DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a video tape recorder showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear and right side perspective view thereof, and FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof. Left side view is identical with right side view.

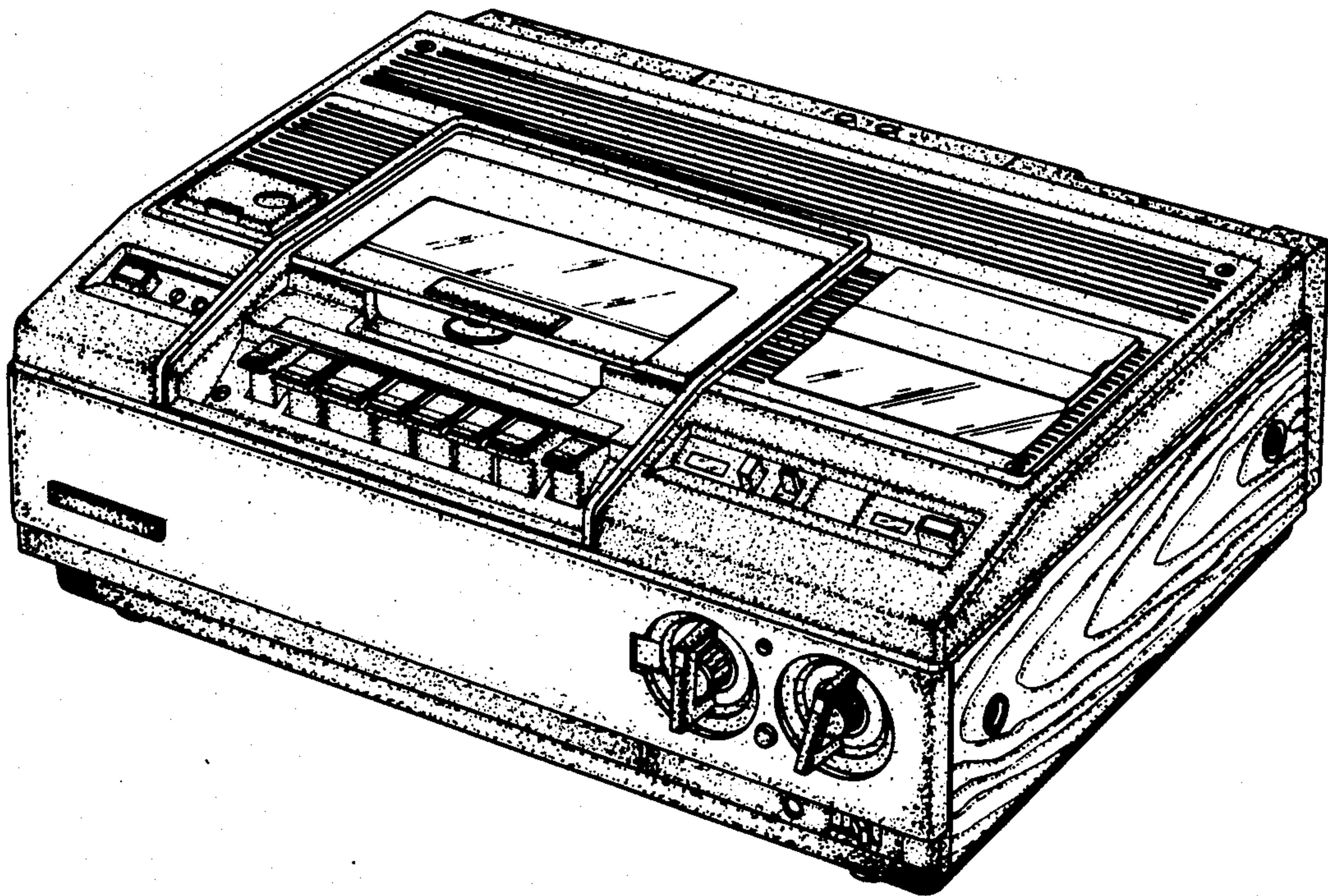

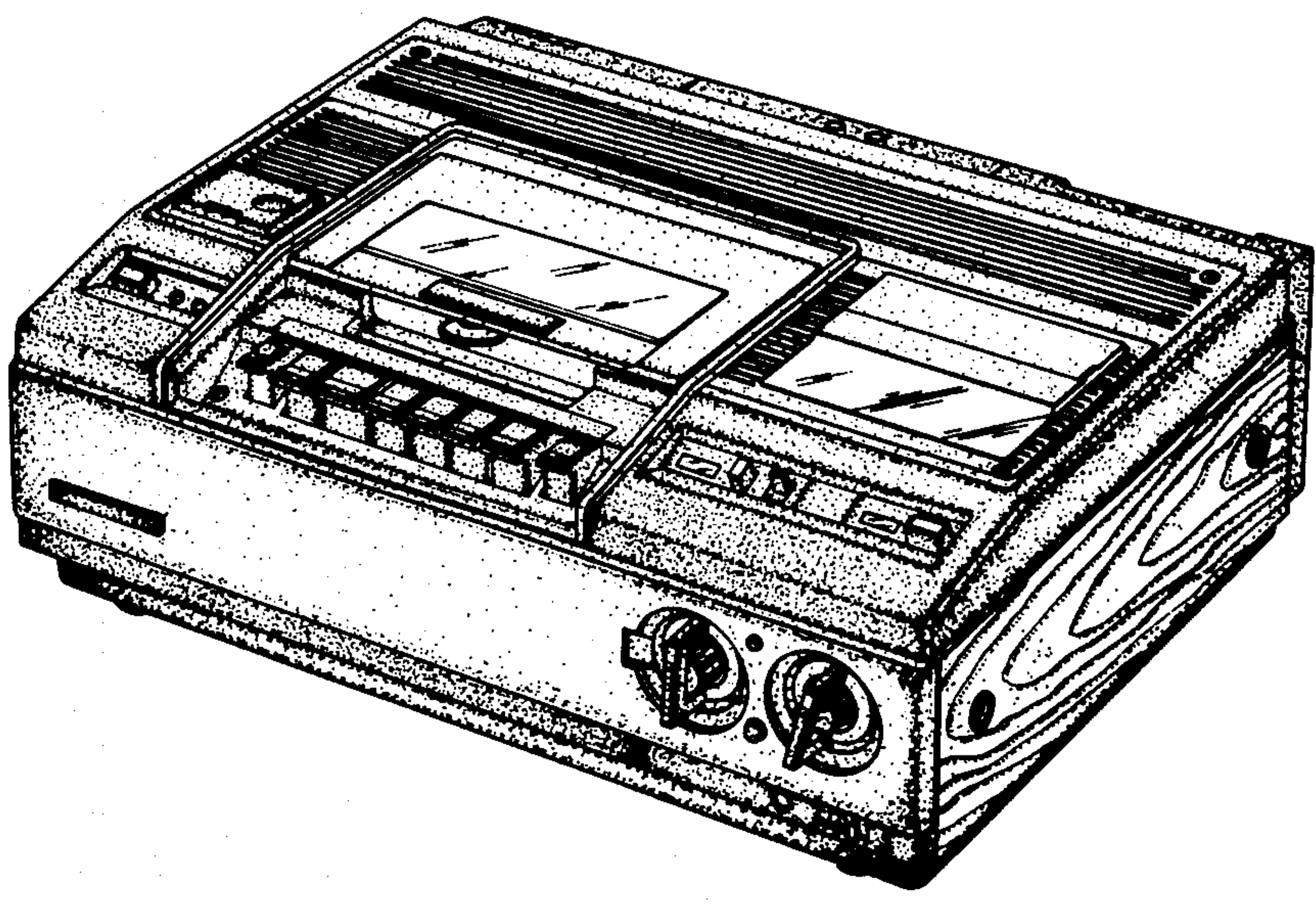

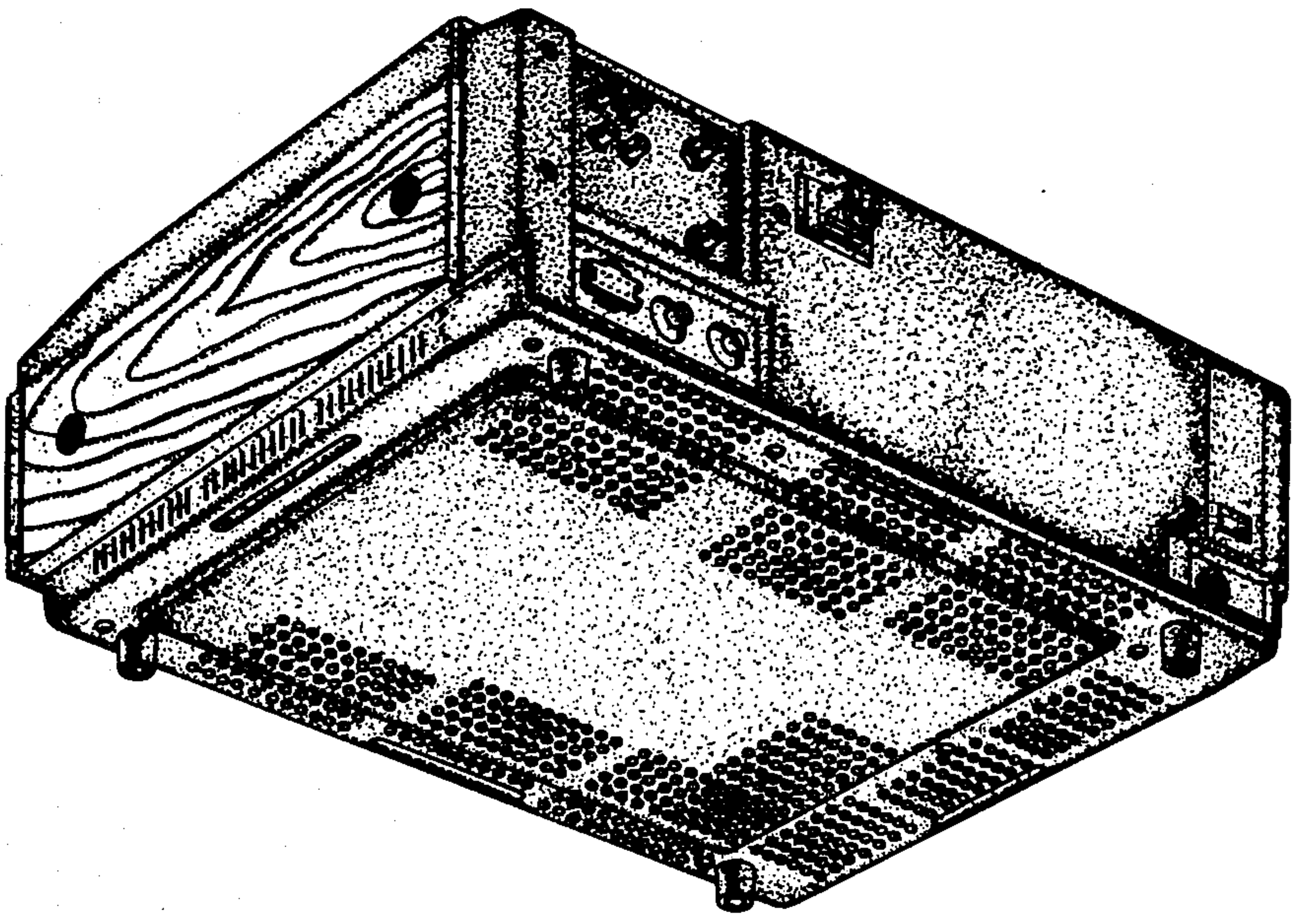
