DESCRIPTION

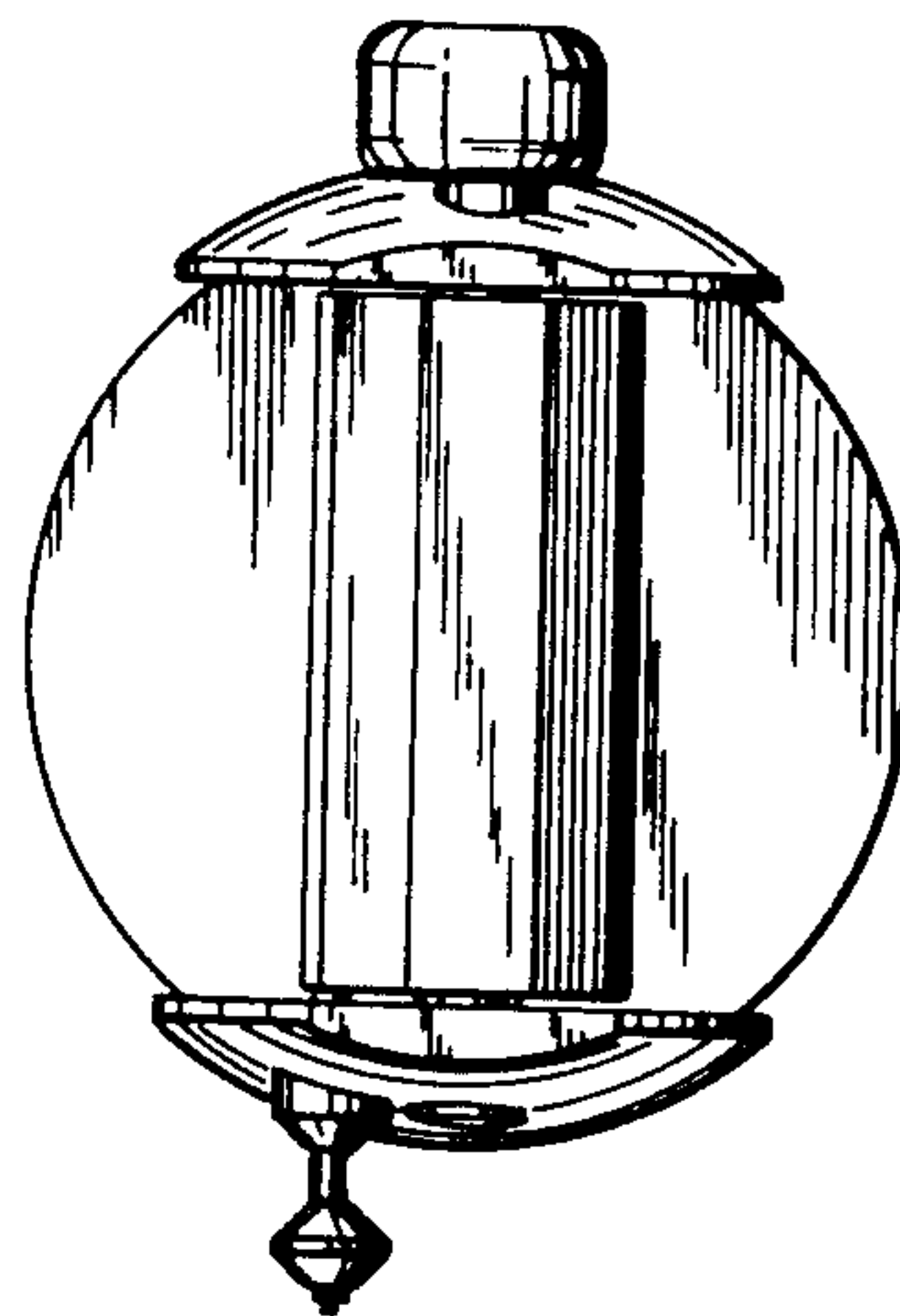
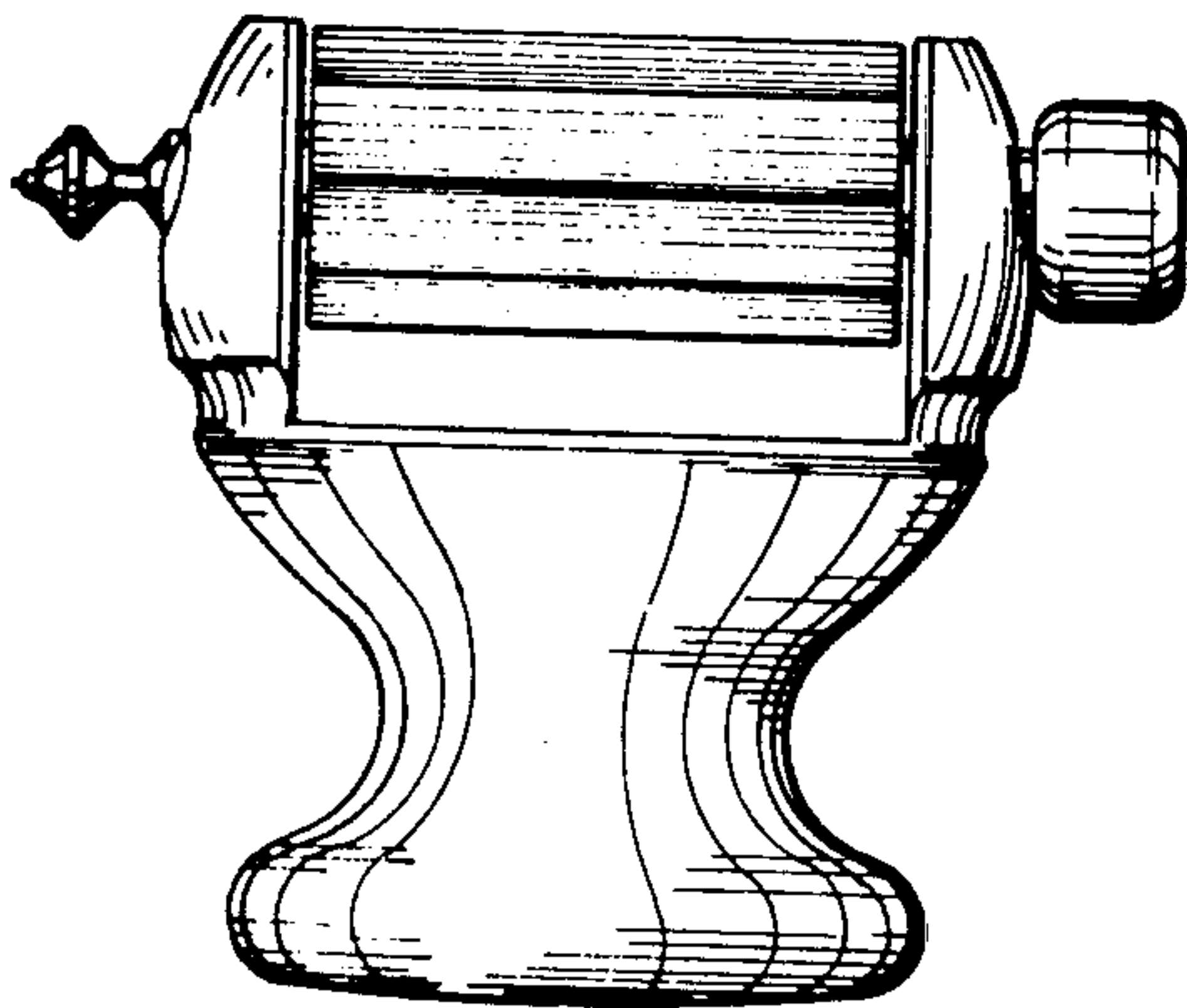
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a rubber stamp showing our new design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the rubber stamp.



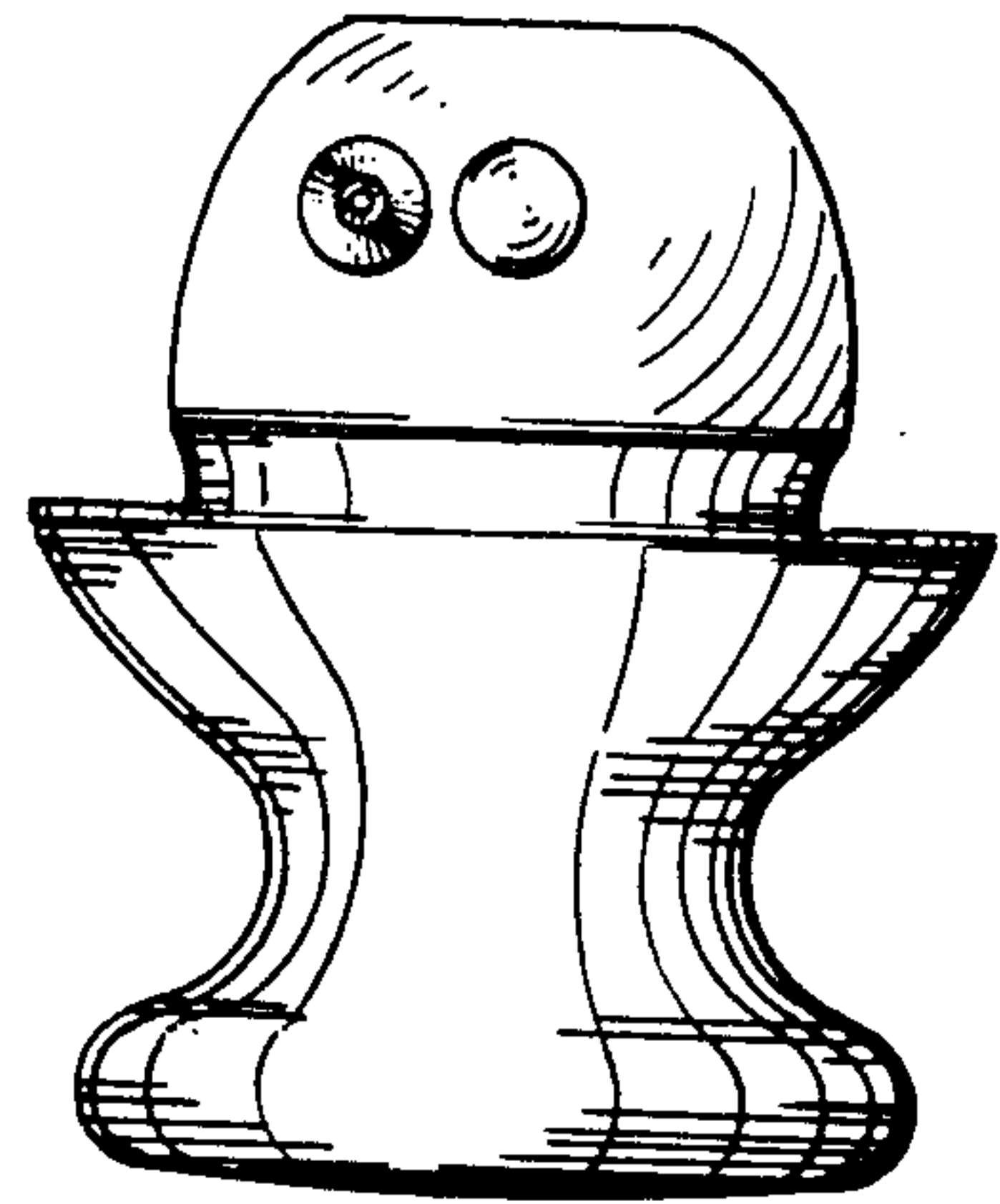

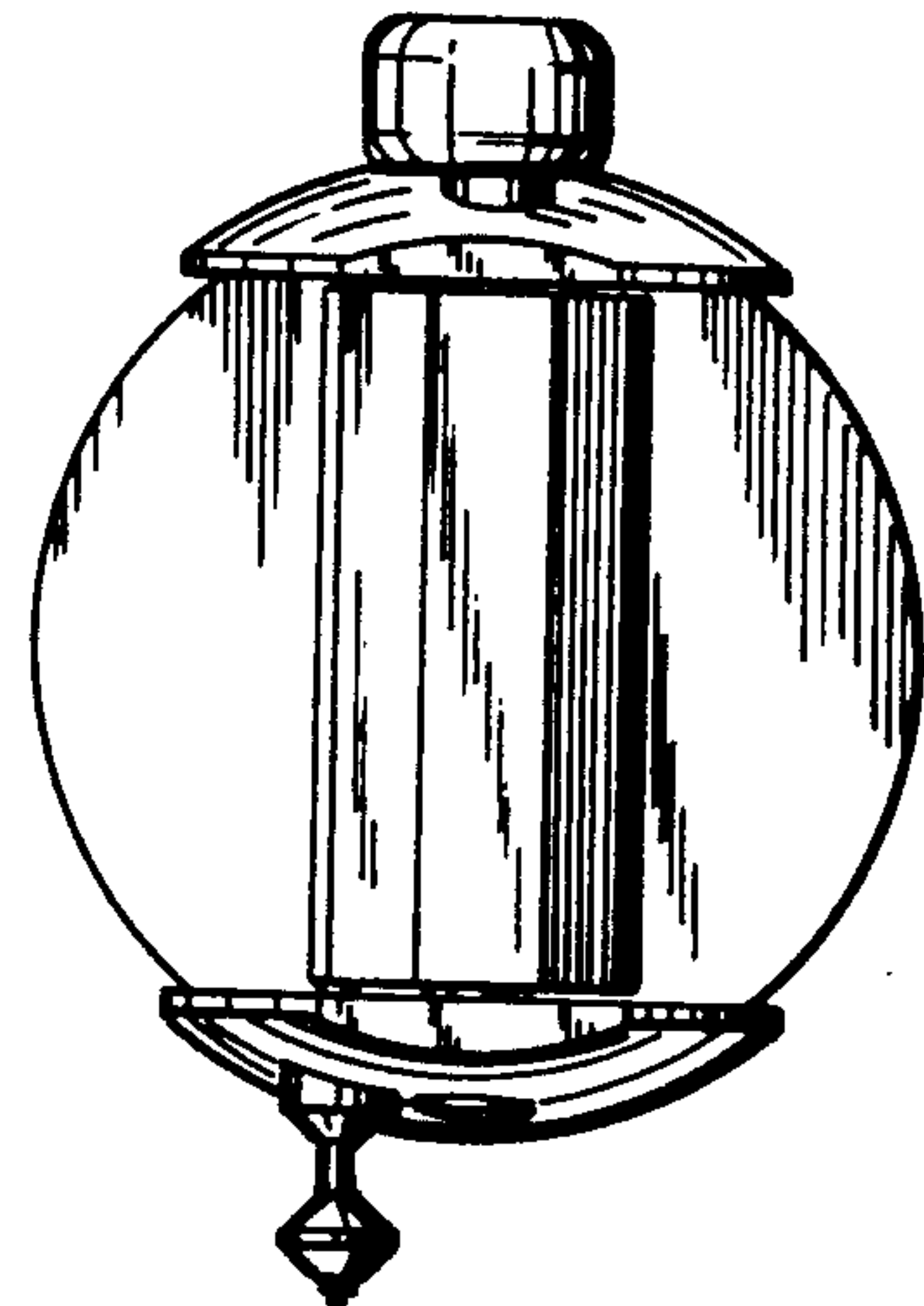
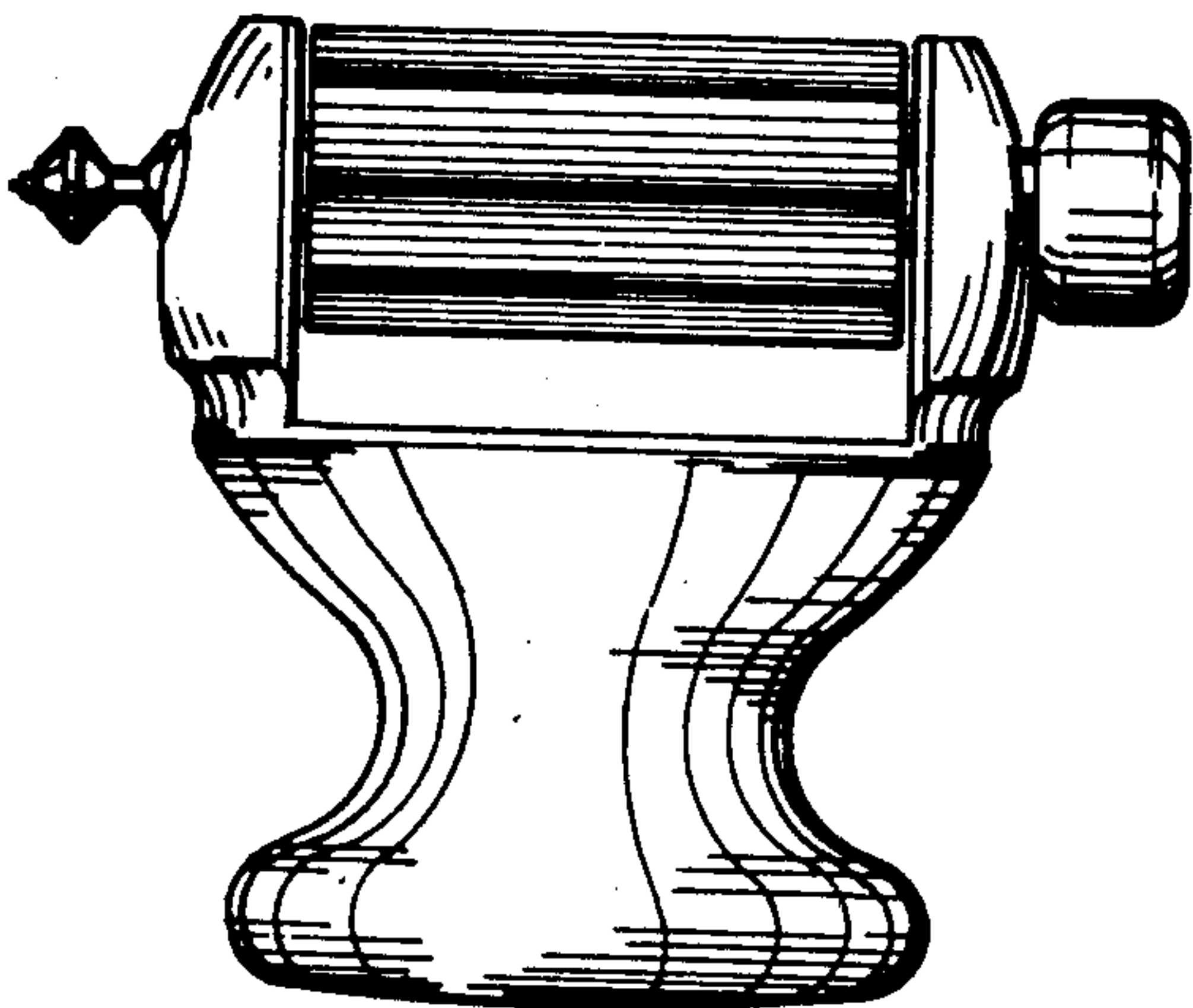

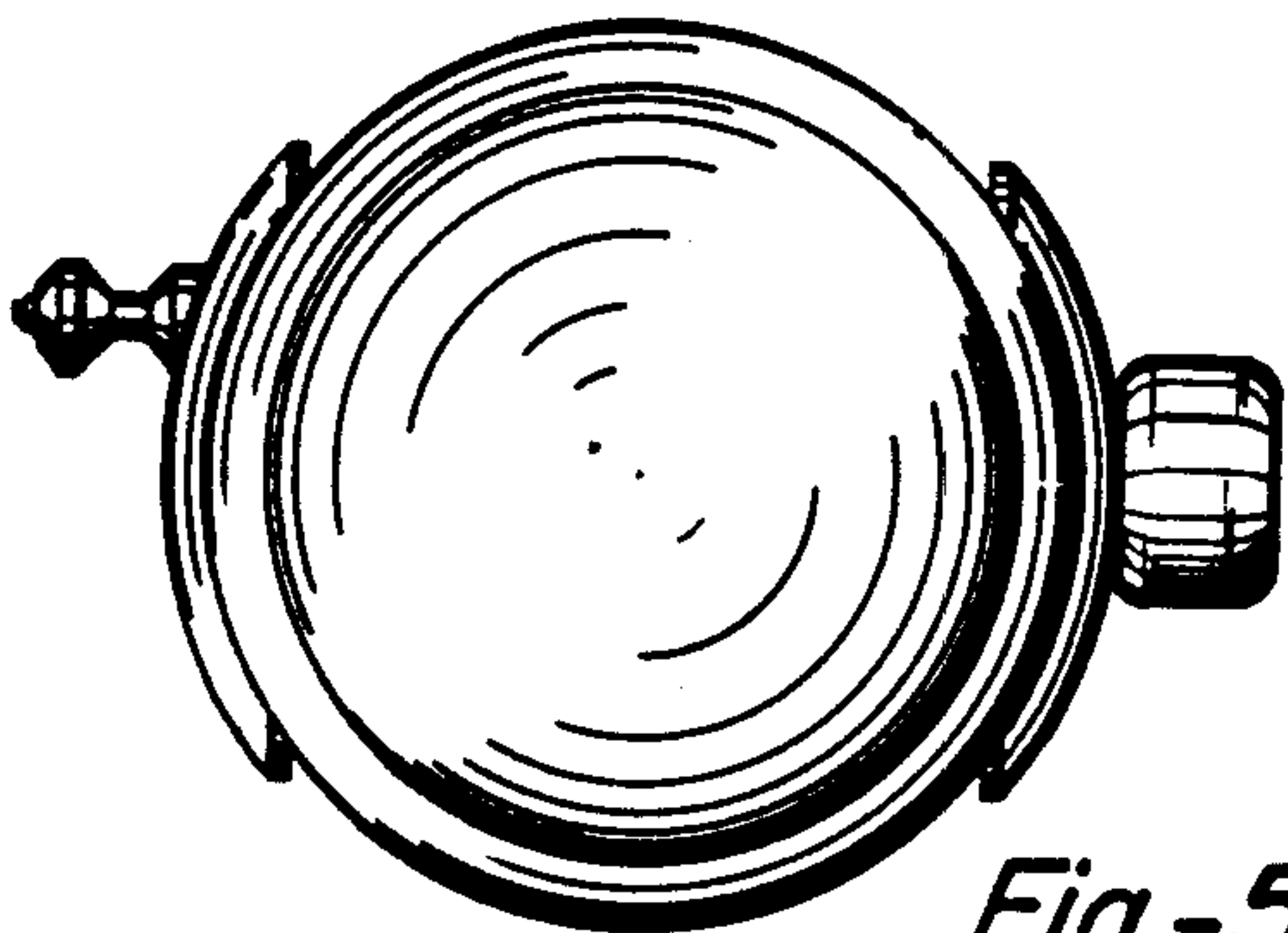
