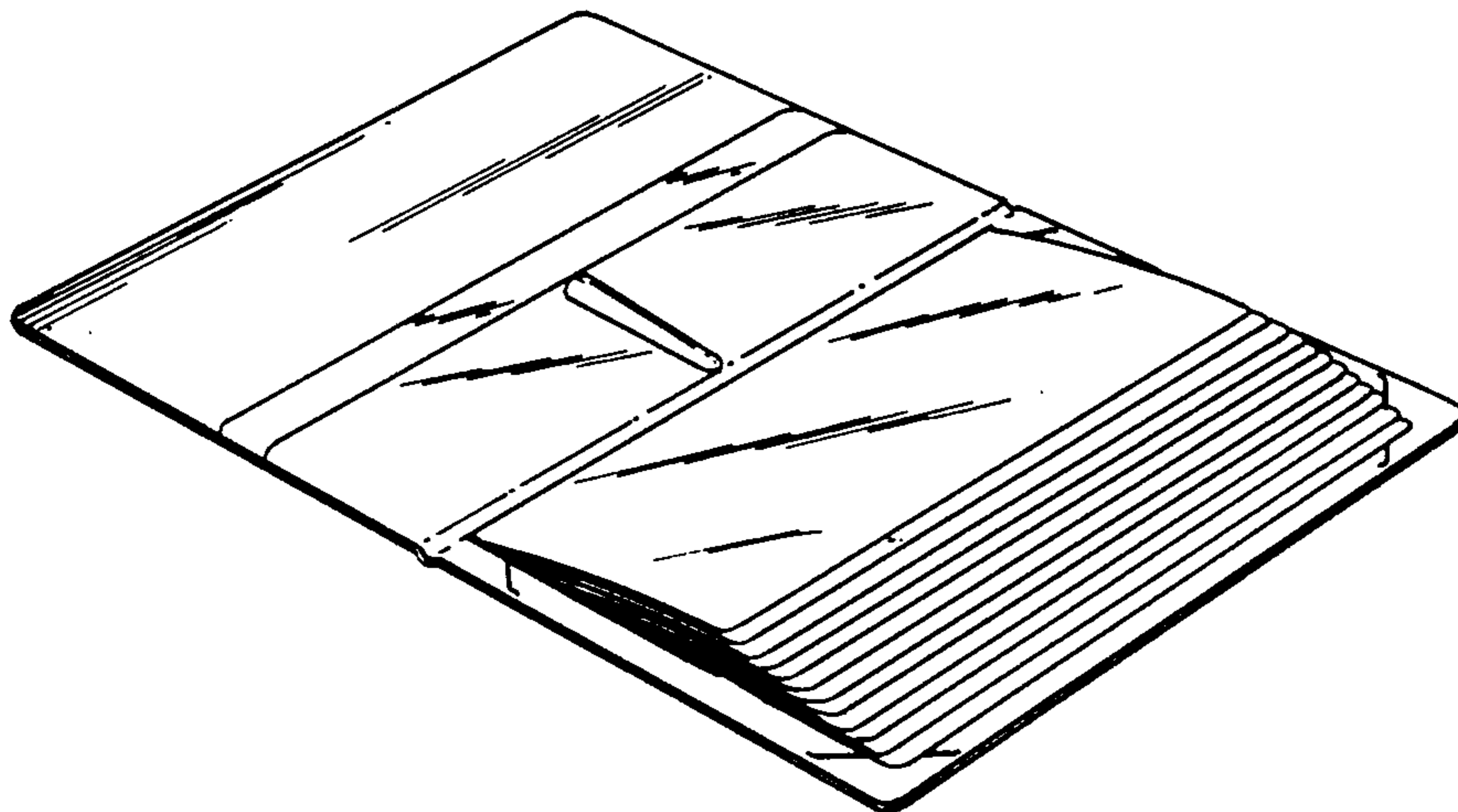

The ornamental design for stationery folder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stationery folder showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the stationery folder with the flap in a fully open position; and
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof showing the internal pockets partially raised on a supporting hinged flap.



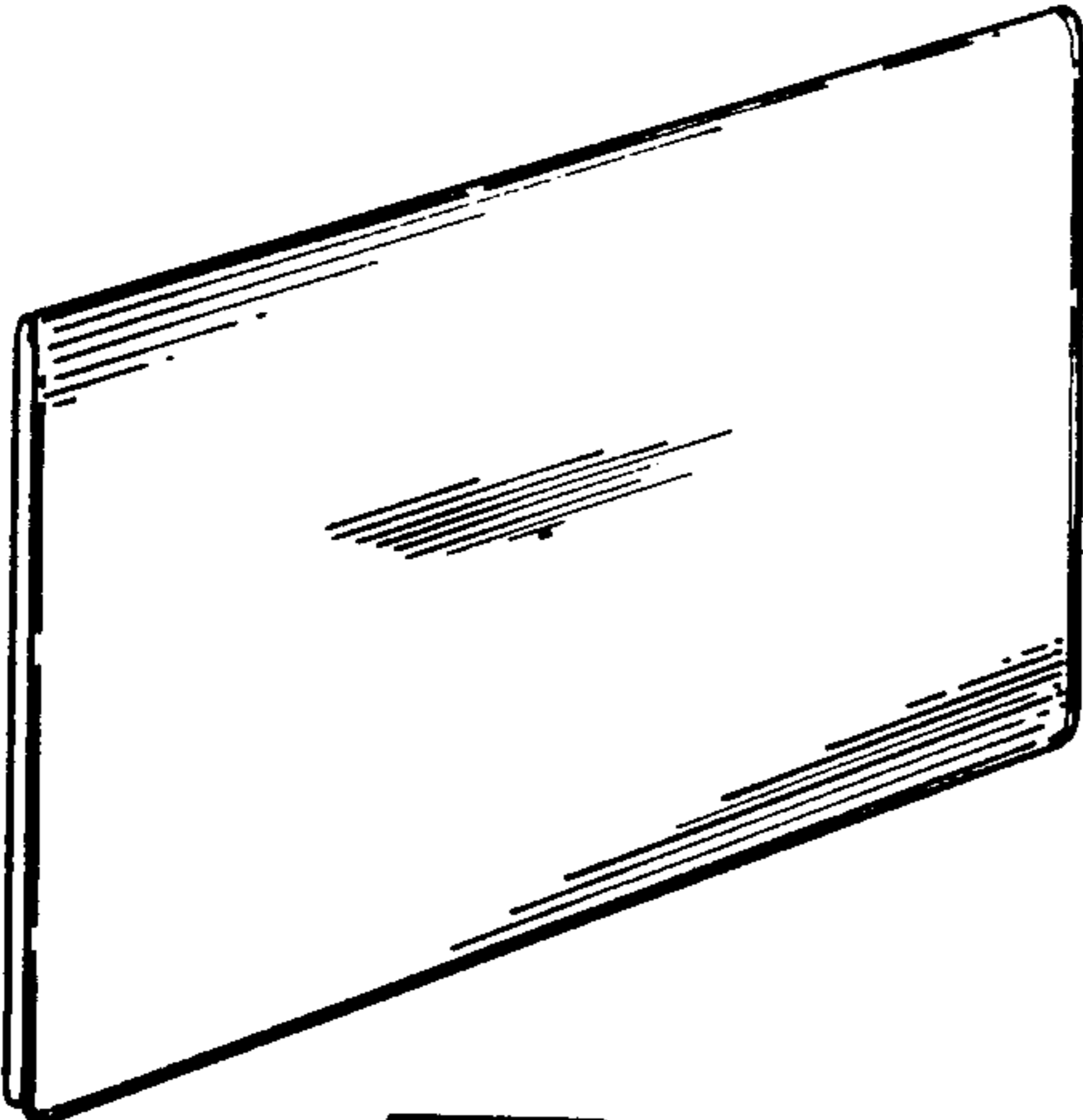

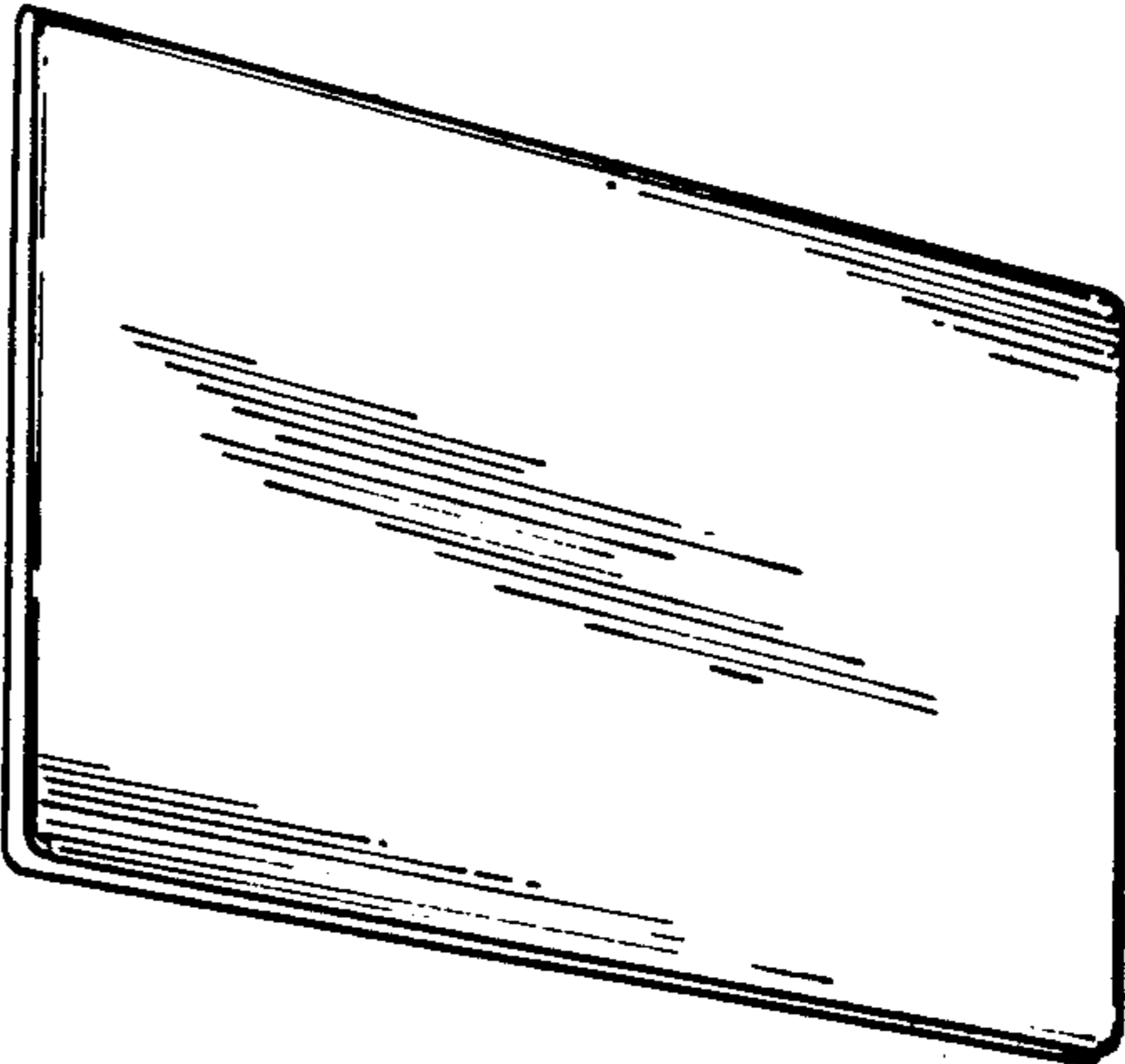

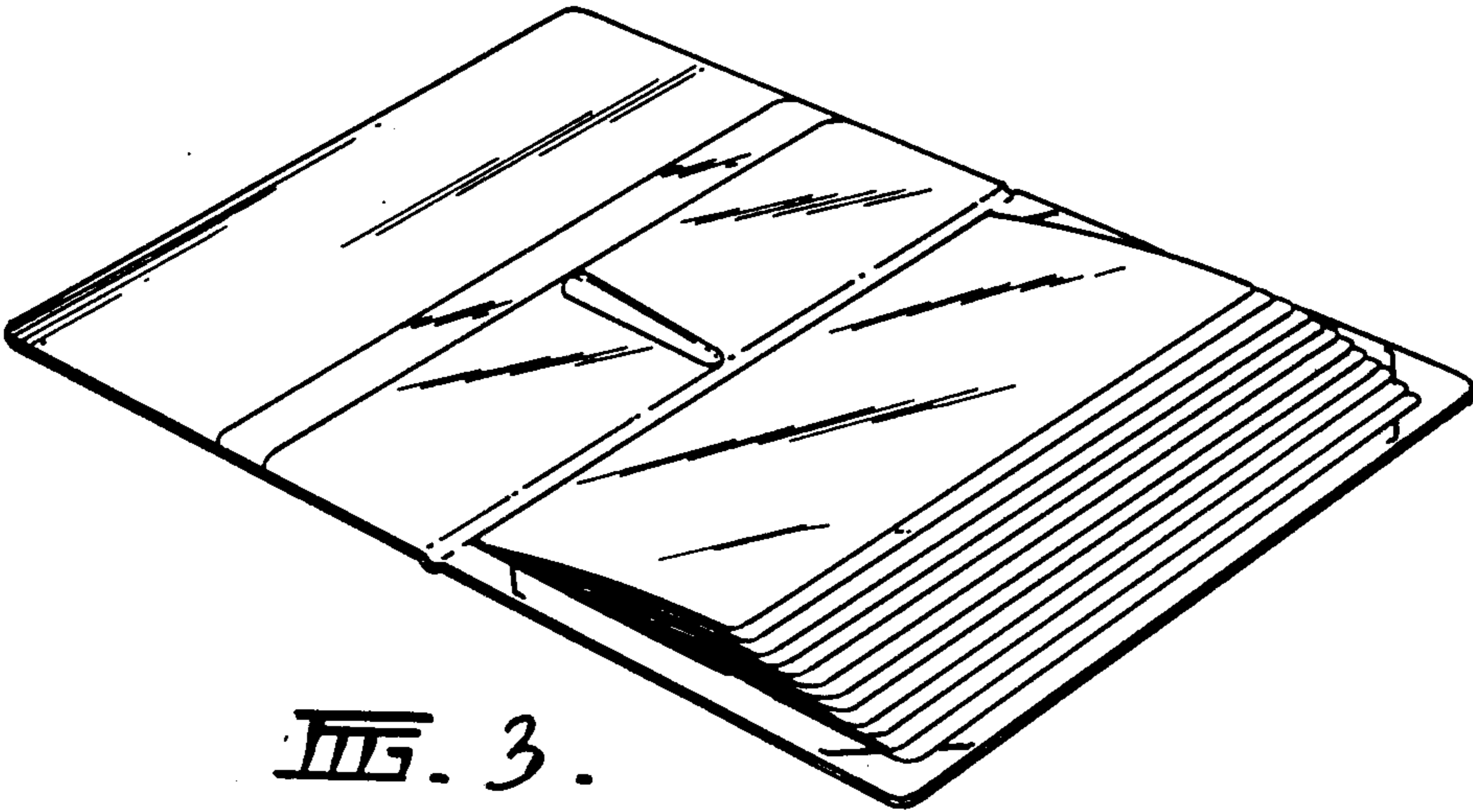

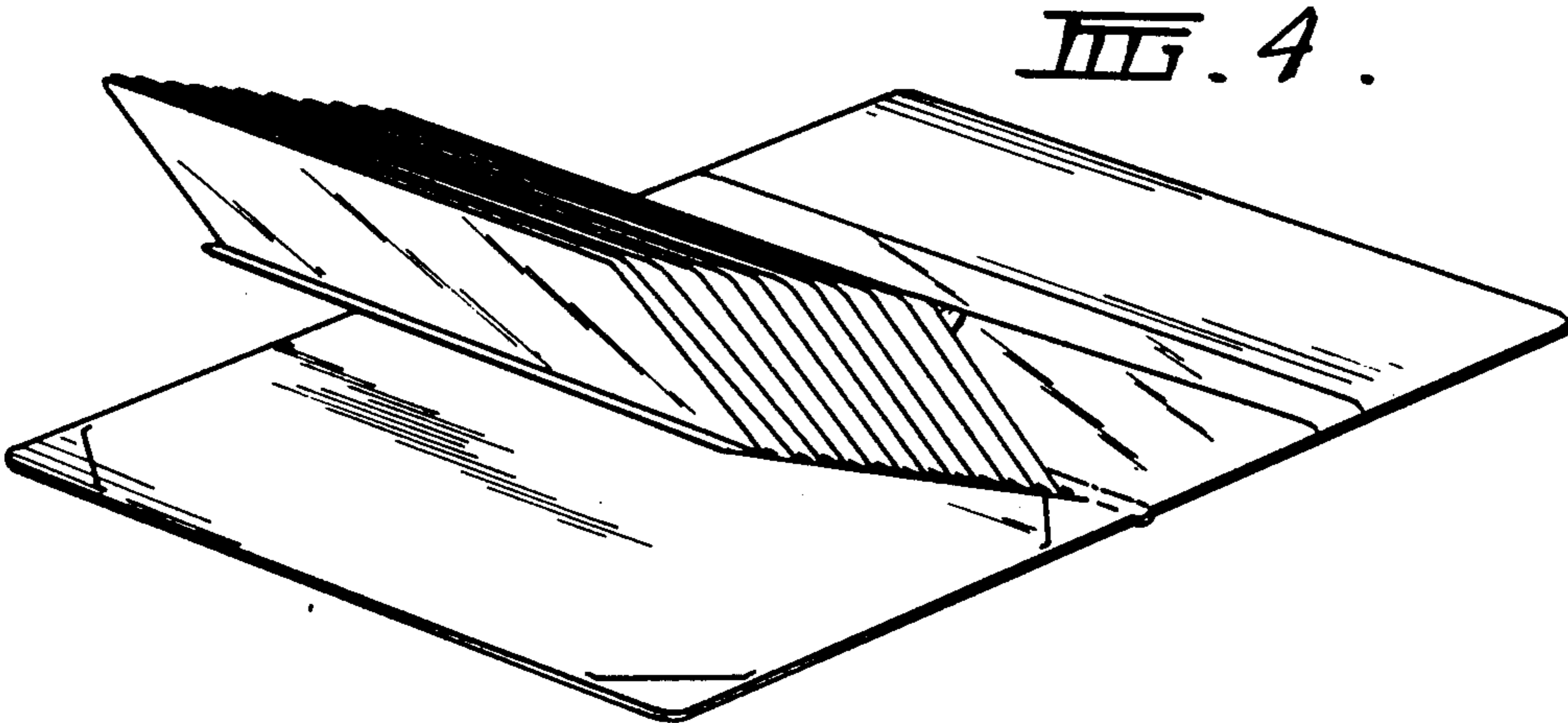
