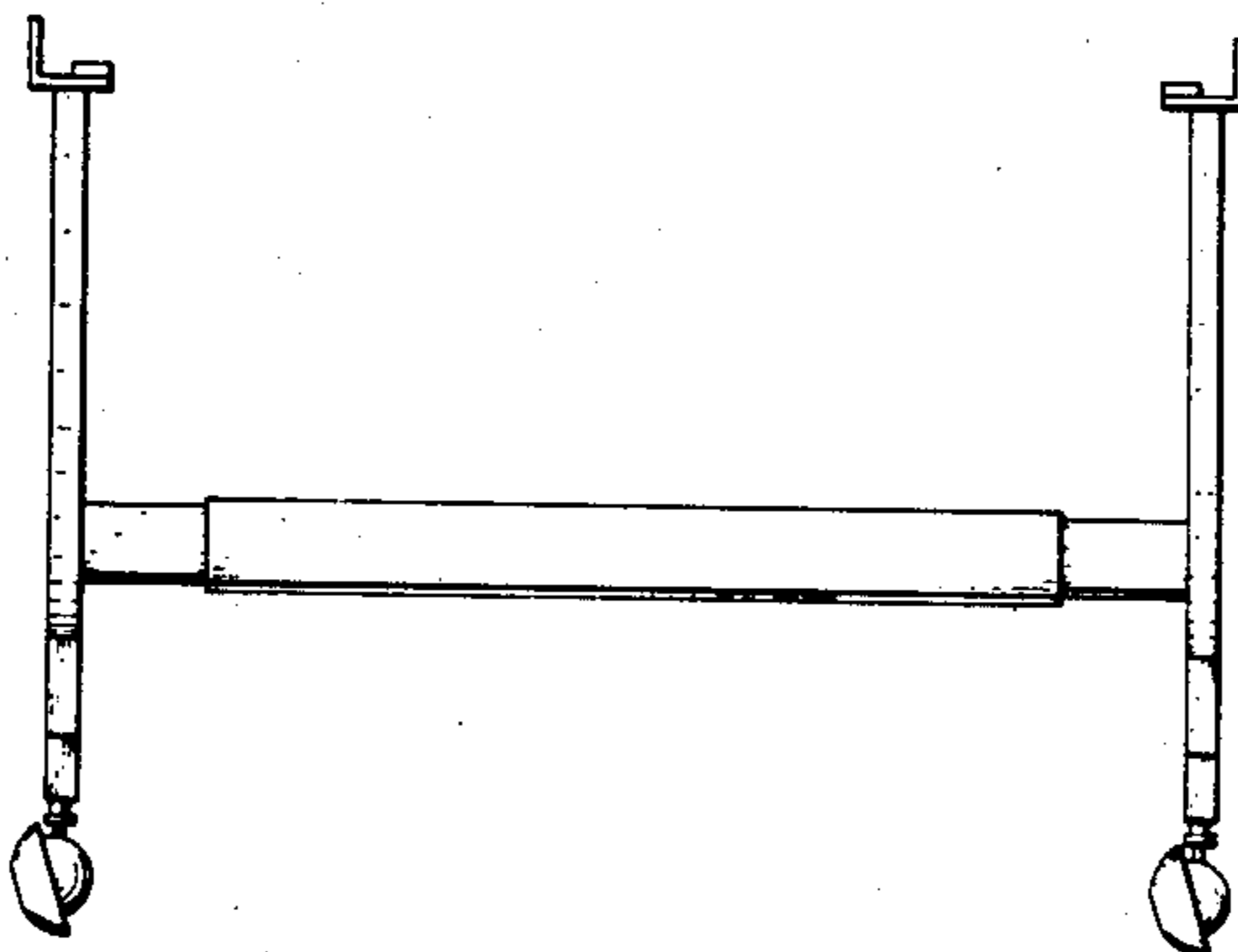
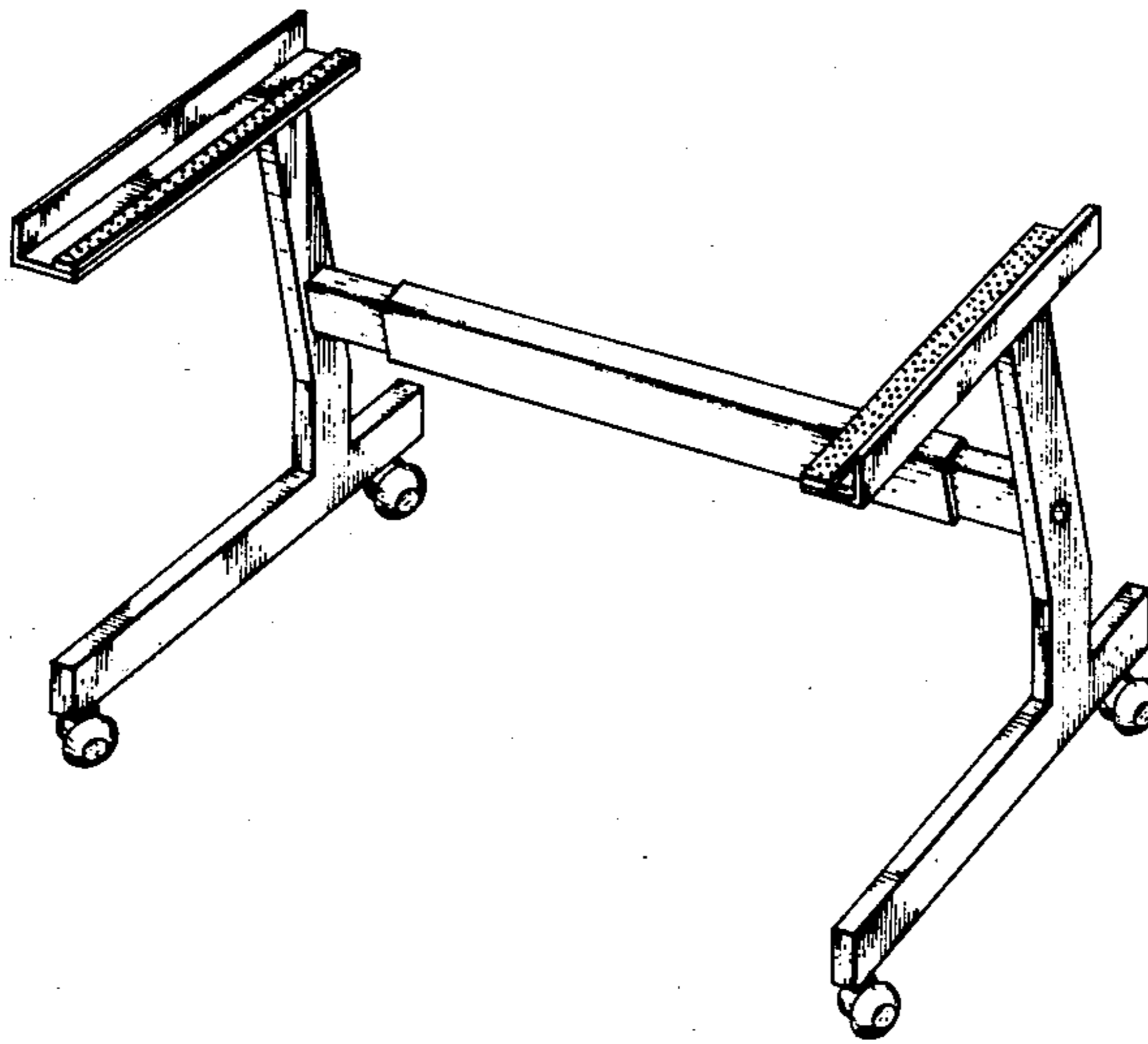

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a music center stand, showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a rear elevation thereof.



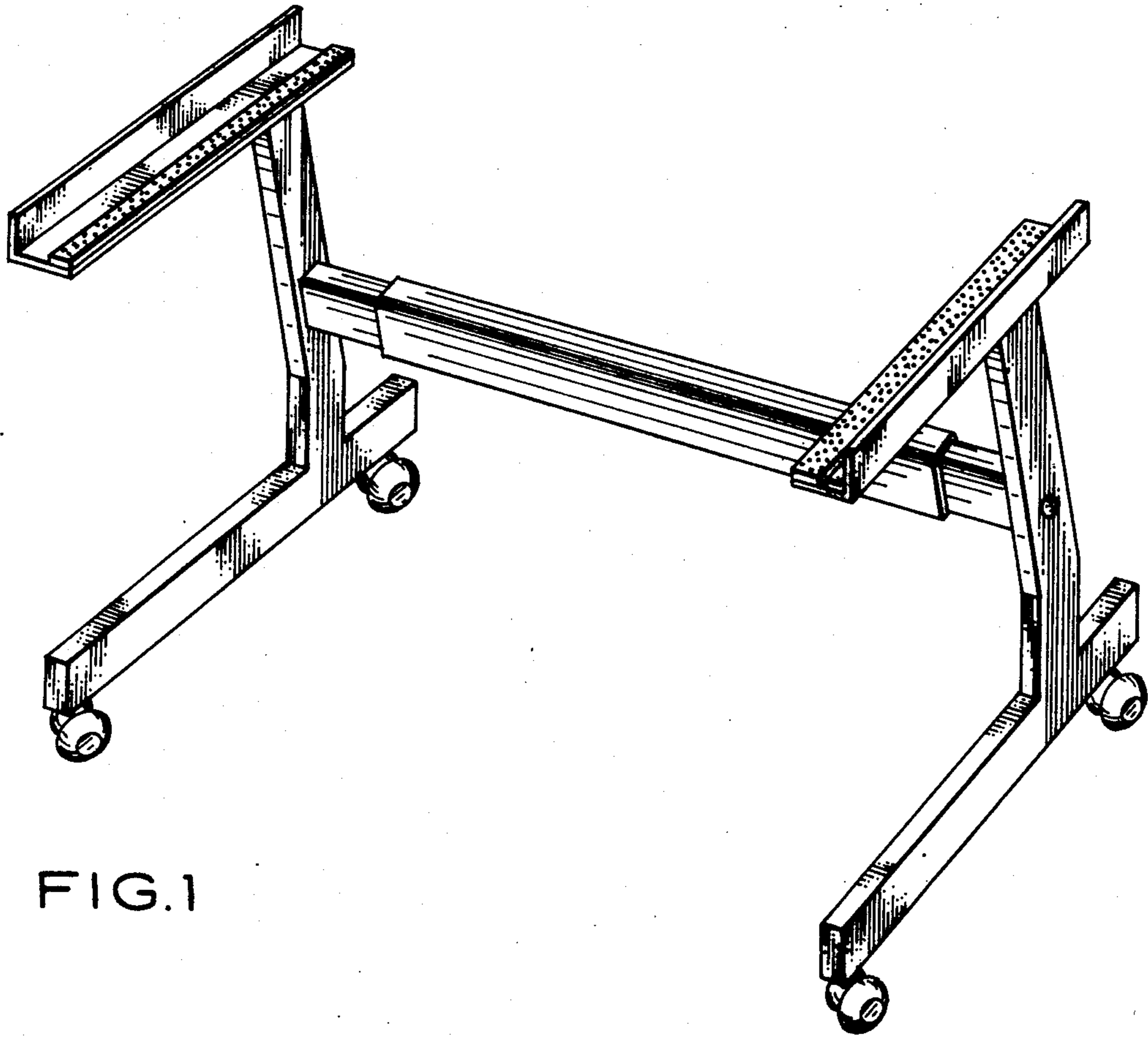

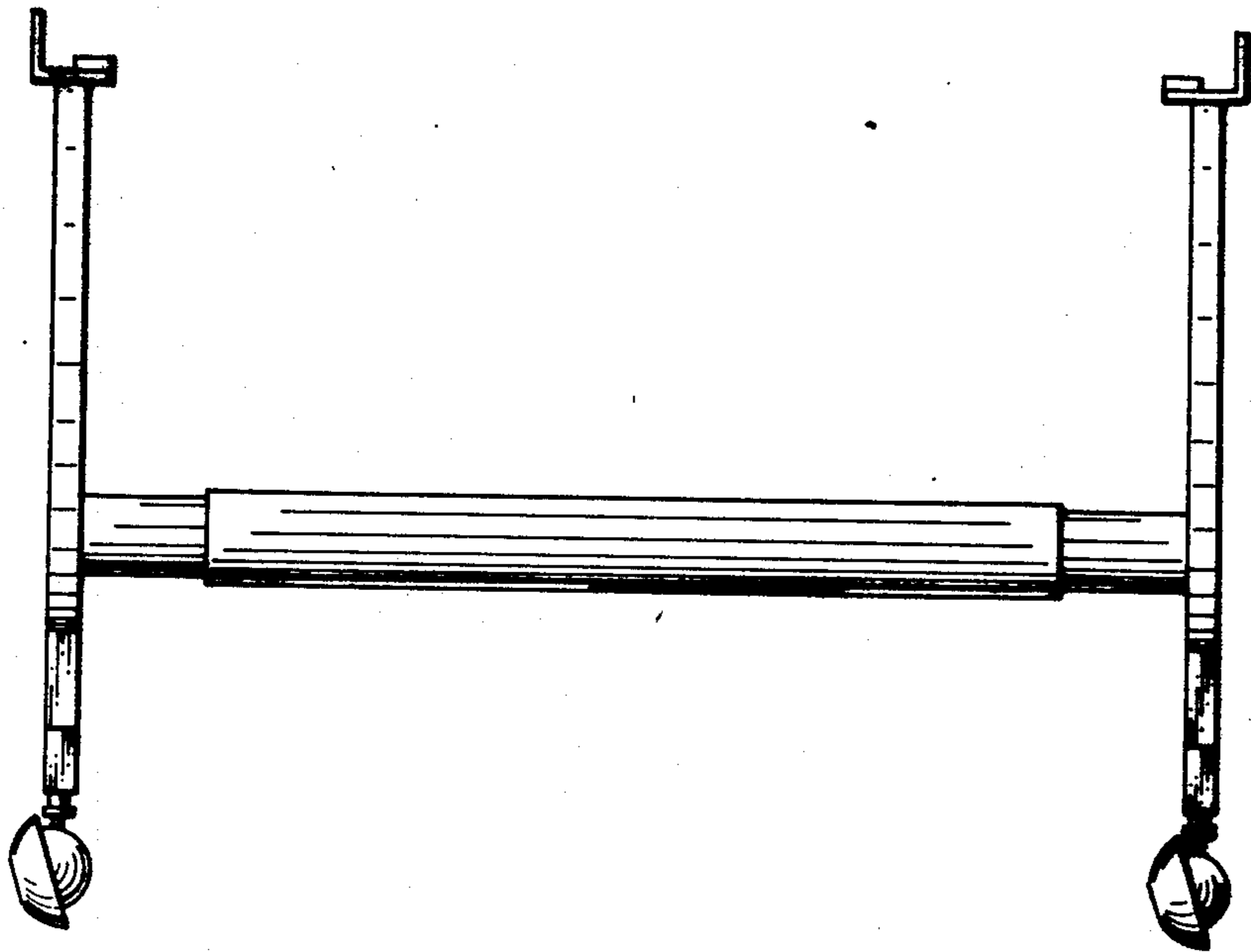
