DESCRIPTION

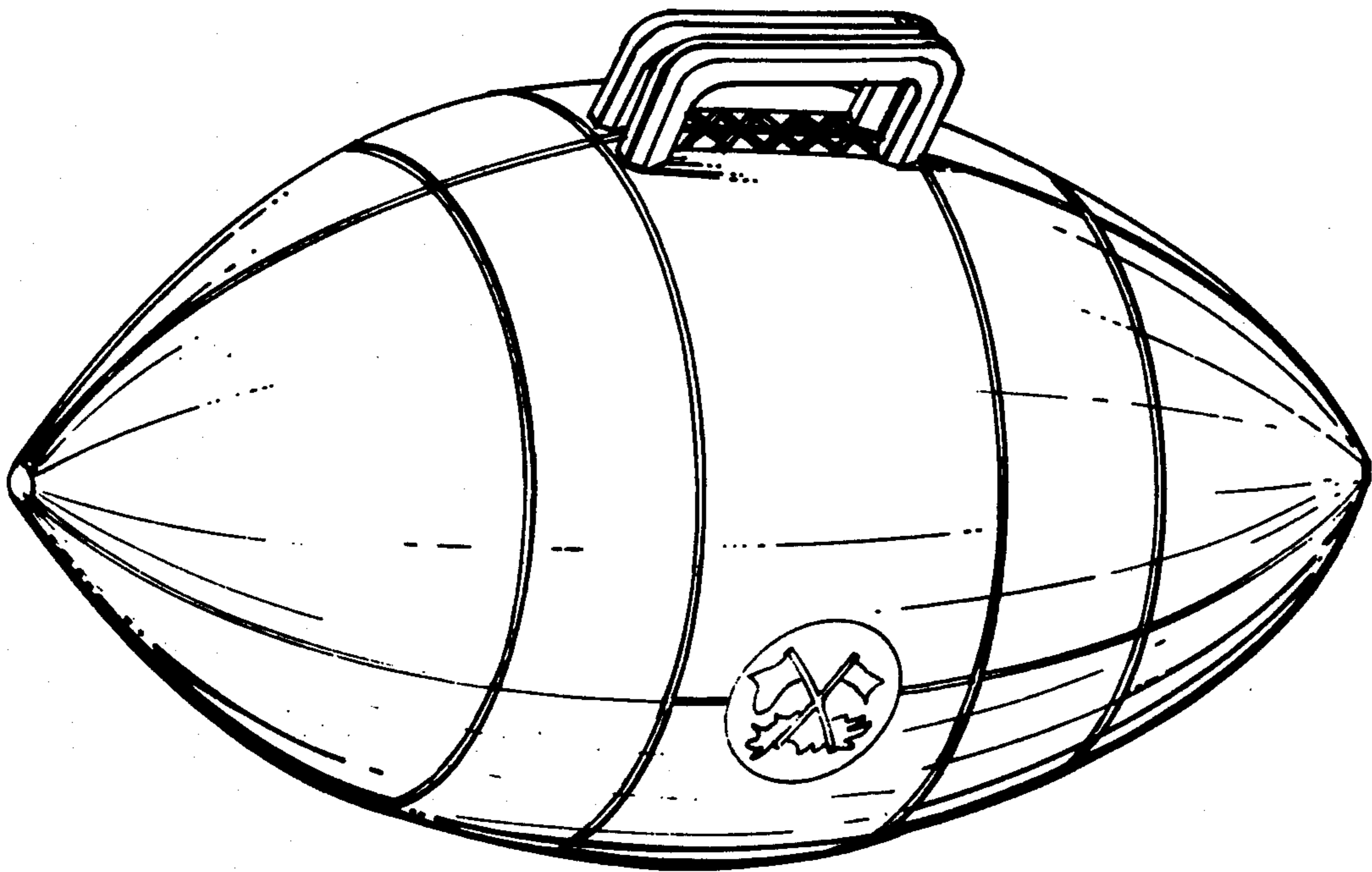
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lunch container or similar article showing my new design.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



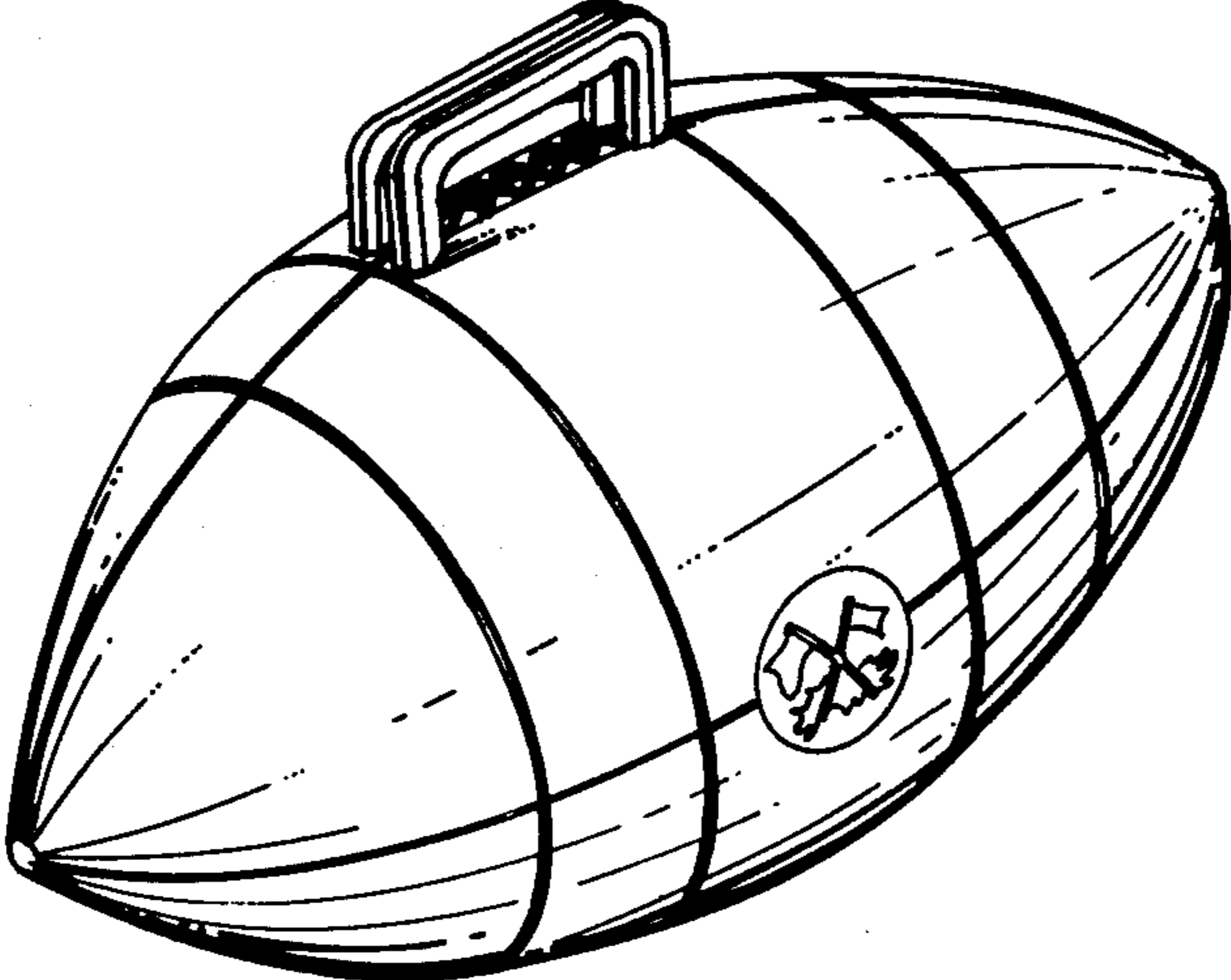

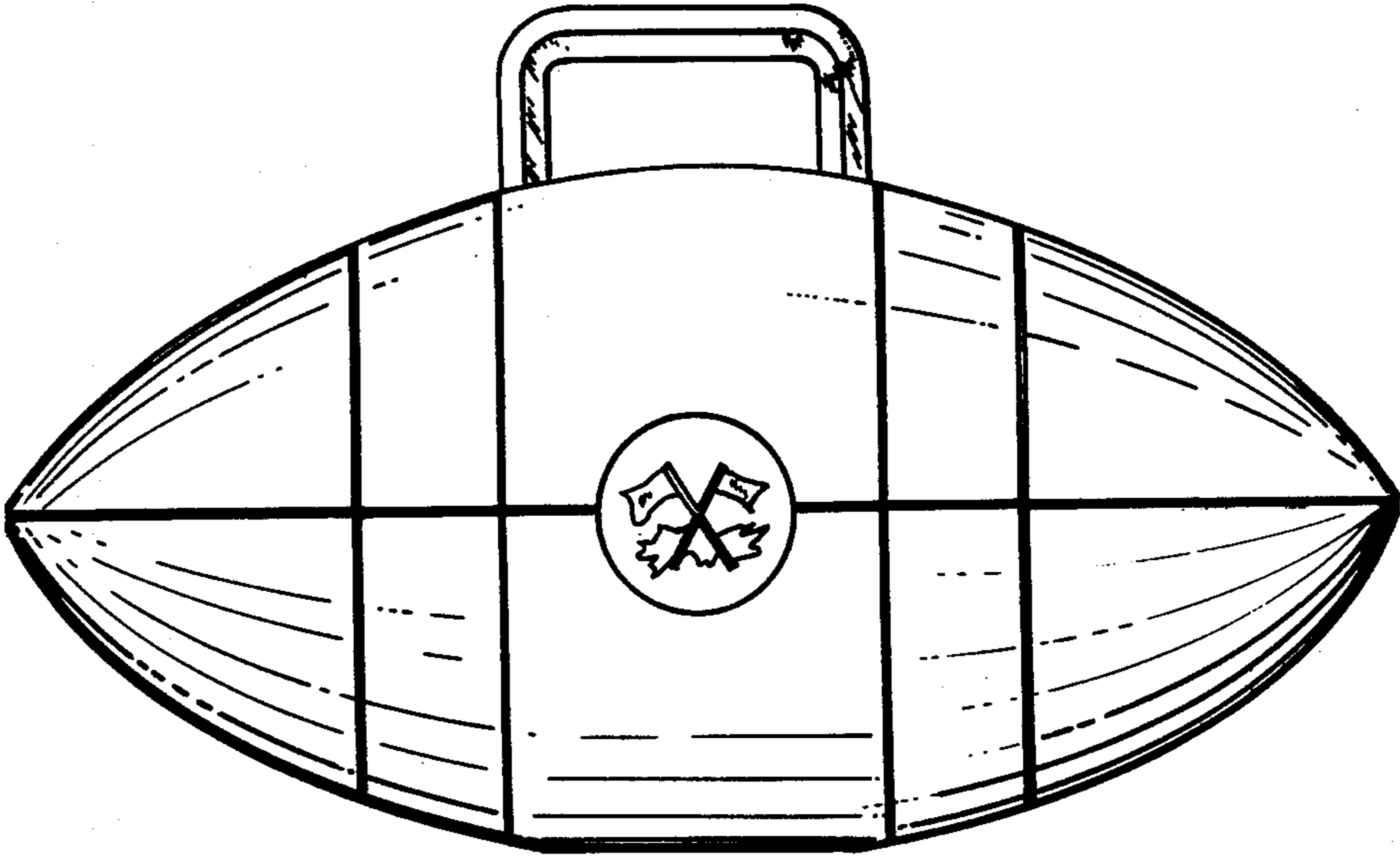

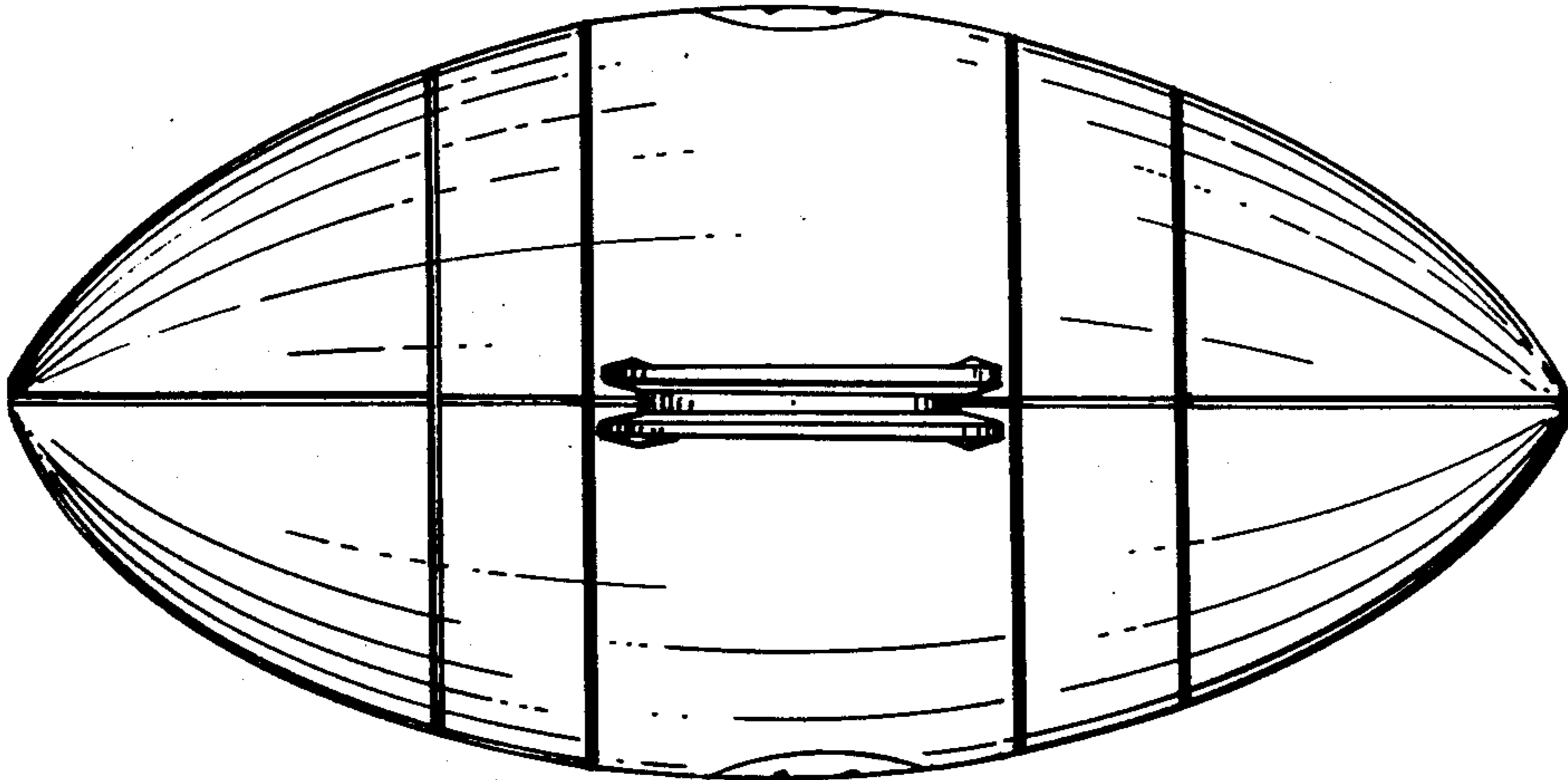

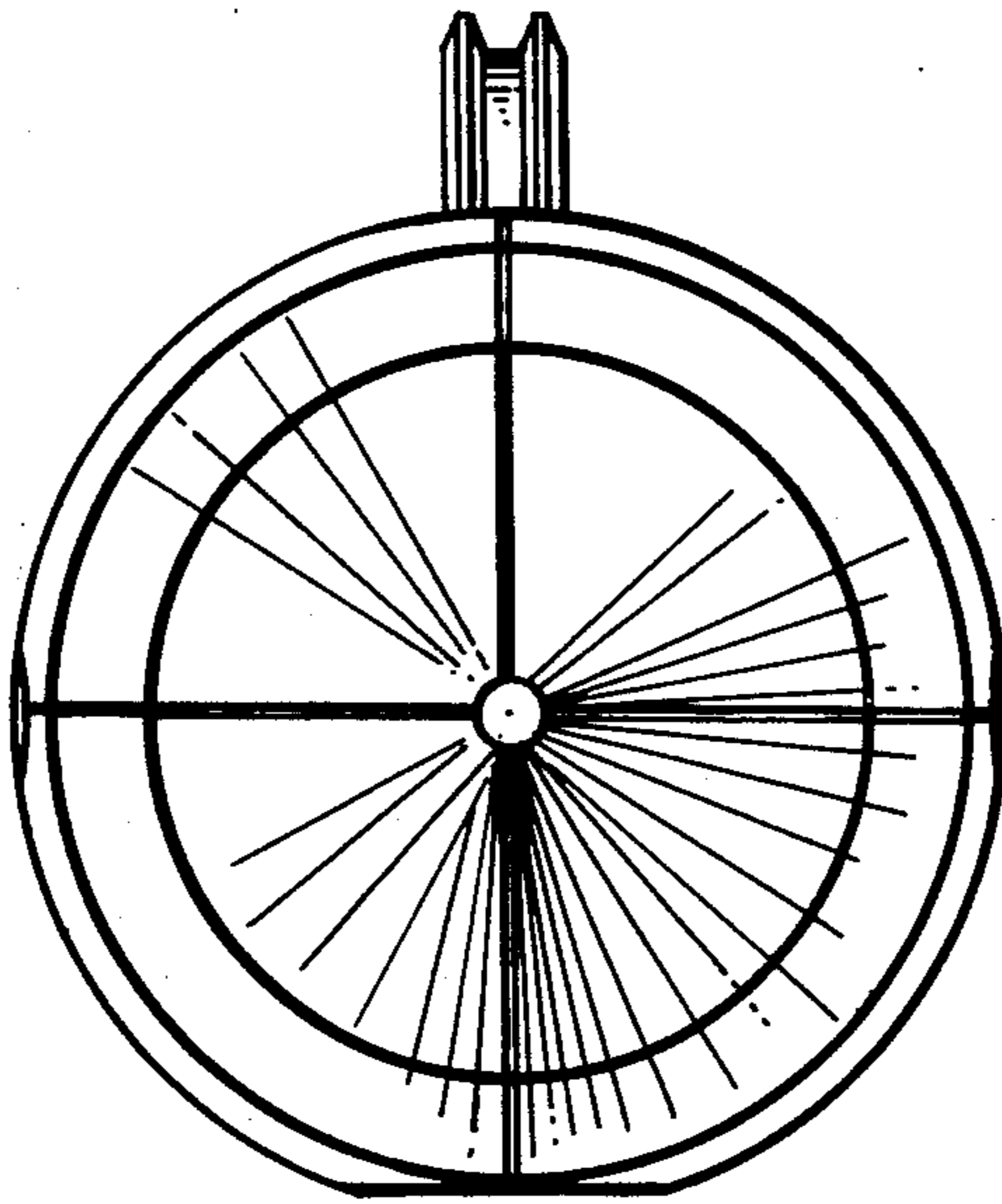

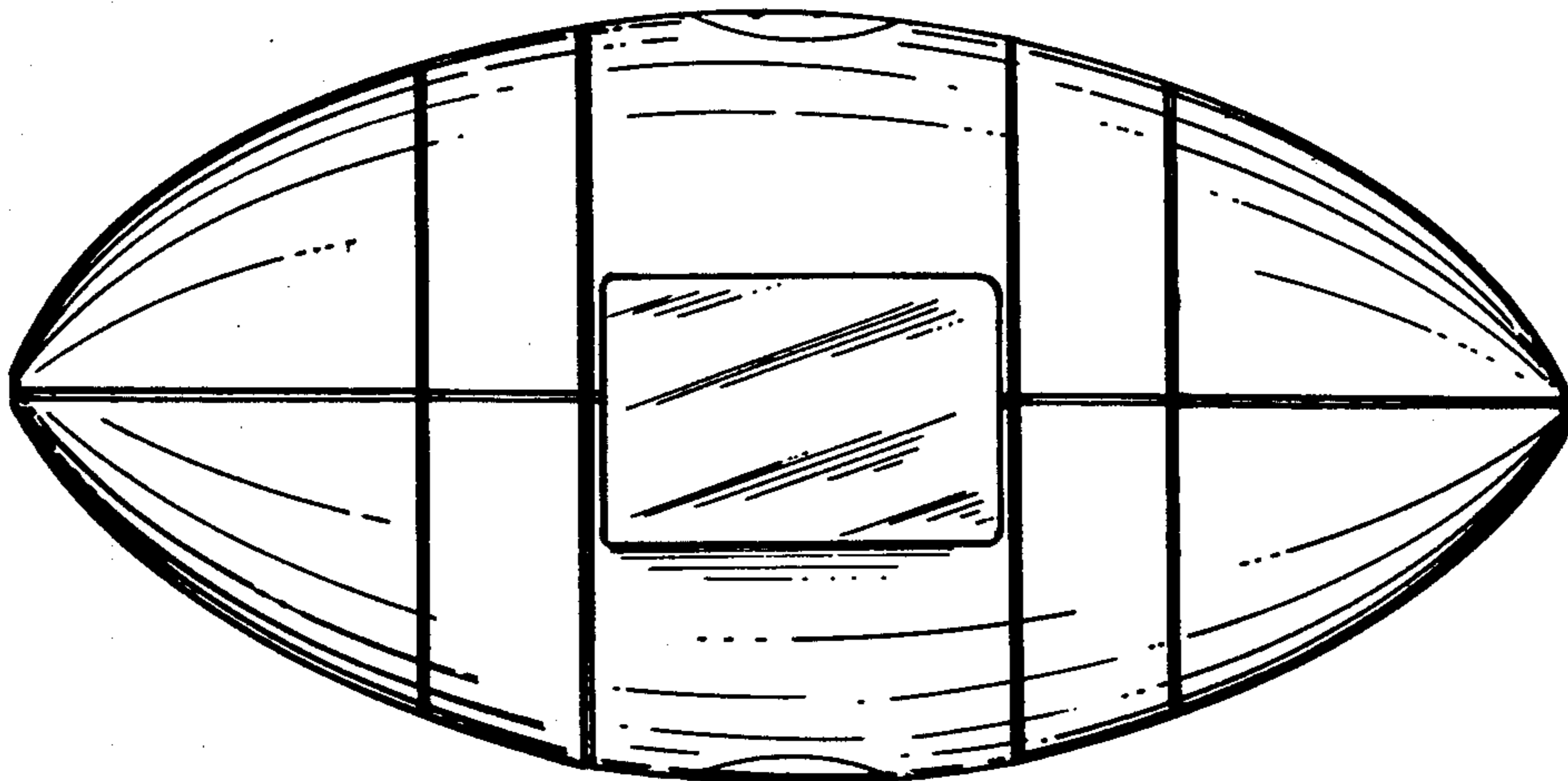
