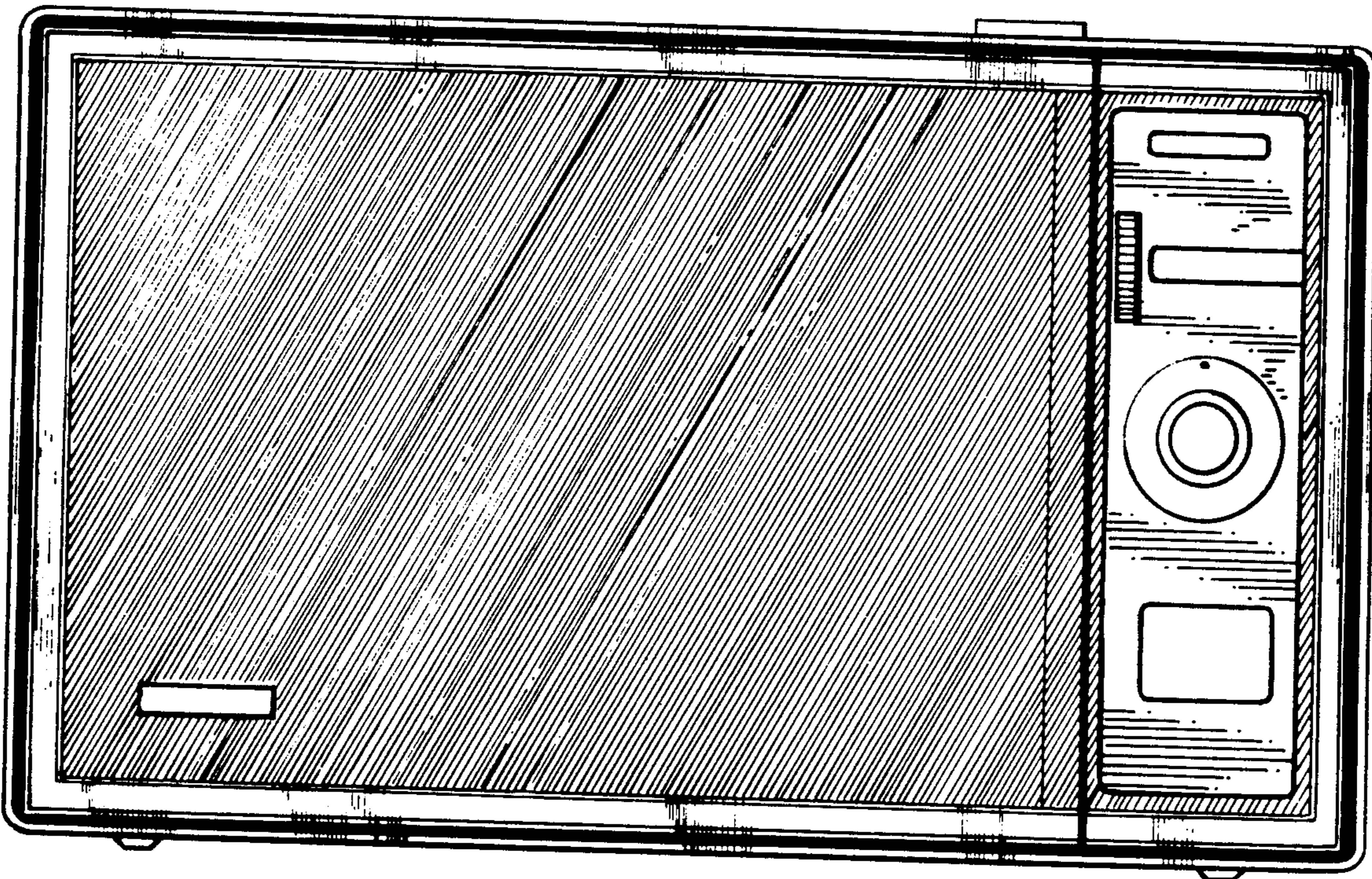

The ornamental design for a microwave oven, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a microwave oven showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof. The side of the oven which is not shown is a mirror image of the side disclosed in FIG. 3.



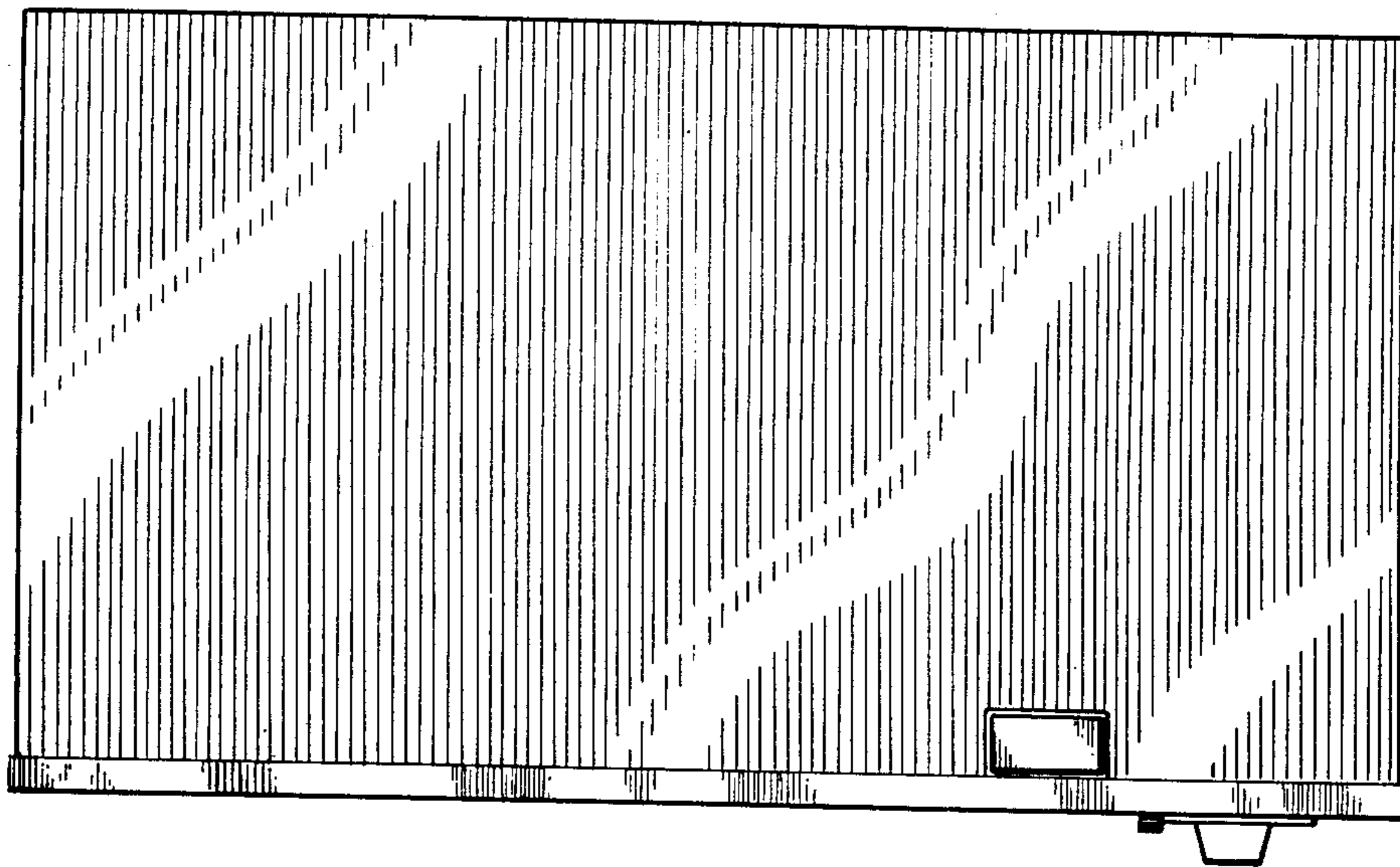

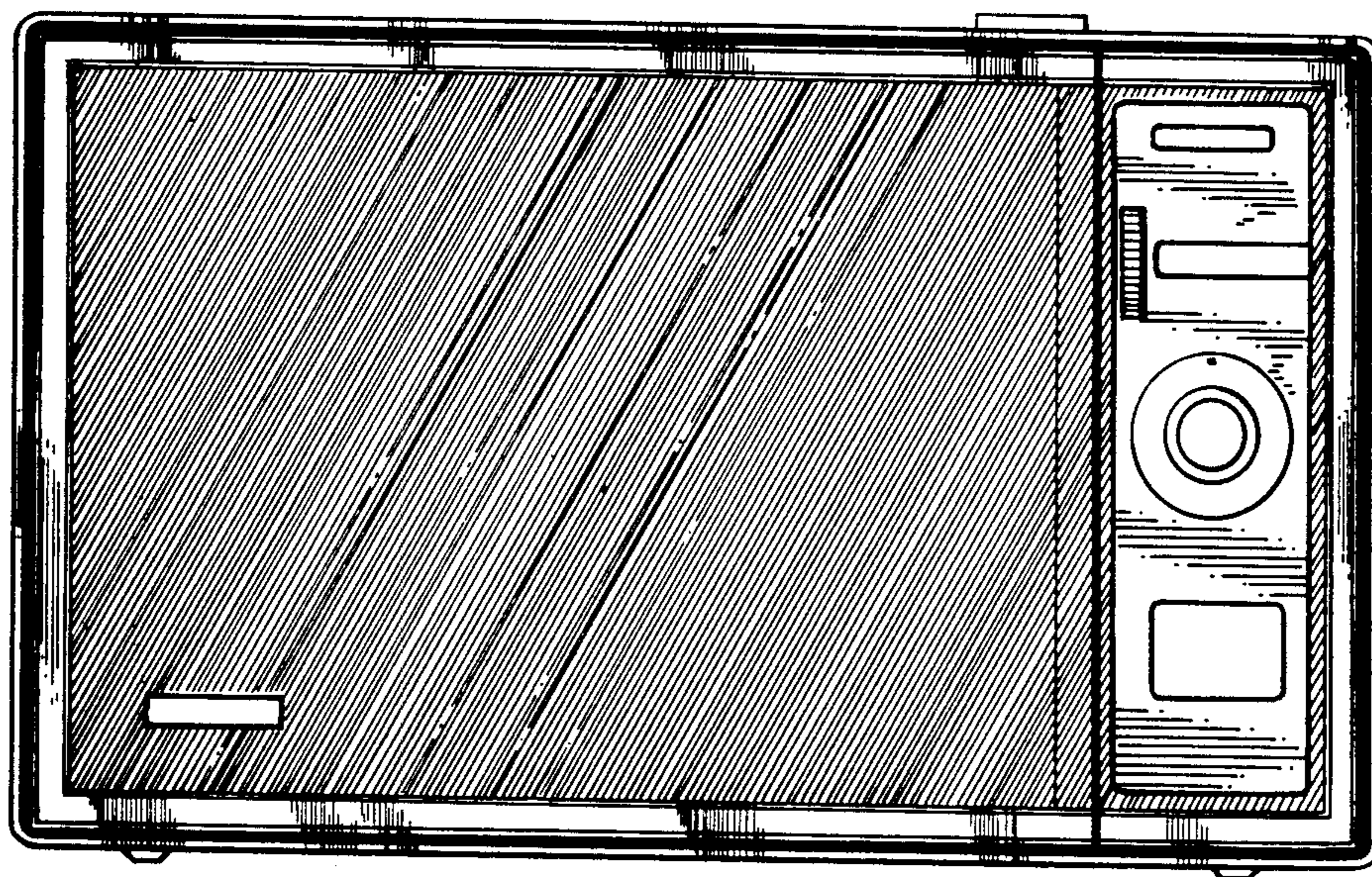

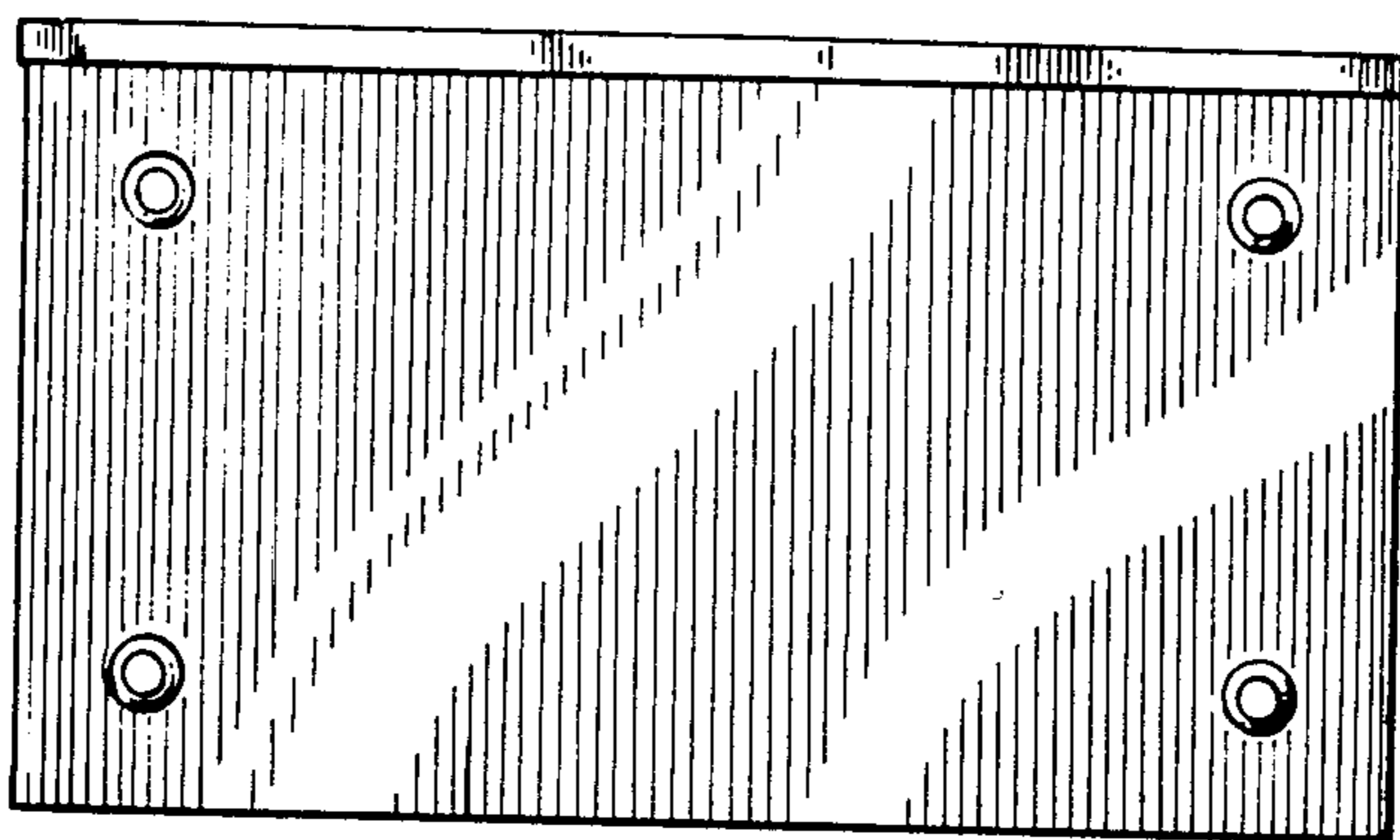

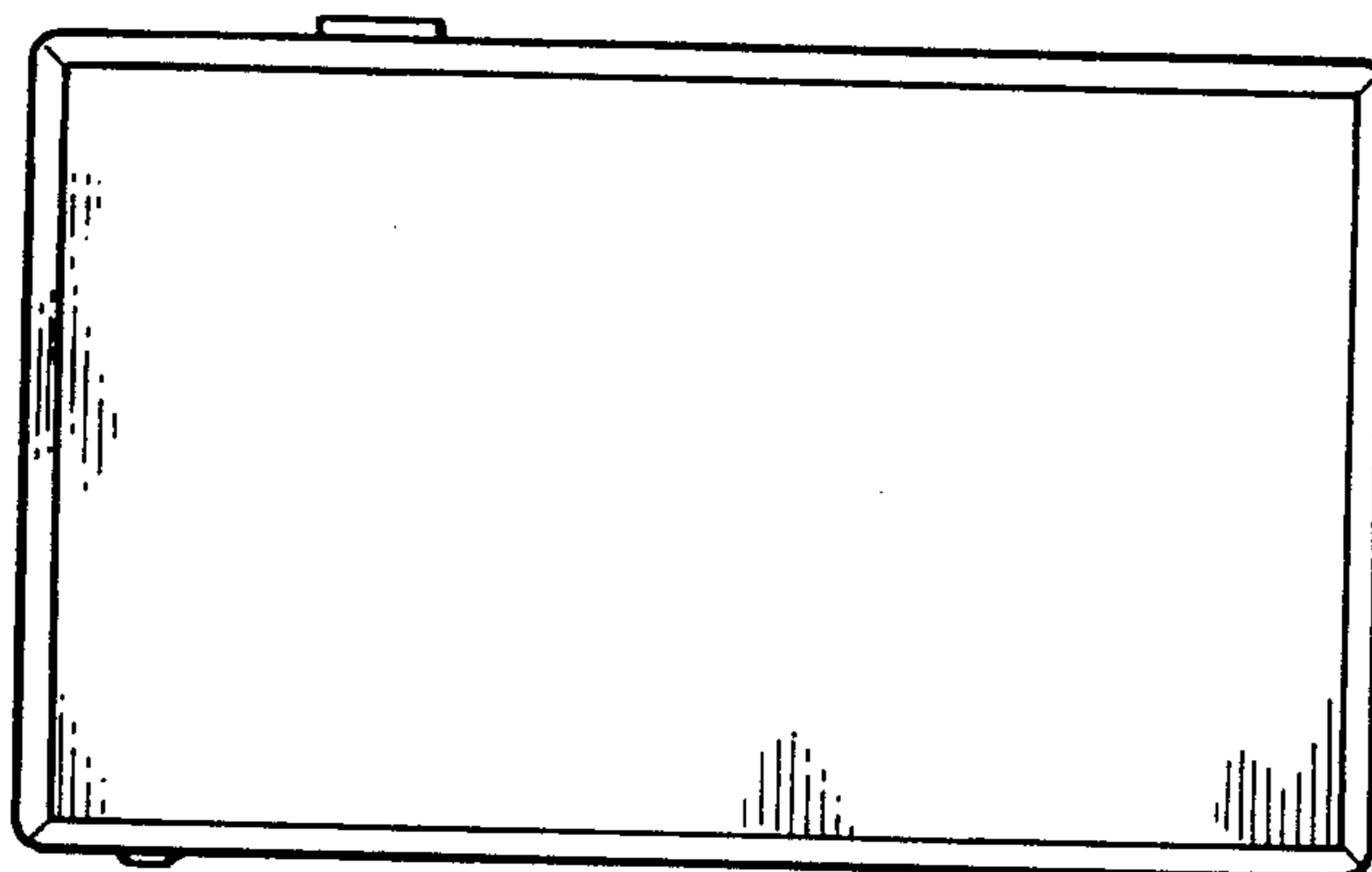
