[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chair with single arm rest, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the chair with single arm rest where one of the two adjacent sides is lowered on the seat forming the arm;
FIG. 2 is the rear elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 5 is an elevational view taken from either side thereof;
FIG. 6 is an enlarged front perspective view of the arm-chair of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the arm-chair in which the two adjacent sides are erect;
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 11 is an elevational view taken from either side thereof; and
FIG. 12 is an enlarged front perspective view of the arm-chair of FIG. 7;

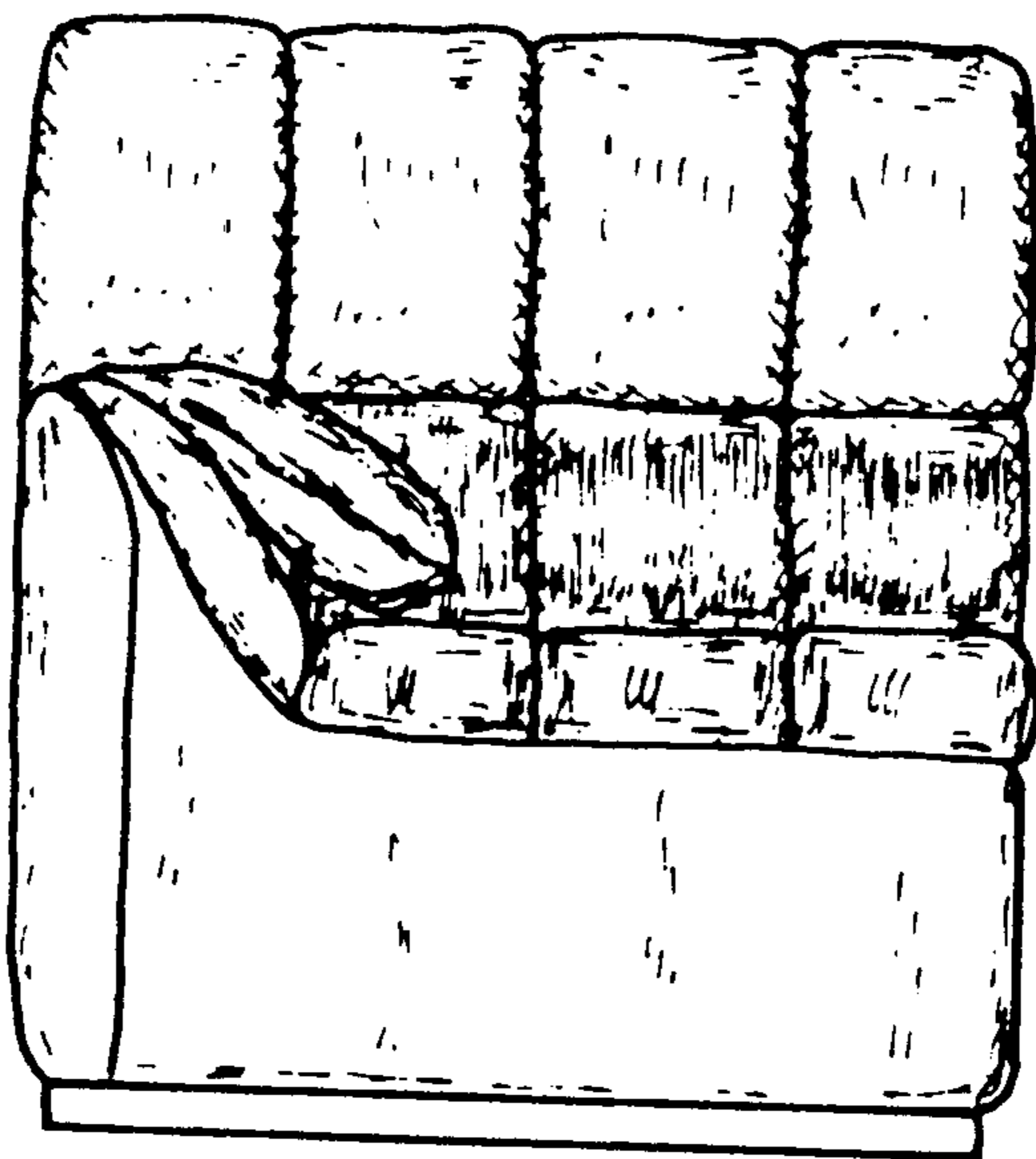

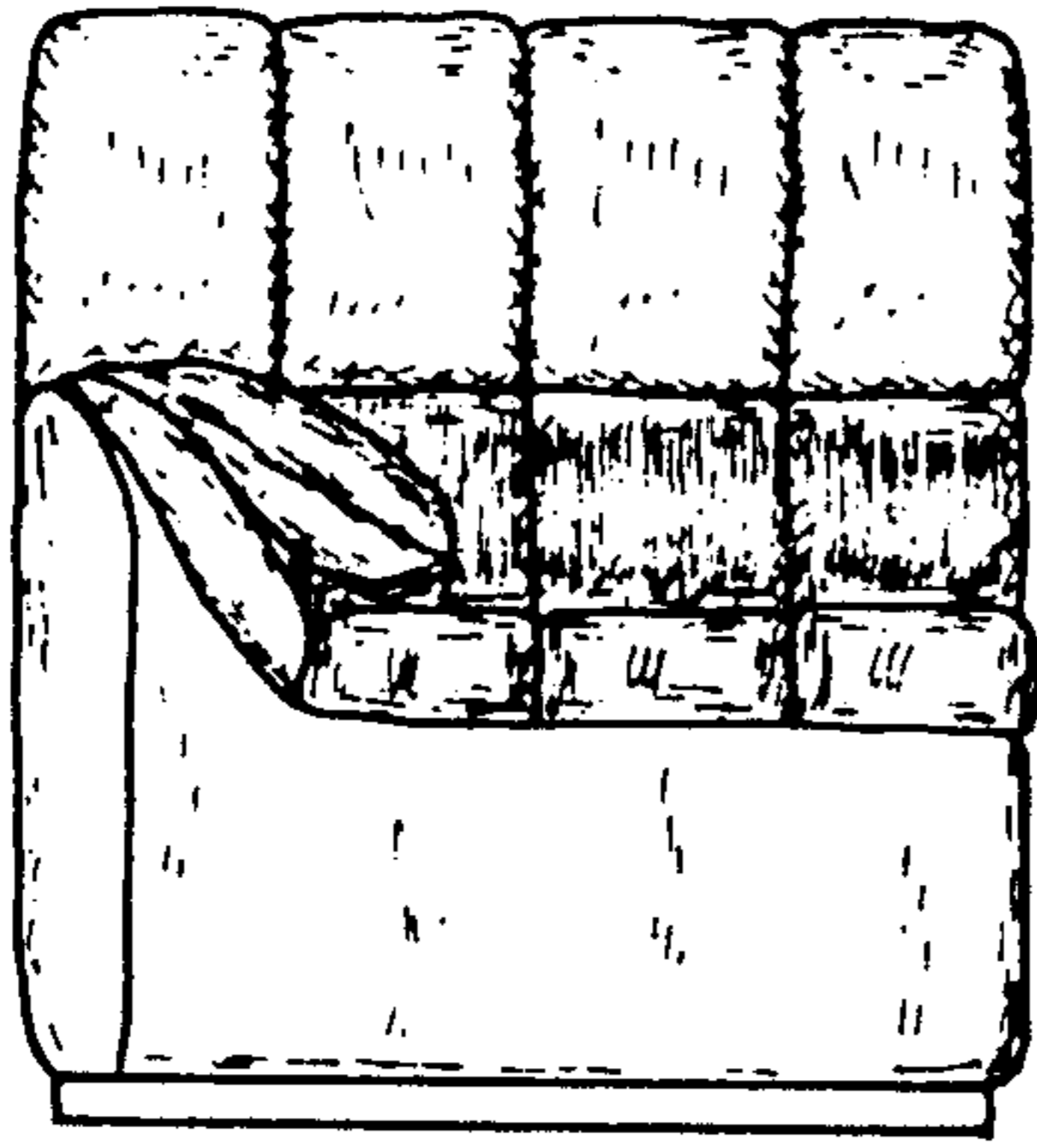

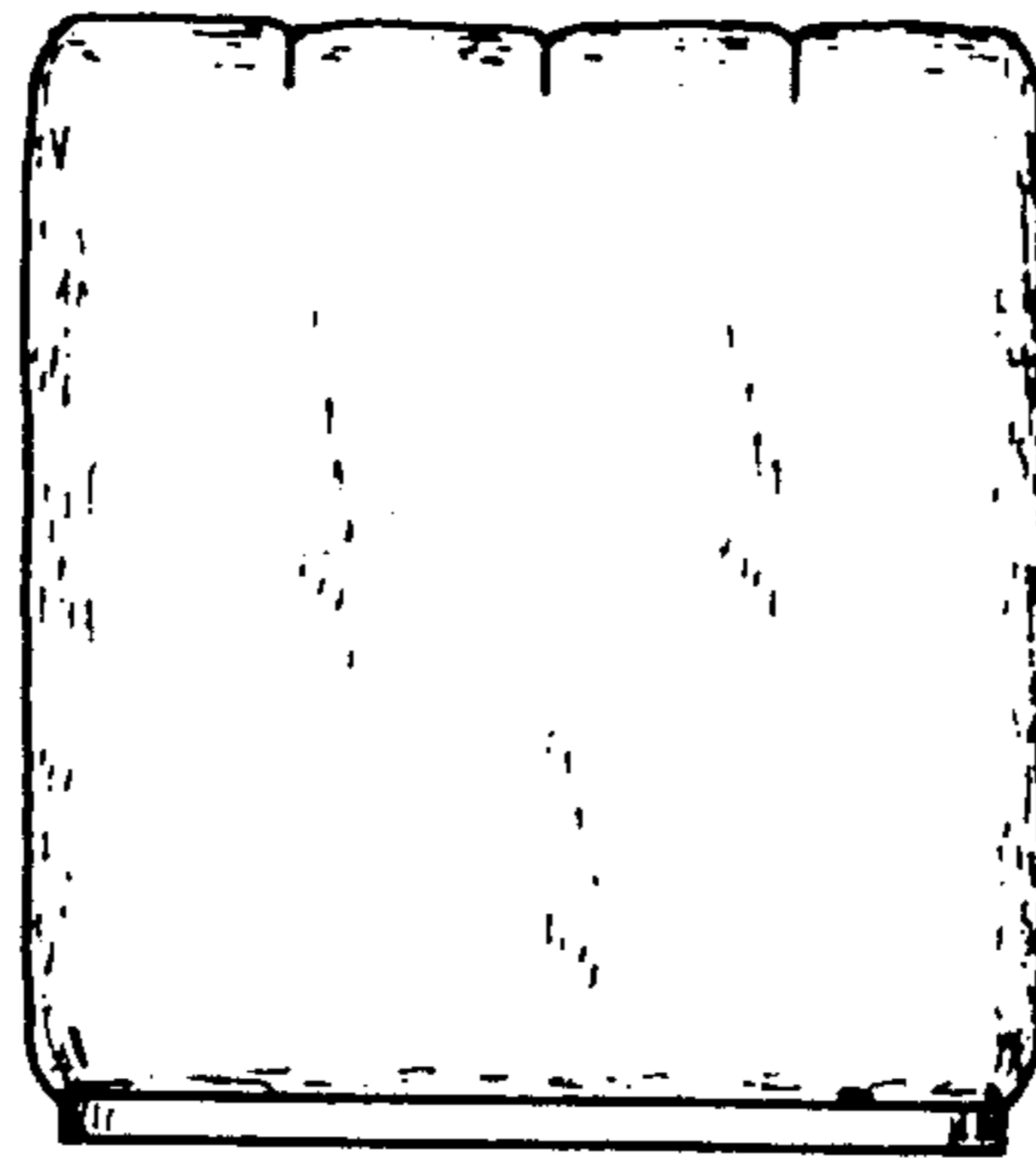

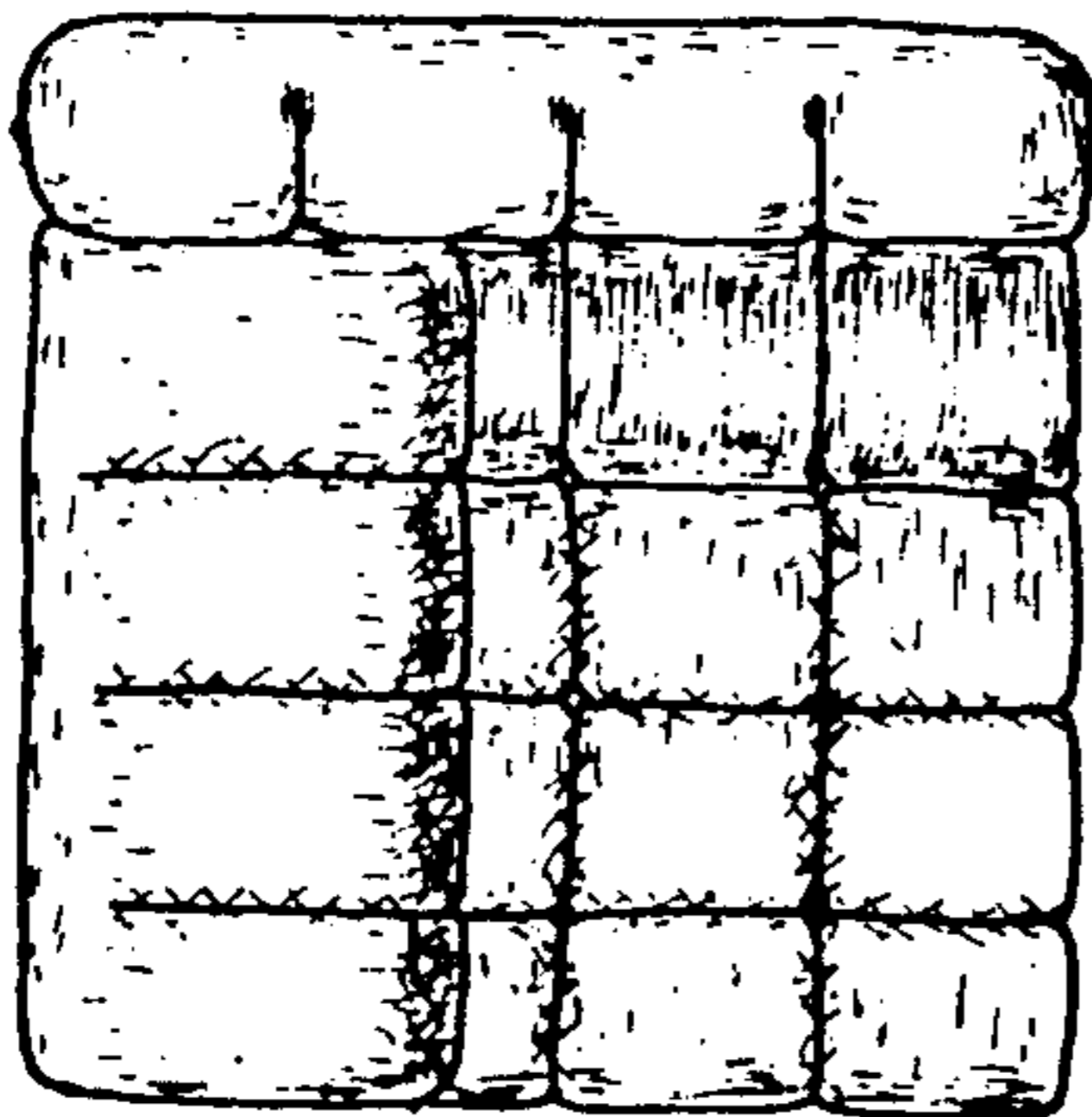

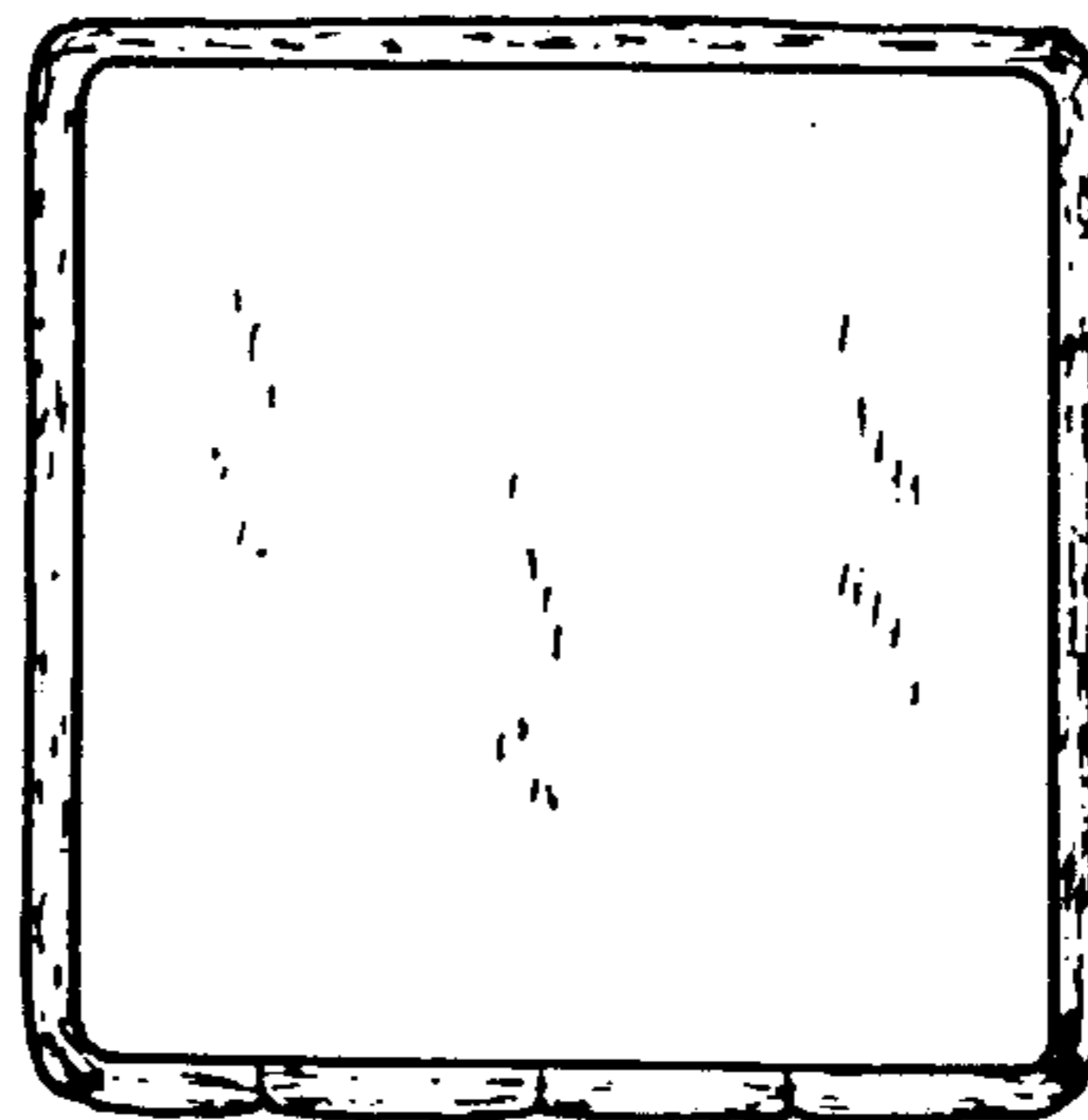

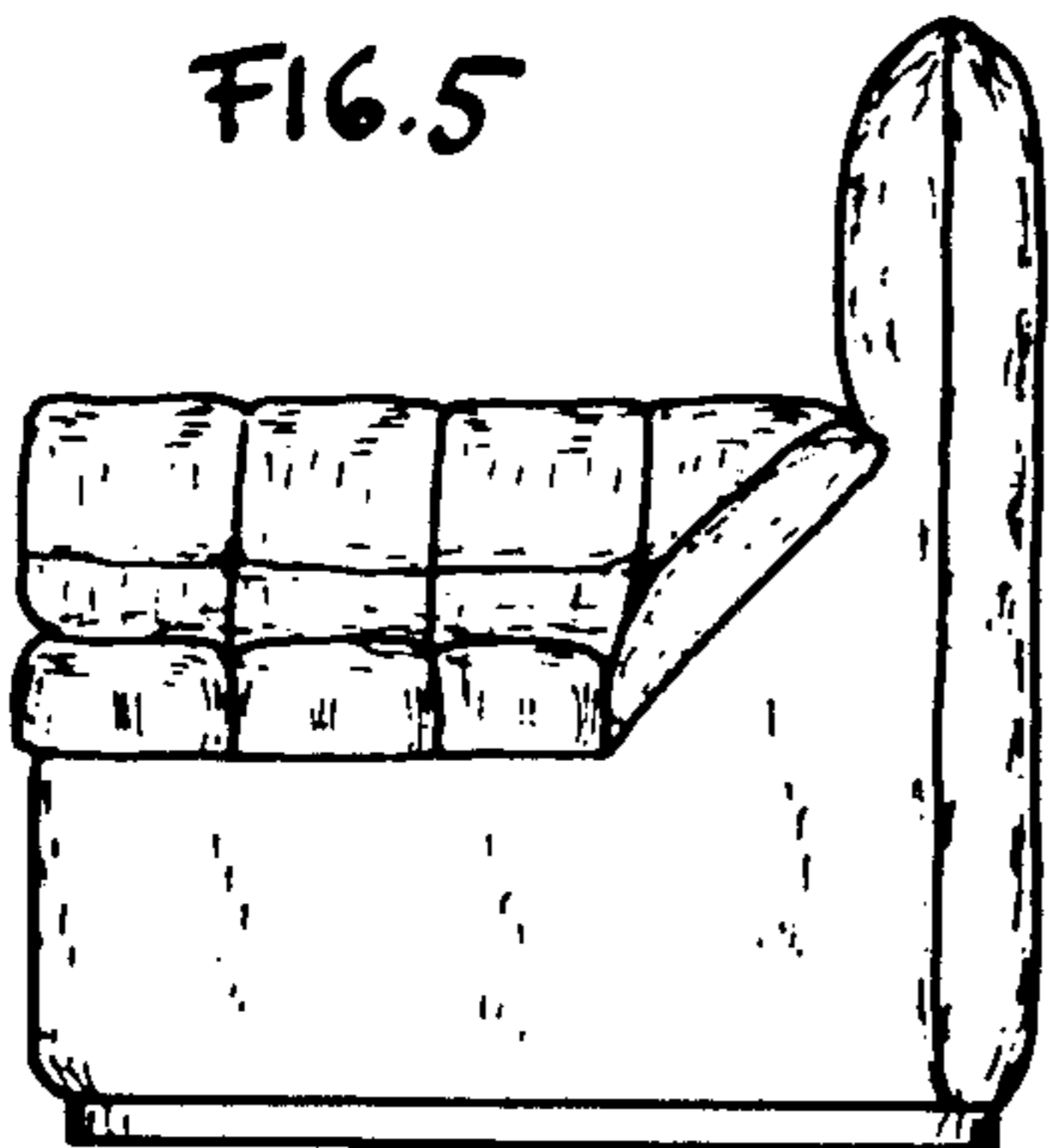

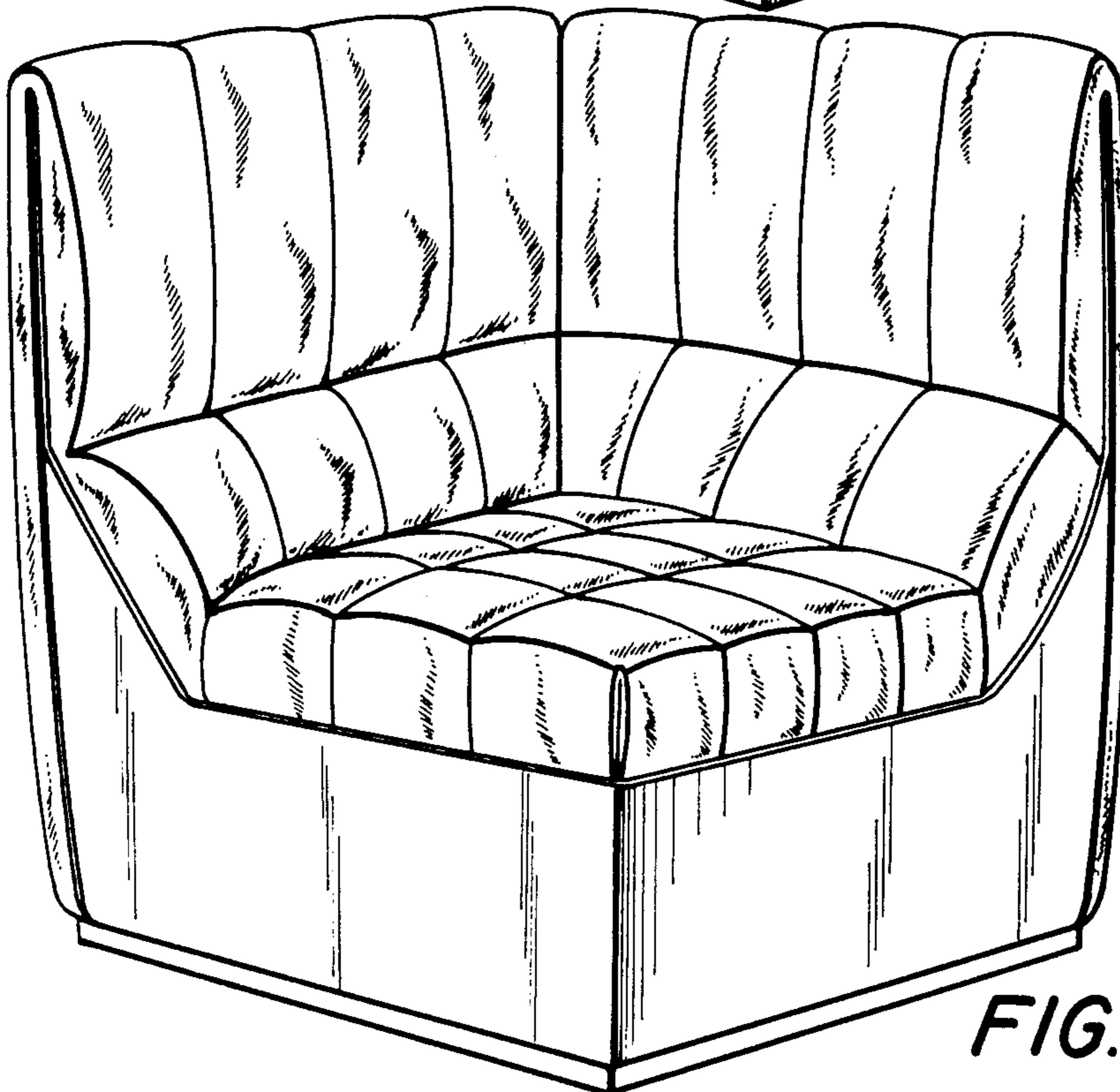
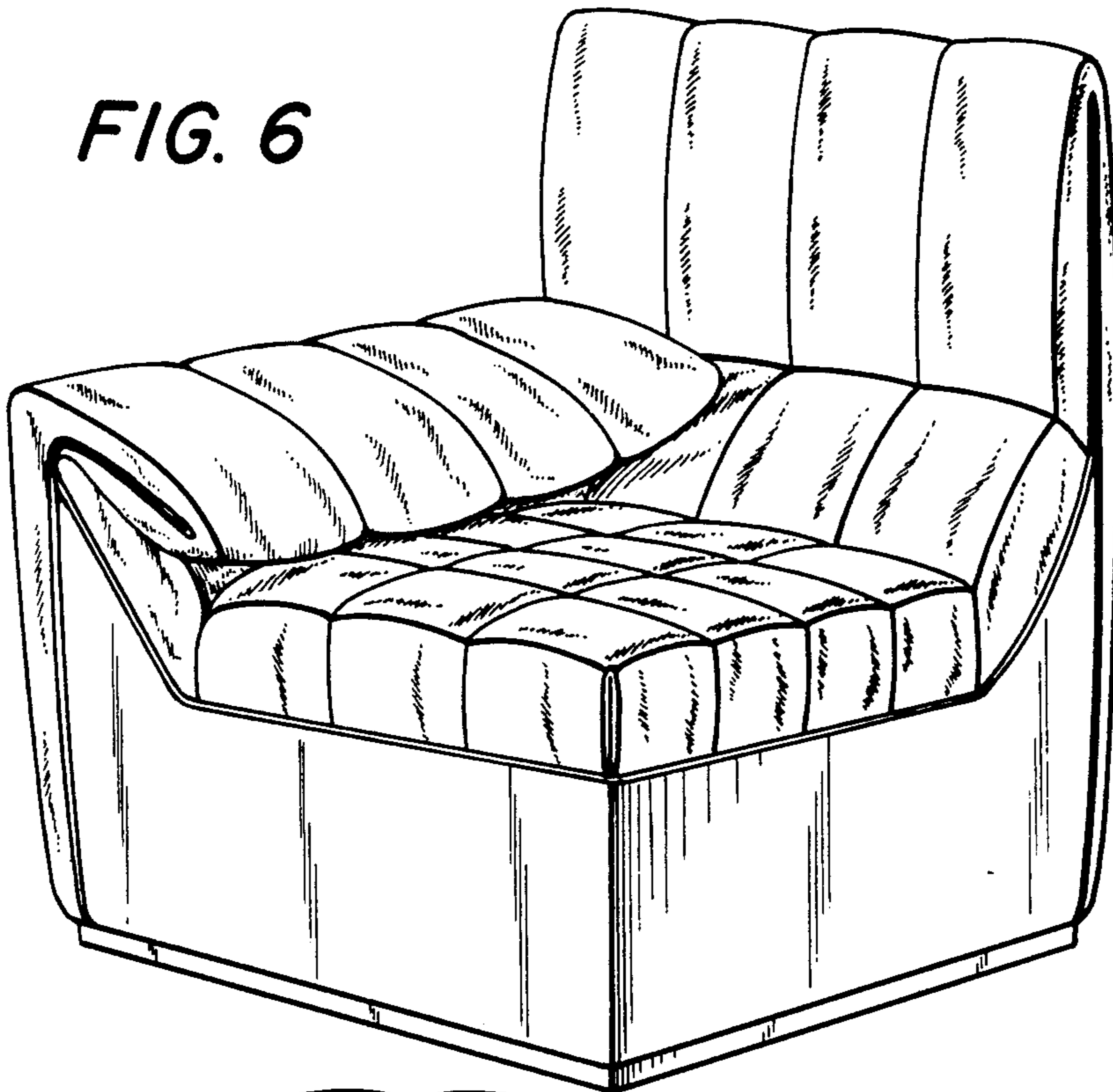

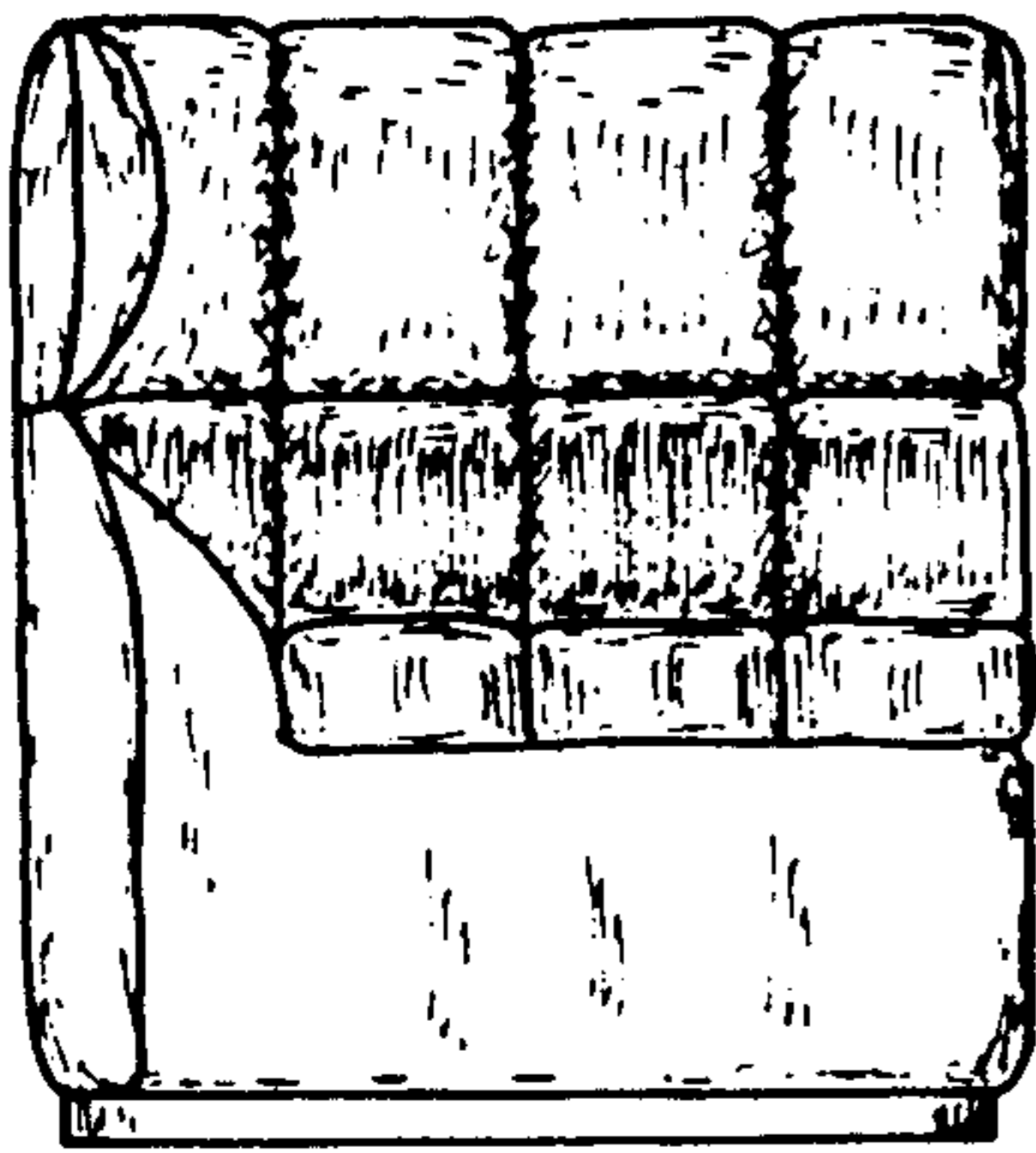

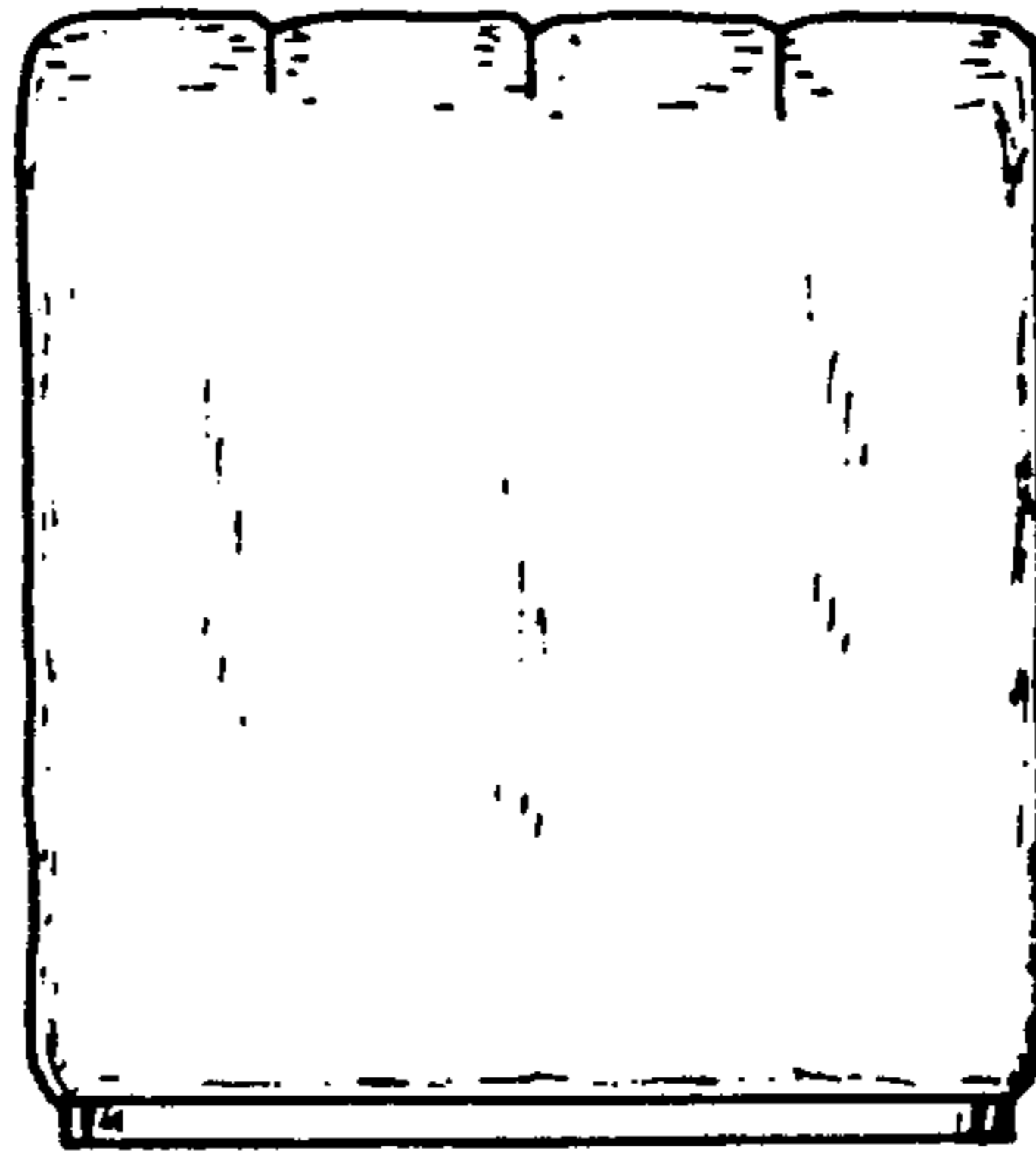

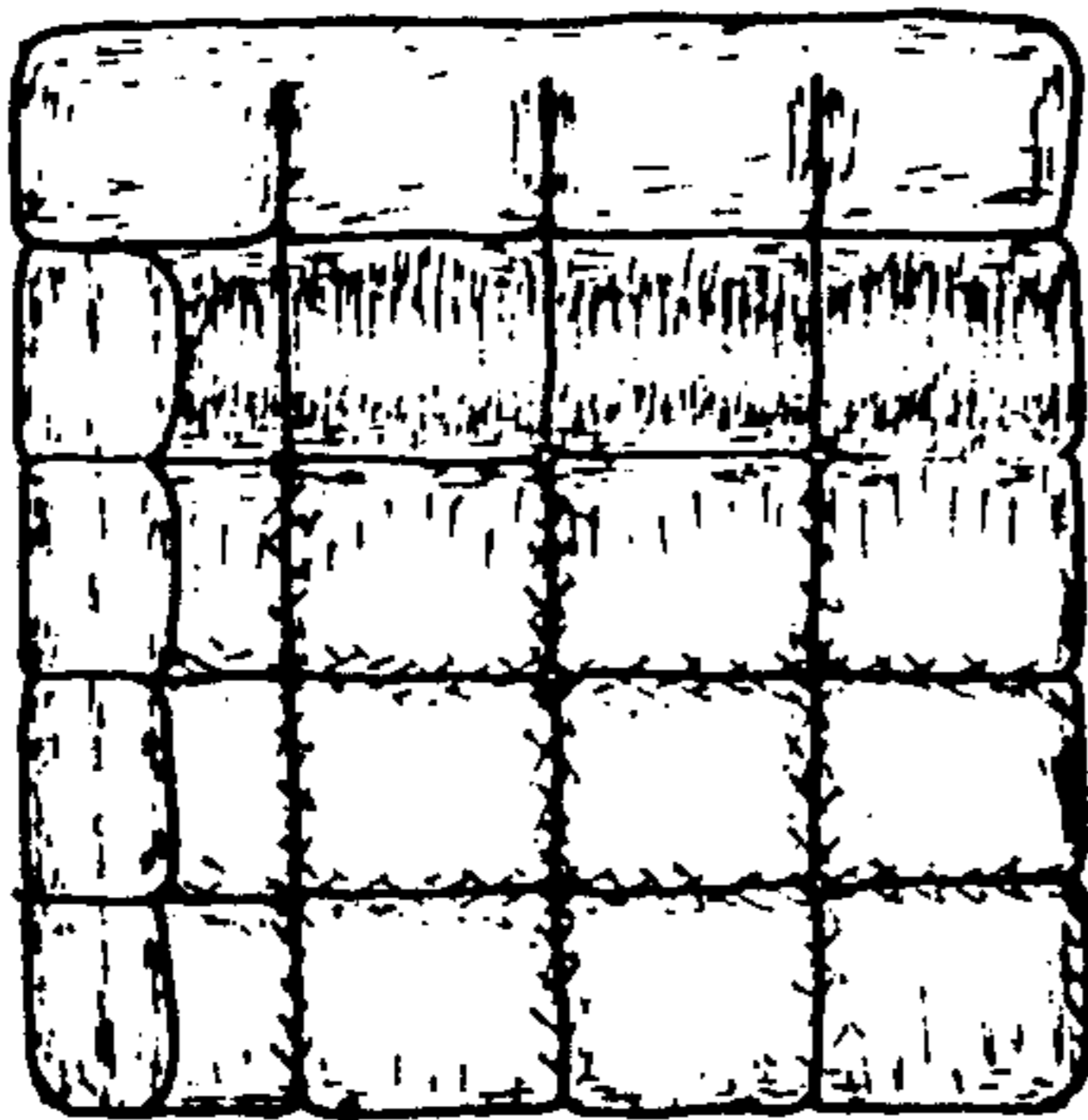

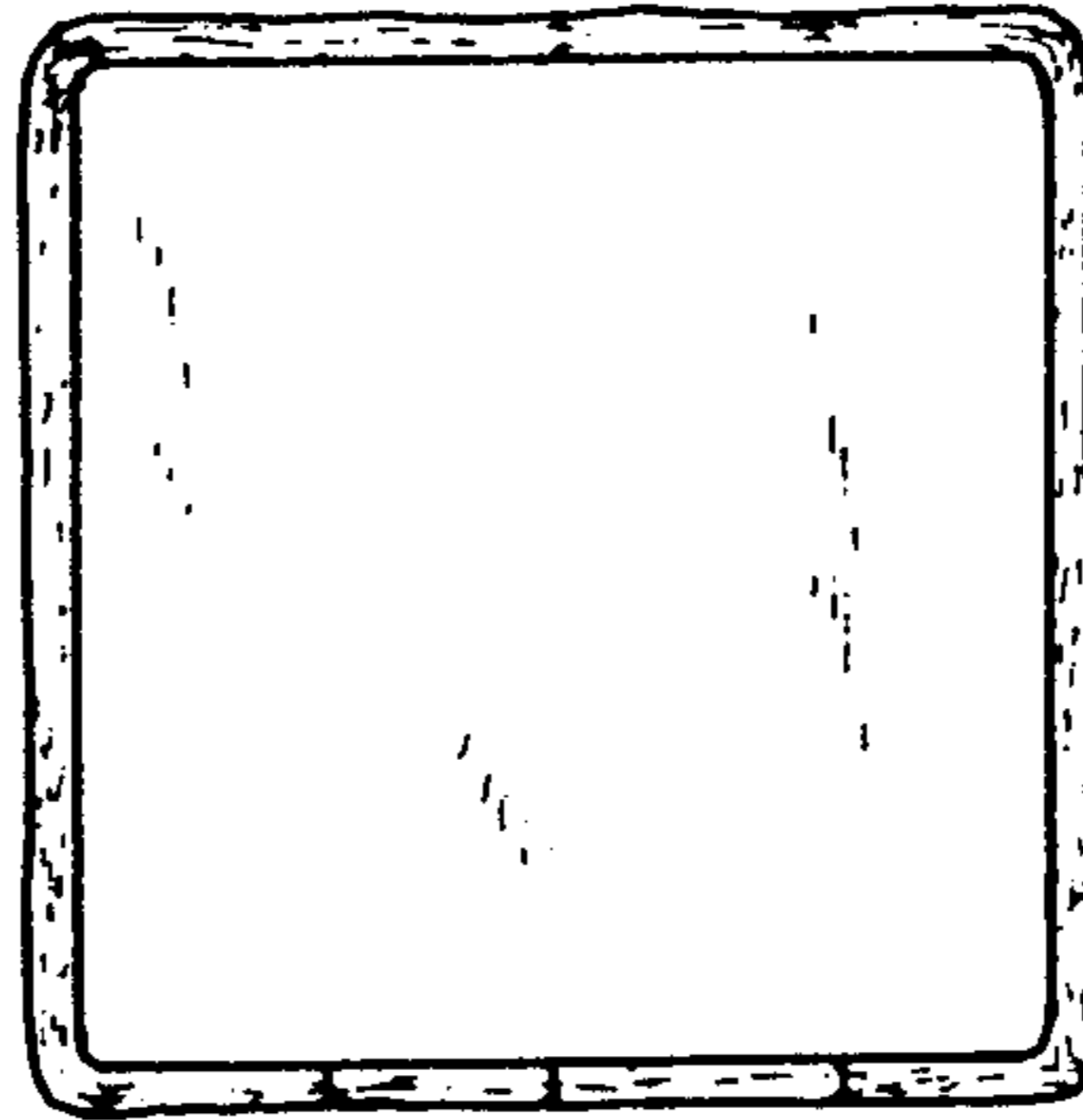
