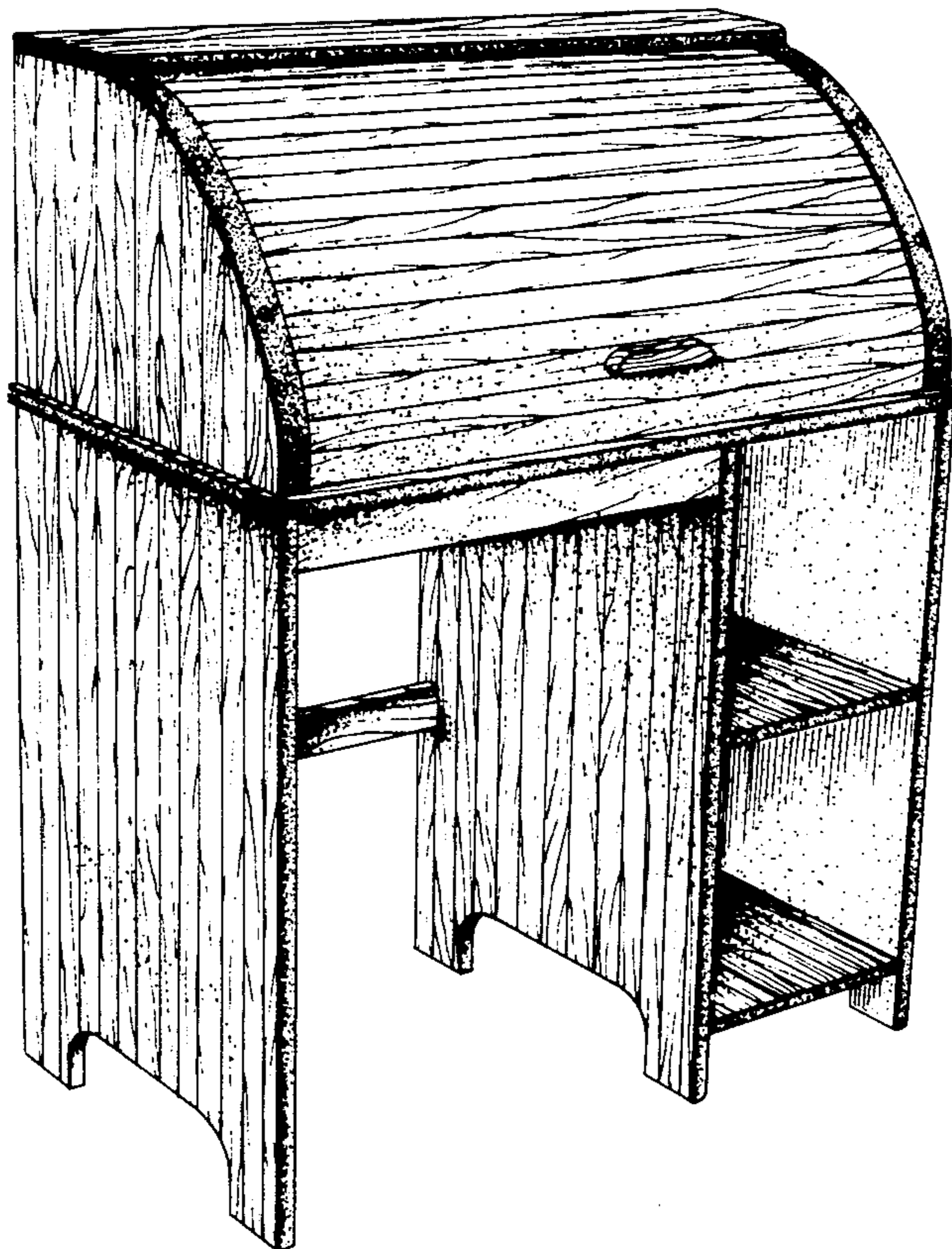

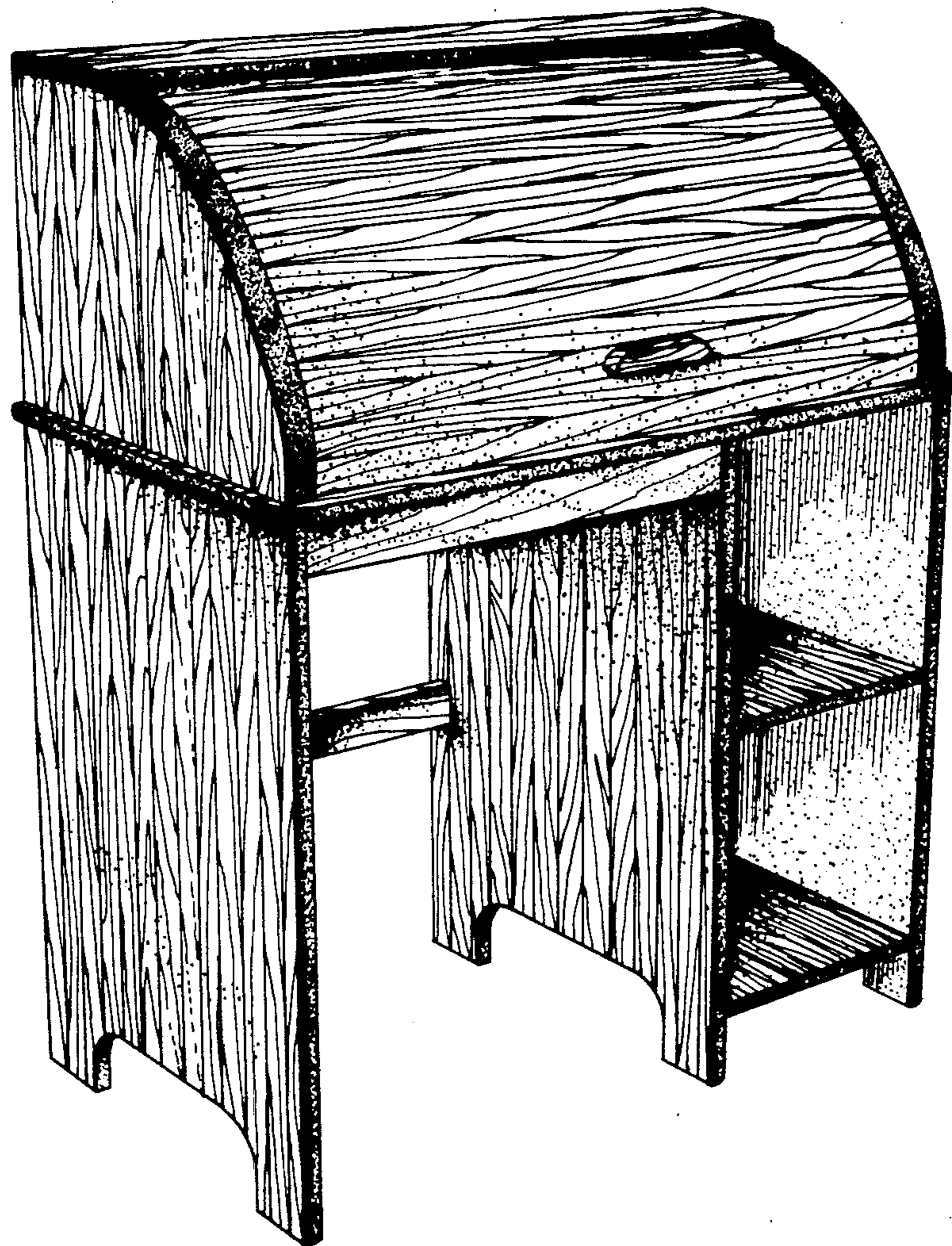
The ornamental design for a child's roll-top desk or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

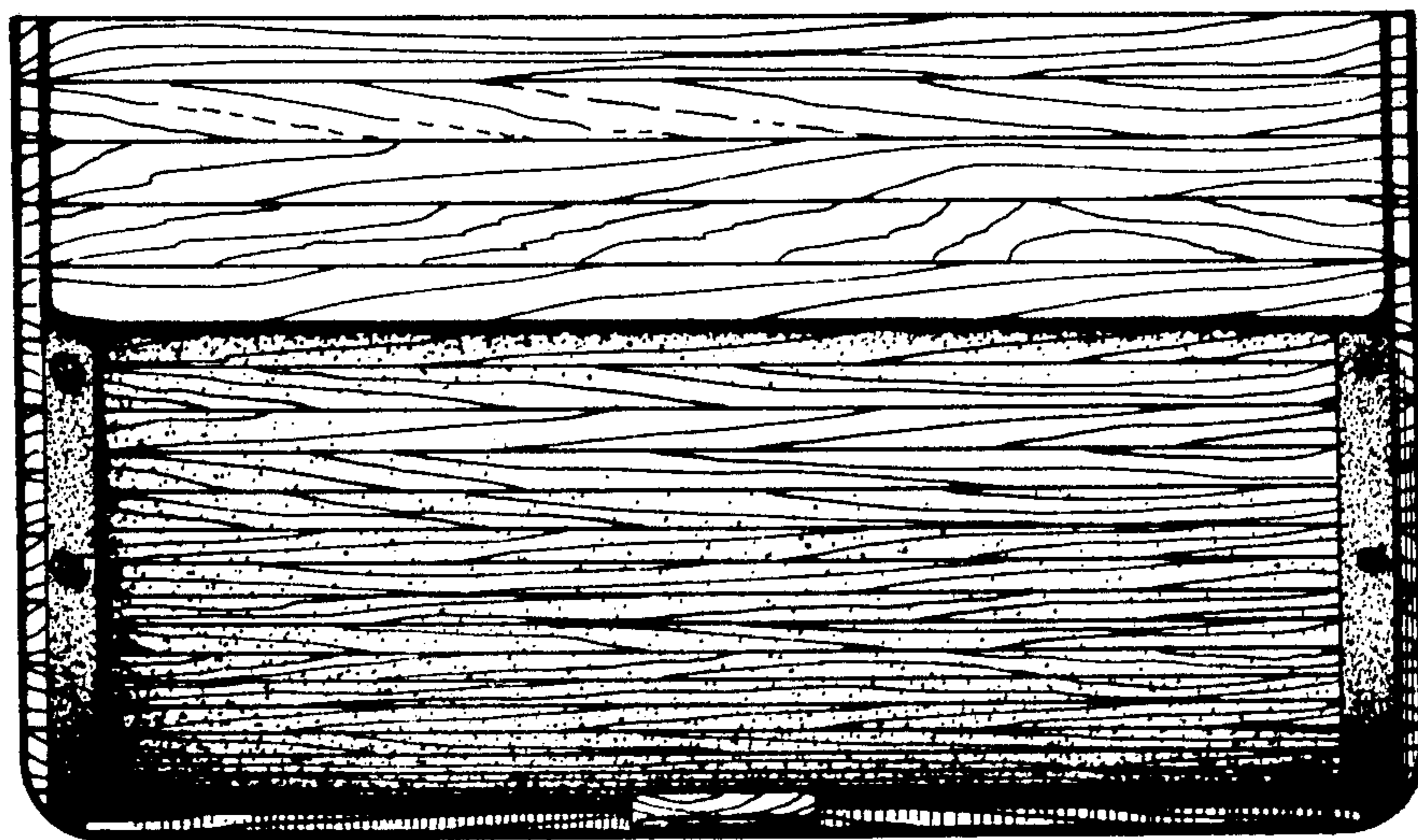

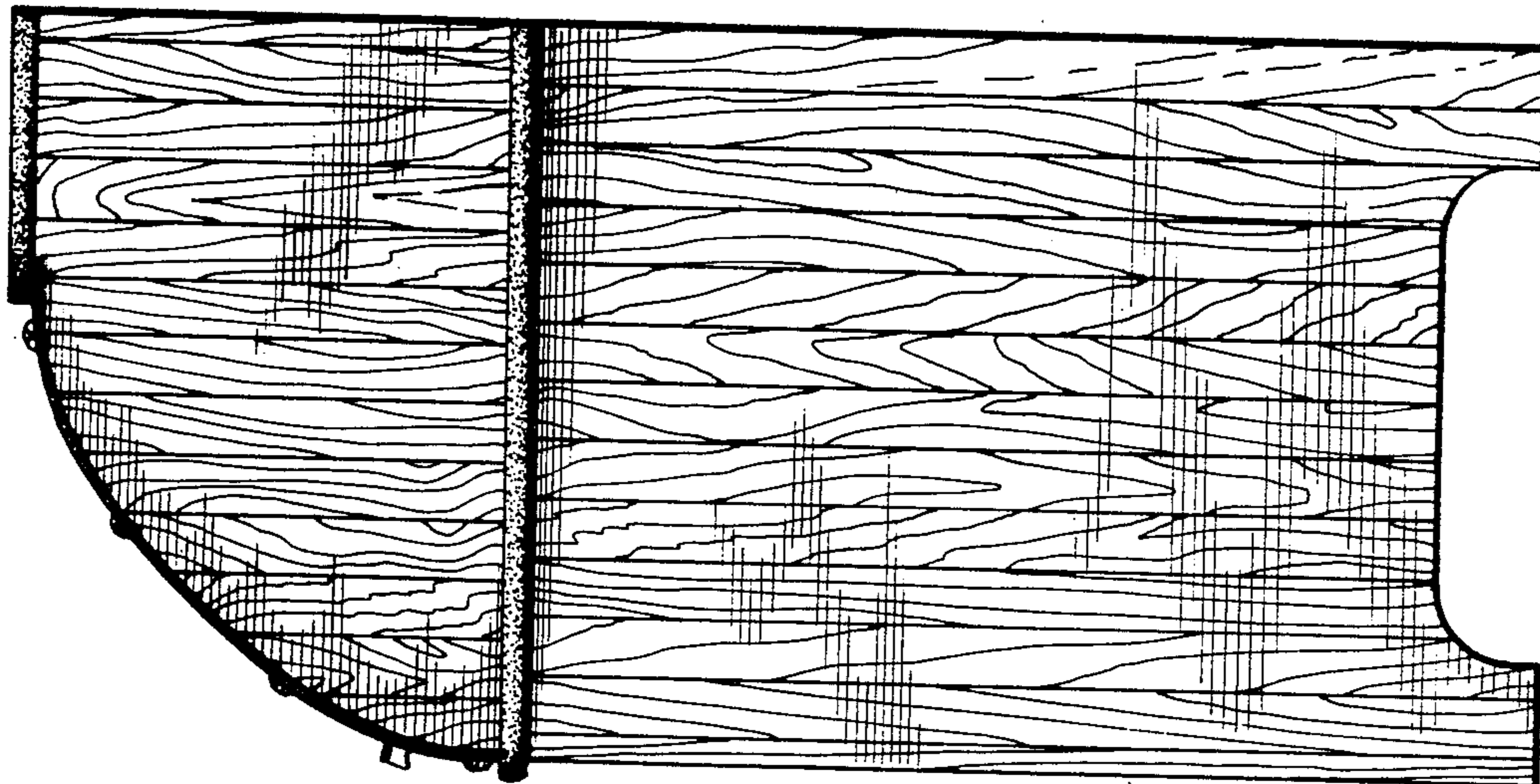

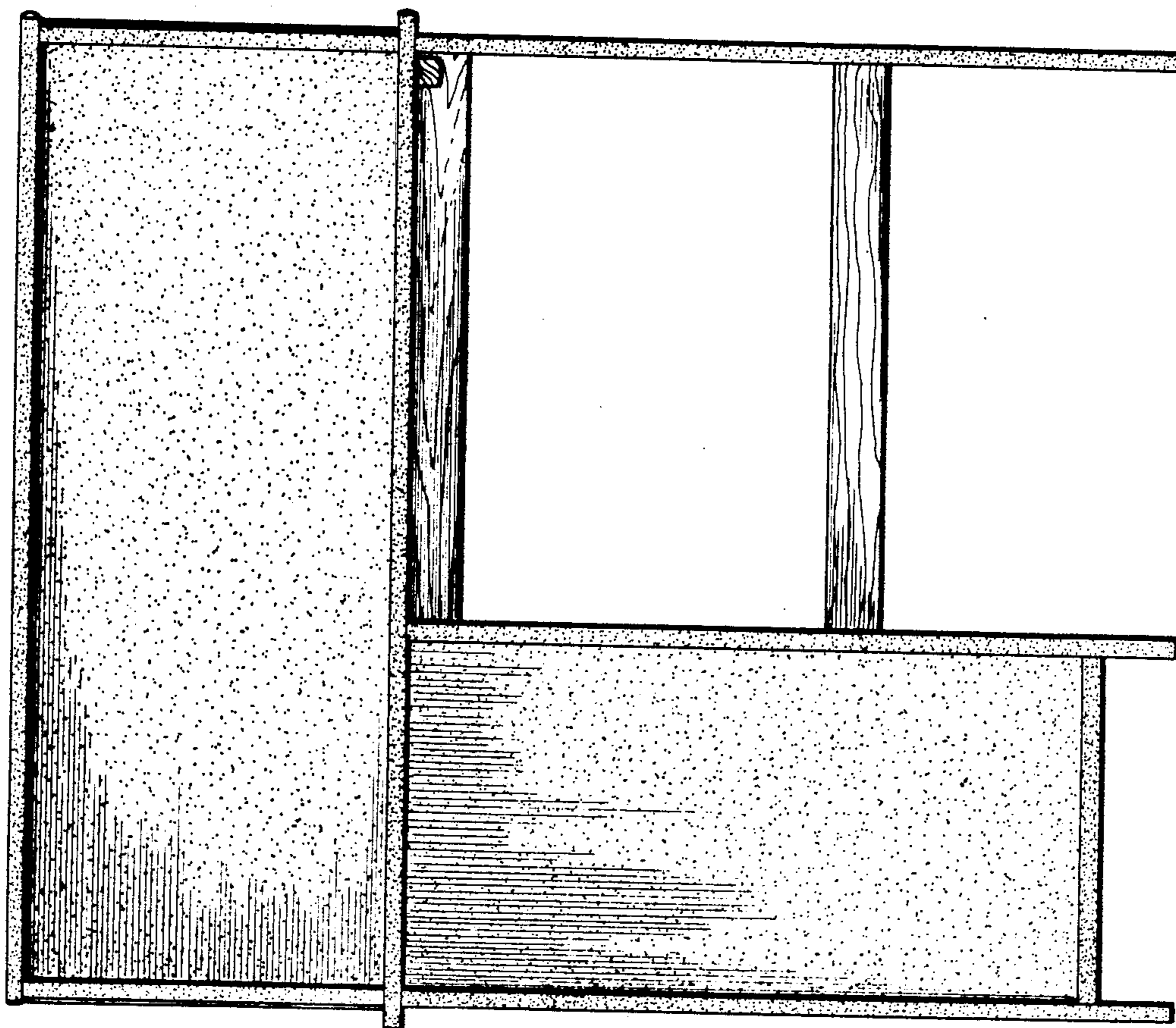

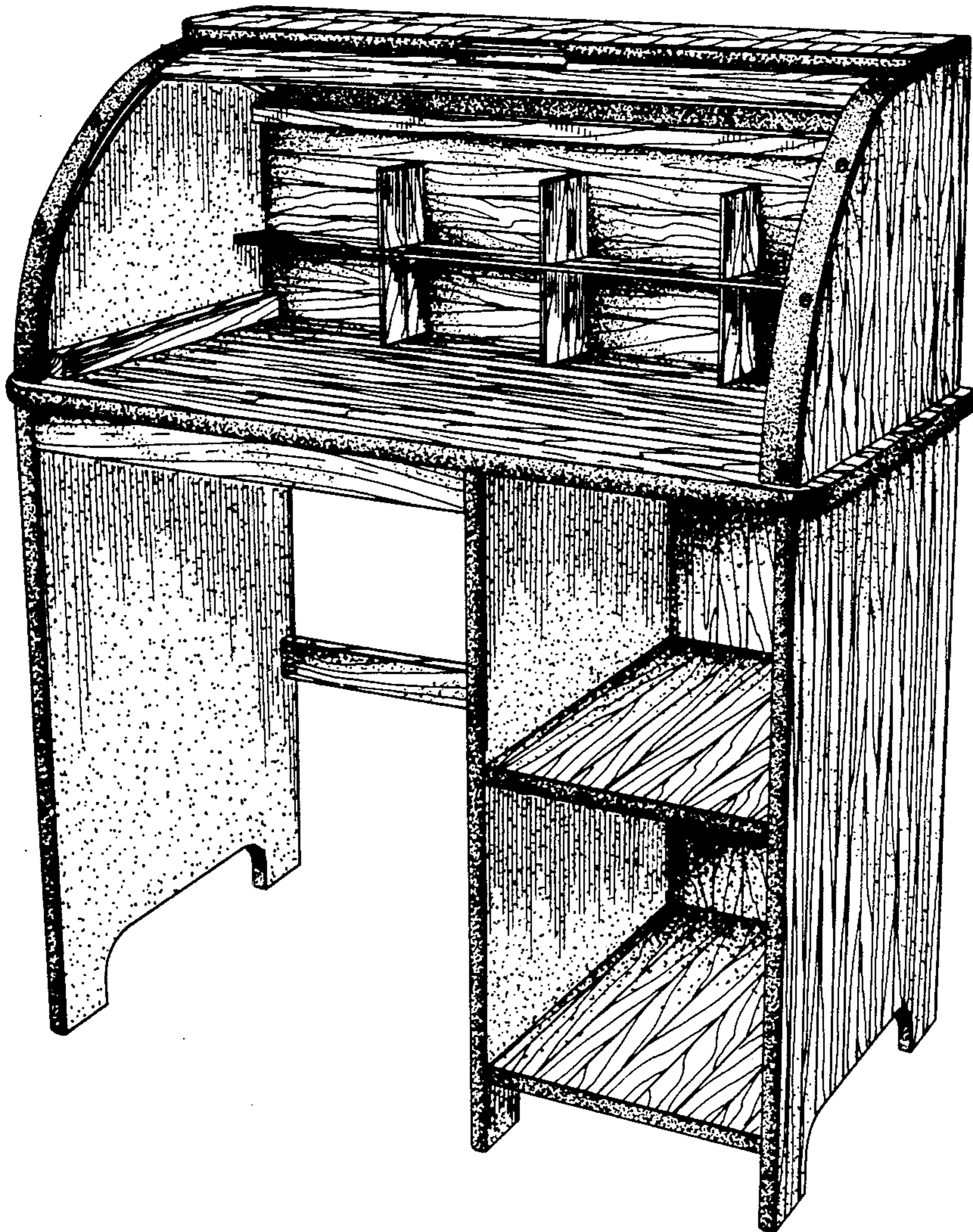
