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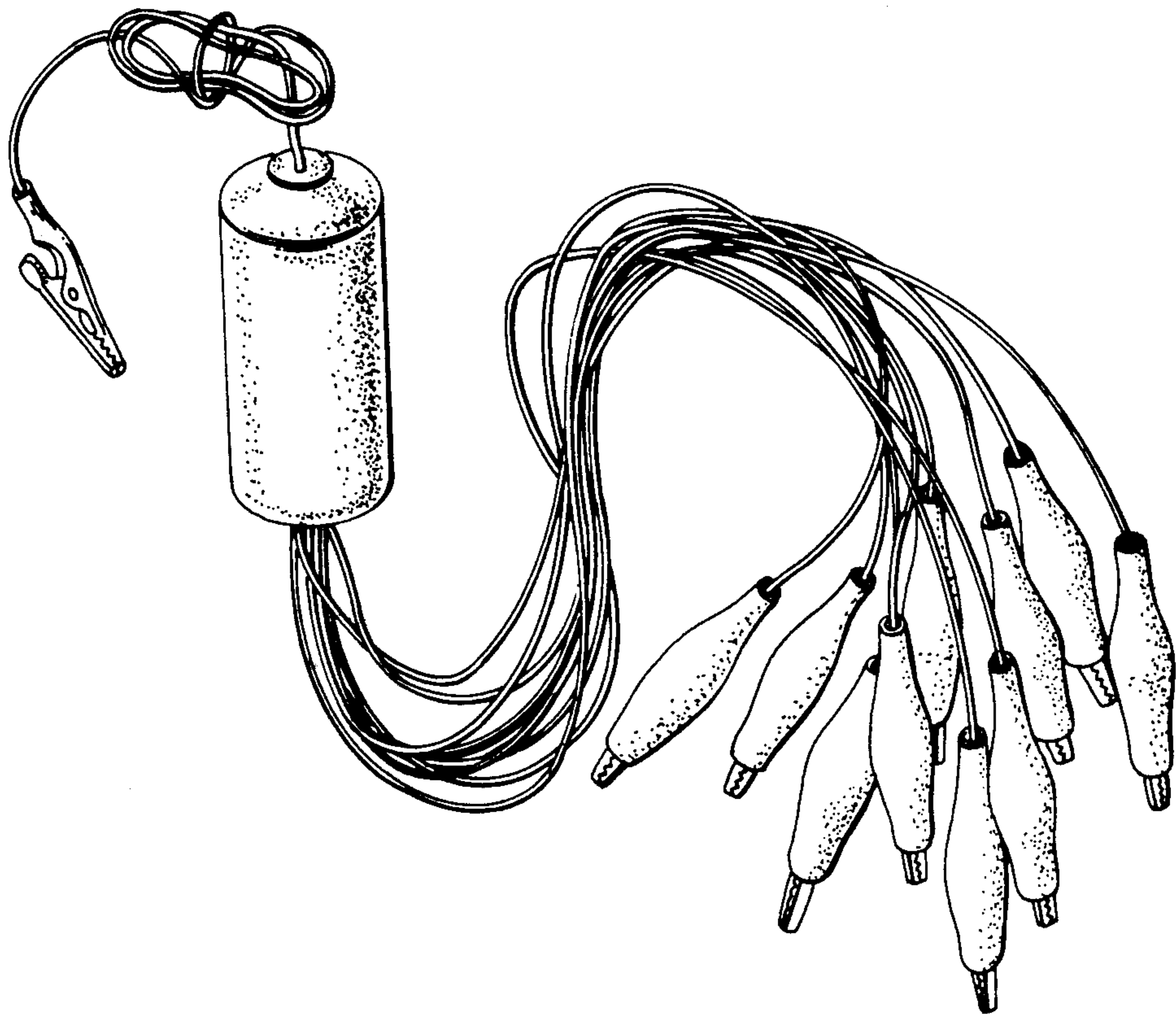

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an electrical testing instrument showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



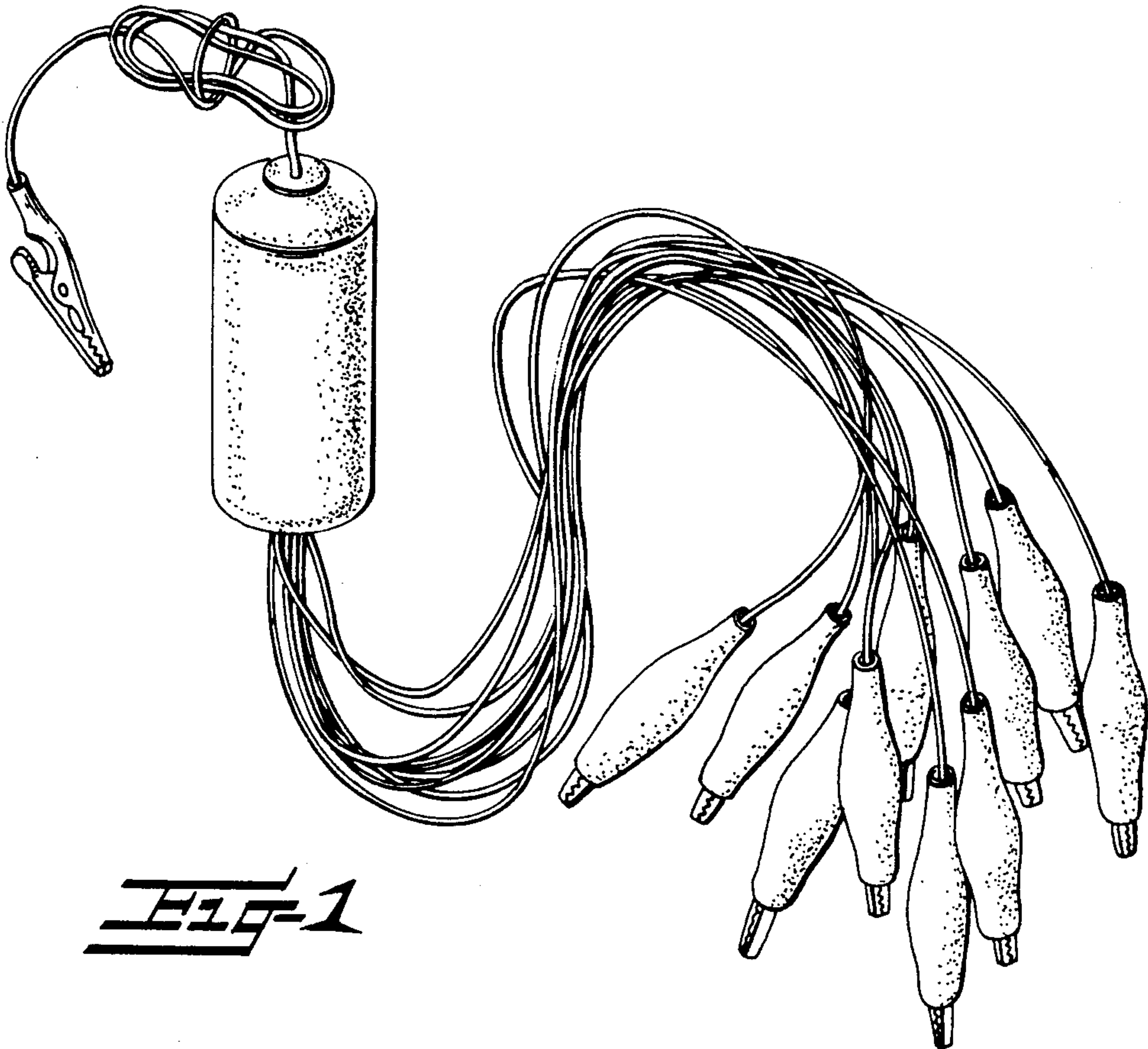

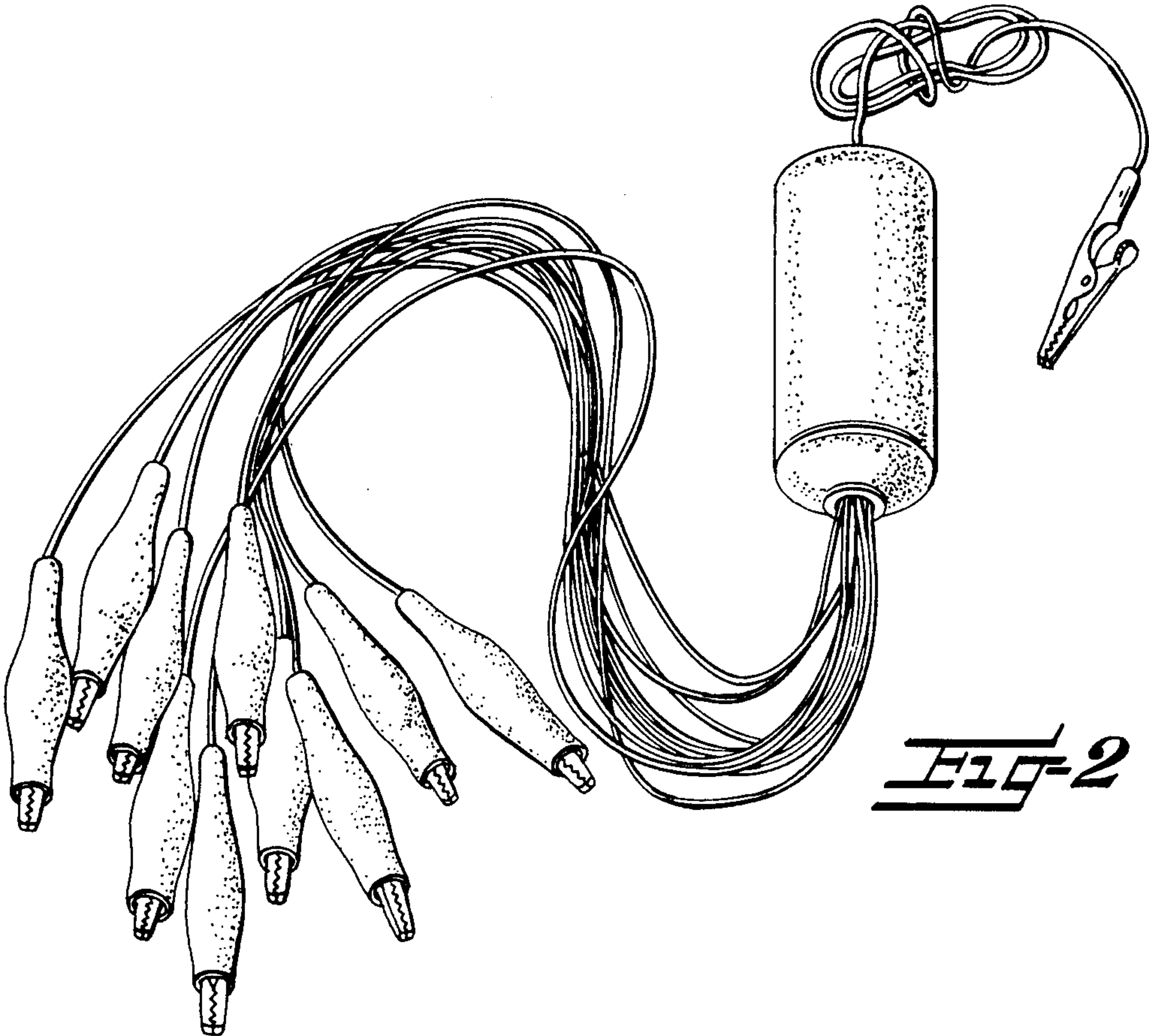
