DESCRIPTION

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a seat, in the form of a sofa, showing my new design.

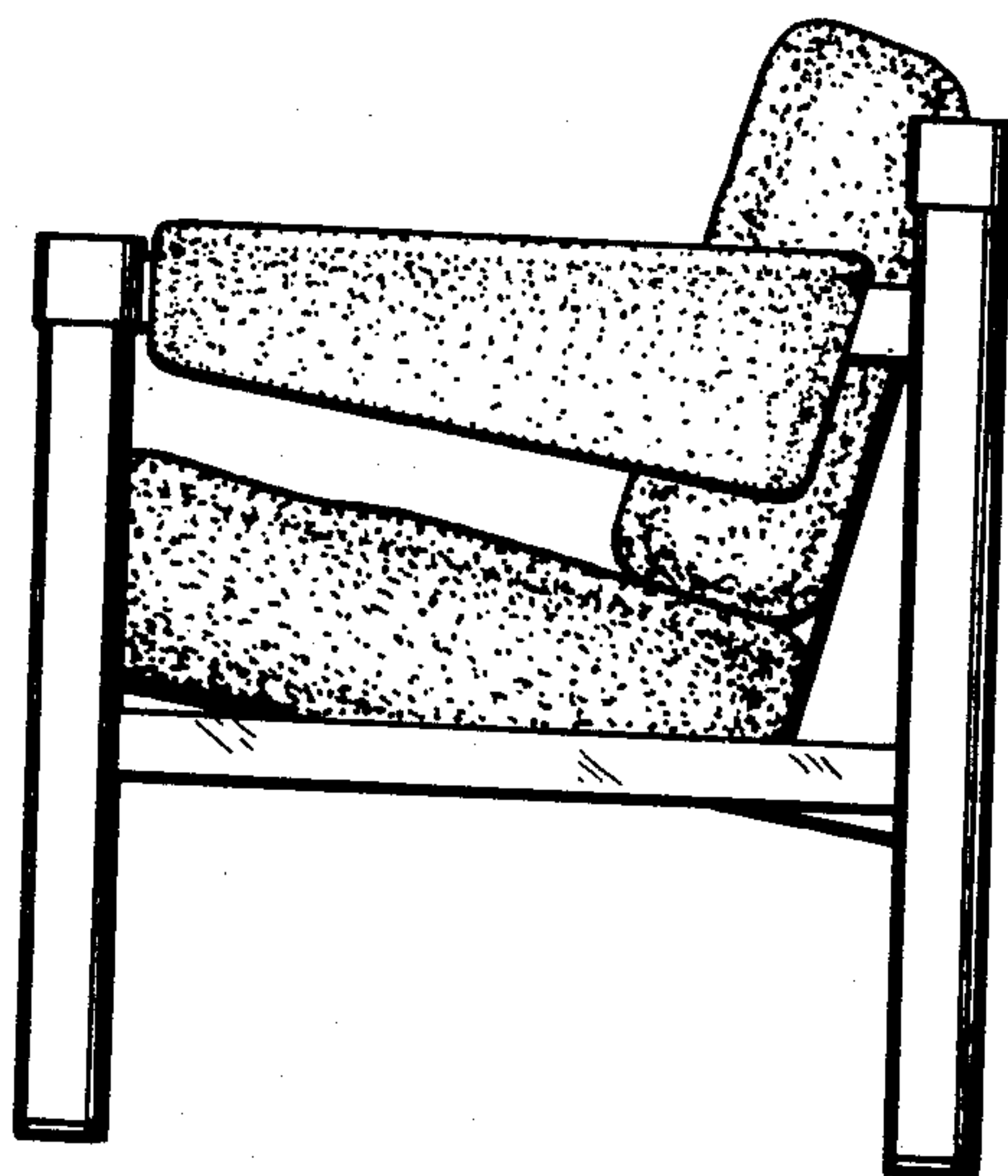

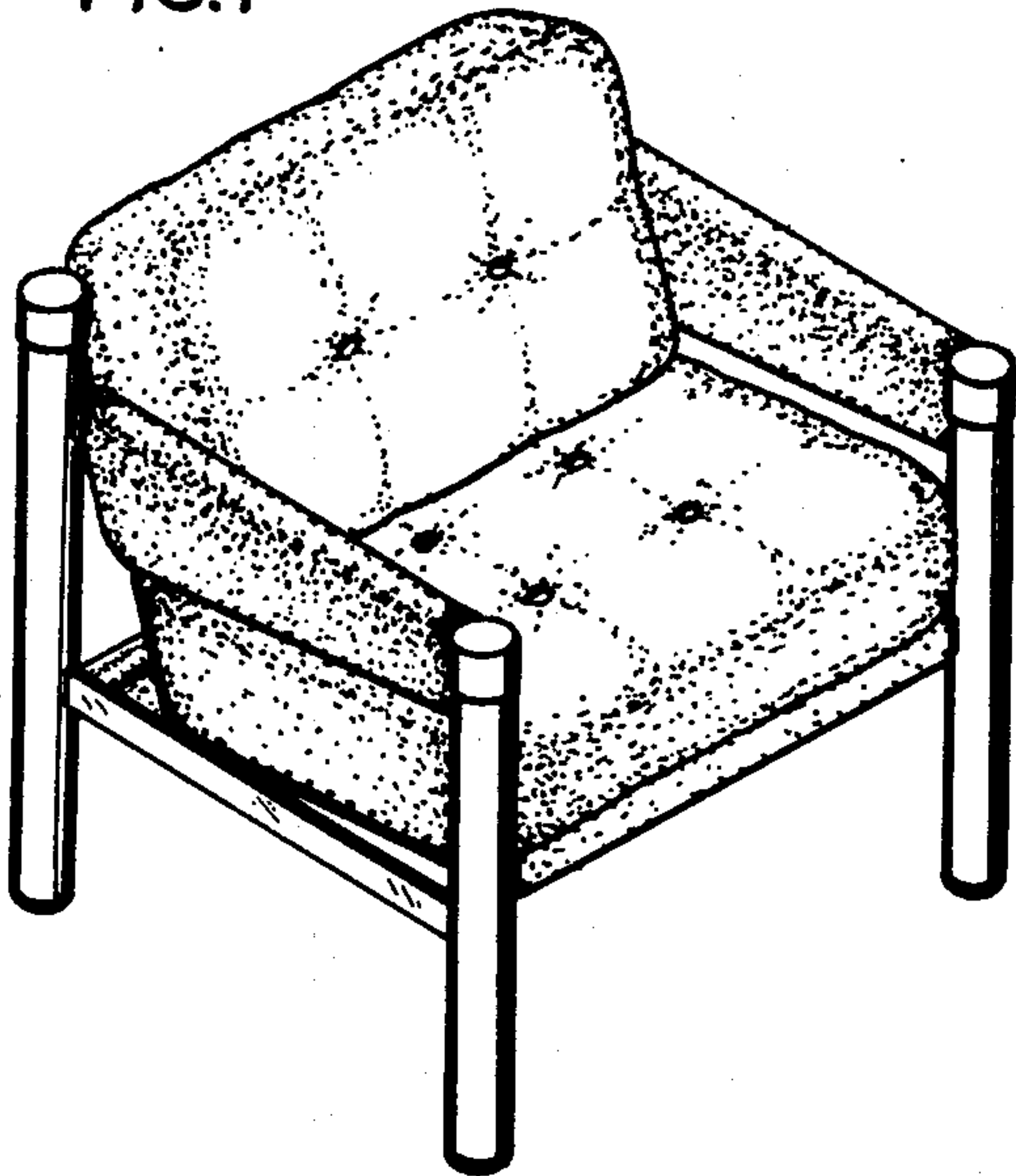

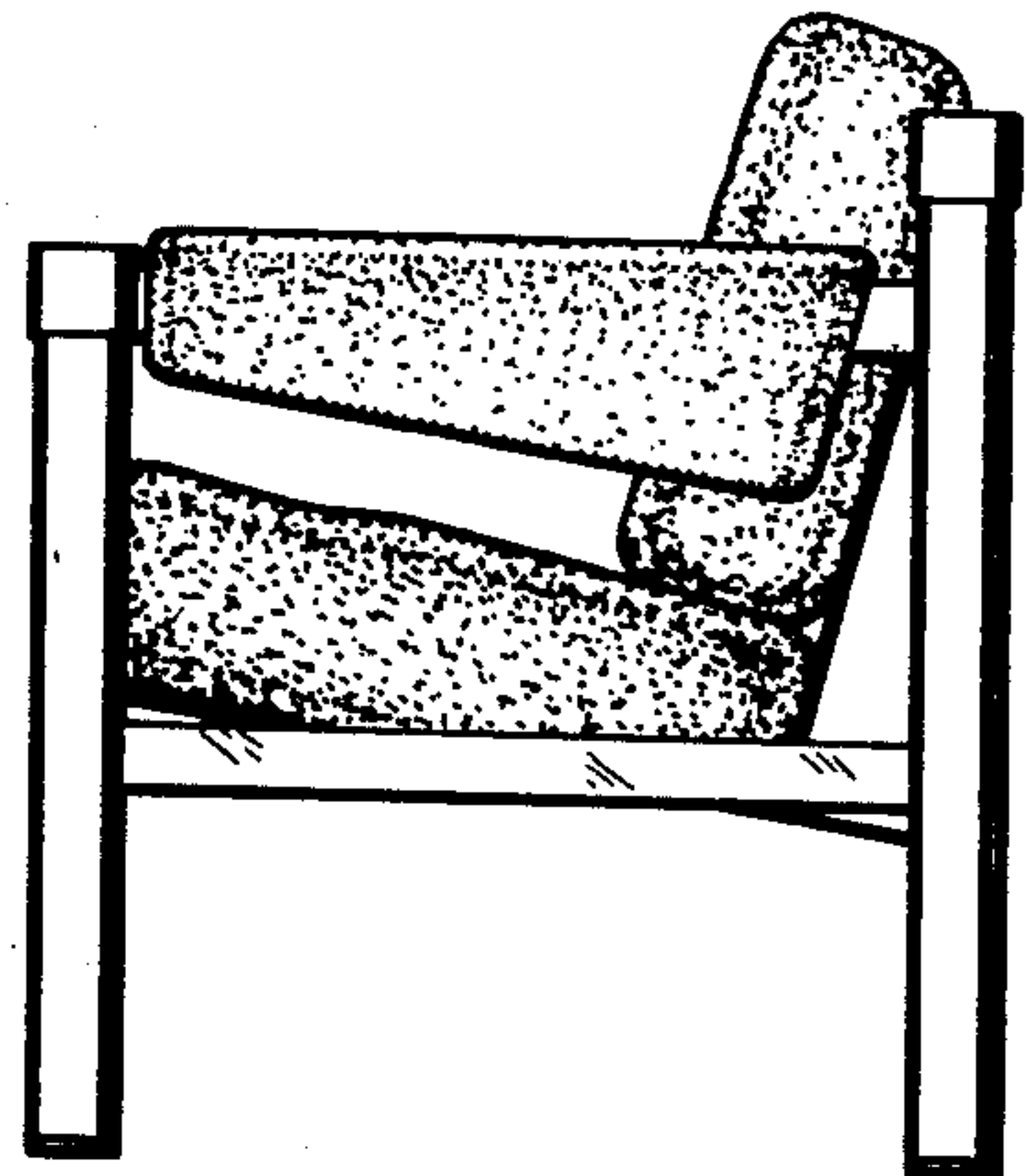

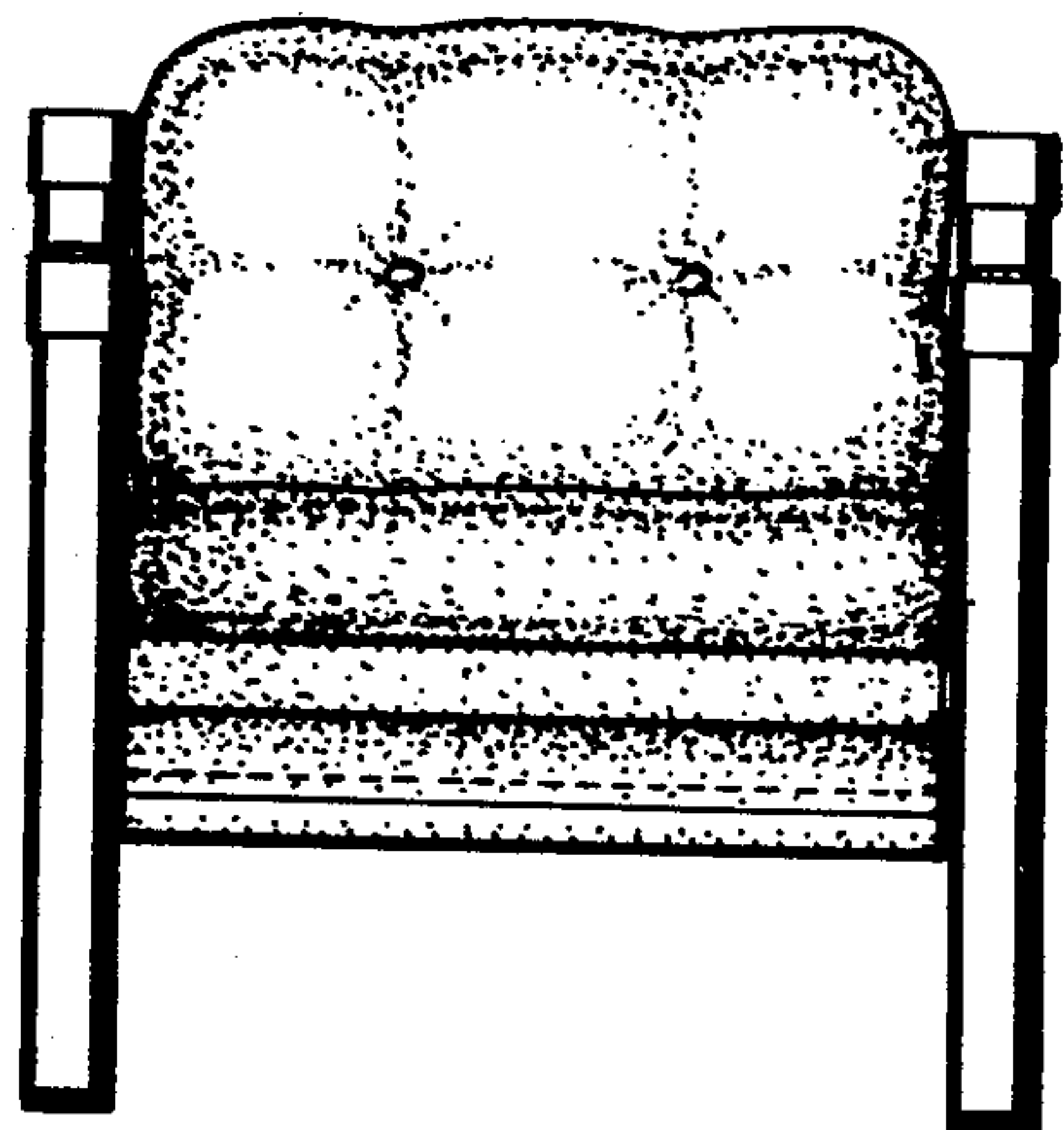

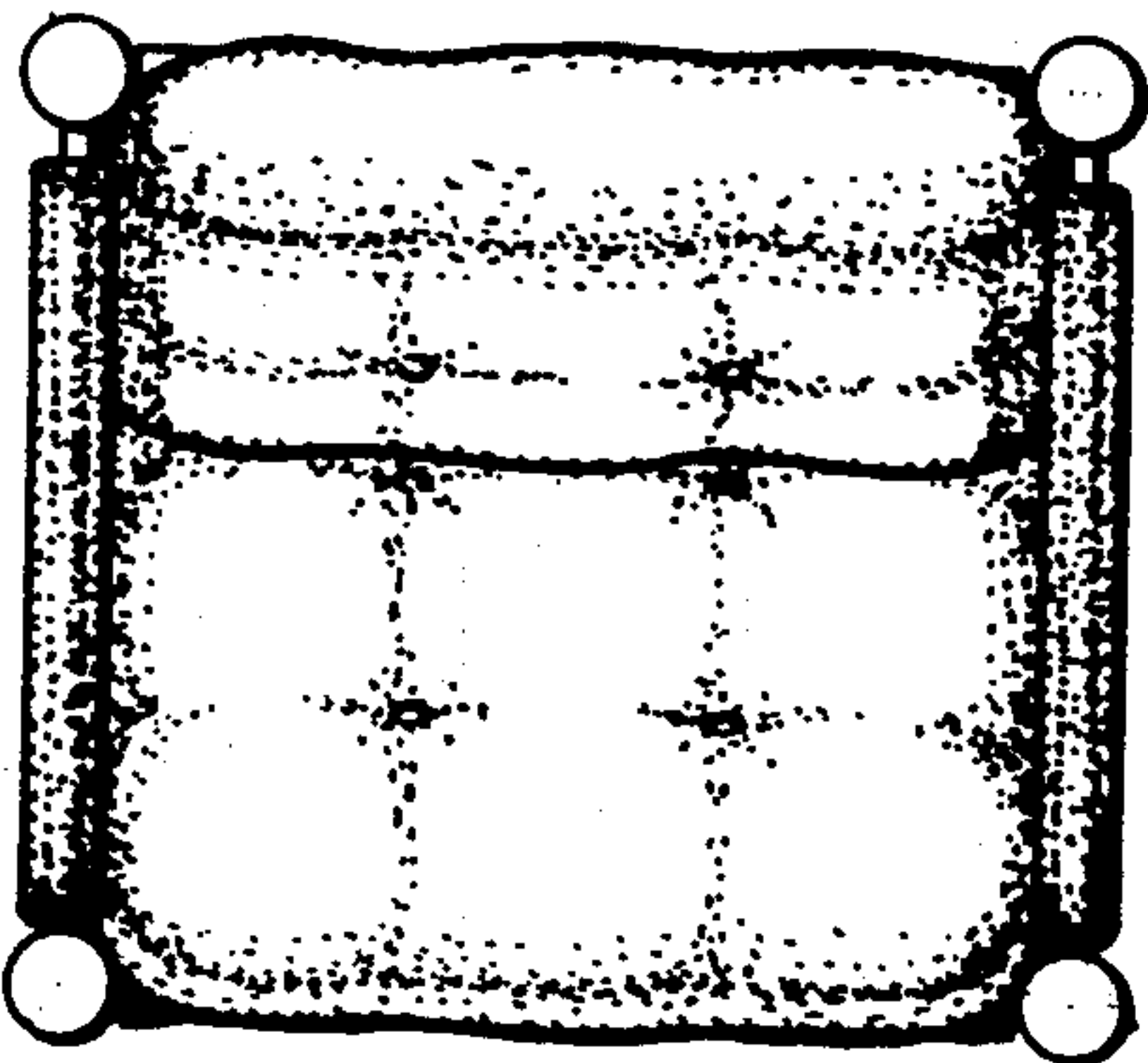

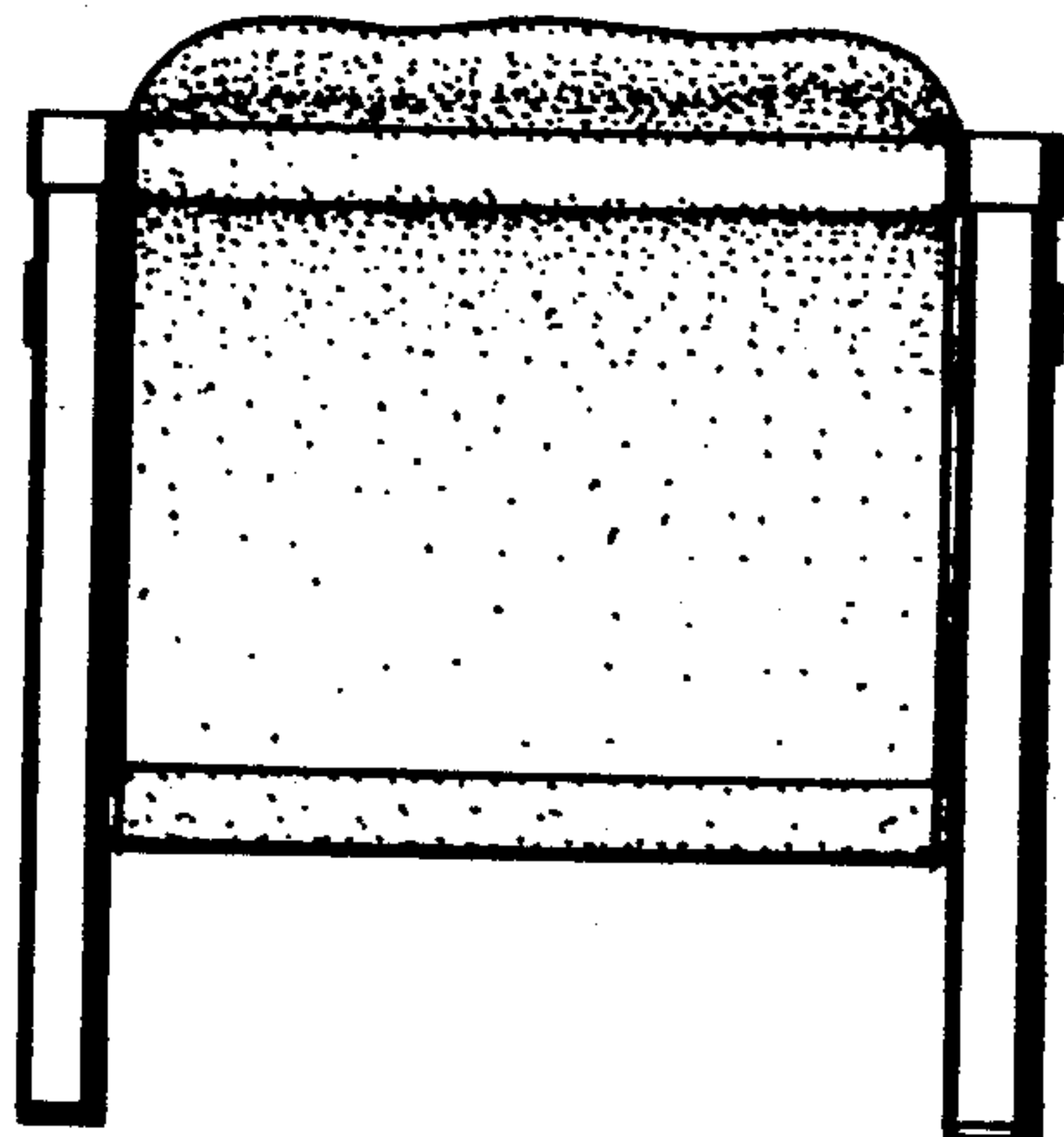
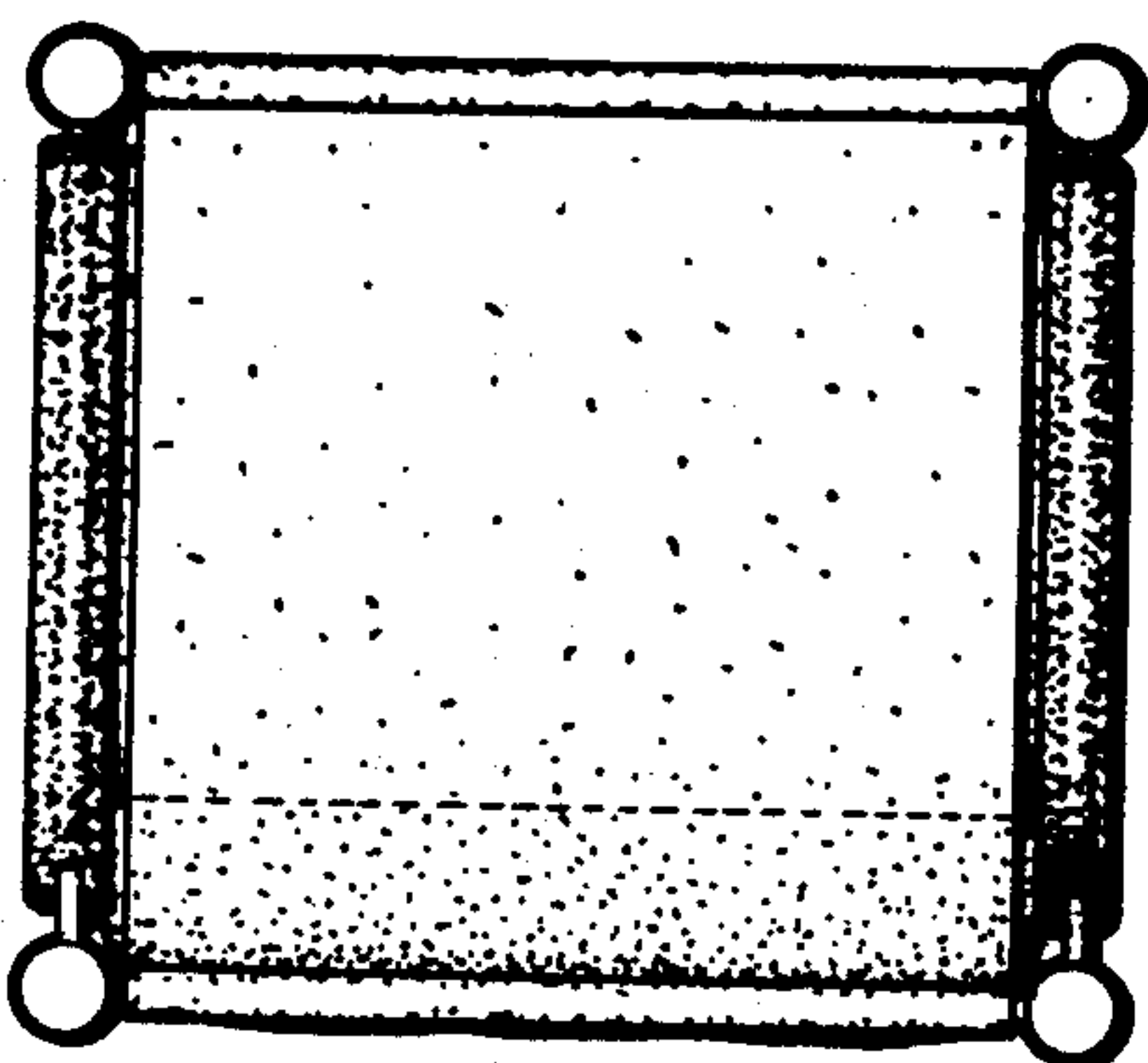

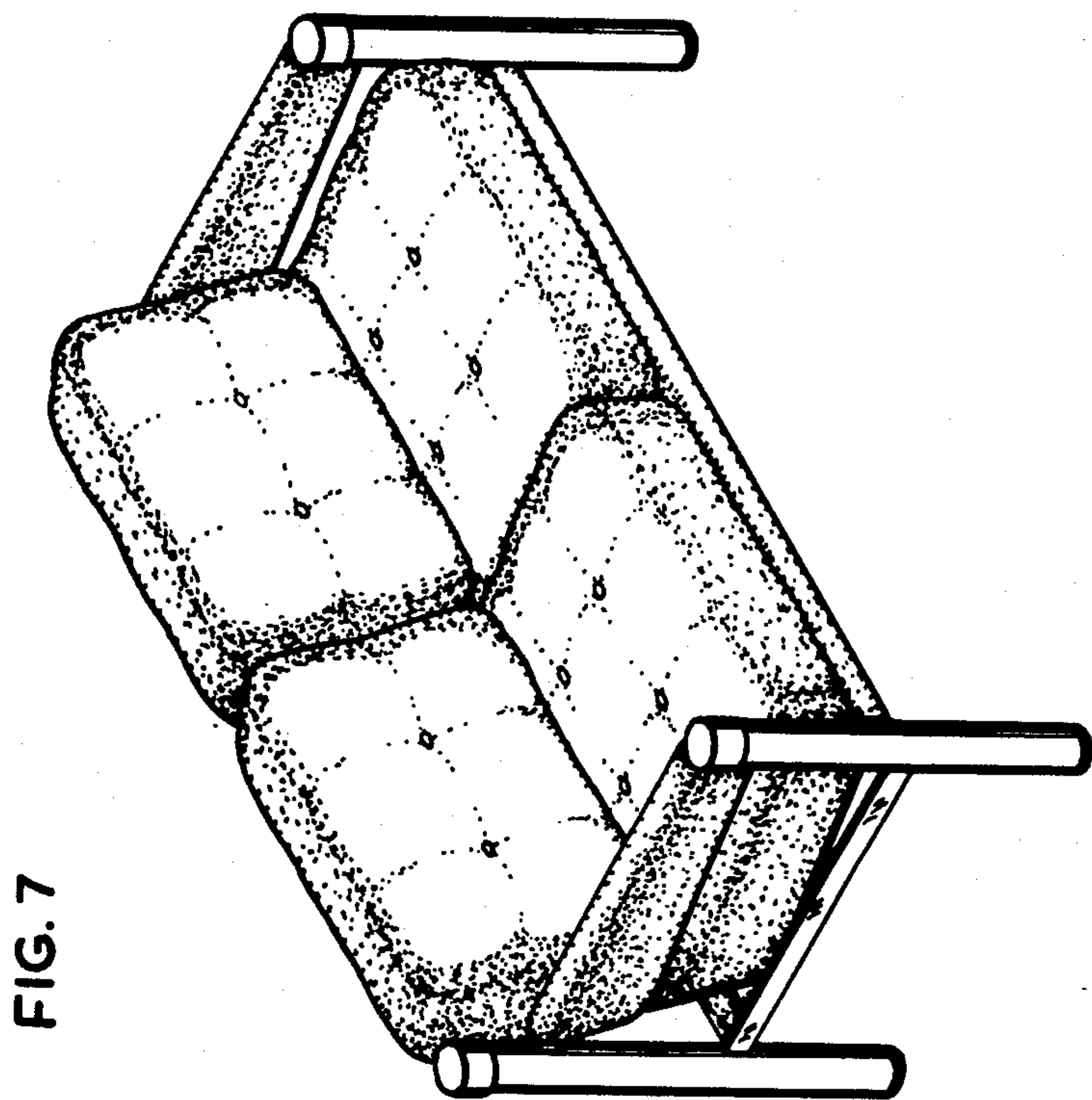

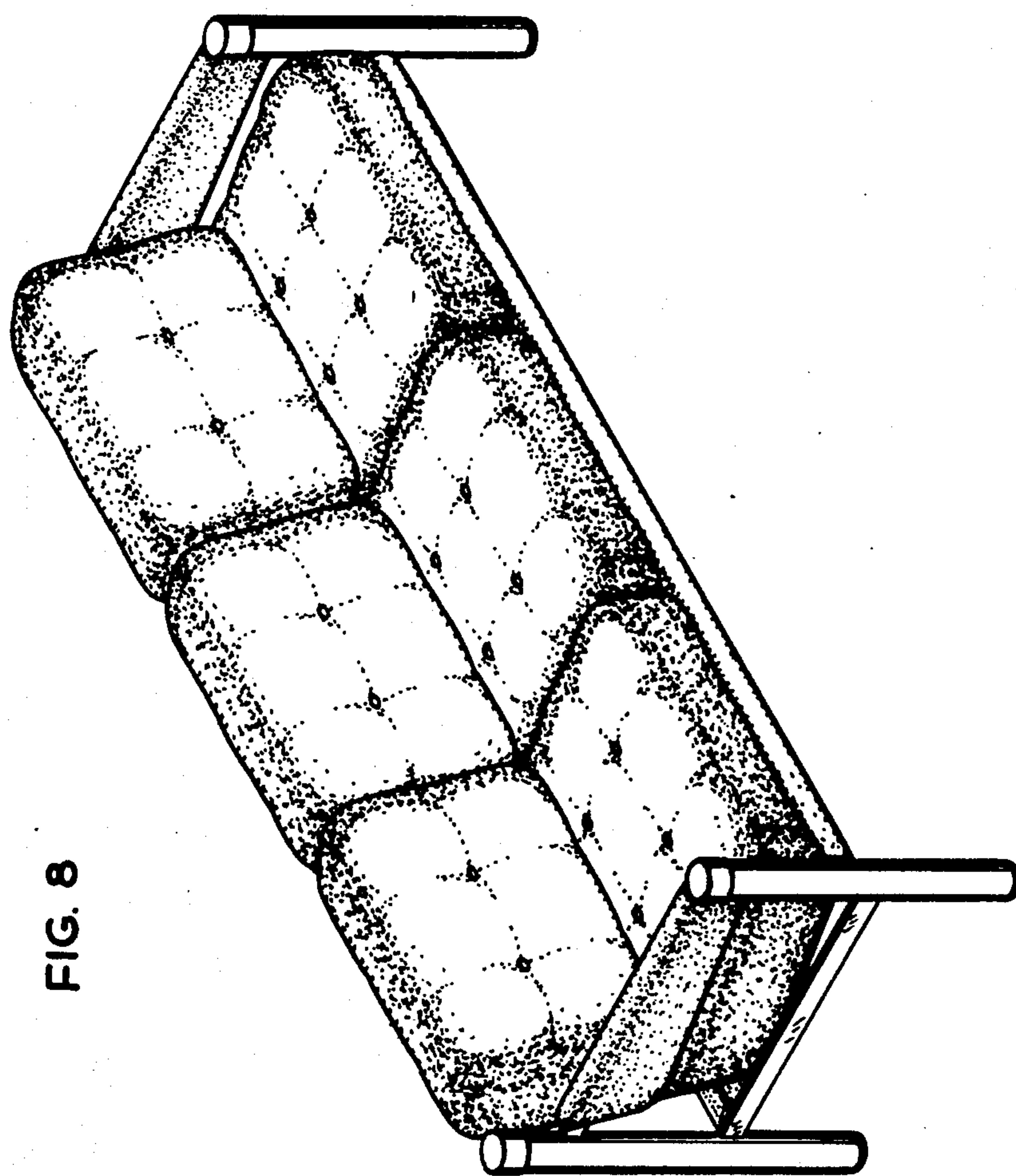
