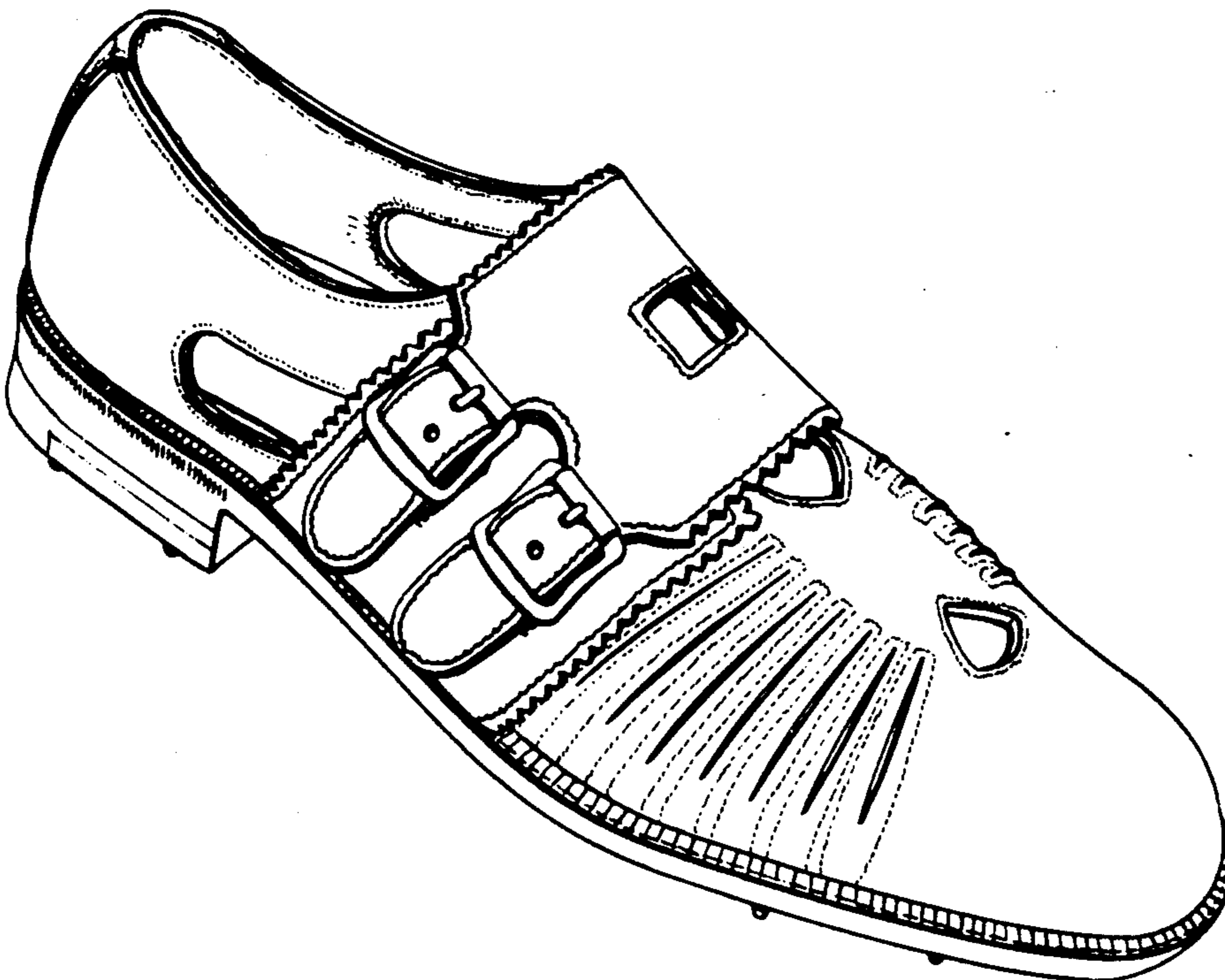

The ornamental design for sports shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a sports shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top and right front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left rear perspective view thereof with the shoe unfastened;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof with the shoe unfastened.



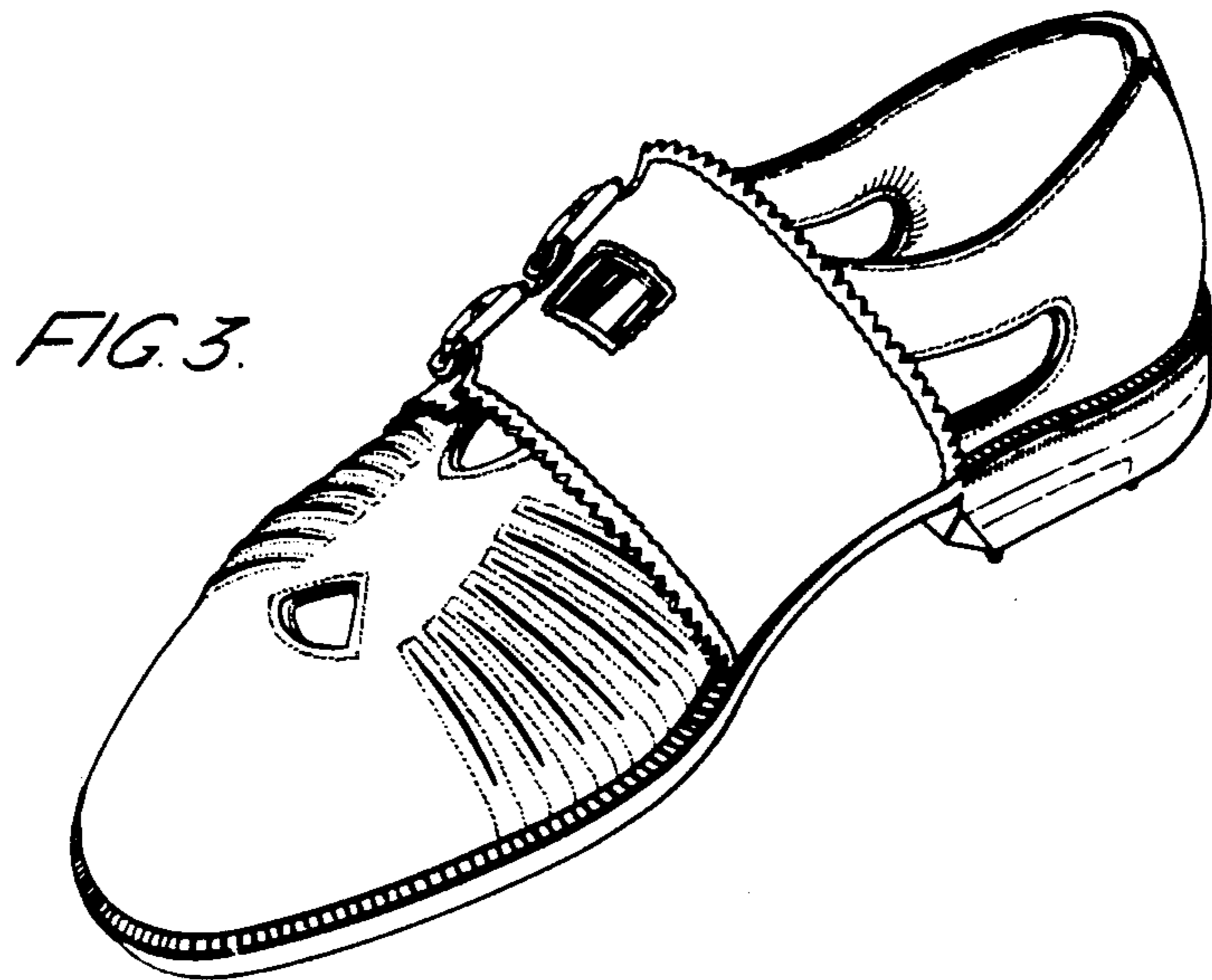
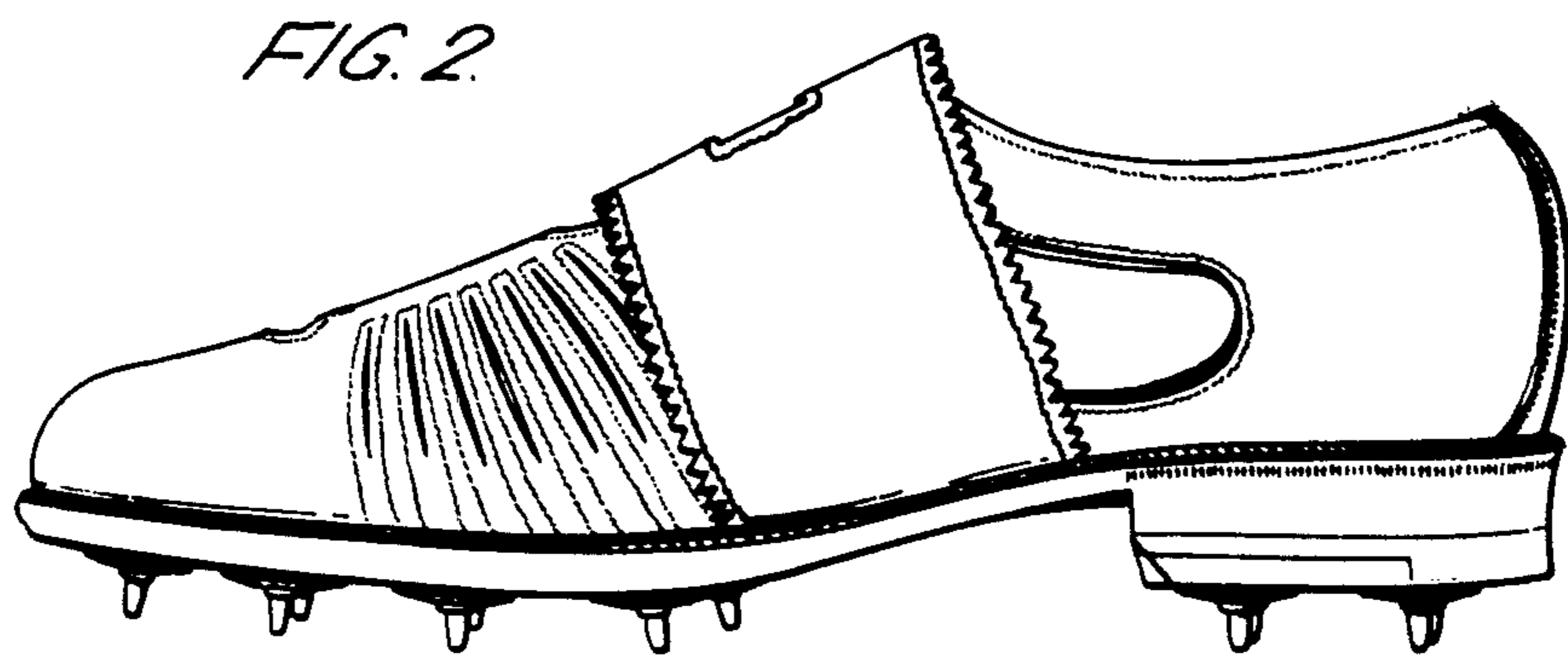
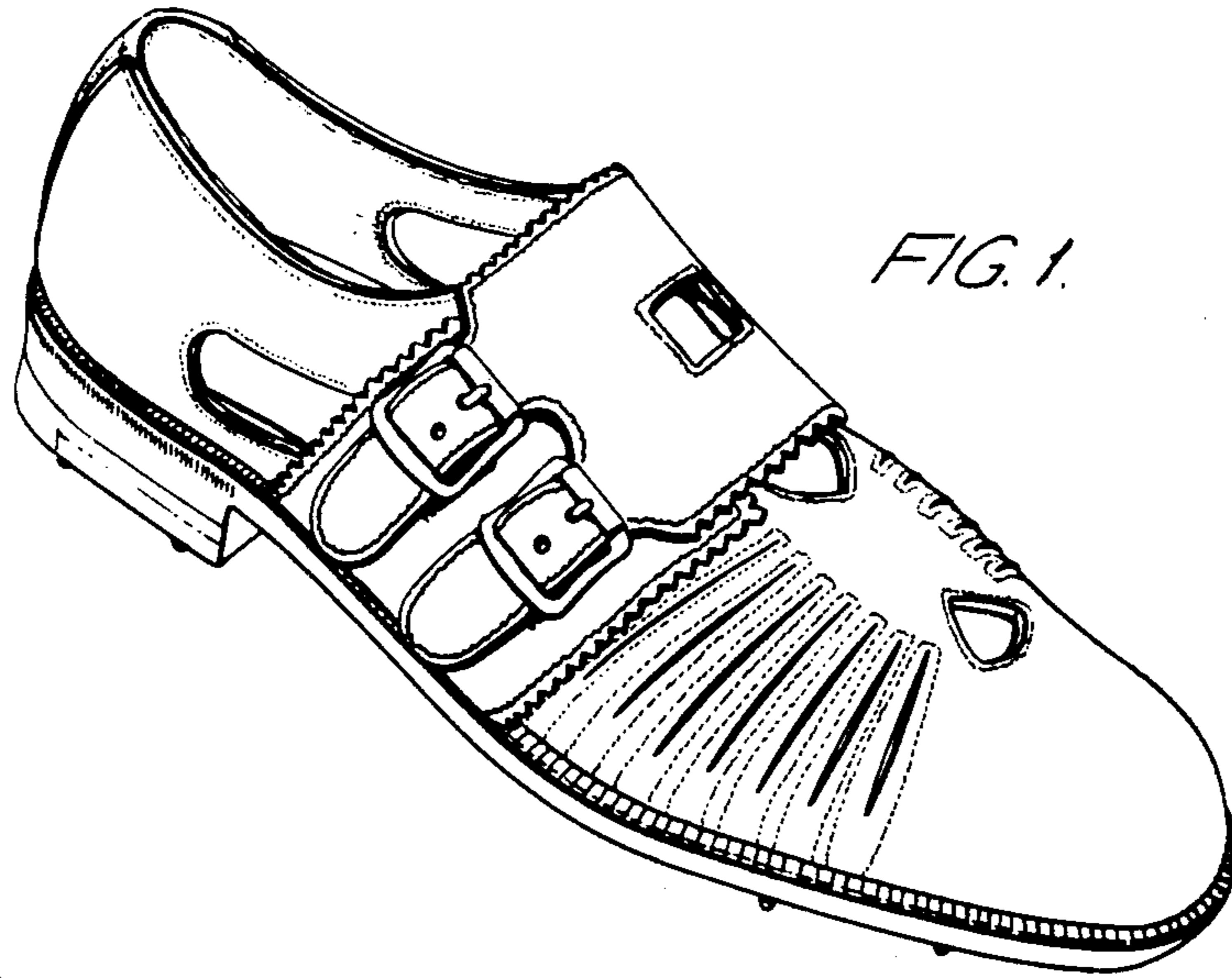

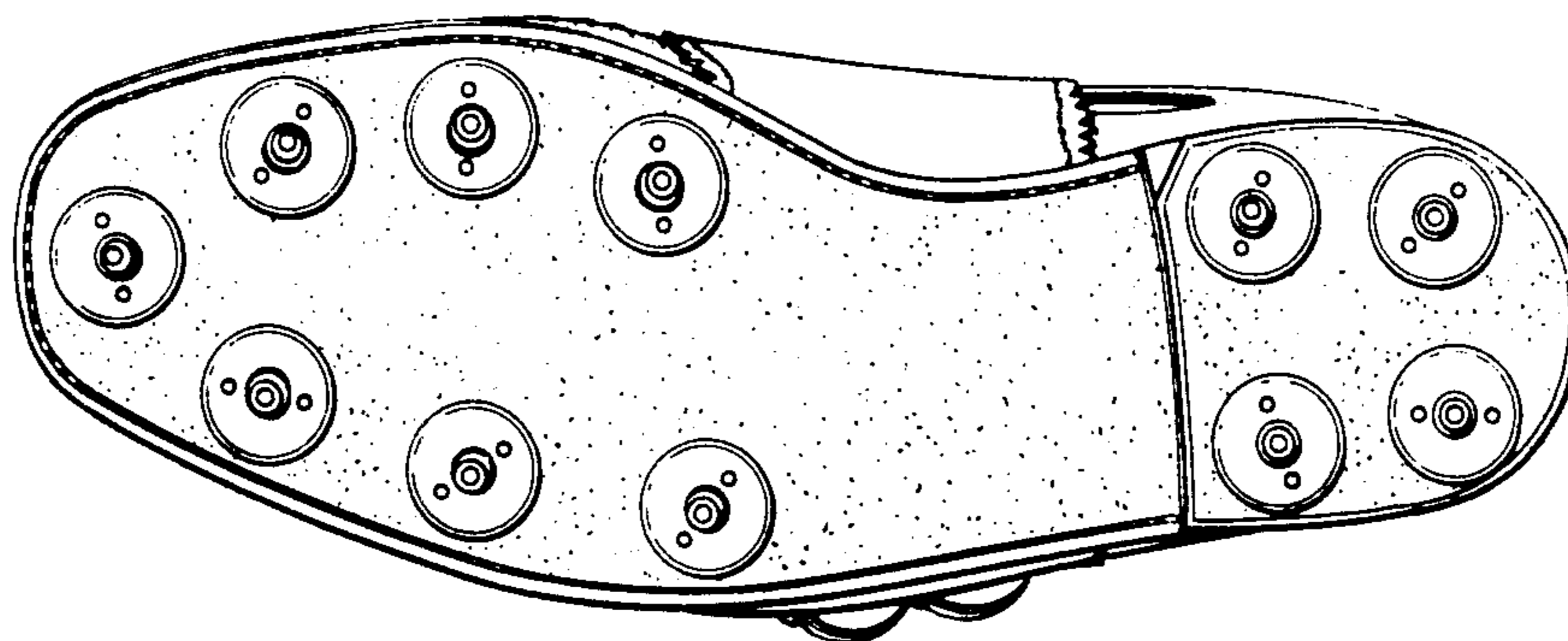

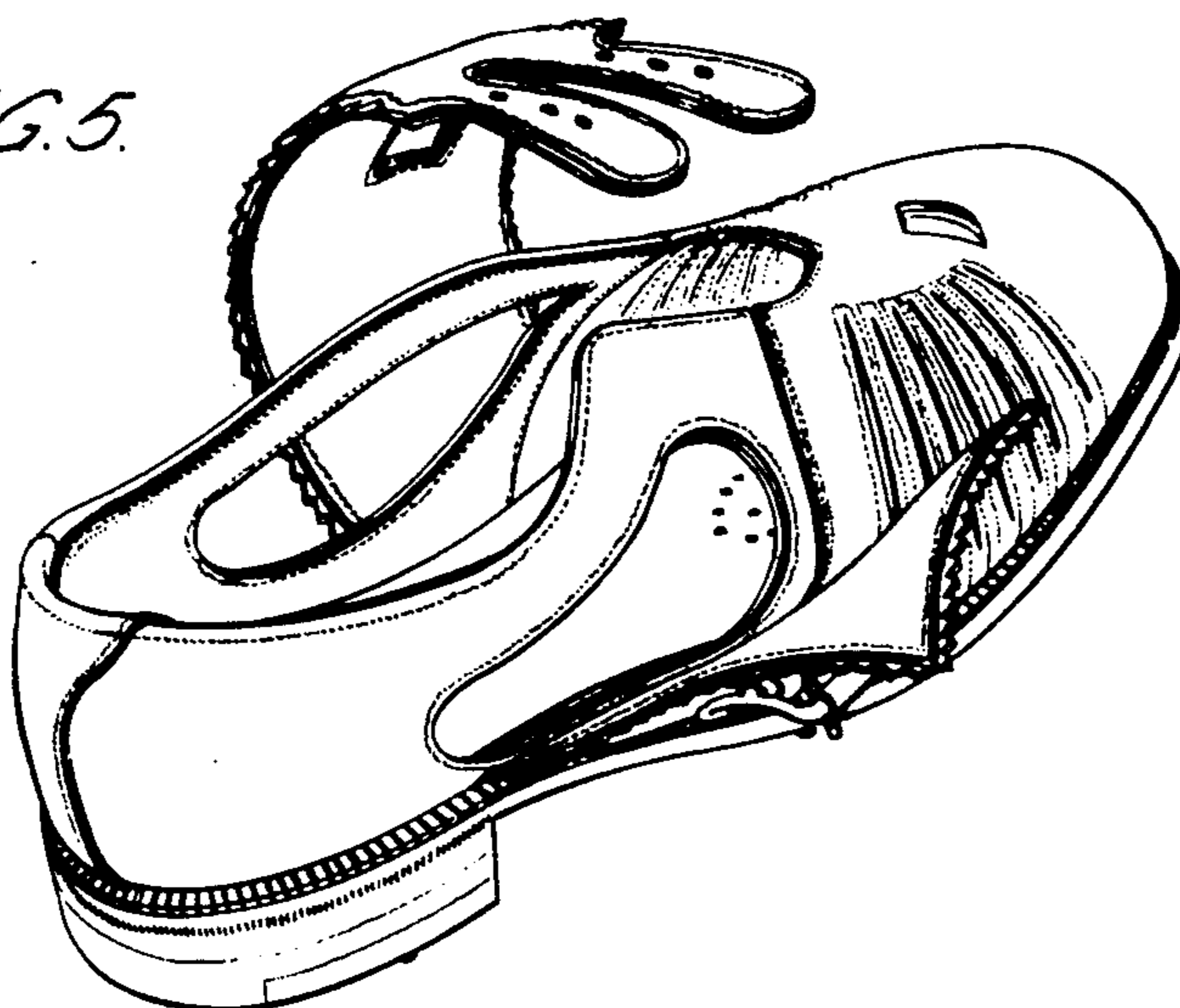
