

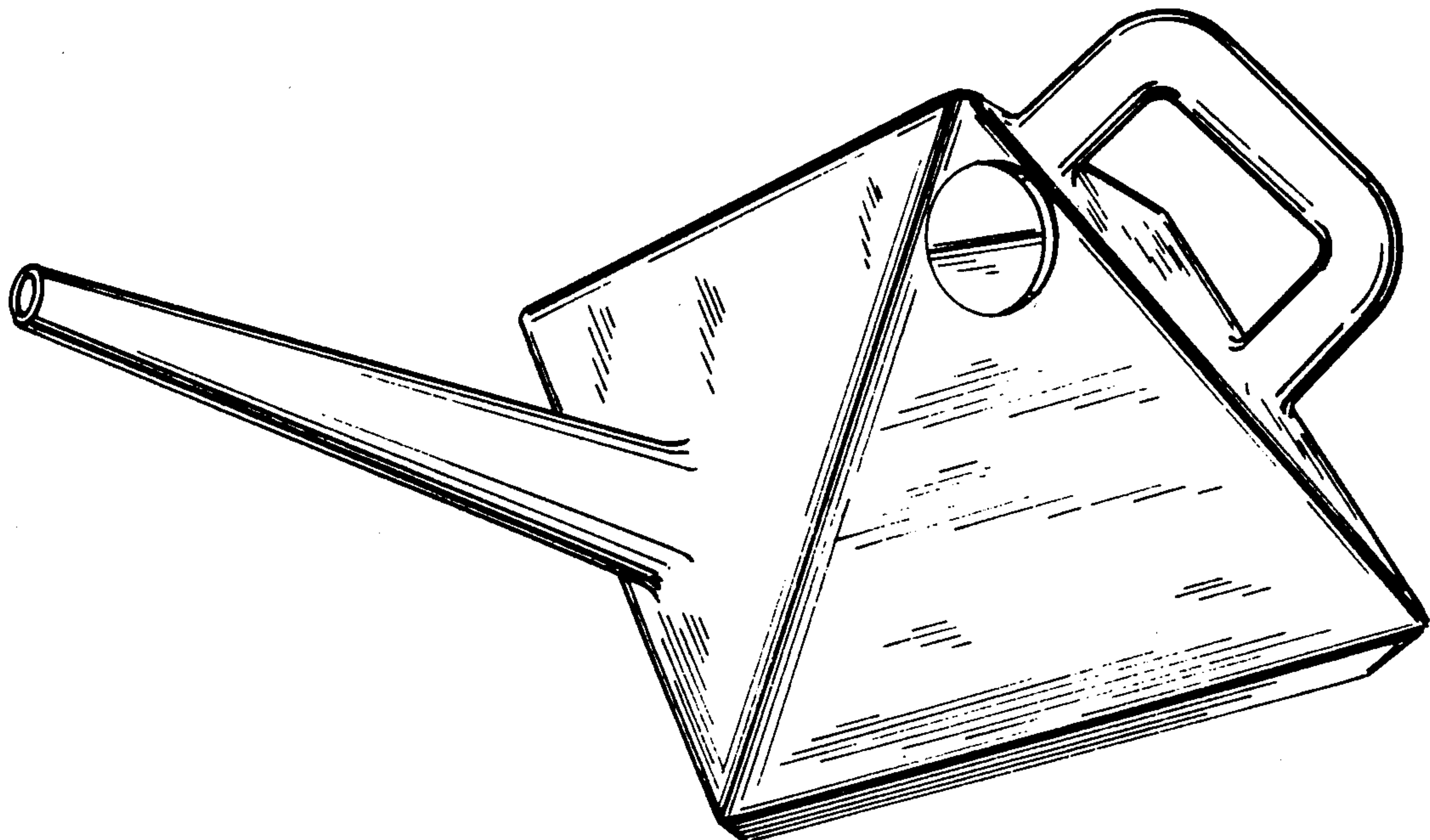

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front
and right side of a watering can showing my new de-
sign;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the top, rear
and left side thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along lines 6—6 of FIG.
3; and
FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along lines 7—7 of FIG.
3.



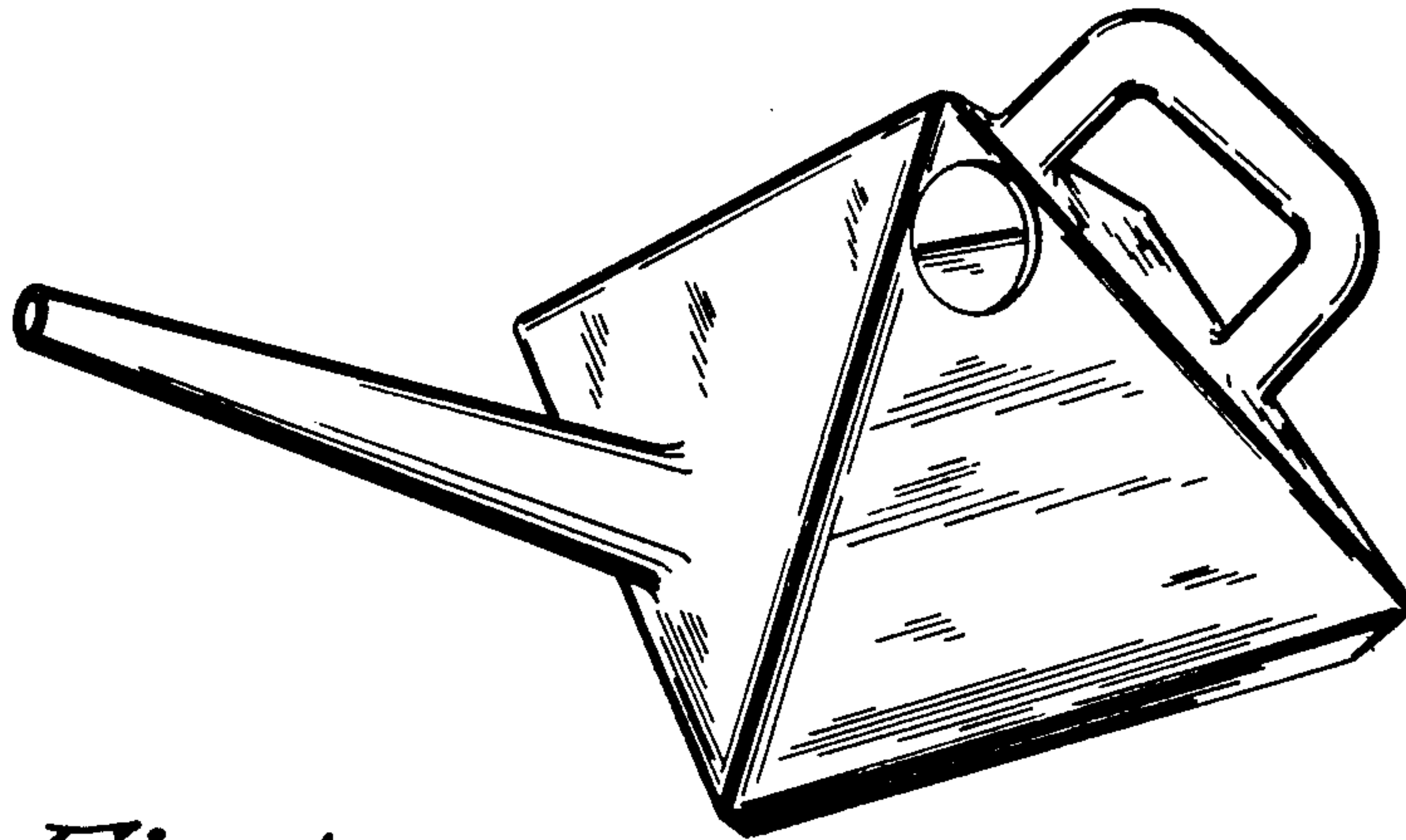

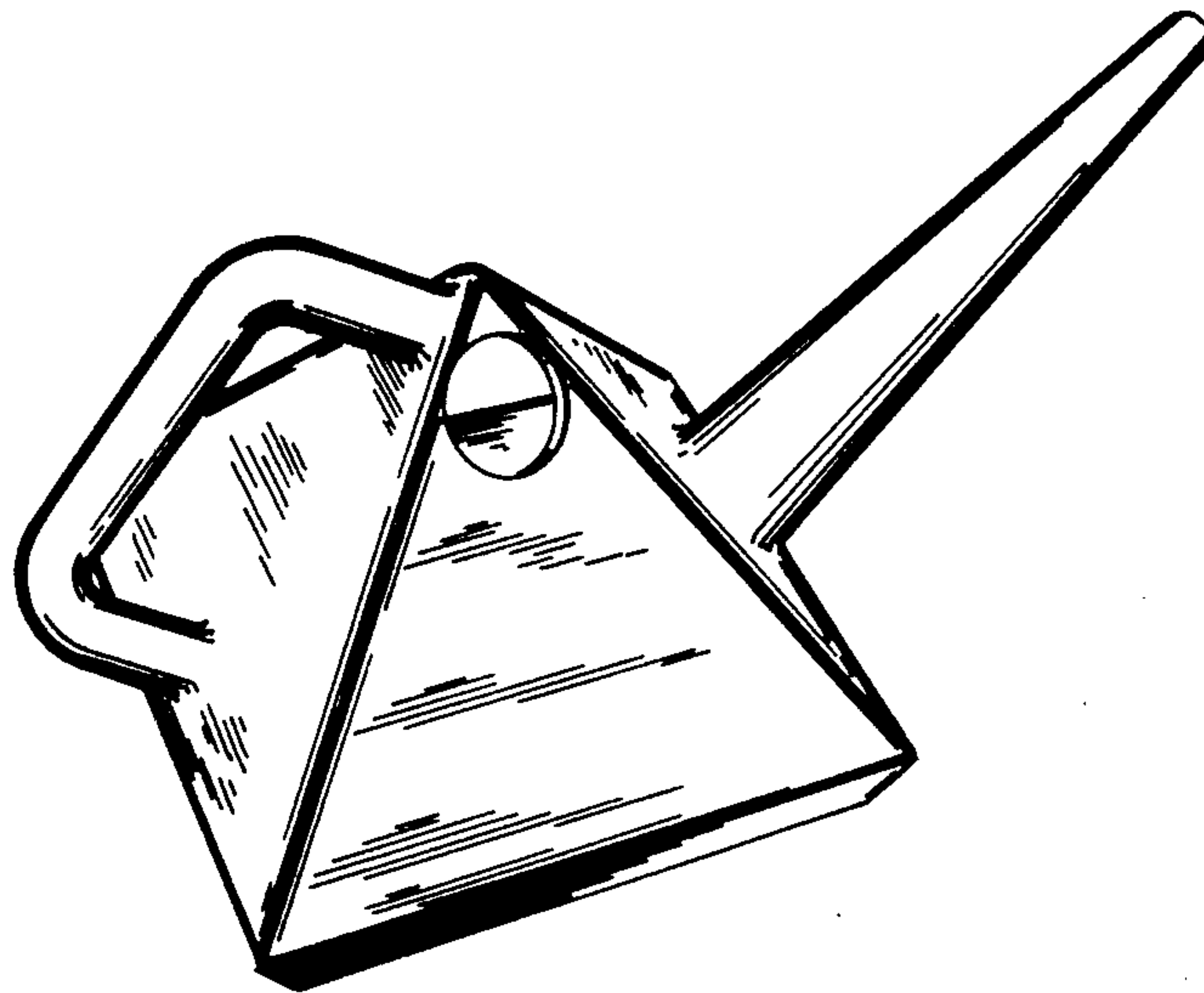

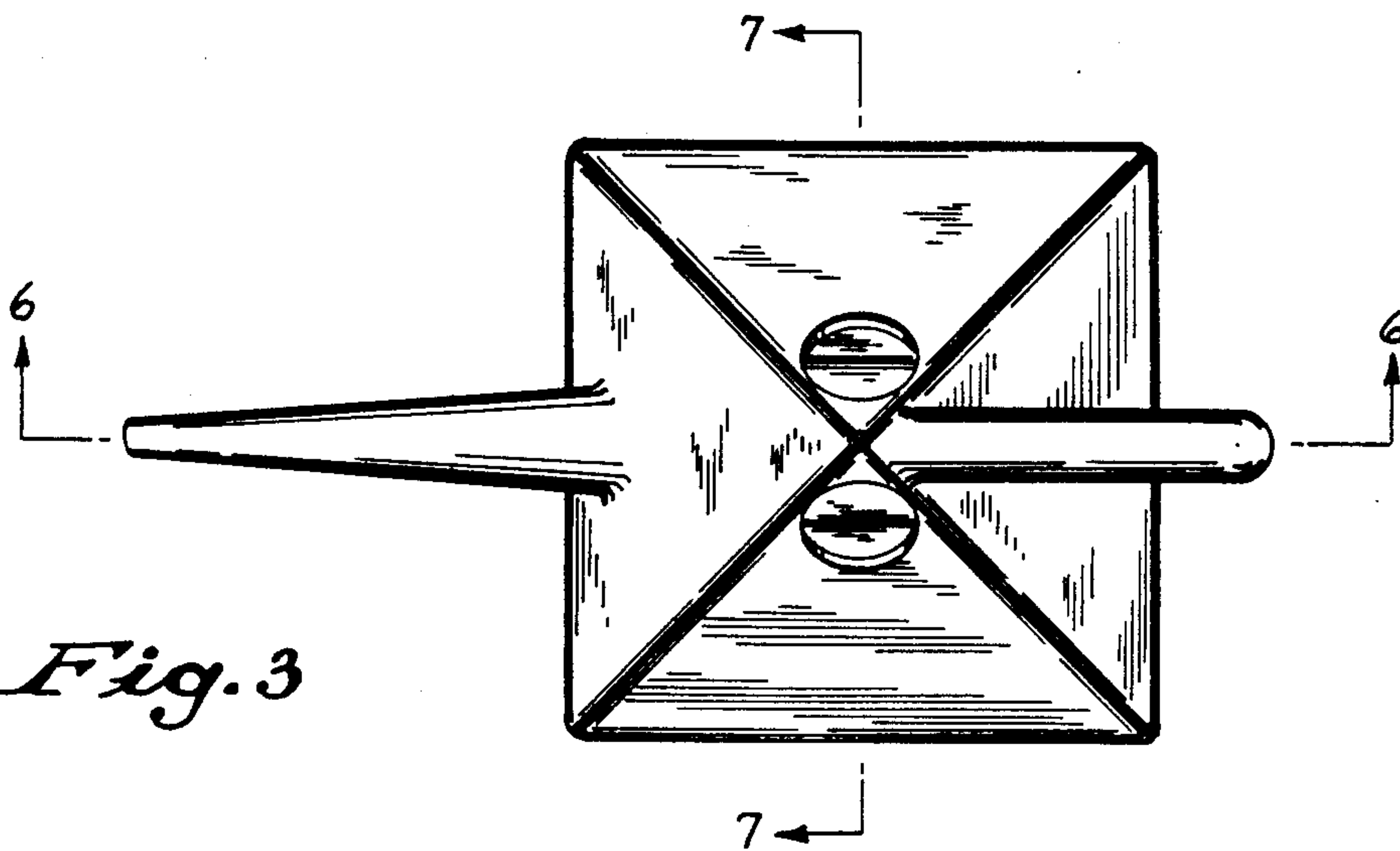

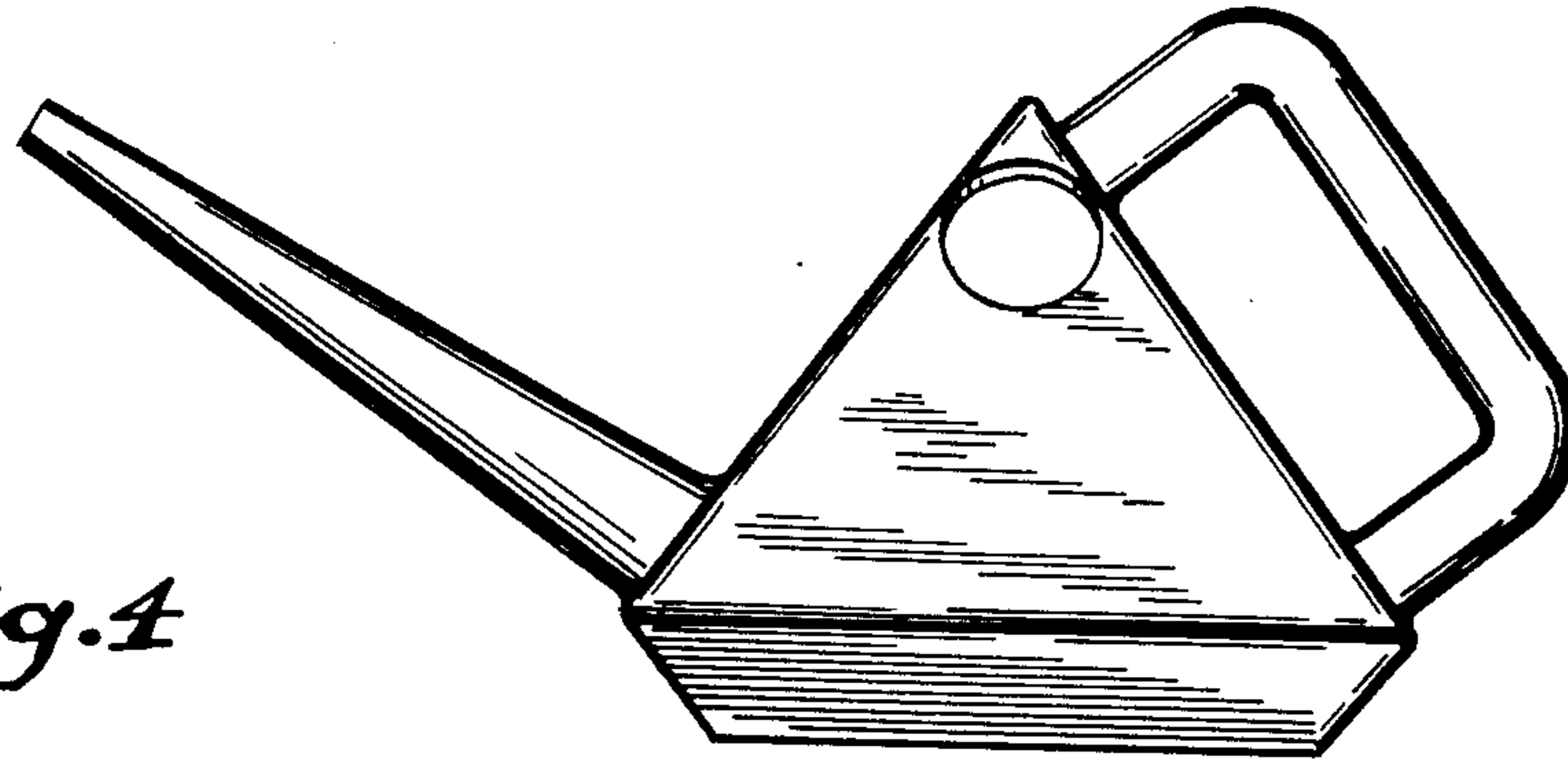

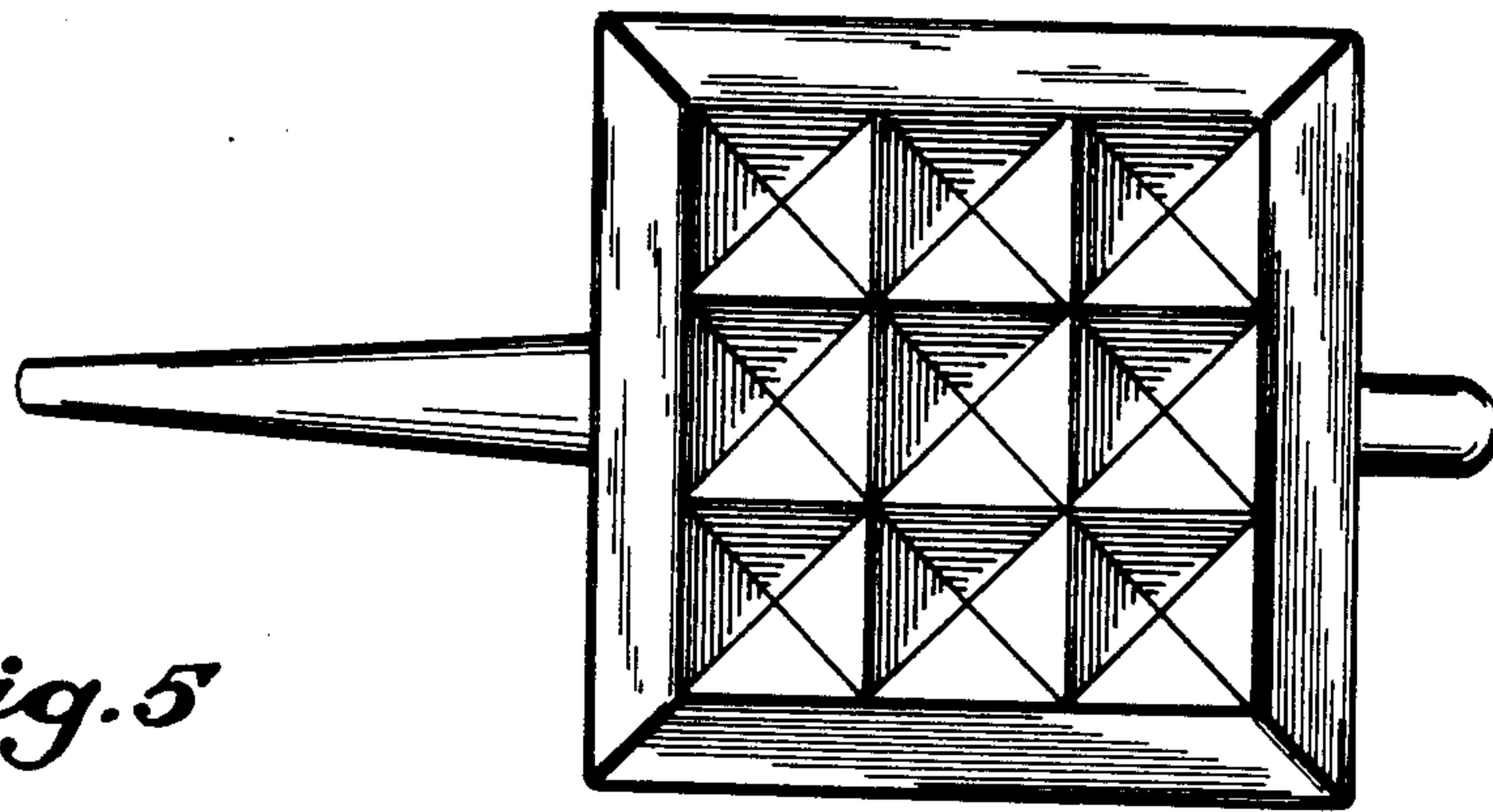

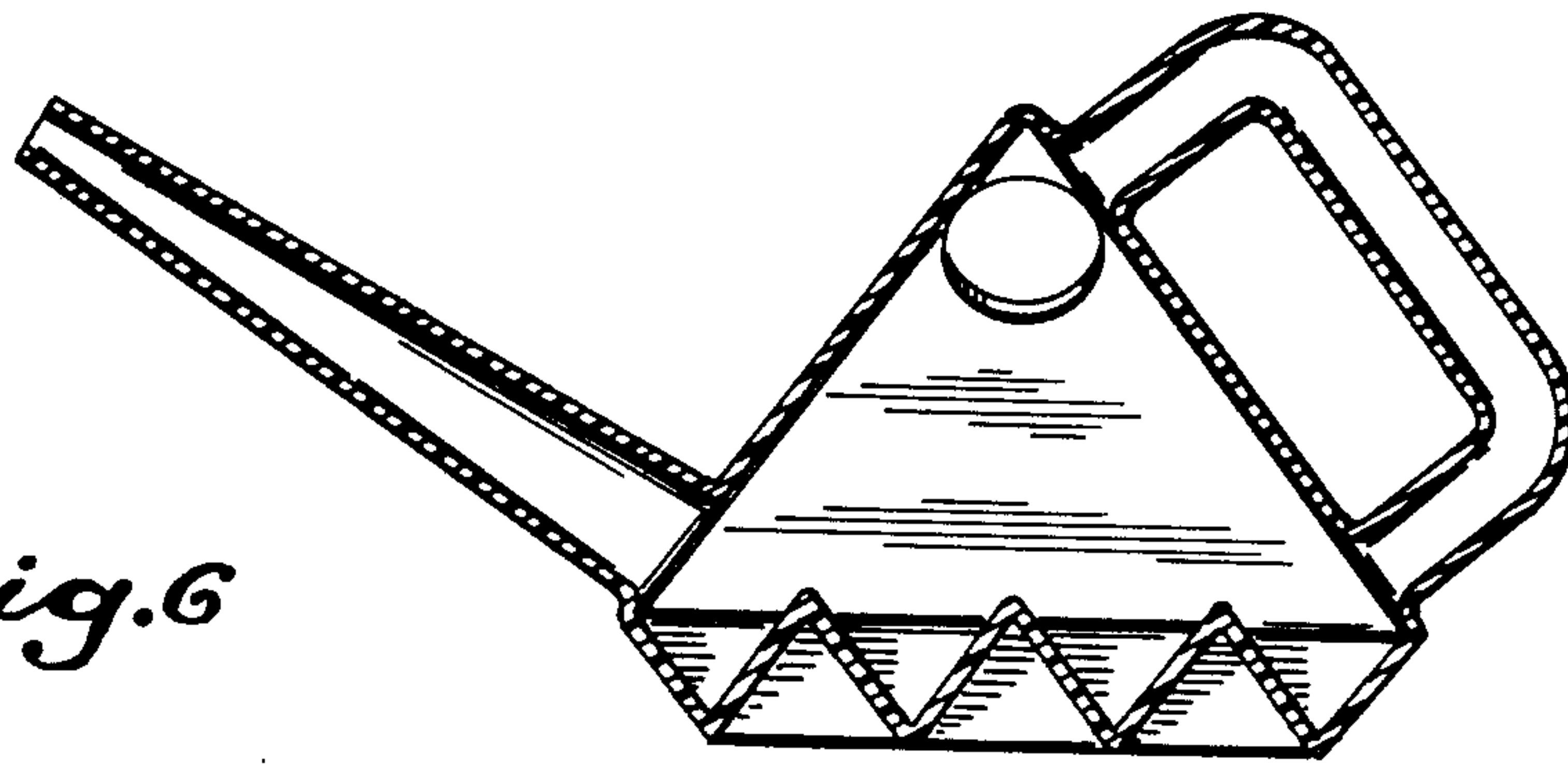

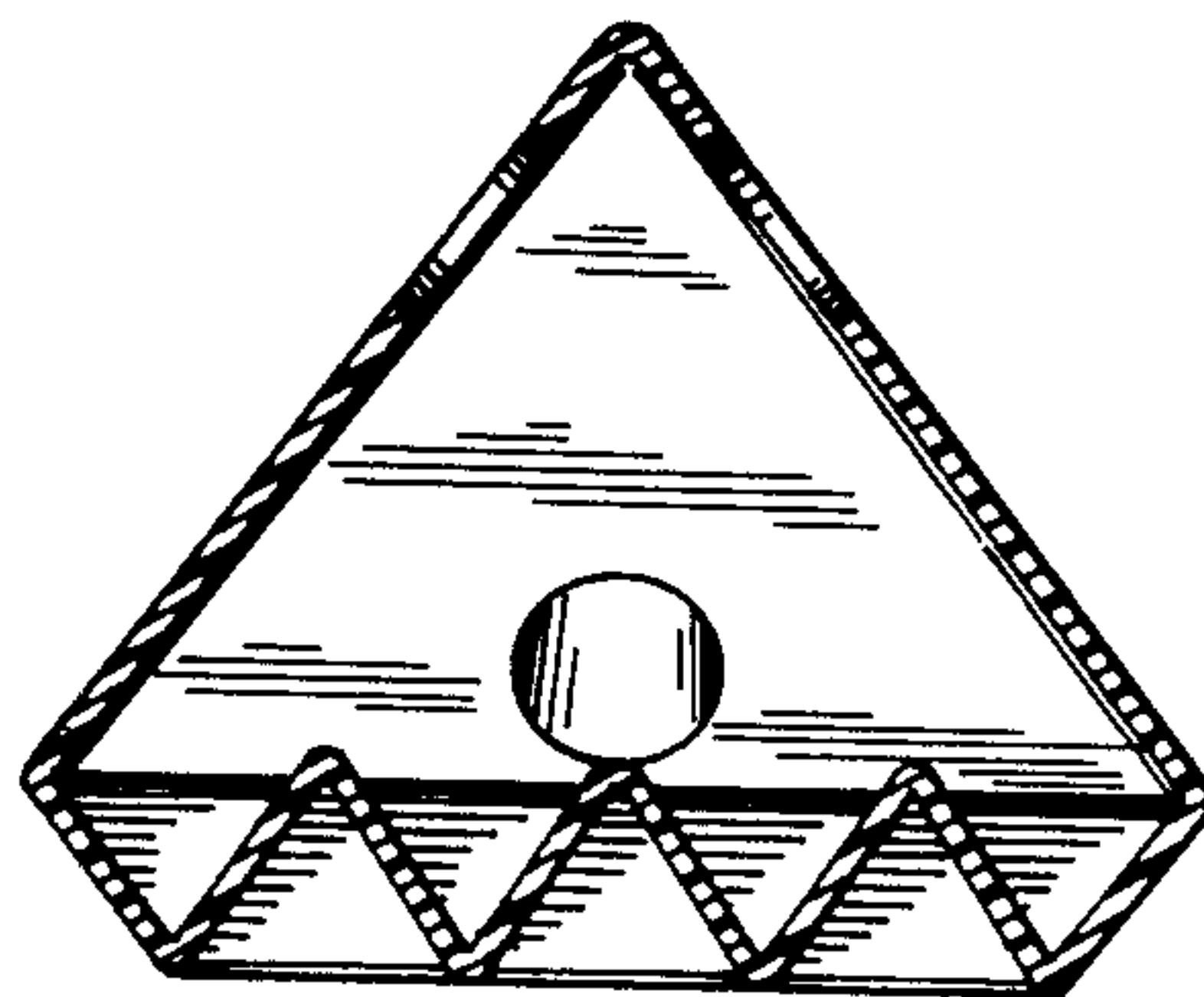
