[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a child's roll-top desk or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a child's roll-top desk or similar article showing our new design, FIG. 2 is a top view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation thereof, the left side elevation being a mirror image; and, FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof, shown with the roll-top opened.

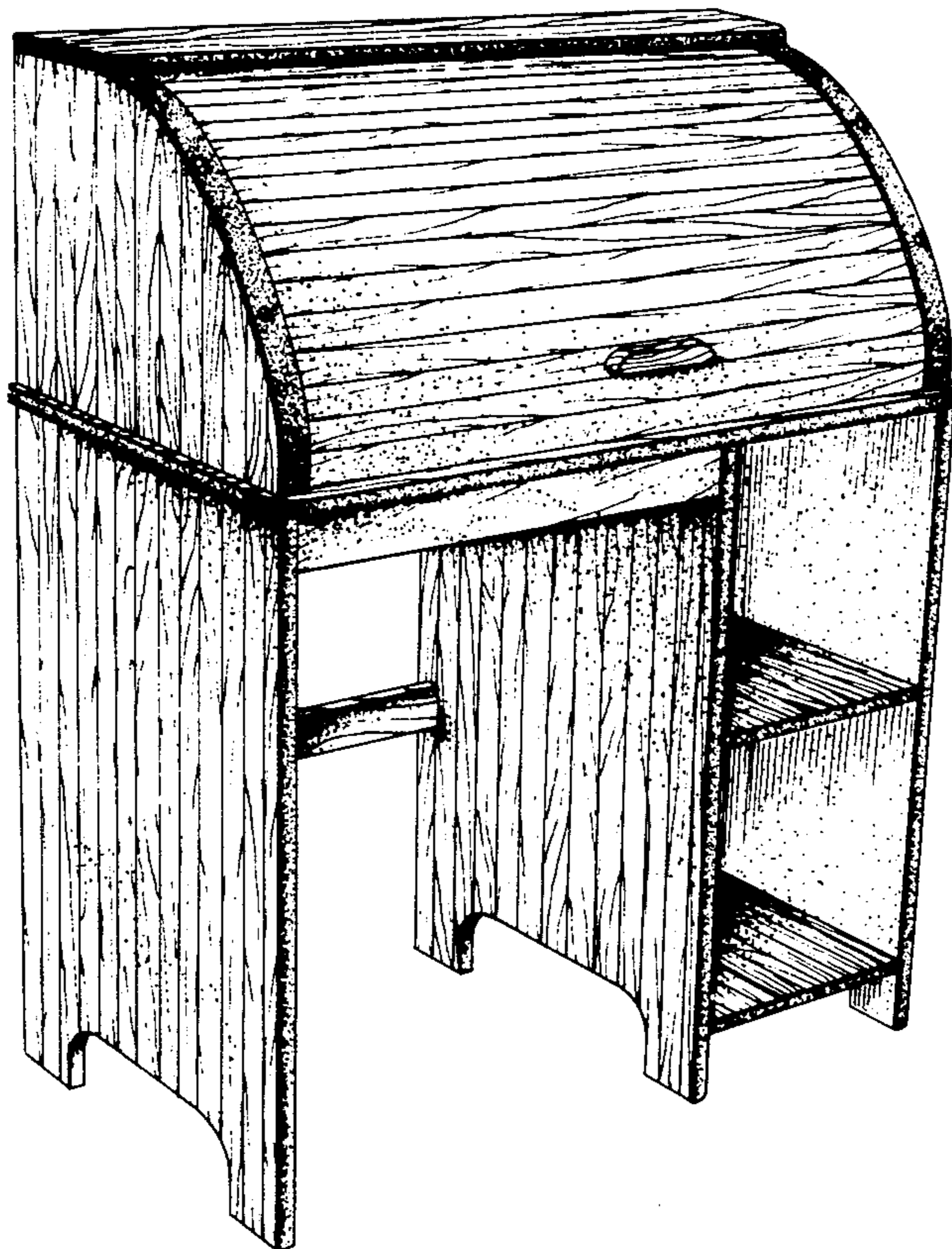

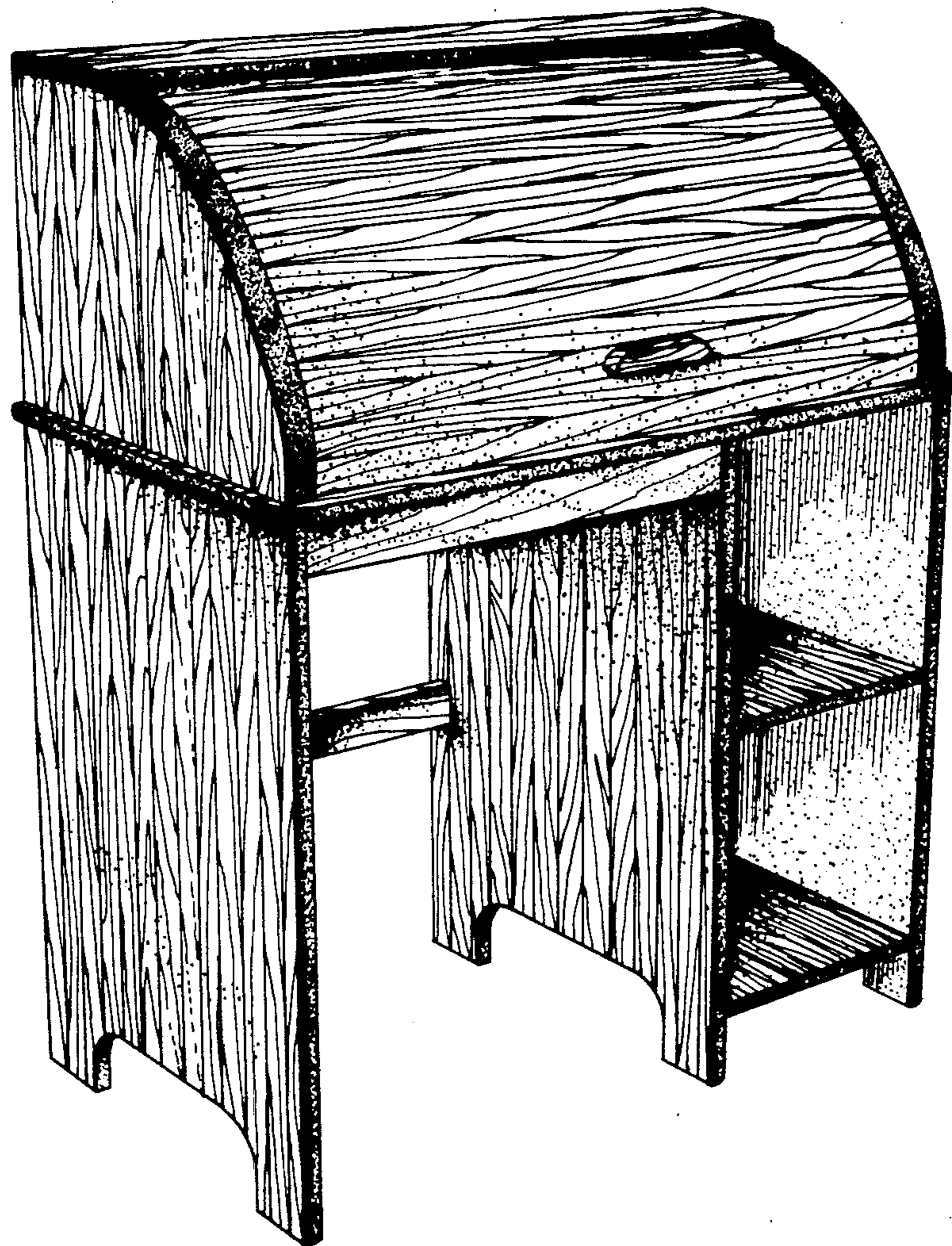

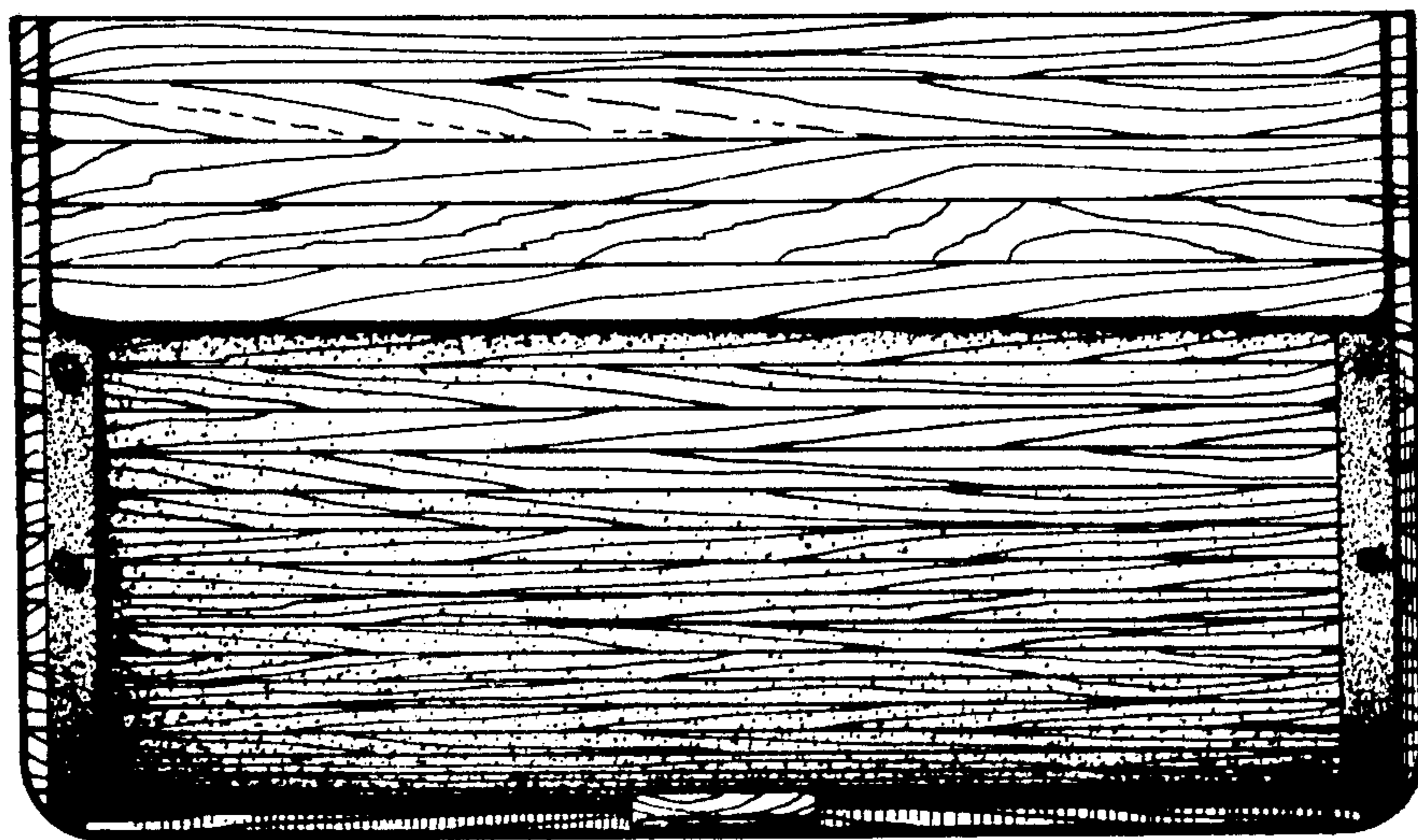

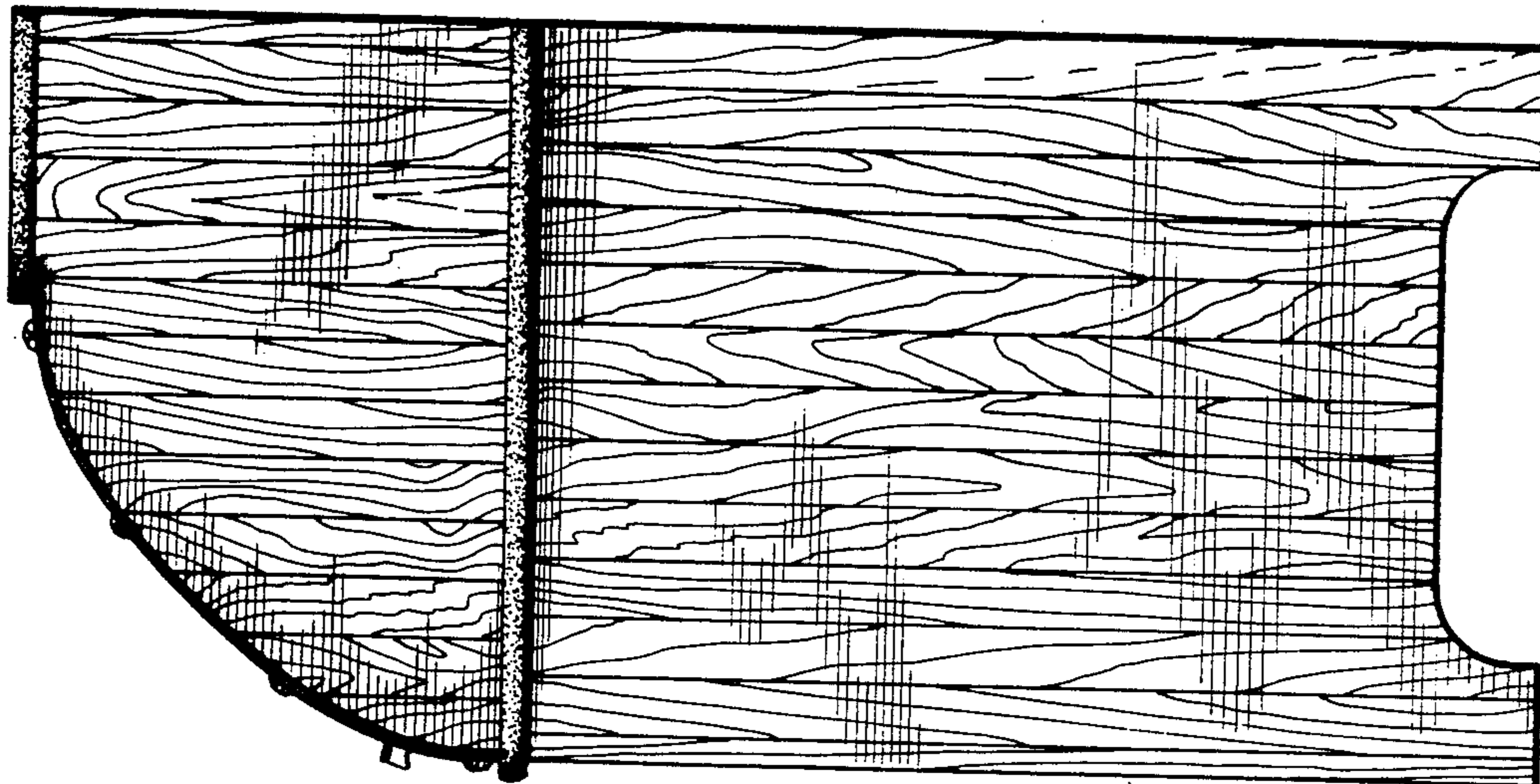
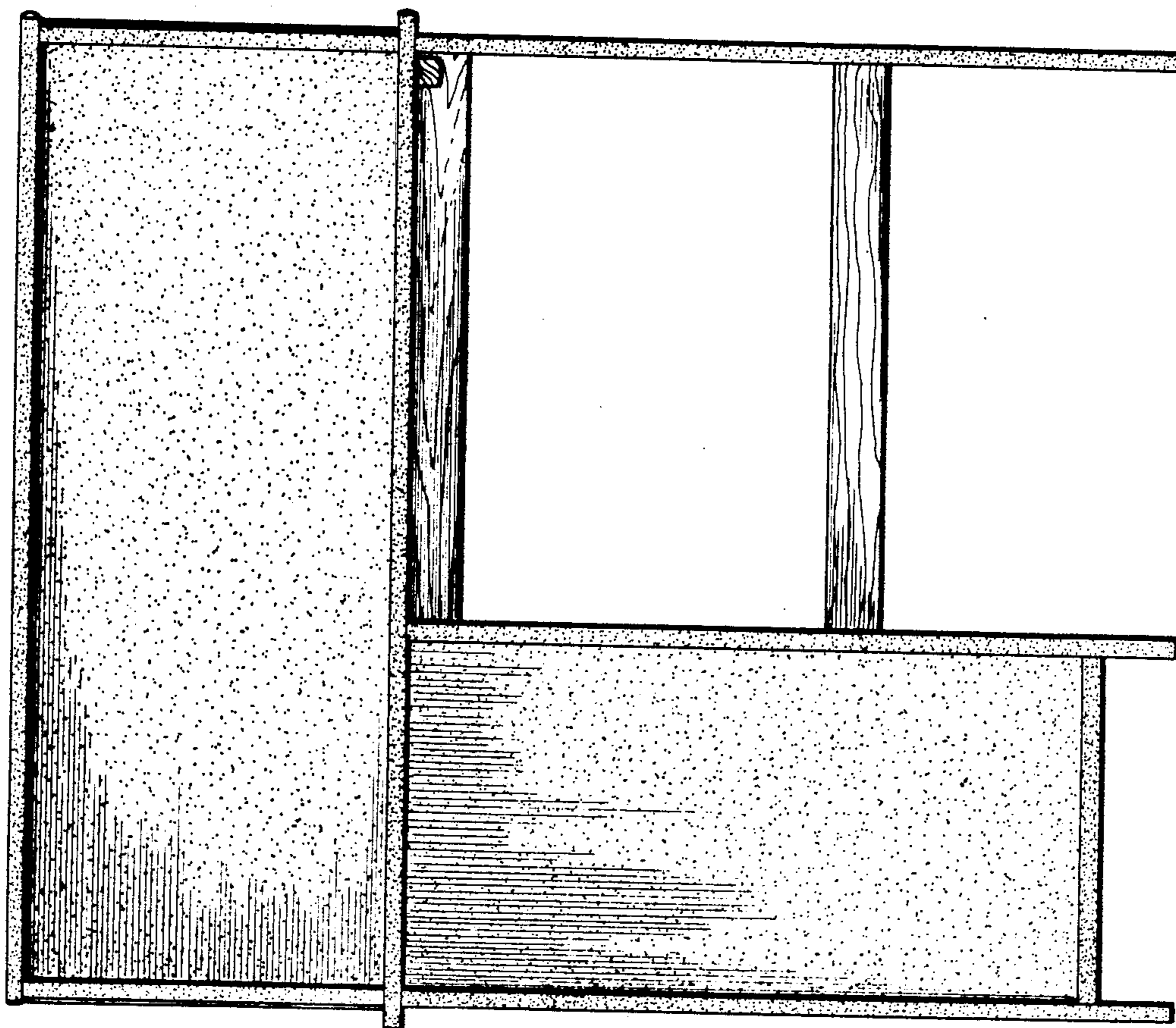

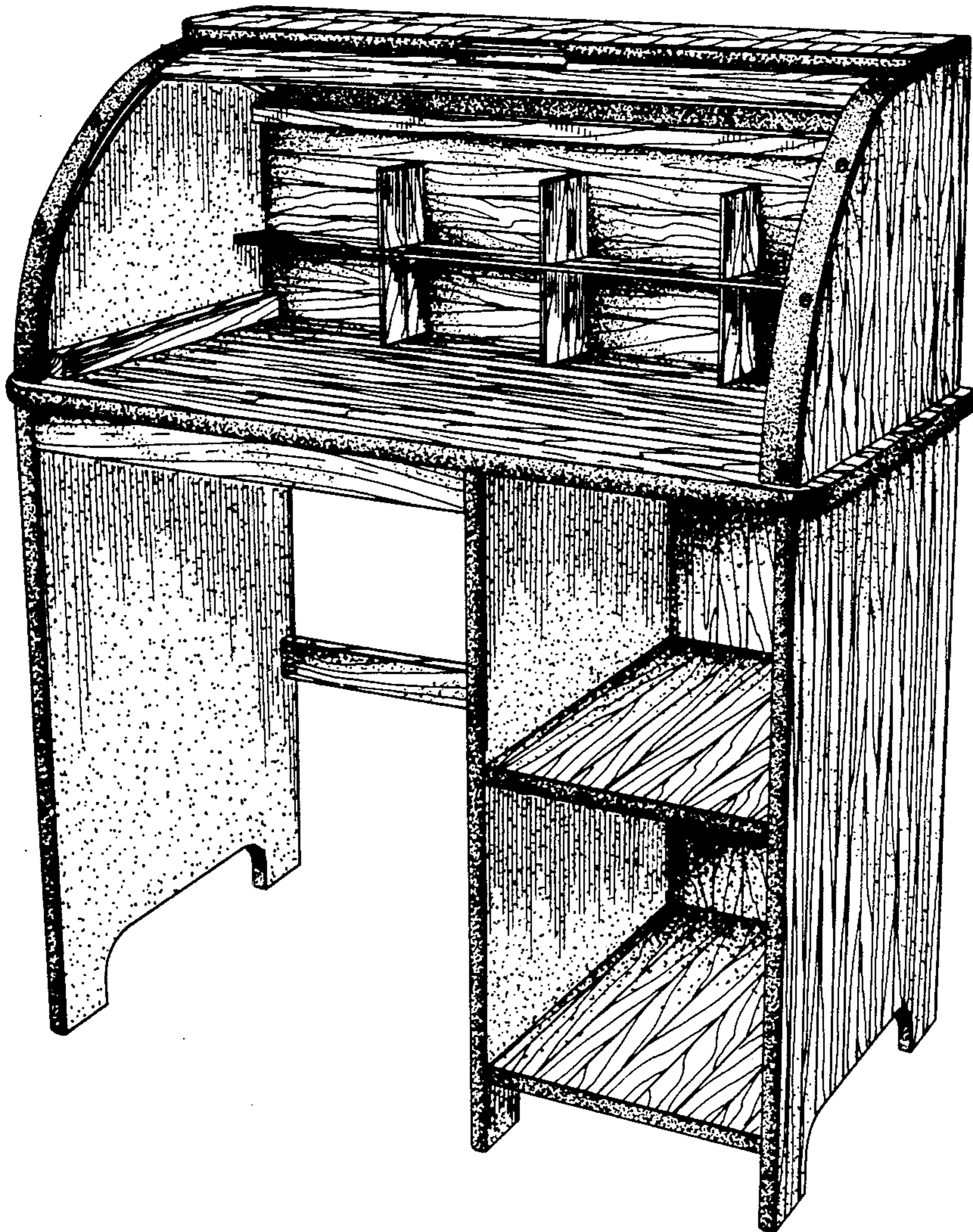
