The ornamental design for a toy doll house, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a toy doll house showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.

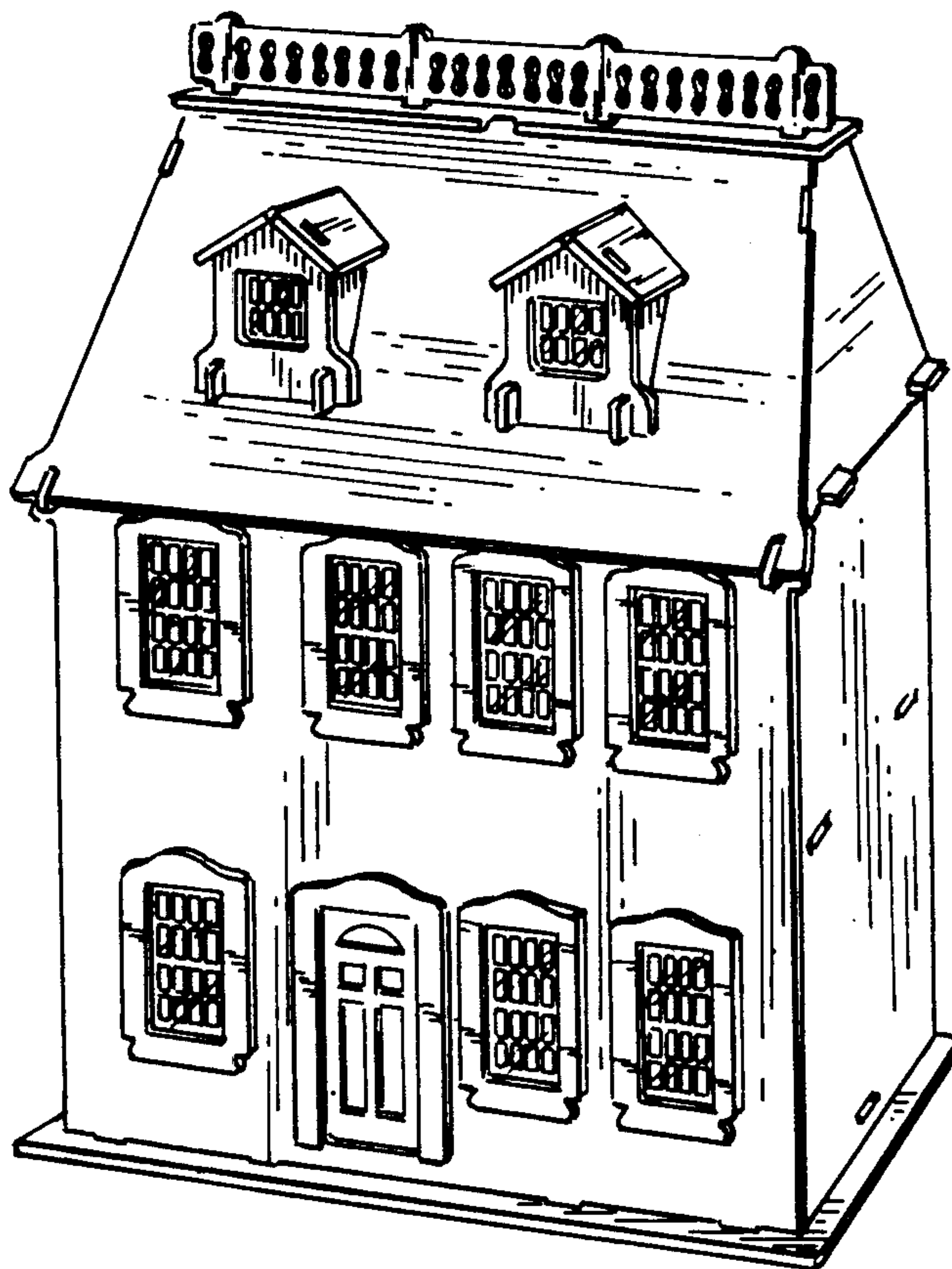

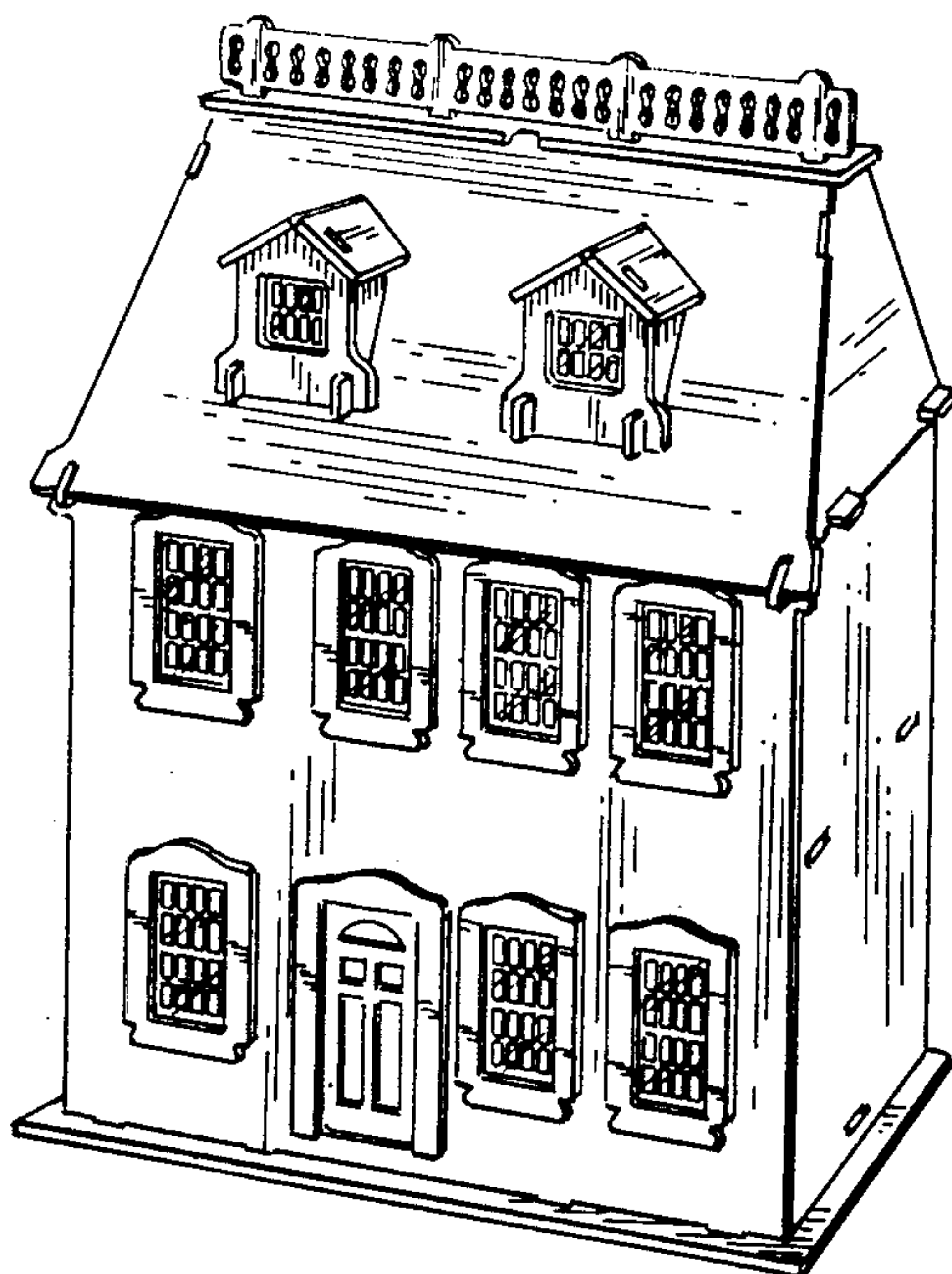

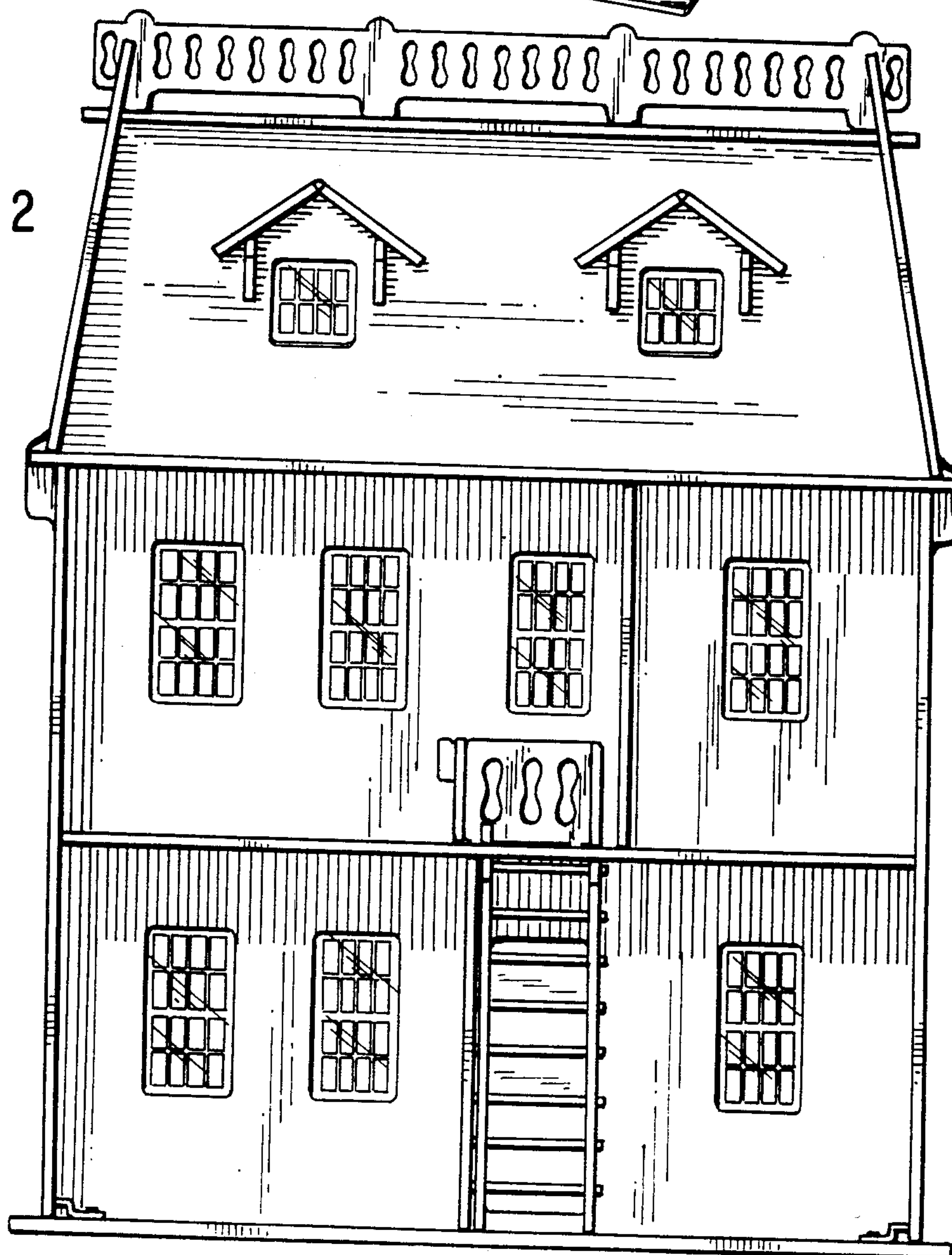

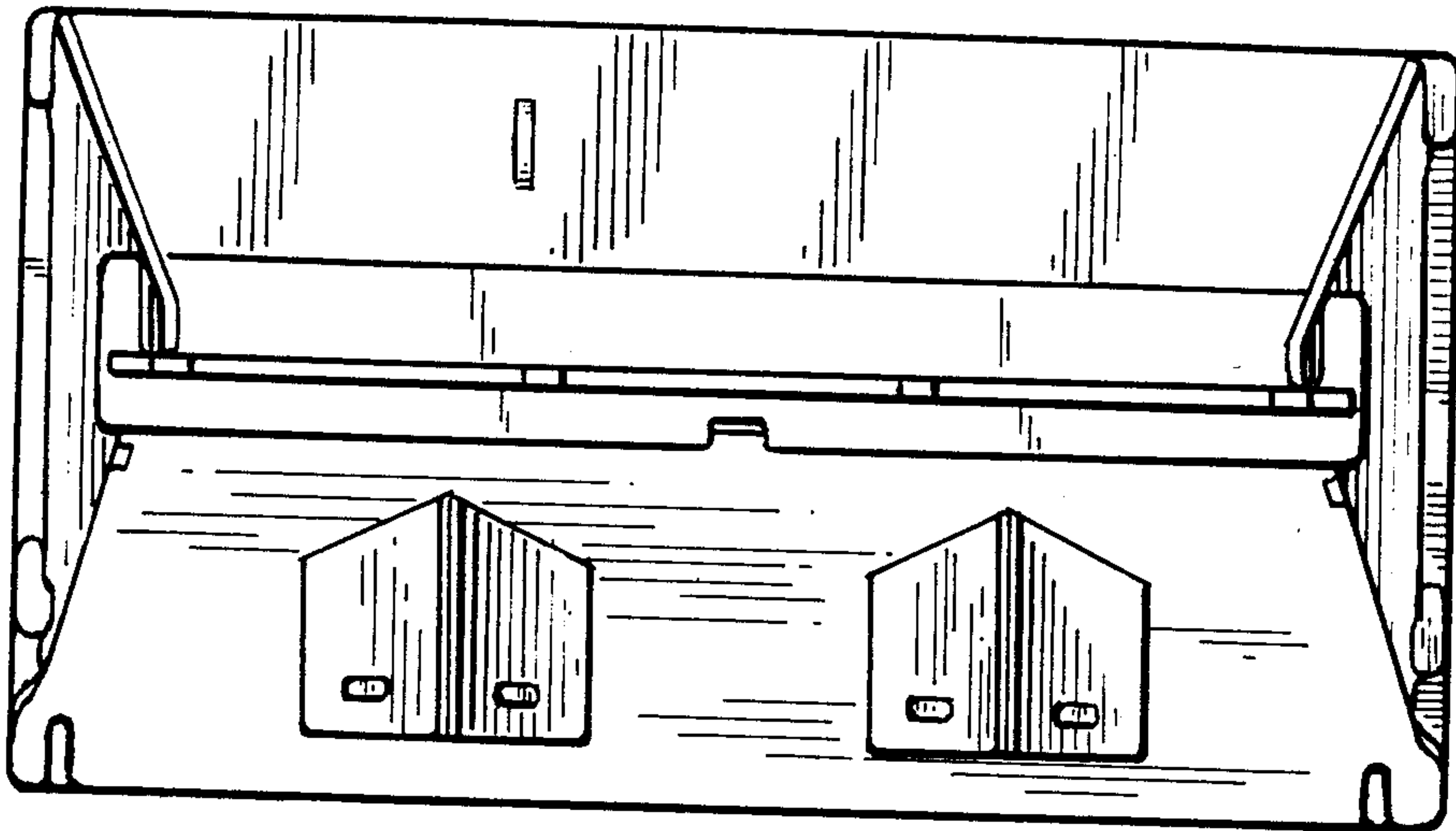
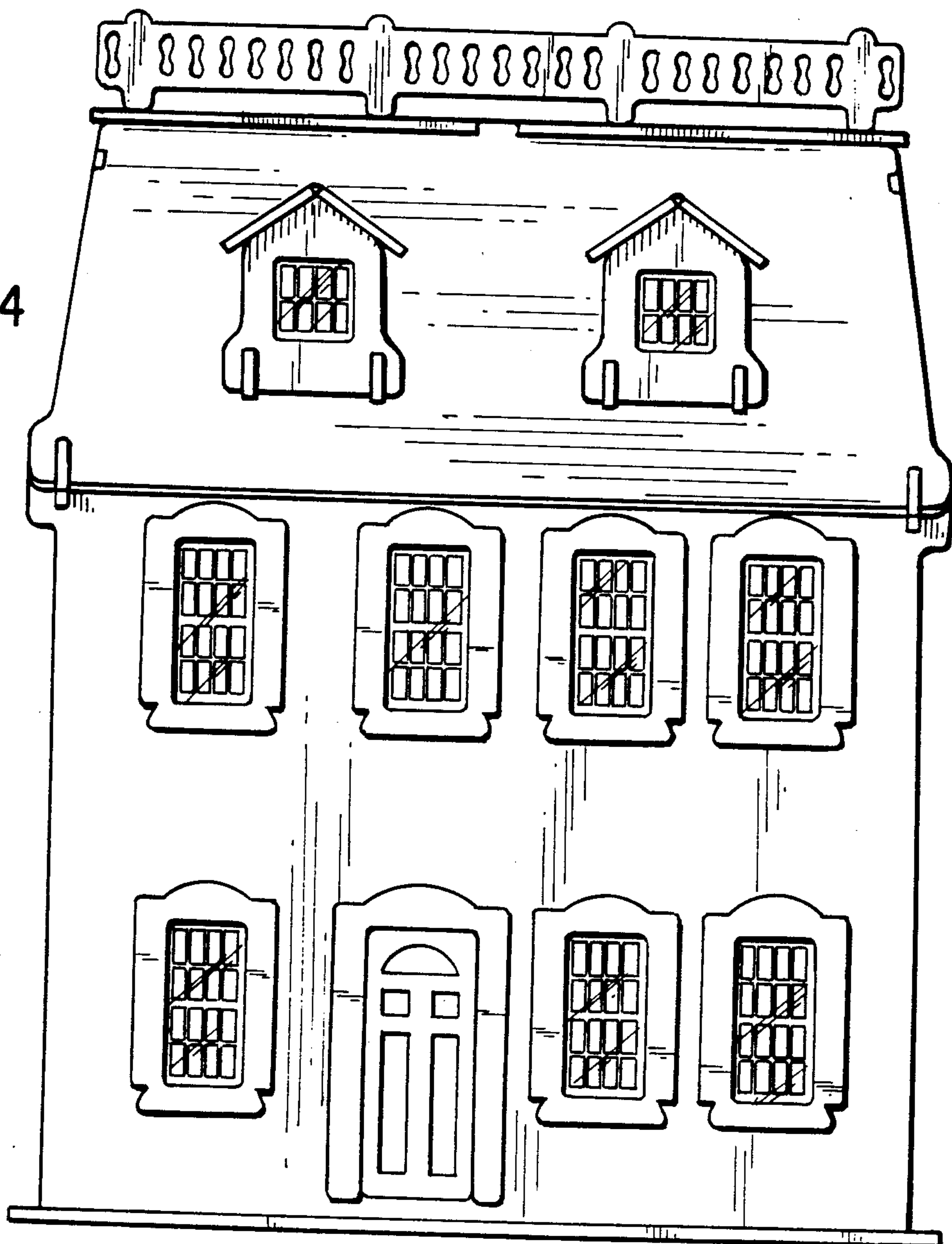

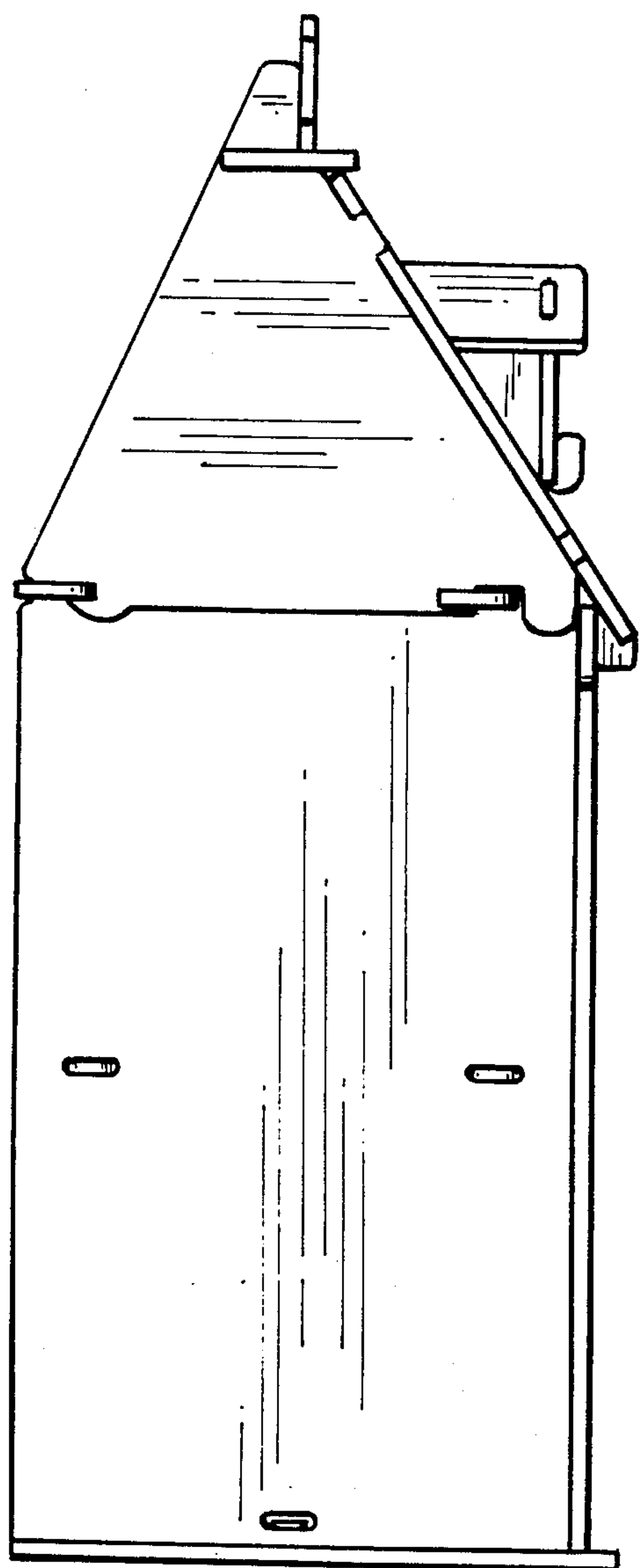
