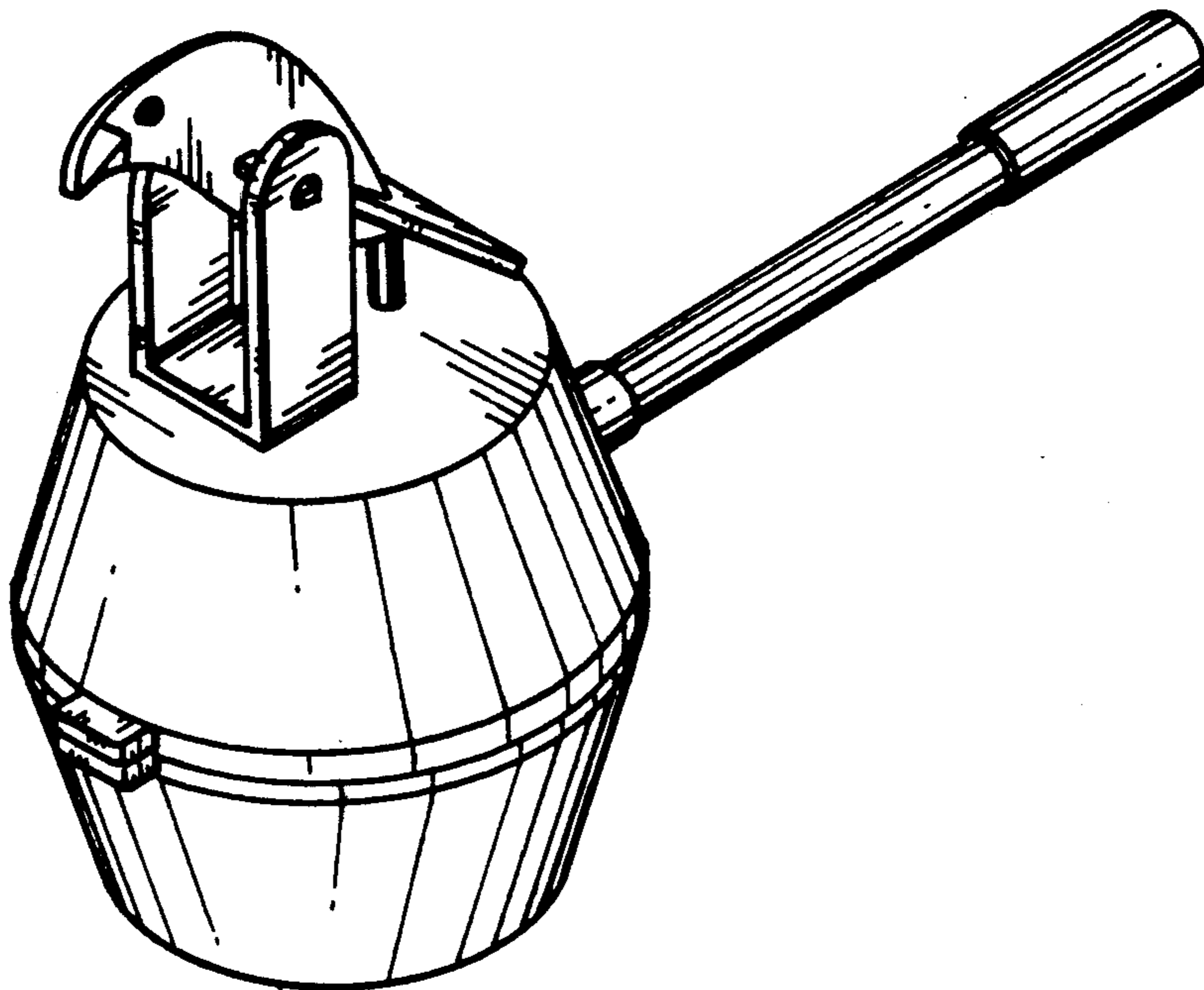

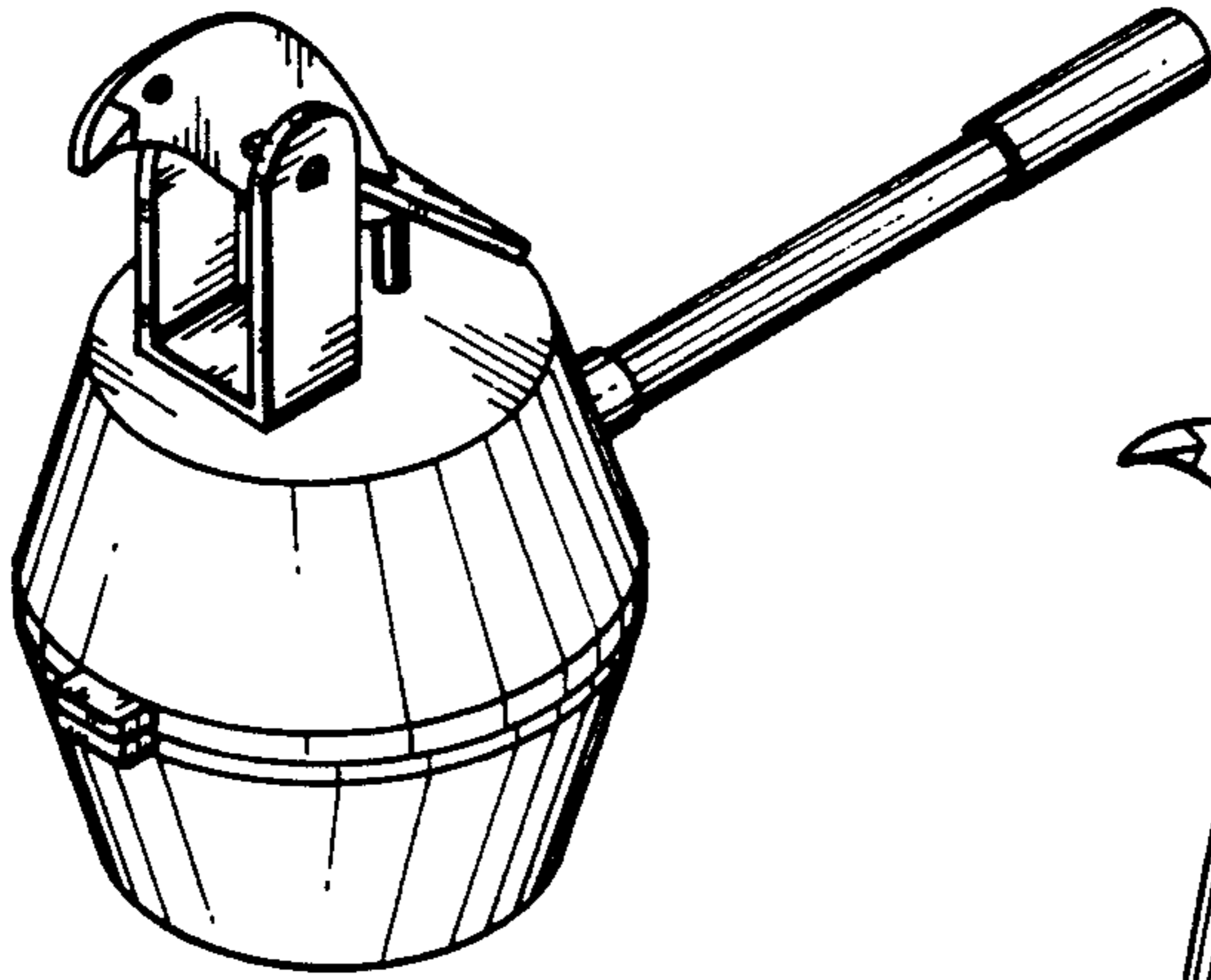
The ornamental design for a breath-operated novelty toy, as shown.

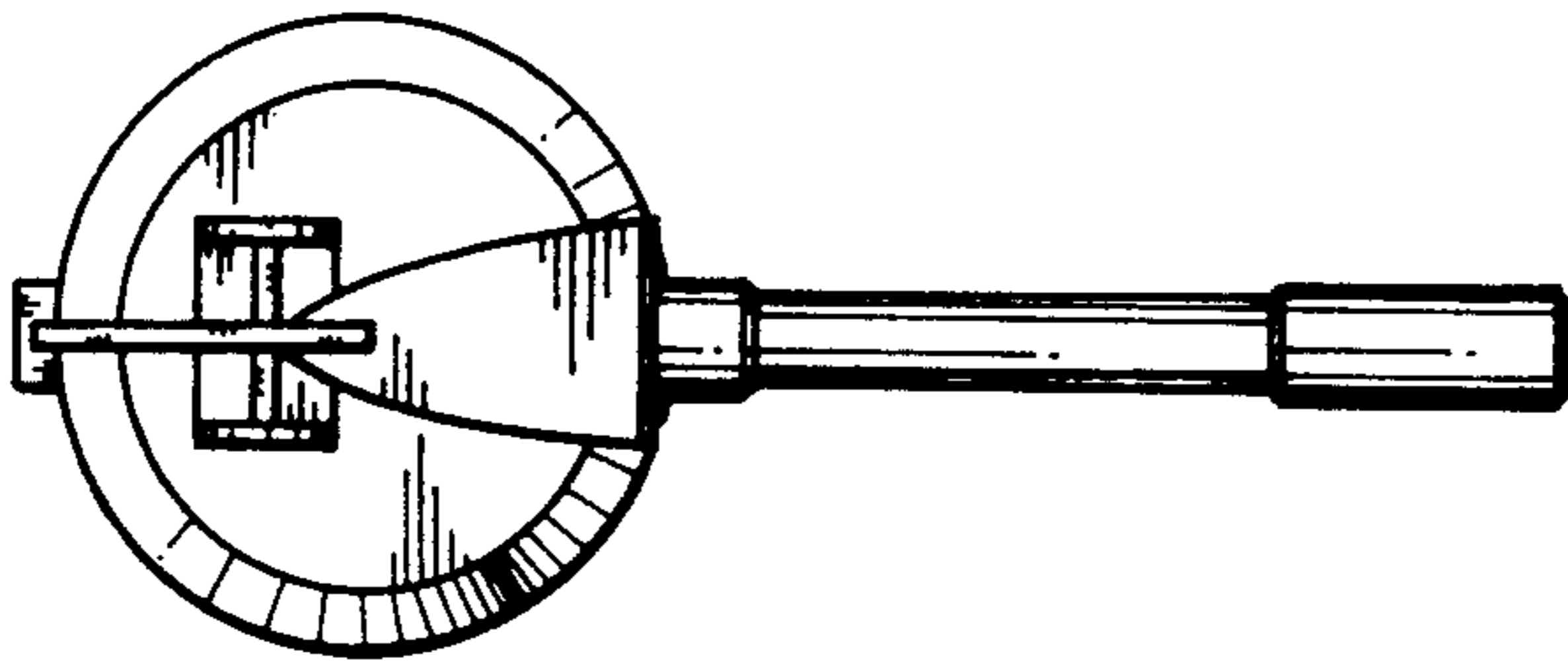
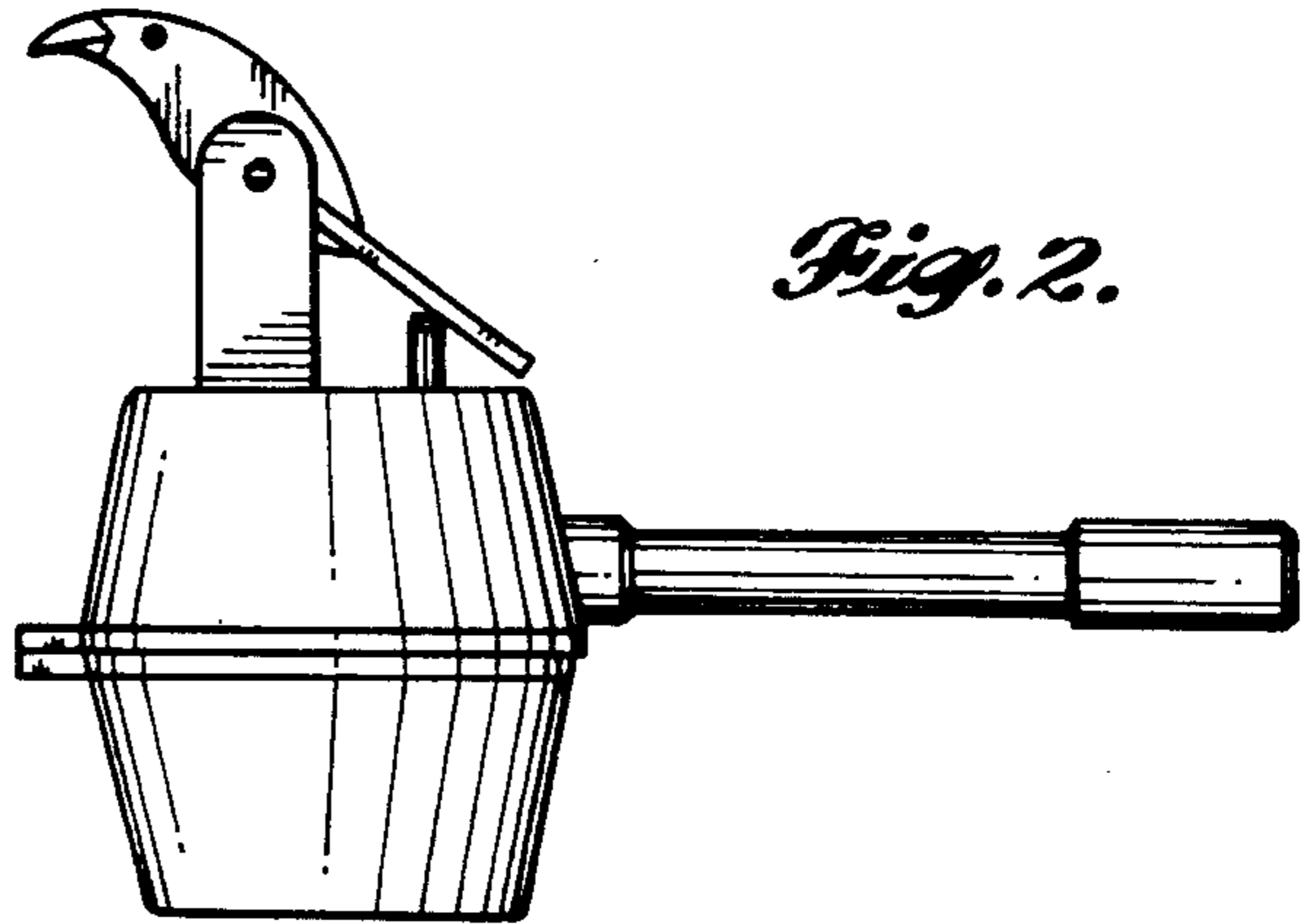
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a breath-operated novelty toy showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.



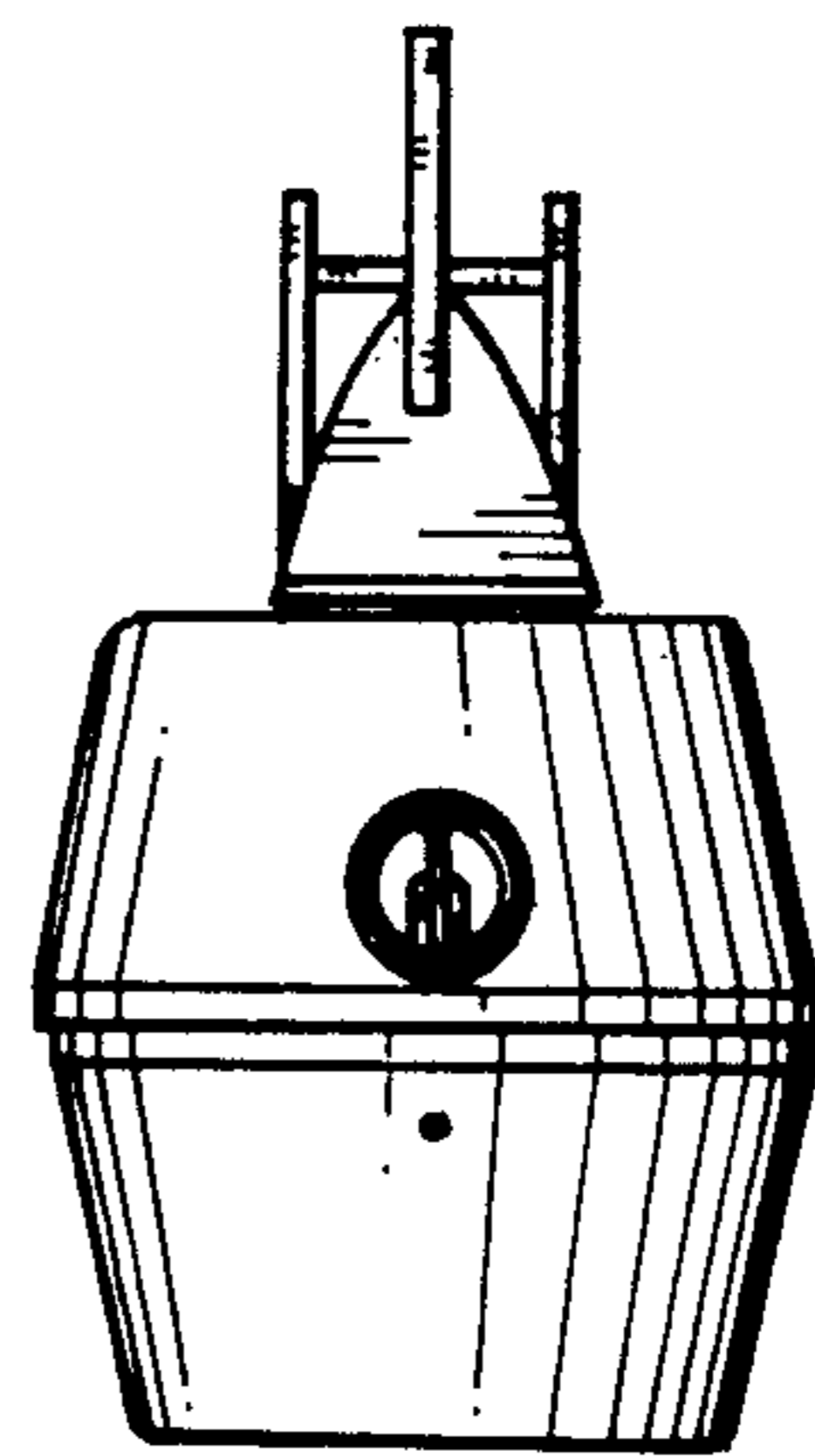
