DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tray showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the tray;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the tray;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the tray; and
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 as applied to FIG. 2.

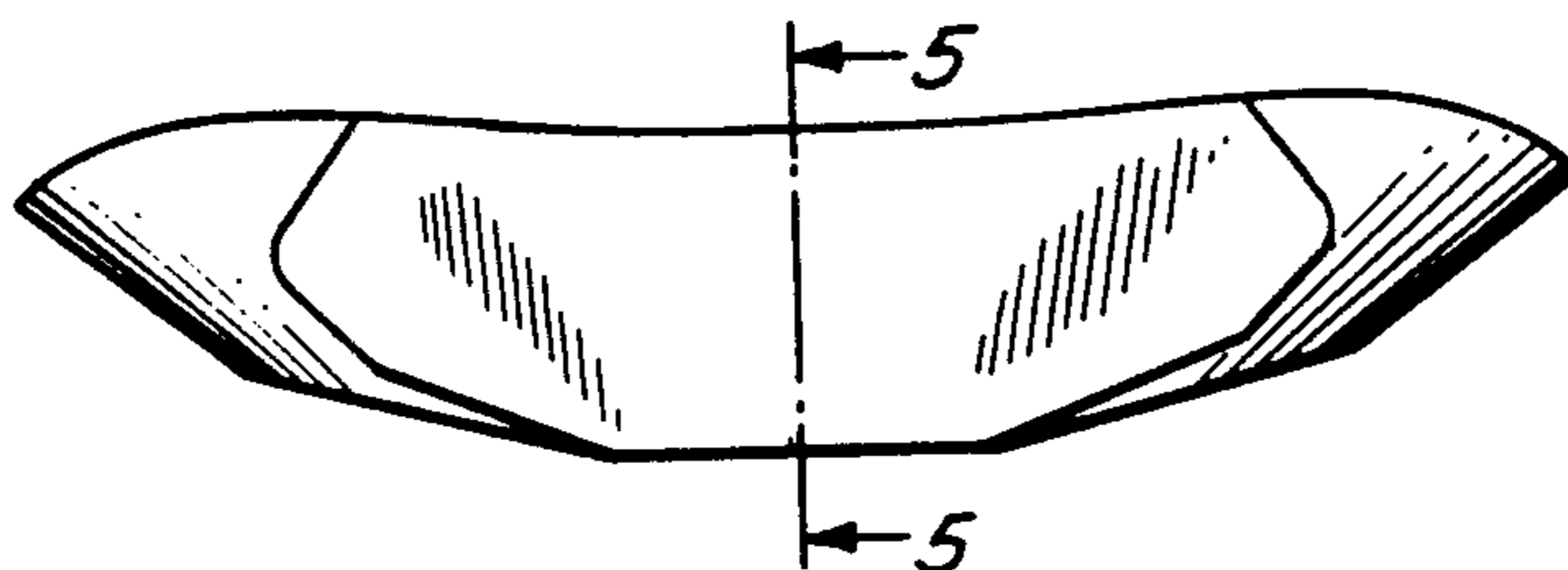
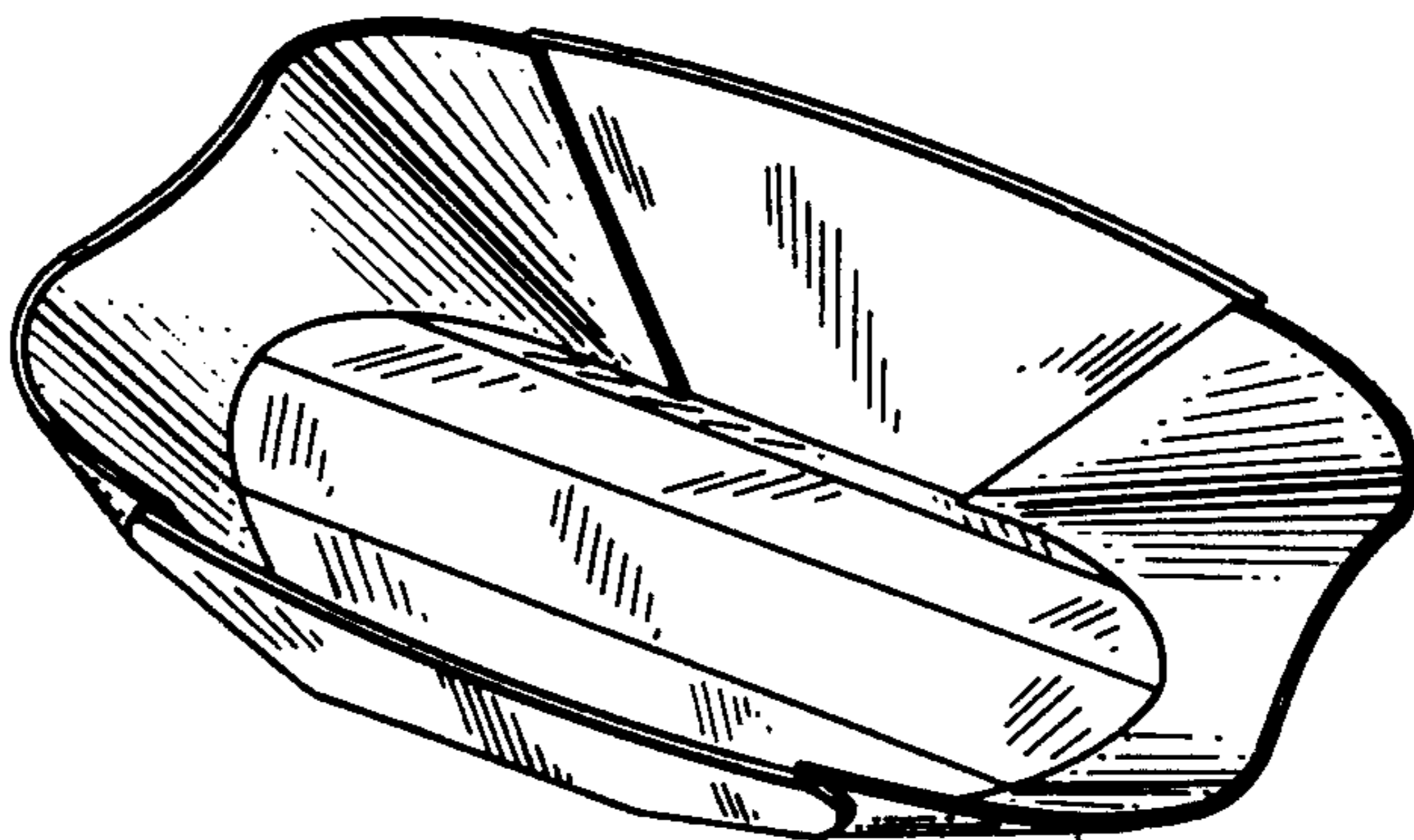

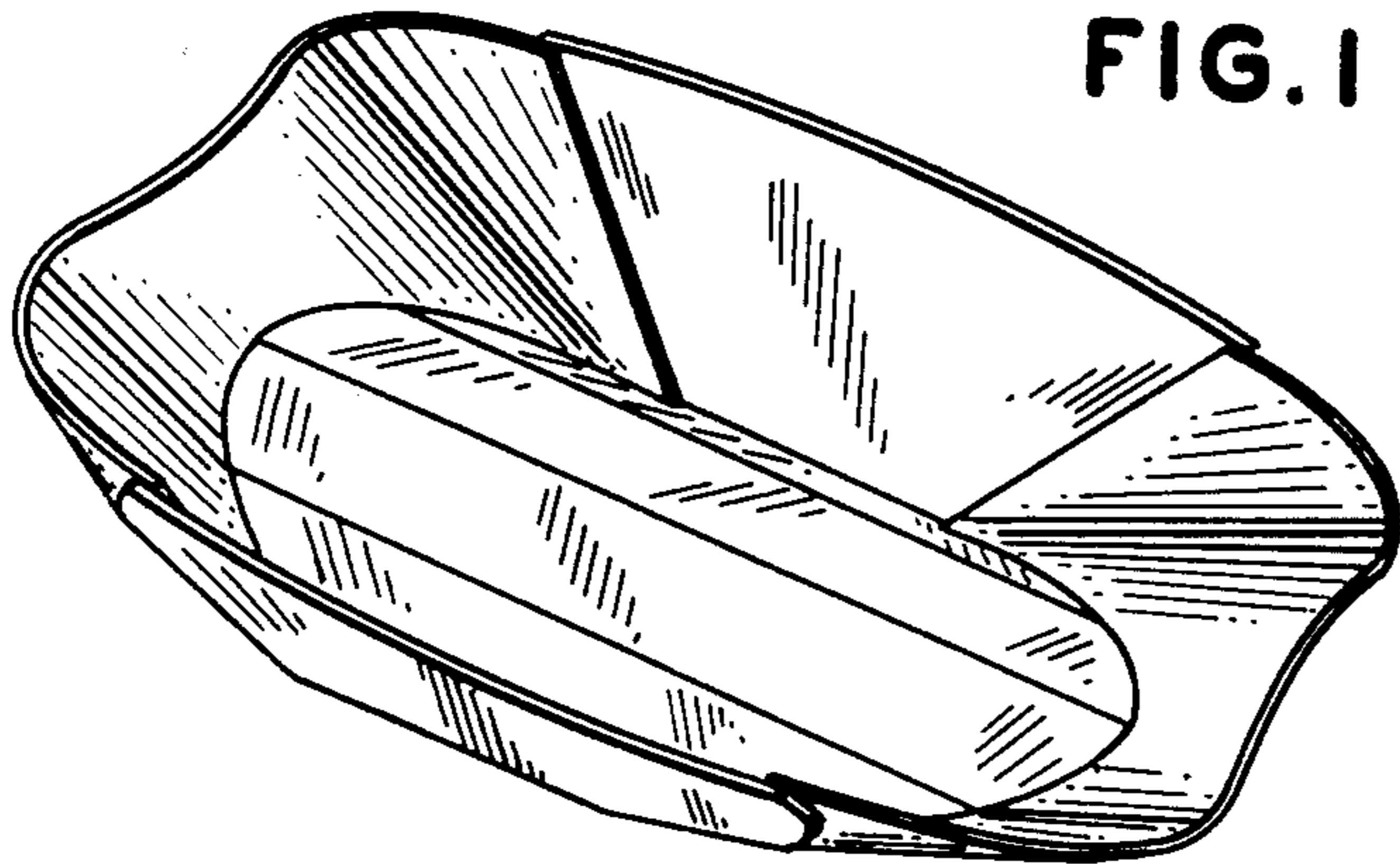

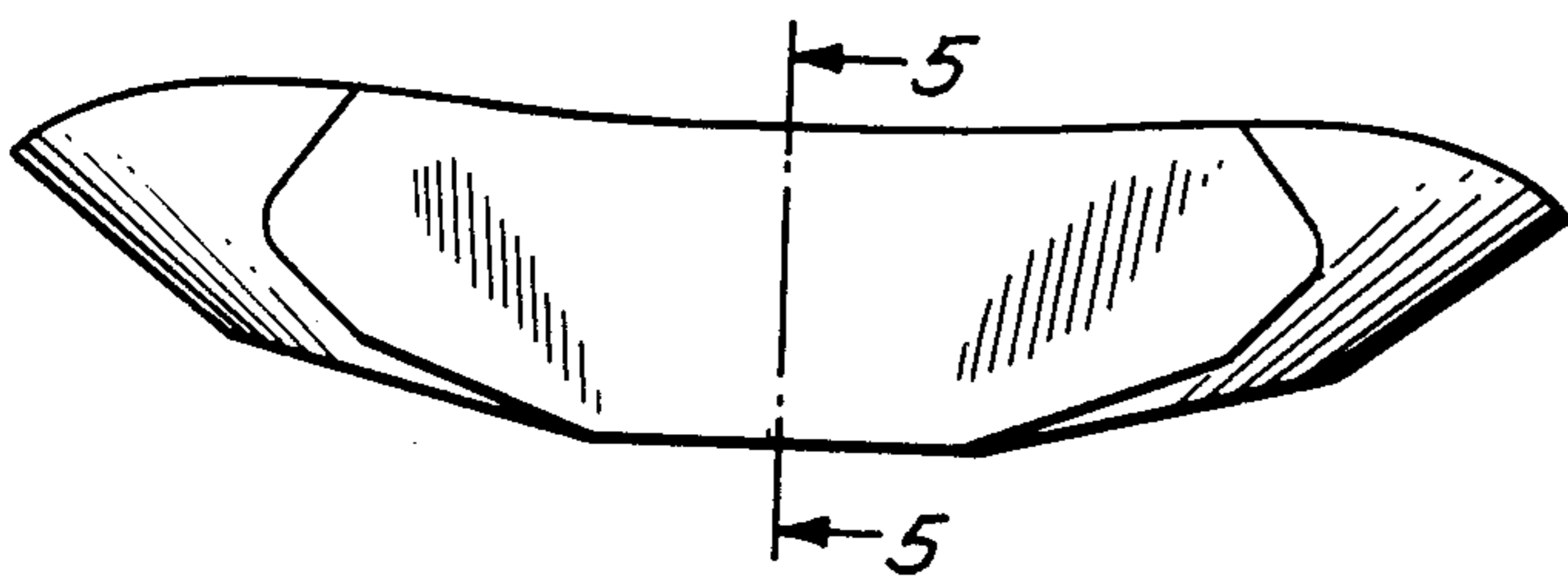

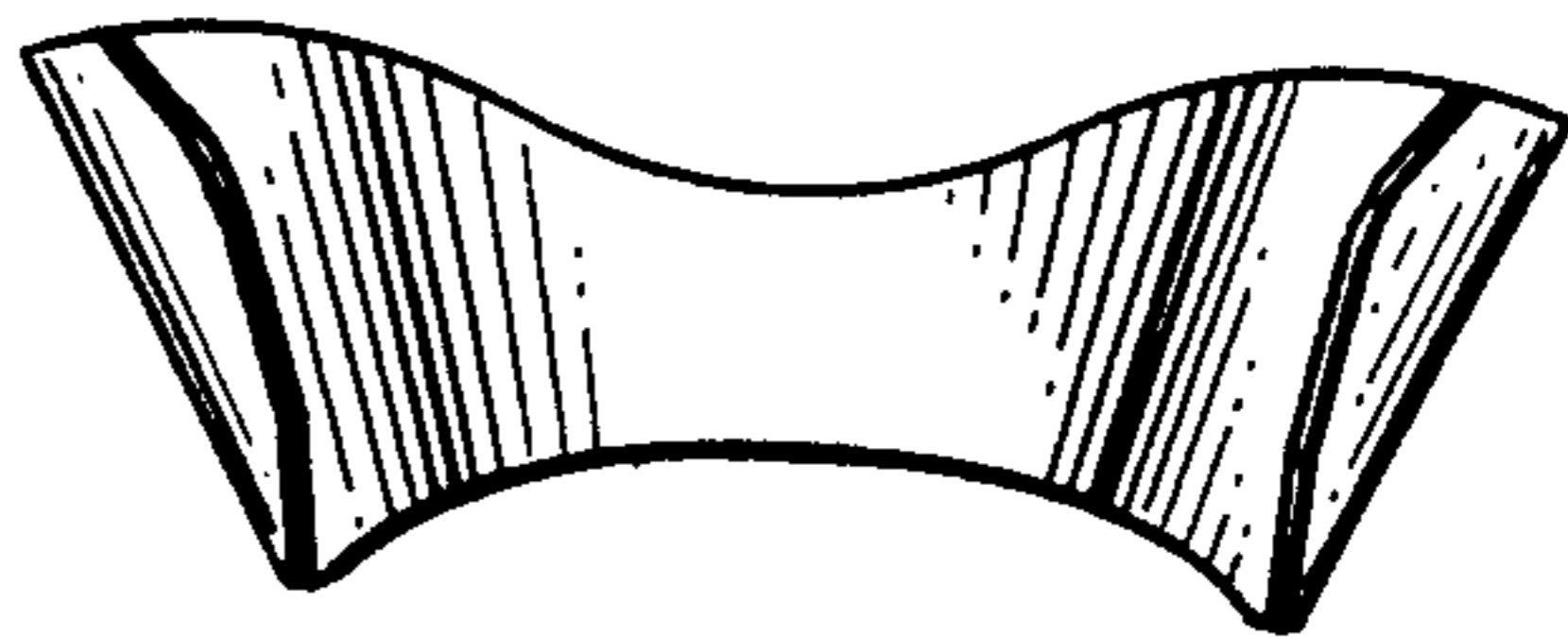

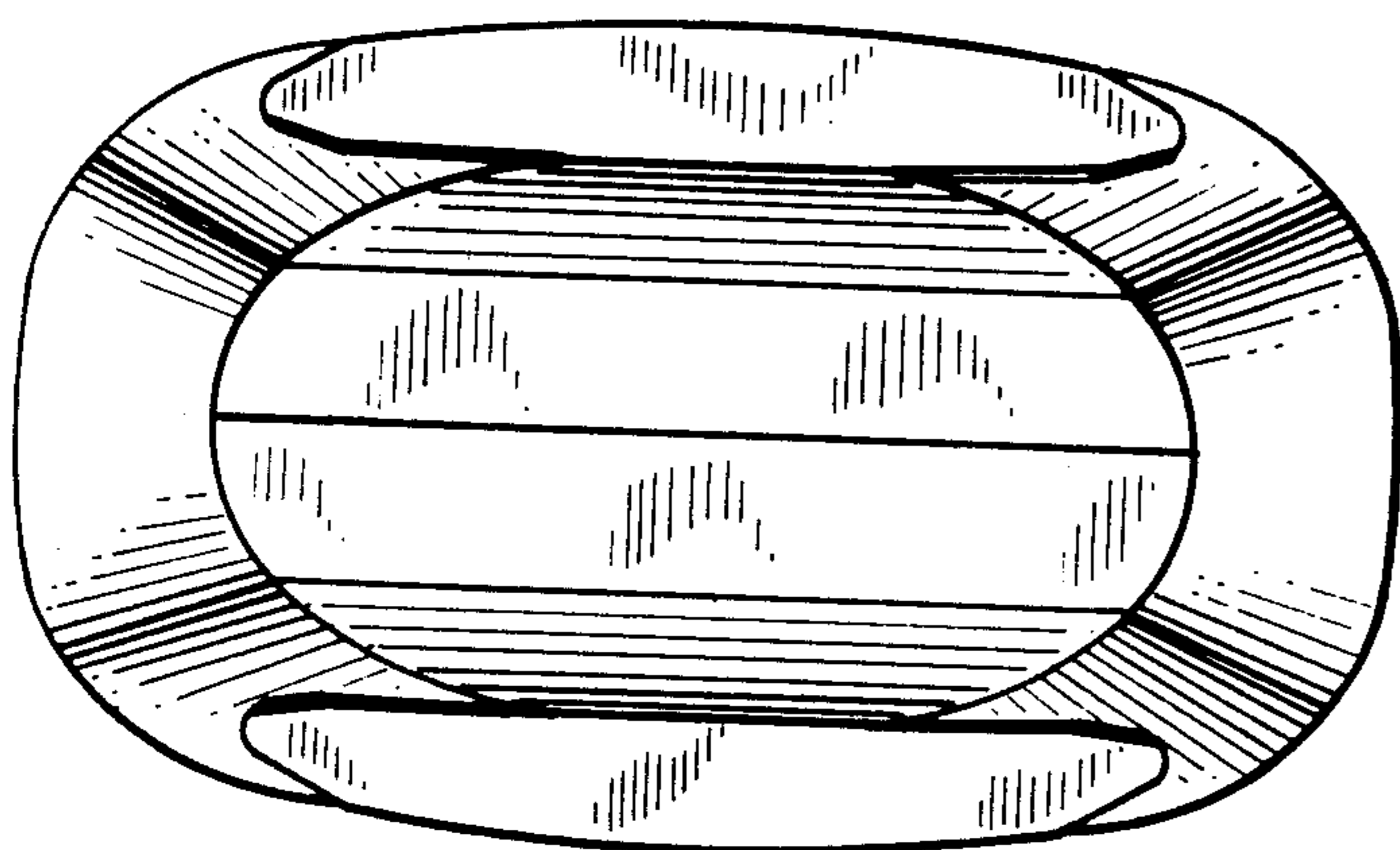
