FIG. 2 is a bottom, right, rear perspective view thereof.

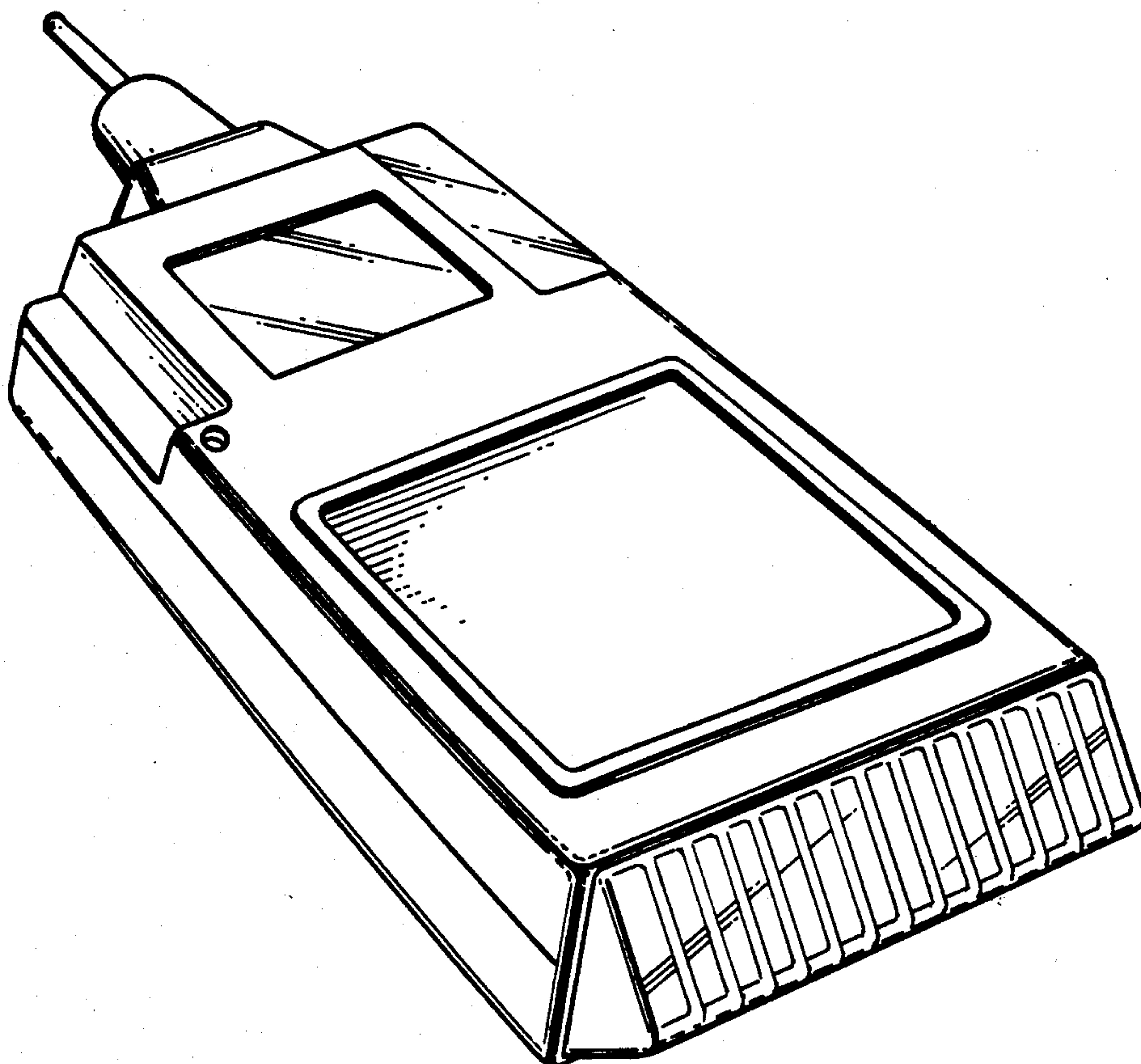

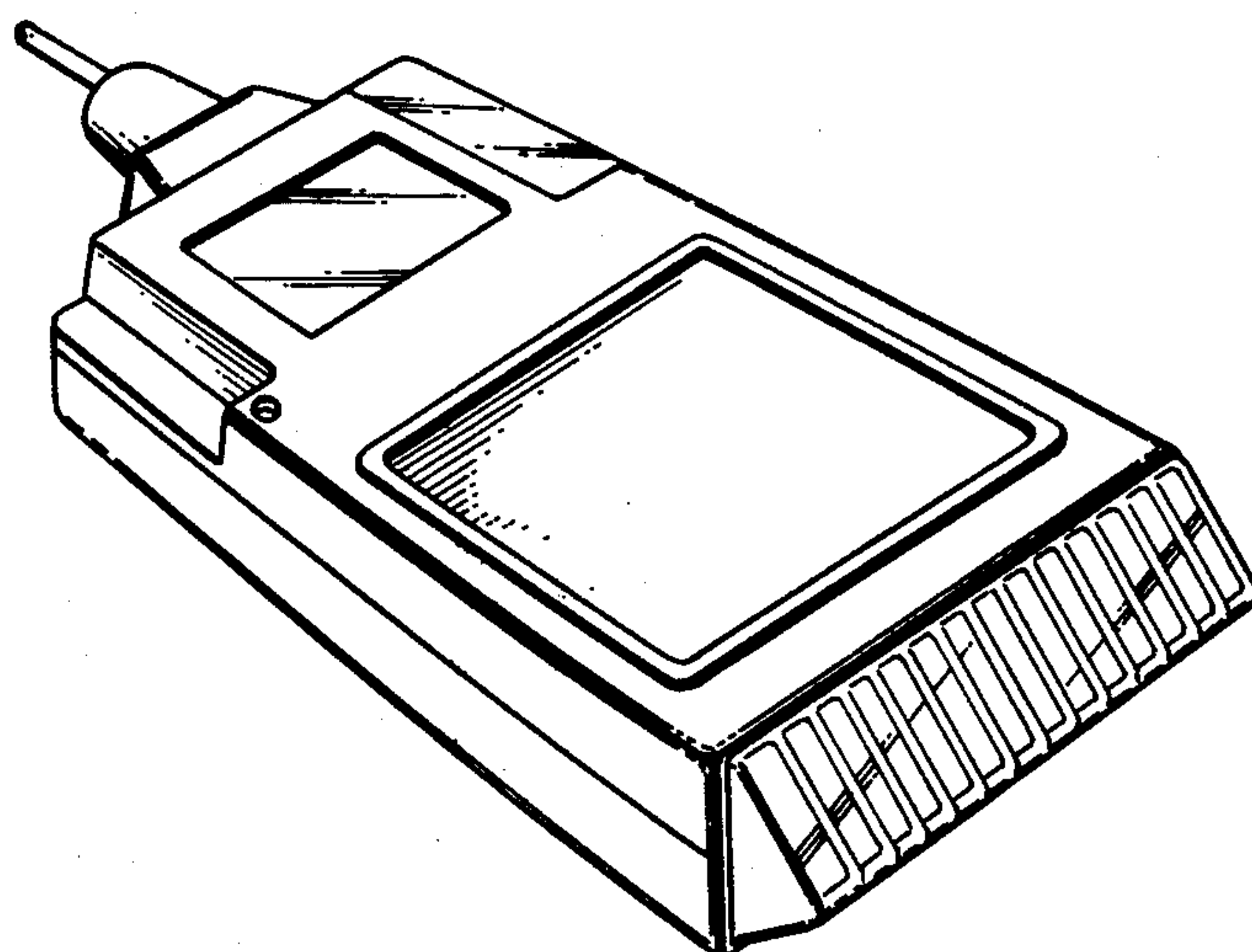
