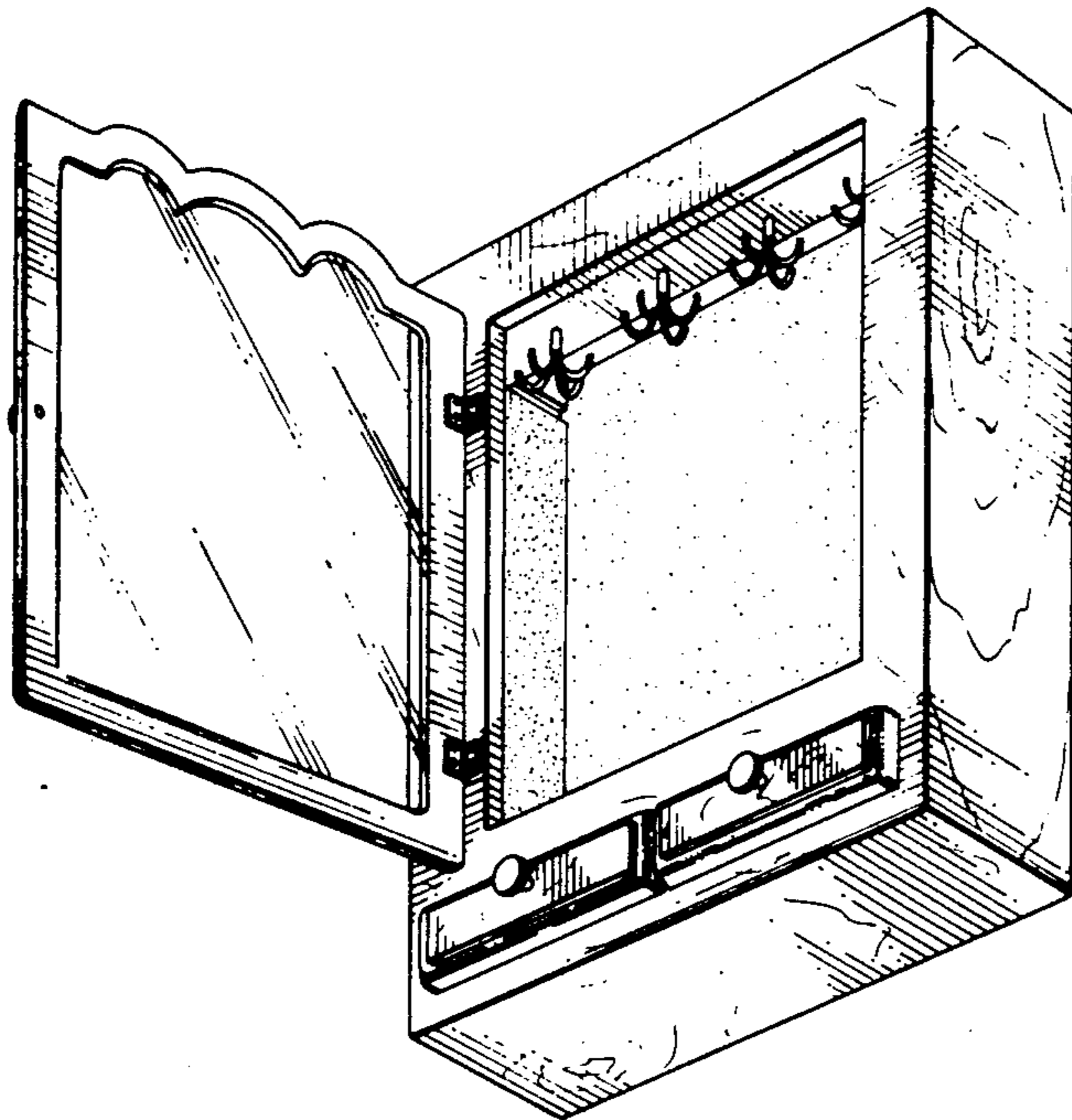

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wall cabinet for jewelry or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a wall cabinet for jewelry or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof with the door open. The side not shown has the same appearance as the side shown.



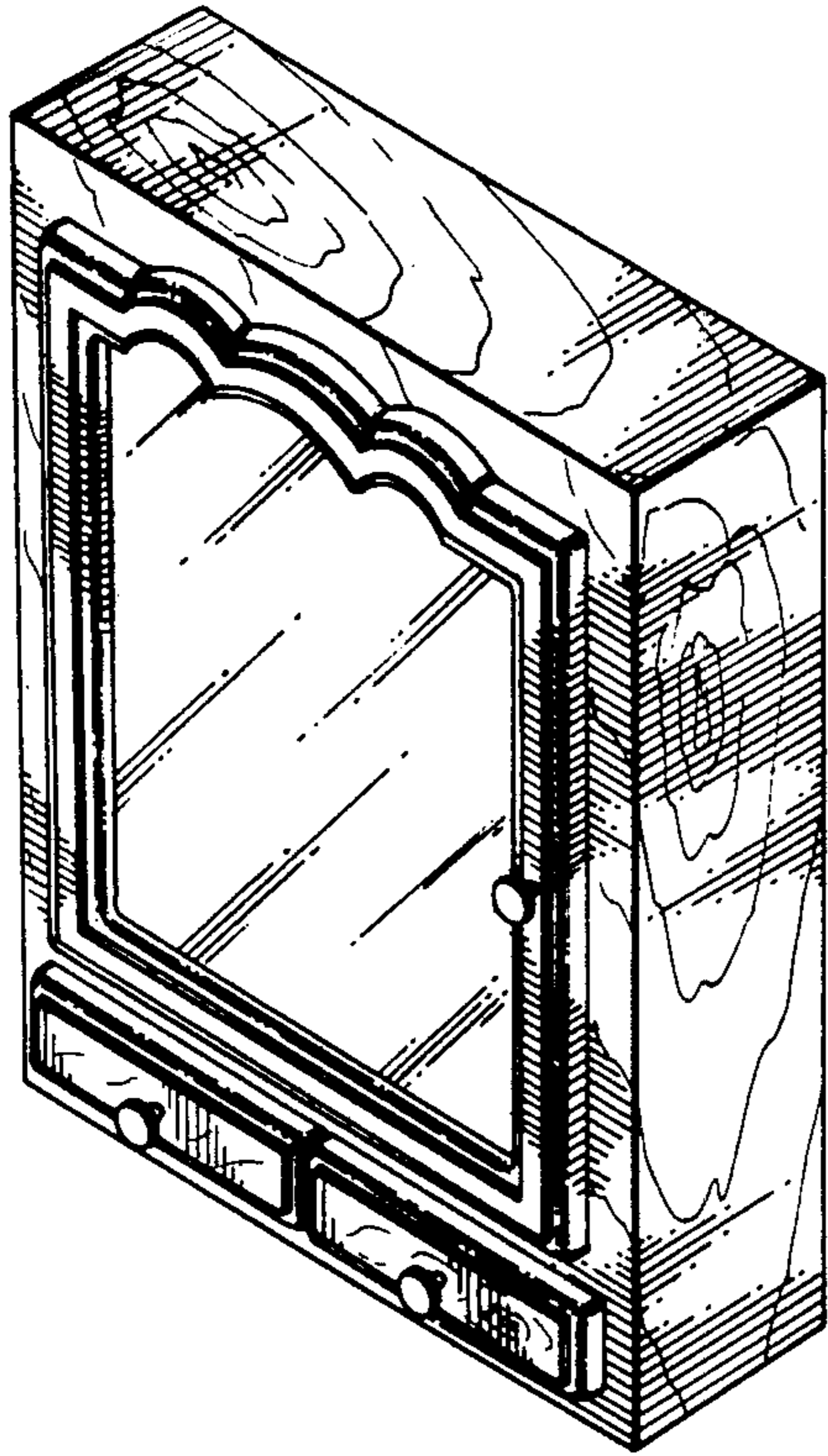

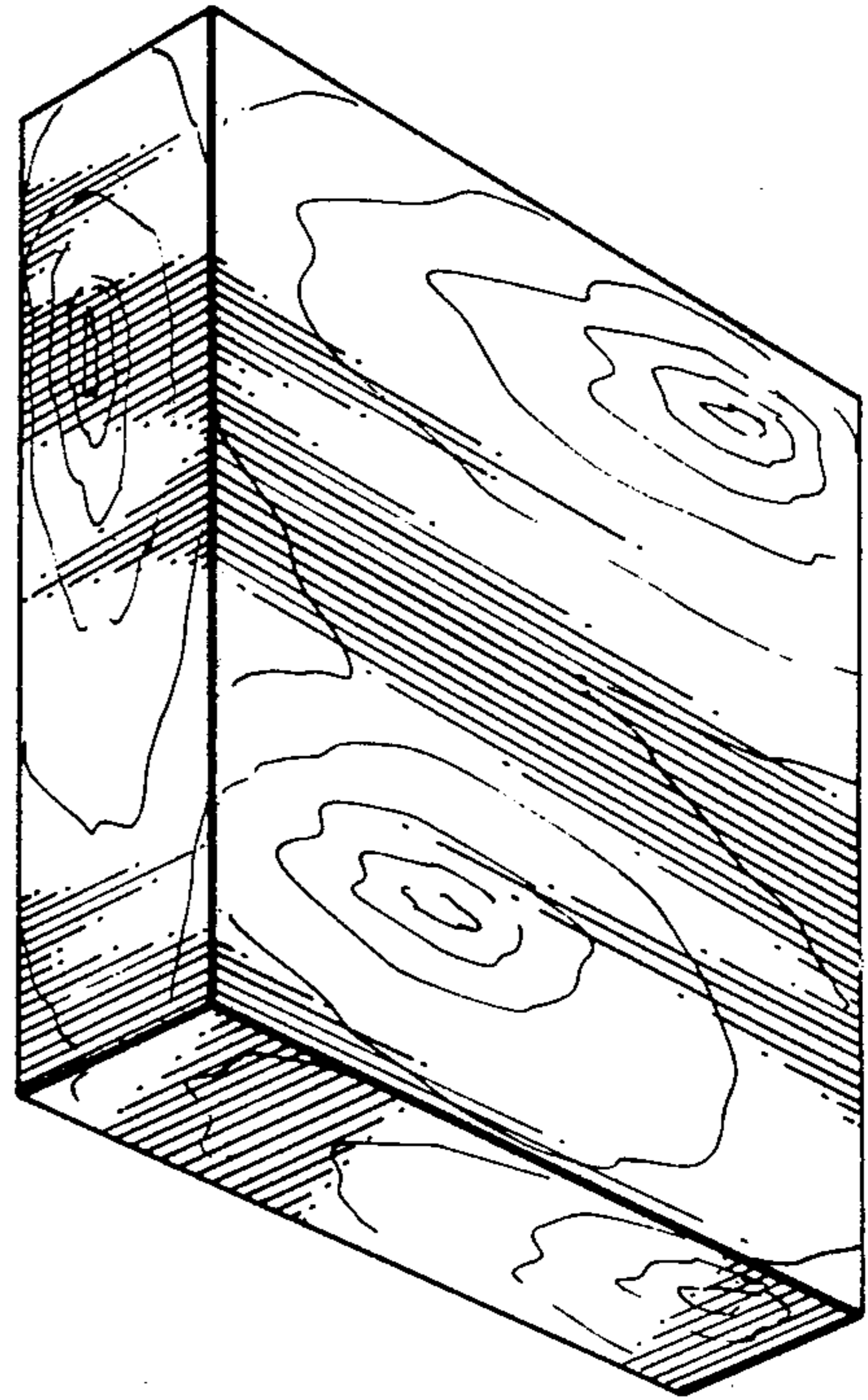

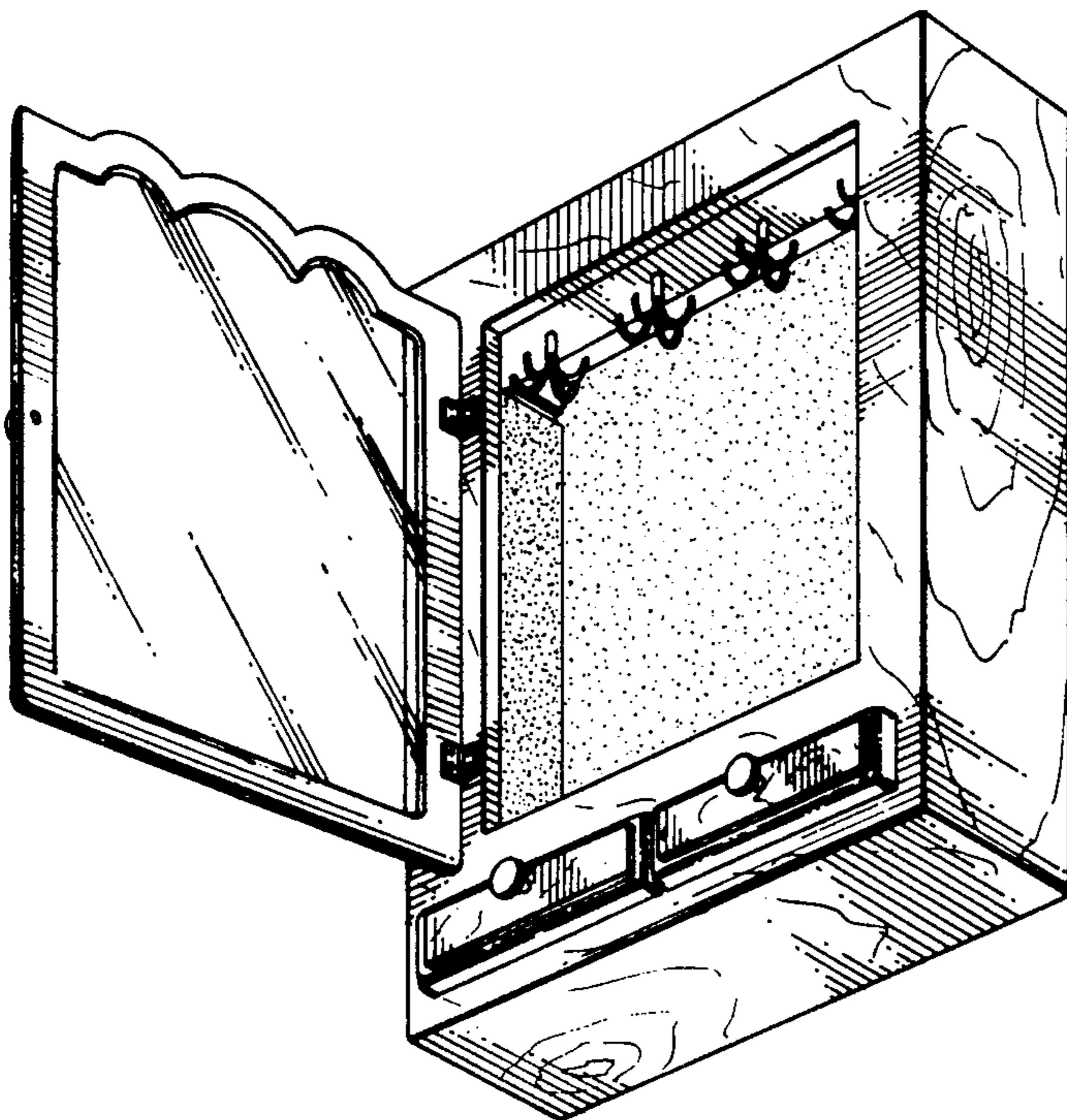
