DESCRIPTION

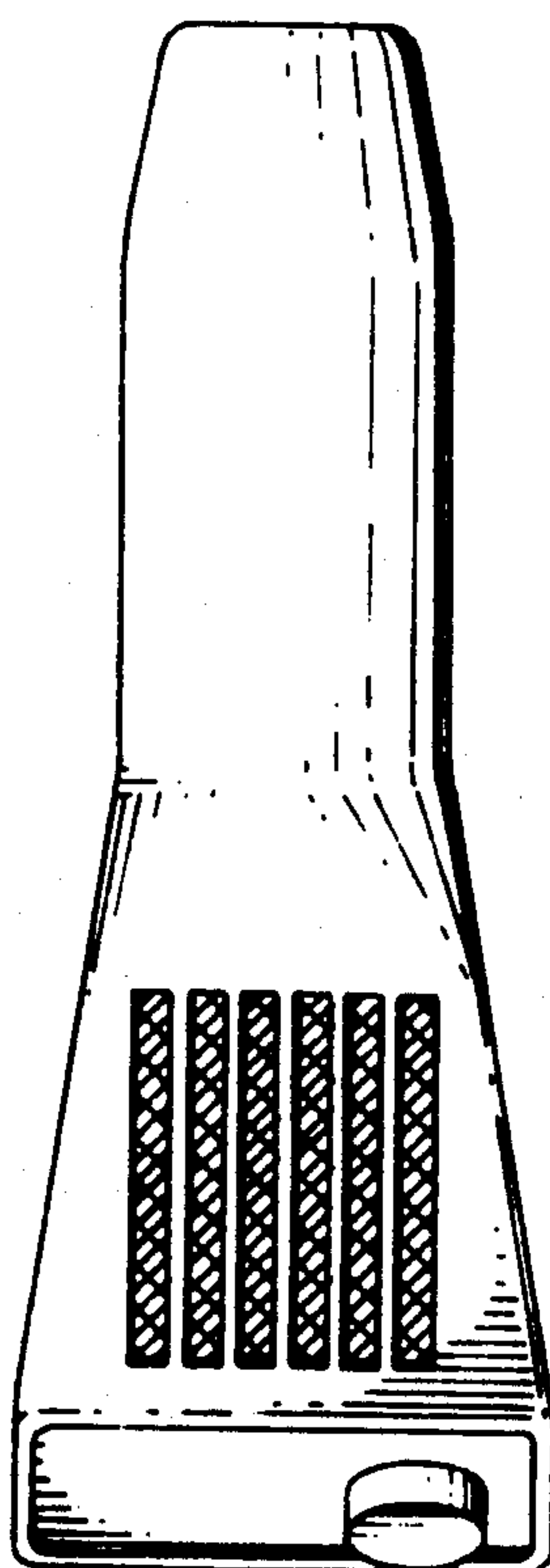
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a detector for metal or the like showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



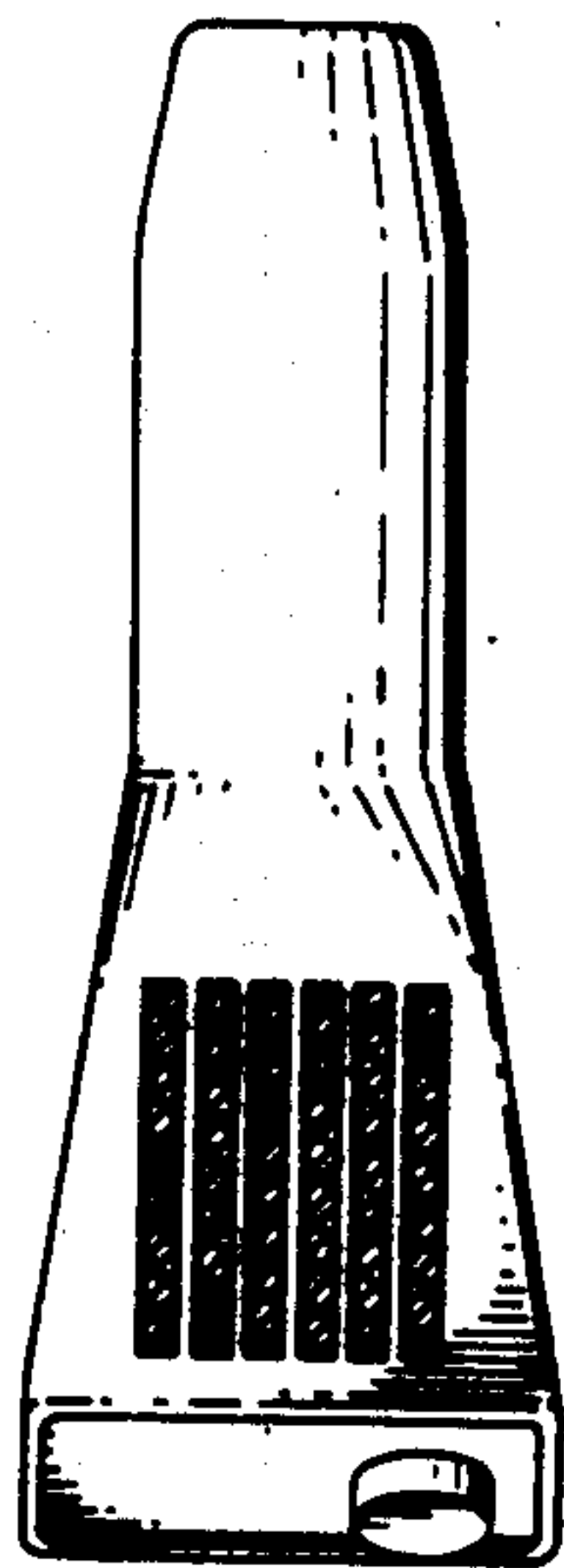

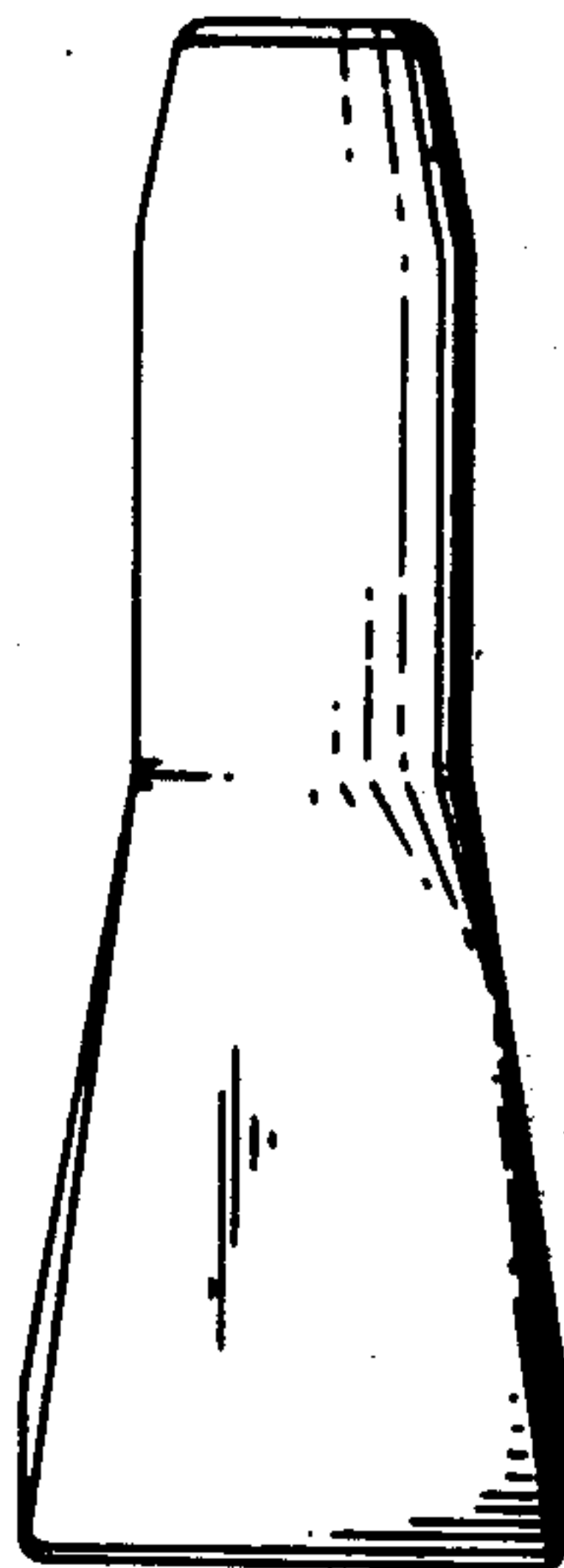
