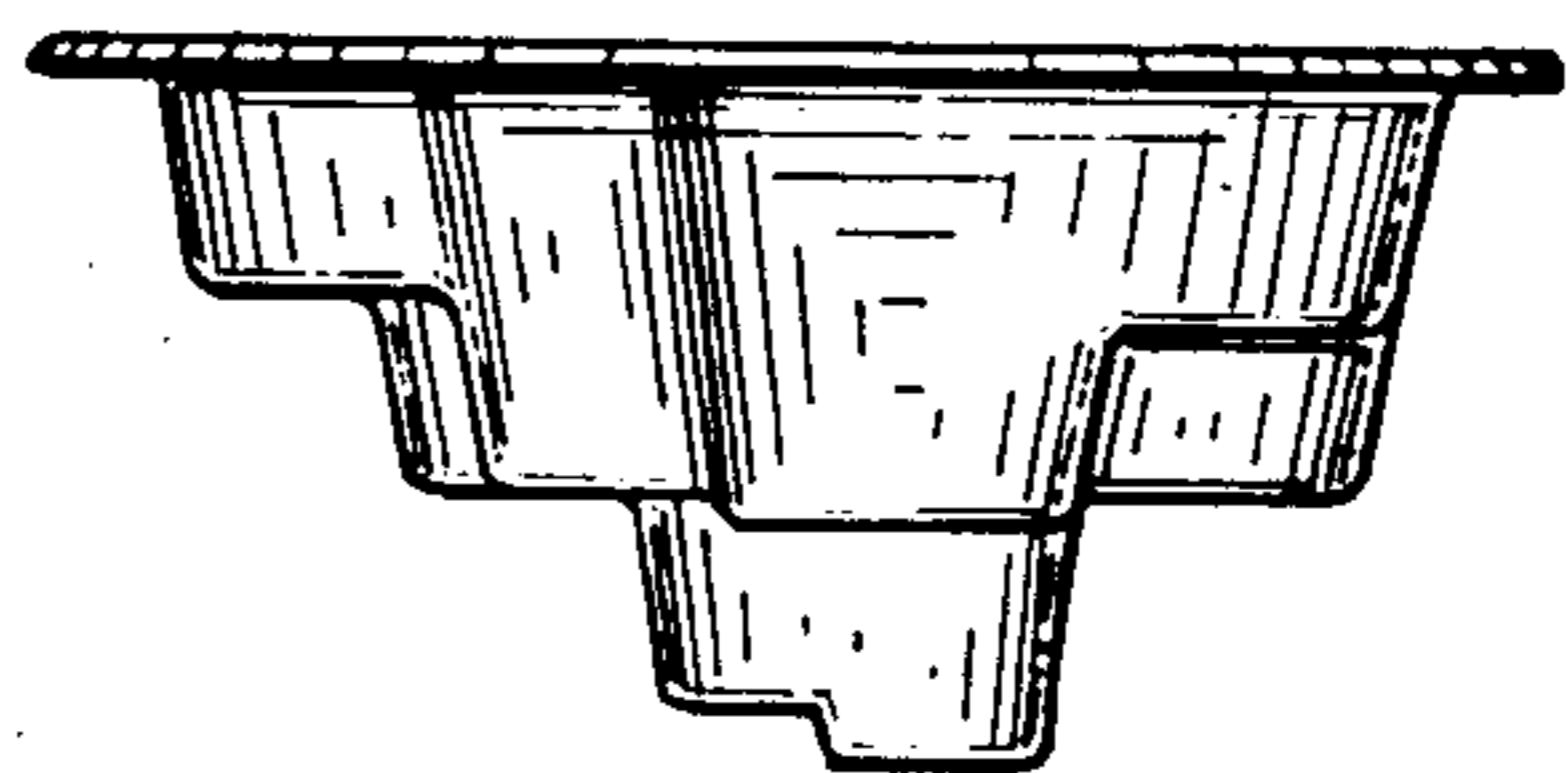
