[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a planter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a planter showing my design; and
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof.
The characteristic feature of my design resides in the shape of its sidewalls in the form of an outline of an apple.

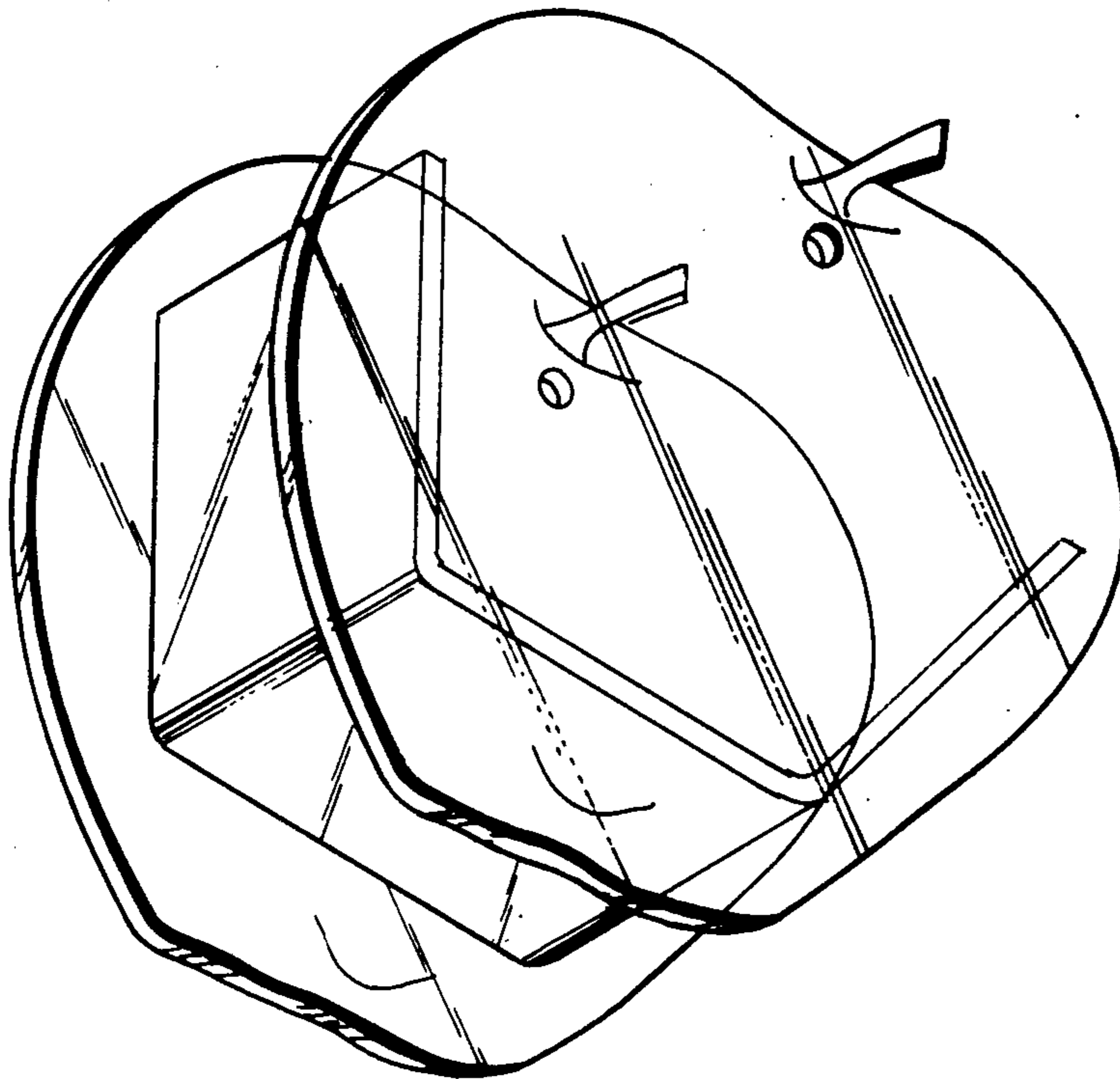

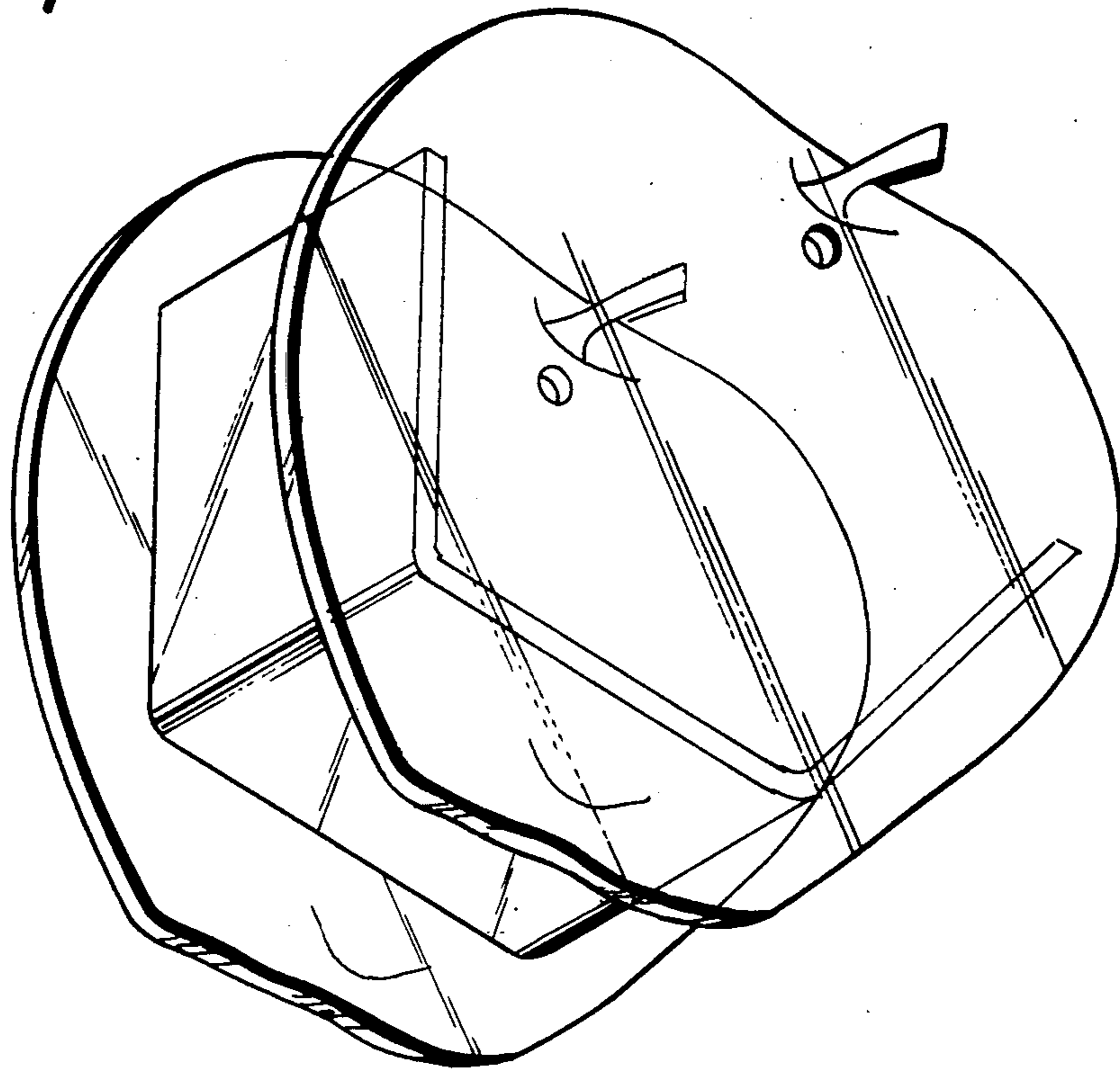
