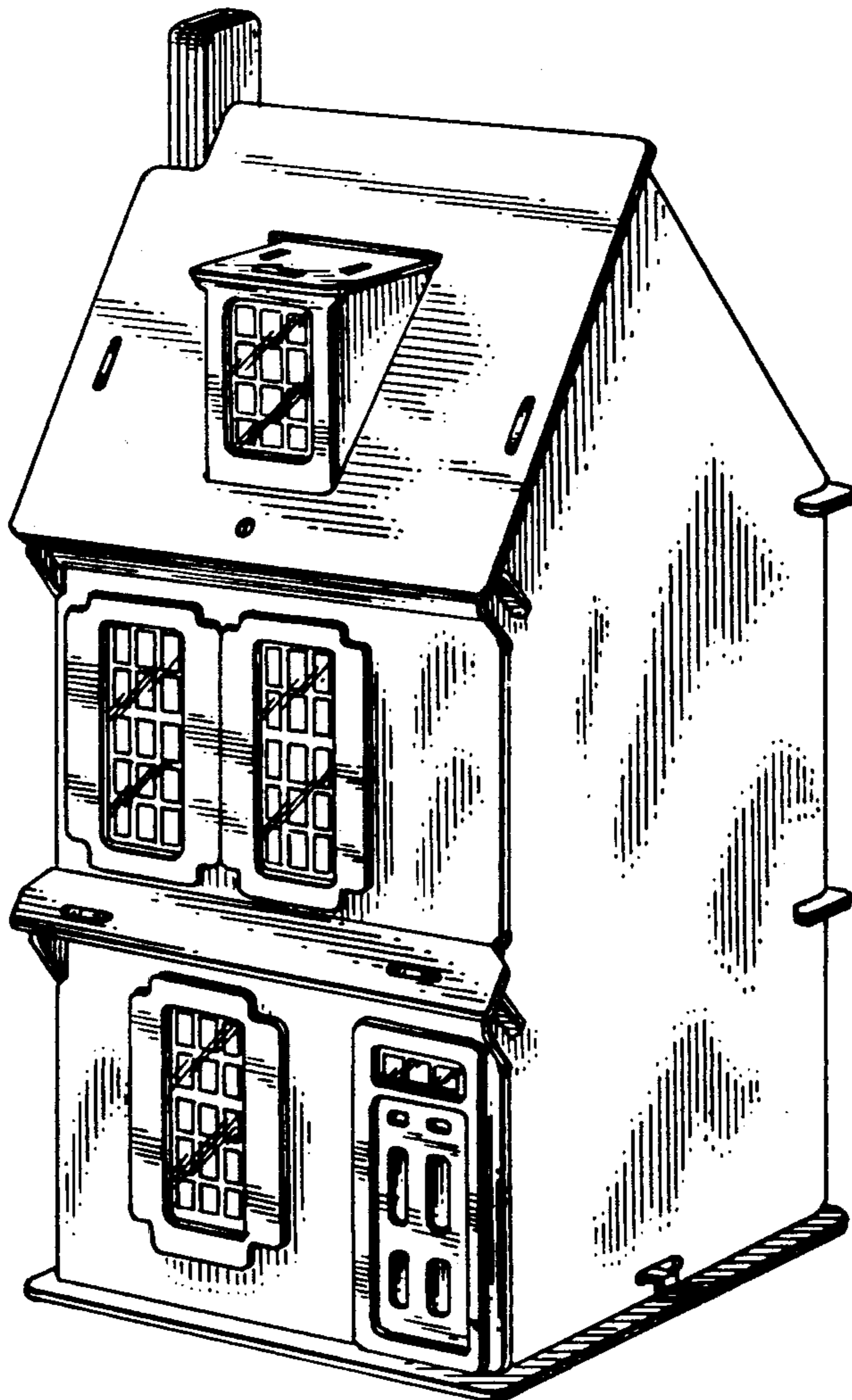

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy house showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



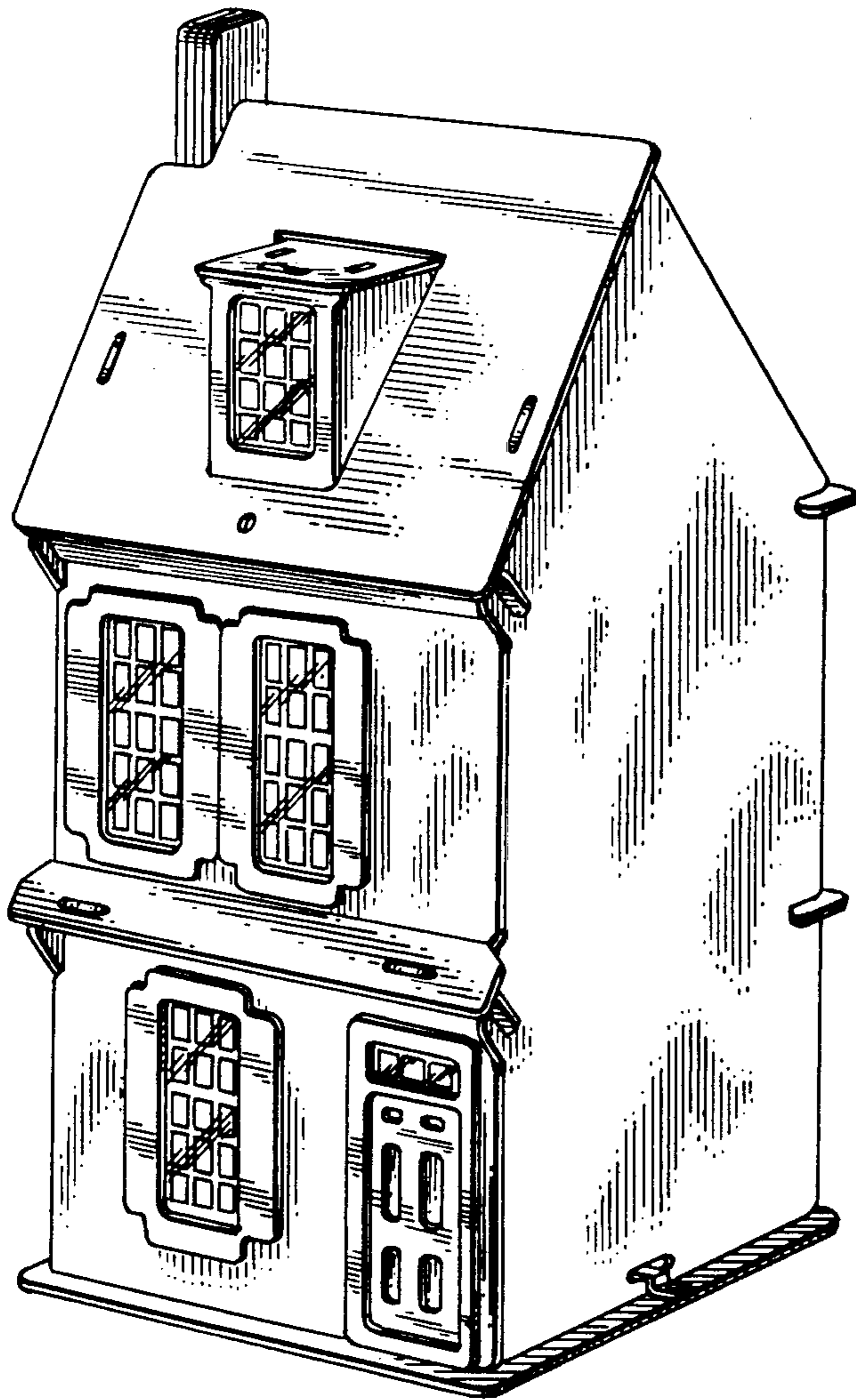

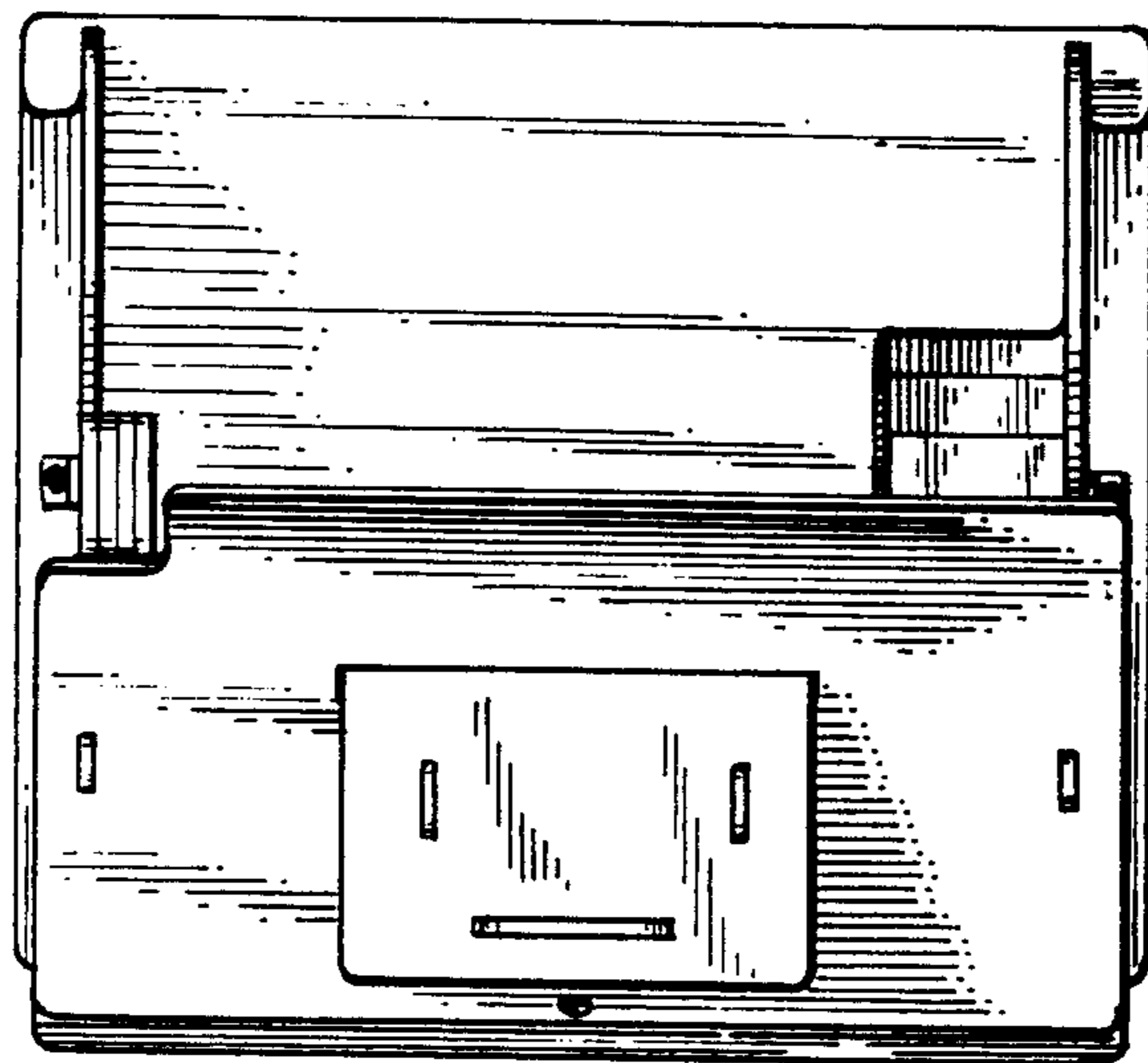

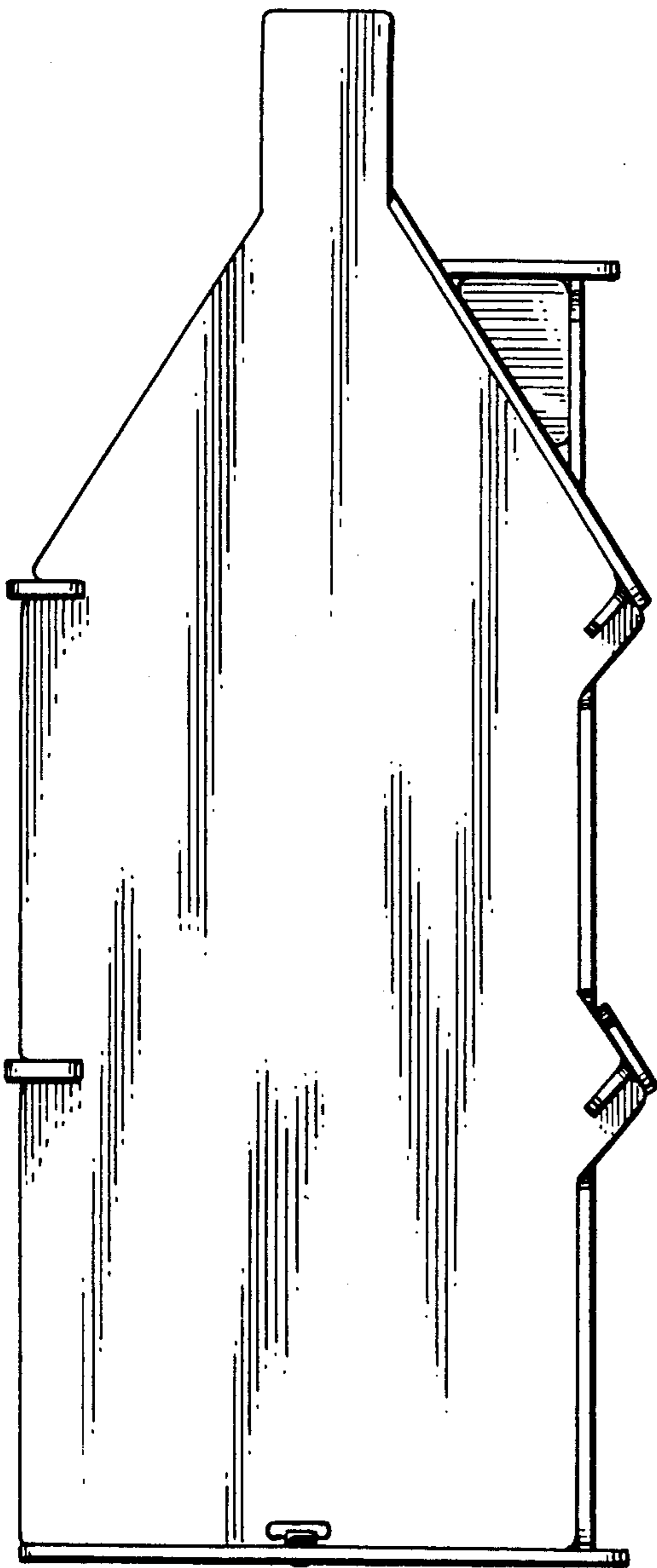

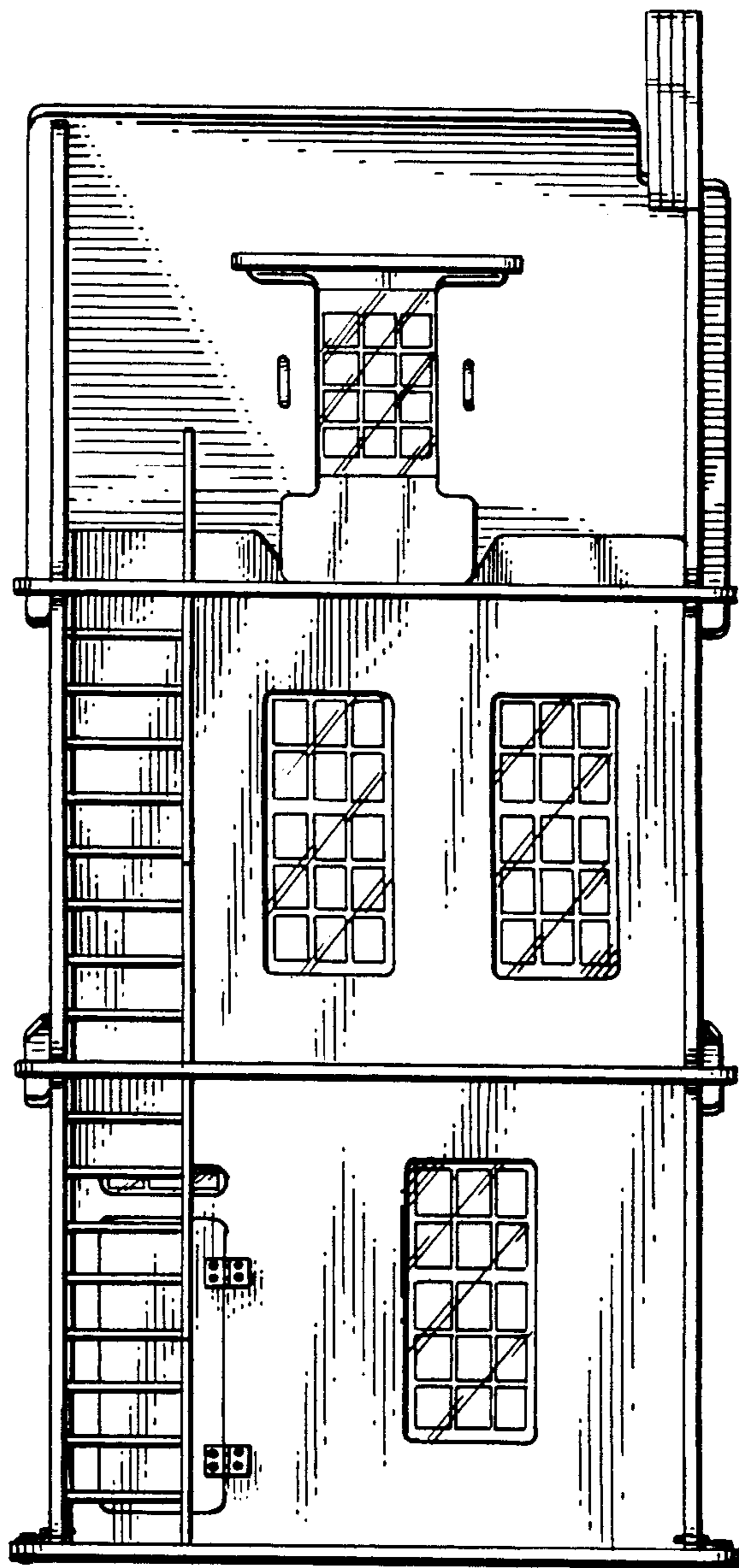

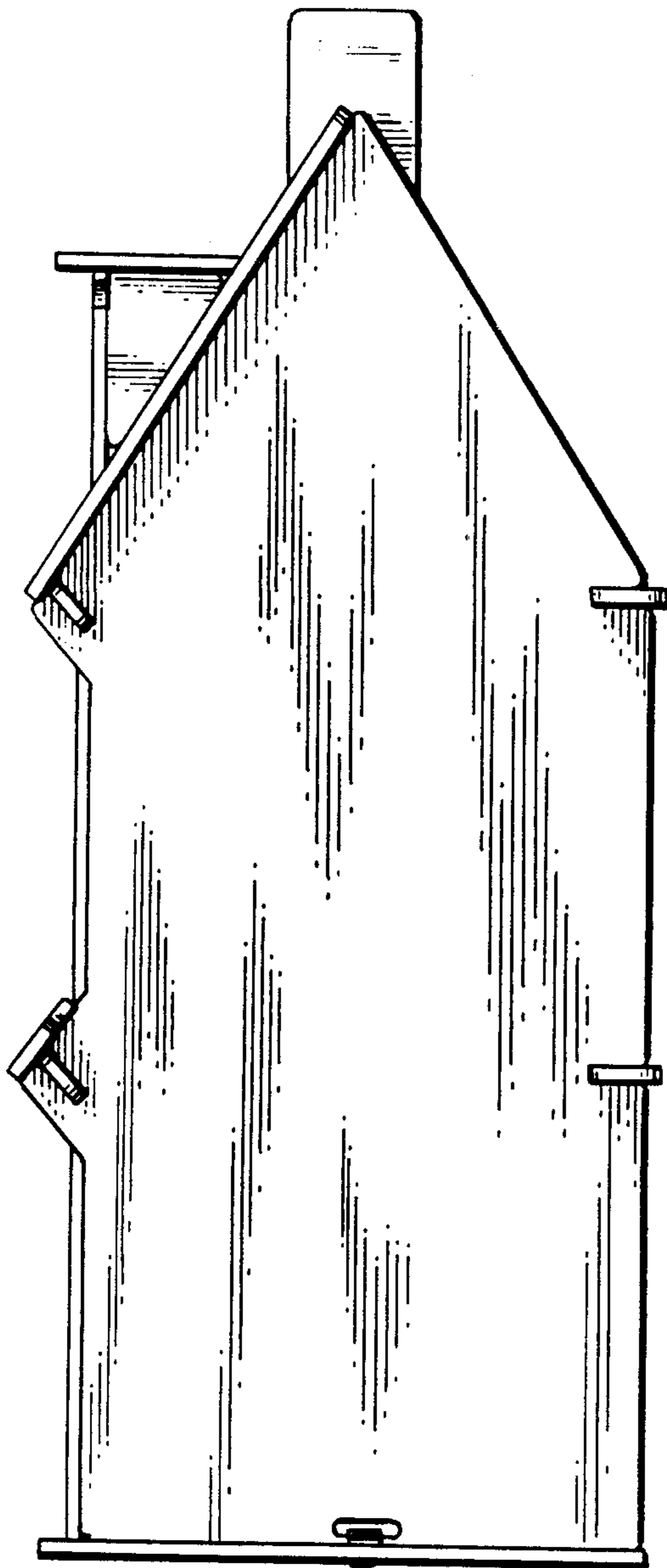
