guard showing our new design;

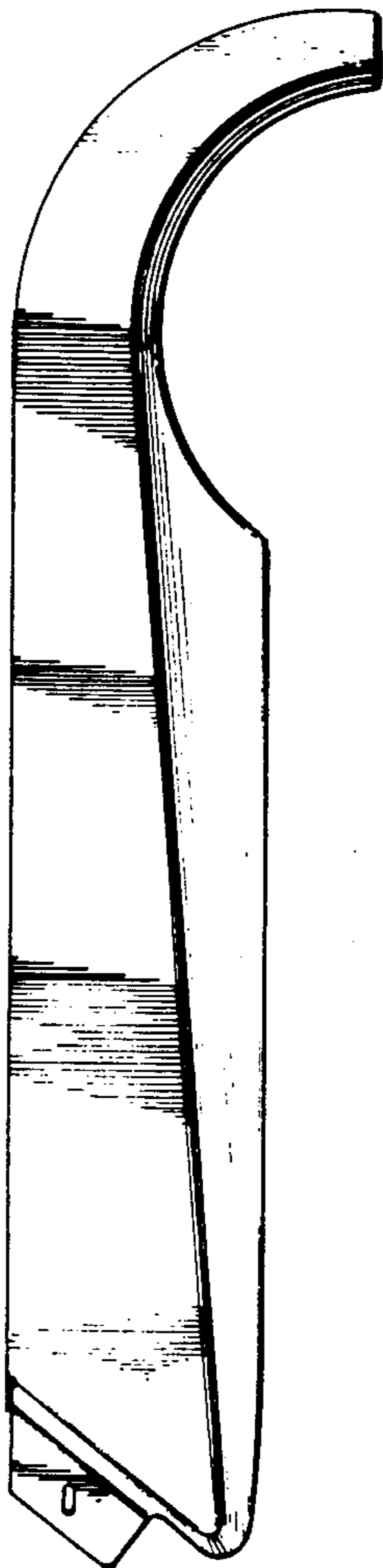
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

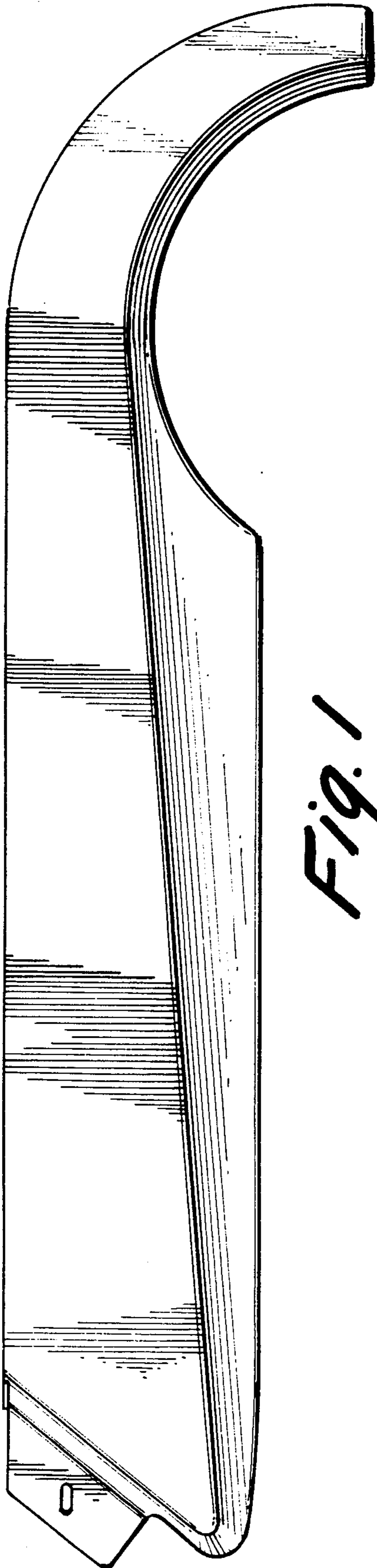
FIG. 3 is an elevational view from the side opposite that

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

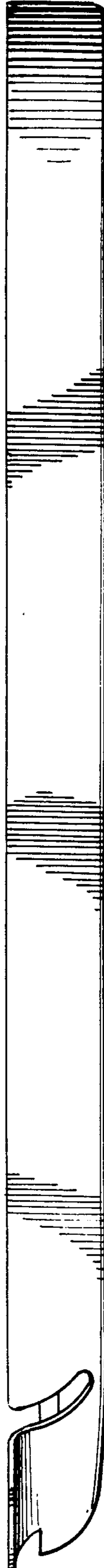
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

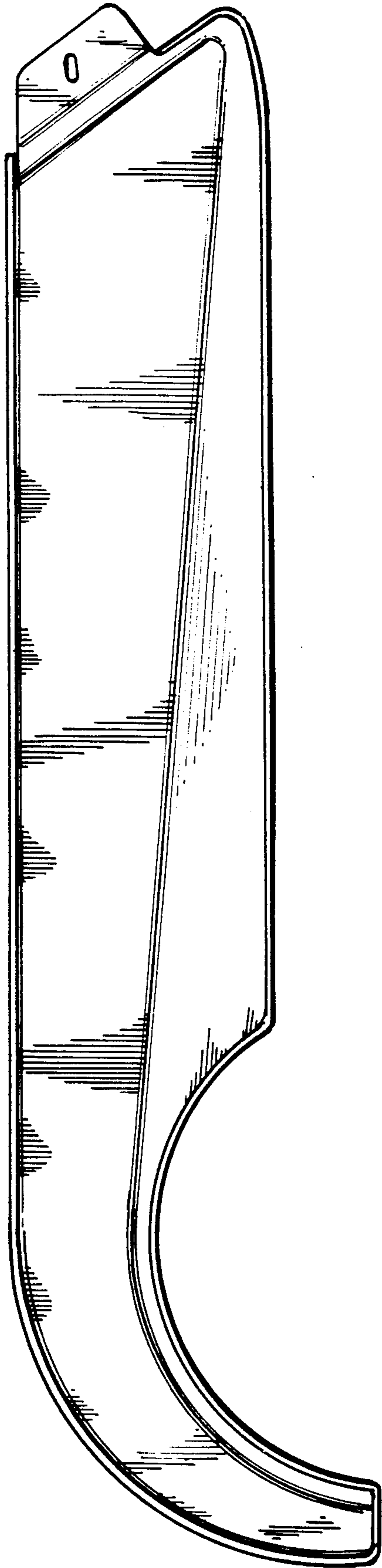

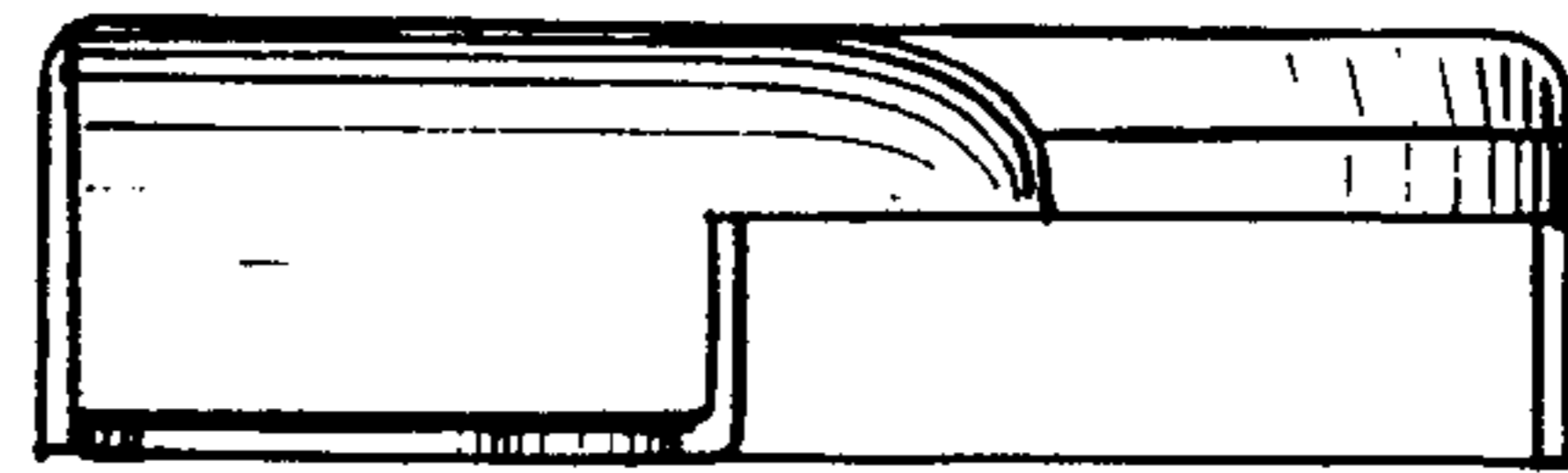
